ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

1. Commonization of mission work.
2. Some old guardian stand by's like Thorsen were not there, and they moved on anyway.
3. They saw themselves as making crucial decisions about the global centrum dynamic, and saw themselves a part of it.
4. They made significant research in polity, especially in local analysis.
5. Charles Moore's closing address got them grounded in R.S.I and they were deeply addressed by his reference to their being the religious.
6. Think tank products are useful, significant work.
7. In the social processes work, significant things were said that could be used in LENS economic lecture.
8. Working on polity models made the social processes come alive
