PROFOUND JOURNEY DIALOGUE FACILITATION STYLE GUIDELINES

STYLE

1. Invite rather than tell
2. Do not call on participants
3. It is not necessary for everyone to answer
- 4.

CONTENT

1. Image of People of the Question
2. Decide on how to refer to PJD i.e. not a course
3. Watch for assumptions throughout e.g that there is universal truth and latent wisdom (participant took issue with this)
4. Clarify language use: vocation, consciousness, profound journey, noetic, neighbor (comment from participants – need a more universal word)
5. Awareness of timing
6. Simplify contexting
7. Do not reference RS-1
8. There are no answers
9. Watch for questions that presuppose an answer
10. Clarify individual and collective focus
11. Use of on B1/2 is unhelpful
12. Do not ignore wide range of cultural awareness
