

1. Summer '71's task was to describe the practical vision of the New Social Vehicle based on the analysis of the dynamics of society portrayed in the social process triangles. During the summer, five basic documents were written. These were letter coded as follows:

- A. - The Dynamical Relations of the Social Processes
- B. - Matrices of Contradictions
- C. - All the Earth Belongs to All the People
- D. - Preproposals, Radical Relations and Target Tertiaries
- E. - 77 Proposals Toward a Practical Vision of the New Social Vehicle

These documents are described in Appendix I of this report.

2. The task of the past nine months has been to test, summarize and analyze the summer's work in order to design the means by which tactical systems would be built which would catalyze the New Social Vehicle.

#### TESTING METHODS

3. Testing the work of Summer '71 does not mean checking the work done by the Research Assembly as to its correctness in accordance with some theoretical image of what social reformulation ought to be. Rather, the three-fold testing phase was developed to disclose the parameters of inclusive scope, internal relatedness and practical implication. In order to test the inclusive scope of the summer's work, the master categories of social processes, dynamics and imbalances, social ideology and contradiction, and proposal and structural form were applied throughout the global Research Net to the nine geo-social continents through their historical periods. The internal relatedness of the summer's work was tested by writing 46-paragraph proposal books for each of the 77 proposals. These books drew on all of the summer work and provided a comprehensive analysis of each key social process. The practical implementation of the summer was tested through the preliminary design of the New Individual in the New Society course, in which the sociological insights of method and content were used in response to the human malaise of contemporary society.

4. The geo-social study, the proposal books and the course disclosed that the work of Summer '71 was amazingly significant. Its methodological presuppositions were validated and its wisdom was both consistent and practical. However, the key insight was that Document E, with its mass of complexly related intensive grass roots wisdom, held all of the summer's work. It is the focus and point of departure for the tactics of the New Social Vehicle.

#### SUMMARY METHODS

5. A major task of research has been summarizing the work of Summer '71 contained in Document E. Document E contains 16 paragraphs on each of the

77 proposal arenas: The following is the structure of one proposal book in Document E:

The first summarizing task was to condense these 16 paragraphs for each proposal into a manageable length and form. This was done by summarizing each contradiction paragraph (4-8) and each proposal paragraph (9-13) into a two-sentence paragraph which precisely named each contradiction and each proposal and described it. Then the five contradiction paragraphs (4-8) were pulled into a three-sentence paragraph which named and described the inclusive contradiction which was at the center of the five. The same procedure was followed with the proposal paragraphs (9-13). Finally, a three-sentence digest paragraph was written which related the social arena and social consequences to the relationship between the contradiction and the proposal. These 13 paragraphs for each of the 77 proposals comprise the document, The 77 Proposal Holding Forms: A Summary of Summer '71. This work summarizes Document E on the basis of its own organization. It essentially sharpens and condenses the raw data.

6. The next task was to organize these data on the basis of the interrelations of the 77 points in the social process models from which proposals were written. These 77 were designated by consistently emphasizing the cultural dimension of the social process, thereby pulling the reality of the 20th century revolutions in sense, style and mood into the essential model of **the way society always operates**. There is derived through this method one inclusive category of Cultural Commonality which informs the whole social process through its rational pole, Symbol. In addition, there are four primary arenas, wisdom, style, economic, and political. These five arenas were used to control two different summarizing methods.

7. The first of these methods summarized the contradictions and proposals for each of the four sub-areas within each of the four primary arenas. As these data were summarized, they were included with the summary for the appropriate primary arena itself. This process resulted in 21 interrelated summaries of contradictions and interrelated summaries of proposals. Each contradiction and each proposal was succinctly named. The master summary contradiction was designated as "Inadequate Contextual Images," and the master summary proposal called for "Recreated Global Sociality." This method of summary comprised the

document entitled, Summary of Document E-77 Contradictions, and Proposals.

8. The second summarizing methods again dealt with the major arenas and sub-arenas from which Document E was written, but it employed gestalting rather than straight-forward summarizing. With each sub-arena, 4-point gestalts of the contradictions and of the proposals were made. Then the process was repeated for the primary arenas. Using this method, the master contradiction was seen as "Collapsed Foundational Social Mythology," and it was proposed that it be dealt with by "Secularly Embodied Word." The results of this methods are titled, Gestalt Summaries of the 77 Contradictions and Proposals.

9. The summary methods dimension of the New Social Vehicle research, therefore, provided both a focused precision and an organizing master context for the work of Summer '71. From this basis, it proved possible to begin to analyze the implications of Summer '71 for the tactical systems to be built in Summer '72.

#### ANALYTIC METHODS

10. Once the social contradictions and proposals have been articulated, the next step is to define the inter-relationships which are present in the social process as revealed by last summer's analysis. Since the social process is one dynamic, it follows that particular aspects of the contradictions and proposals are related in both expected and unexpected ways. Two different analytical methods have been used which illuminate these inter-relationships: Social Imbalances and Active Plotting Concentrations.

11. The first analytic method that illuminated the strategic possibilities is to show the imbalances of the social process. The social imbalance is applied to the social process triangles to the fourth level, naming one pole as the tyrant, one as the ally, and one as the collapsed. The social process which has grown in power out of proportion to the other two is called the tyrant. The process whose reaction to the tyrant has been submissive, impotent and ambivalent is called the ally. The remaining process which, in the face of the overwhelming tyrant and submissive ally, has become totally ineffective is called the collapsed. For example, in the whole social process, economic commonality is tyrannical, rendering political commonality impotent, and collapsing cultural commonality. In principle, tyrant processes are not viable arenas for social reformulation, for they are entrenched in dominance. Since an ally pole is presently in the service of a tyrannical pole, it cannot be empowered itself. Therefore, primary tactical attention must be given to collapsed poles. This imbalance method, since it indicates strengths and weaknesses within the dynamics of society, provides a theoretical strategy which informs the tactical systems.

12. The second analytic method, active plotting concentrations, locates for each of the 77 proposals, both the social process which, through its malfunctioning permits the contradiction to continue and the social process which is most directly involved in providing the action called for by the proposal. The process which sustains the contradiction is the contradiction agent; the process which provides

the demanded action is the proposal agent; and the process from which the analysis was made is the beneficiary. Plotting the proposal agents on the social process triangles reveals concentrations. These groupings of a number of proposals' agents is called a cluster, and each cluster indicates where attention must be focused in order to develop New Social Vehicle tactical systems. The development of the tactical systems will be one of the major efforts of Summer '72 Research Assembly.

#### ANCILLARY METHODS

13. In addition to these major methods of dealing with the material of Summer '71, there have been two approaches which have yielded significant data to be used in the context and the content of the tactical systems. The first of these ancillary methods is to begin to build courses and reports on the summer. The insights gained through this method have gone into the summer lectures and will prove valuable in future dissemination of the work which went into building the practical vision of the New Social Vehicle. The second ancillary method catalogued all of the content of the 5 proposal paragraphs in terms of its function. Some sentences dealt with the present situation of society; others' proposed intermediate steps which have to be taken to bring the New Social Vehicle into being; still others describe the future vision of the new society. These data are expected to provide crucial information for the practical application of the tactical systems.

#### THE FIVE NEXUS

14. One major result of the testing, summary and analytic methods employed during the past 9 months is the articulation of five nexus of proposals which, from Summer '71, state the master activities which characterize the task of forging the New Social Vehicle. These five proposal nexus are presently stated at the most inclusive level, their sub-nexus must be discovered and clearly articulated.

#### THE FIVE PILLARS

15. The second major result of the work since Summer '71 is the preliminary articulation of the five pillars of the New Social Vehicle held in the book, Toward the Practical Vision of the New Social Vehicle, along with a statement of the proposal nexus. This document states the foundational presuppositions of Summer '71 about the New Social Vehicle, as well as describes the basic methods by which the analytical basis of the New Social Vehicle has been forged.

#### THE PRACTICAL VISION BOOK

16. The combination of the five nexus with the five pillars provides the practical vision of the New Social Vehicle. This document must be written by Summer '72. On the basis of it, the forces of social renewal will be motivated to build the earth anew.
