

## **EI/ICA ART FORM METHOD CONVERSATION QUESTIONS**

### **(A sample of questions used in movie conversations)**

#### **Objective Questions**

What scenes in the movie do you remember?  
What characters were in the story?  
What lines of dialogue stand out in your mind?  
Where do you remember music in the story?  
What scenery was particularly striking?  
Where do you remember outdoor scenes?  
What were some indoor scenes?  
What inanimate objects do you remember?  
What were expressions on character's face that stood out?  
What was the actual sequence of events in the story?  
What things did you see as symbols?

#### **Reflective Questions**

Where did you laugh?  
Where did you feel happy (sad or other emotions)?  
Where did the audience respond (laugh, gasp, cry, etc.)?  
What made that scene (line, incident) funny (serious, etc.)?  
Which characters did you most closely identify with?  
How did you feel sympathetic towards that character?  
Which character did you dislike the most? Why?  
What was your mood at the end of the movie?  
Who did you identify with that you didn't want to identify with?  
What was your own mood at the end of the story?  
What were the turning points in the story?  
What kind of journey did it take you on?

#### **Interpretive Questions?**

What seemed to be the most critical moment in the story?  
What was really going on in that scene?  
What was (character's name) really struggling with?  
What were the motives behind the character's actions?  
What kind of journey was the main character on?  
What do you think the story was trying to communicate?  
What social issue is this production out to address?  
What are the ethical questions that this story raises?  
What is the dilemma of the characters?  
What is the role of a story like this in today's world?

#### **Decisional Questions**

In what ways do you most appreciate this story?  
In what way is this story helpful for people today?  
What do you least appreciate about this story?  
On what points would you like to argue with the script?  
If you had to rename this story, what would you call it?  
How would you briefly describe this story to someone?  
How are you a little bit different for having seen it?  
How has it changed your perspective on life?  
How does this story affect your perspective on life?  
How does this story affect your relationship to the future?
