MOVEMENT

As an imaginal education tool, the Global Odyssey offers face-to-face encounters with the object of one's care. In this dimension the Global Odyssey is a witness by the Spirit Movement to itself and to the world that the responsibility of resurgent man is nothing less than world wide.

THE

RESEARCH

The Global Odyssey is research into methodologies that include the dynamics of group travel, embodying dimensions of preparation by a dispersed group, experience by that group, and reflection on that experience, that enables the total group to engage in a journey and to name that journey. The Global Odyssey is research into the possibility of very intense cultural immersion for the sake of imaginal explosion of world view. The Global Odyssey serves as an experiment in the use of travel as a form of imaginal education in the arenas of raising to consciousness man's care for the world and in broadening one's cultural awareness. It determines what new tactics of care need to be applied to the world cultures, realizing that these tactics will vary greatly among different cultures. The Global Odyssey will address itself to the question of how resurgence is emerging in other cultures.

THE

TRAINING

The Global Odyssey is training for global revolutionaries. We approach the world not as idle spectators, but as warriors sizing up their battleground. Through the experience of the Odyssey we will be trained in corporateness, in practical model building on group logistics as well as corporate care for the individual. In the midst of the objective need which the world presents and the strains of being part of an intensive group, we will sense ourselves acquiring new internal discipline, a new ability to detach ourselves from our personal desires and to will the one thing of the mission with our own most personal decision. We will be newly trained in revolutionary thinking as people who come upon every situation with the active question "What does it need?" and then, "Where do I start?" and experience in answering those questions in a higly concentrated period of time.

ODYSSEY GLOBAL TASK F.

The Global Odyssey is a dramatic form of globality tabining. The other Urs are encountered as vehicles to include with one's own in a vision of the recreated civilization. The contentlessness of authentic religion is grounded in discovering the power of other religious modes. A rational screen is created to responsibley organize the complexity of history, geography and sociology of the world. And the burden-of-the-world image is filled to overflowing with particularity beyond one's local experience.

The Global Odyssey is a decisional spirit journey intensification approached with both fear and fascination. It is structured intrusion on the self with a deluge of otherness. It is structured "no-escape" for a month from illusion-shattering experiences and the necessity to move out to meet "the Dark Night" over and over agaim. It is a decision to create and rehearse the corporate, sustaining mythology on this journey. And it is decision to recreate the interior environment with intensive reflection in this fertile Odyssey landscape.

The Global Odyssey is radical movementalization. It is a contained demonstration and intensive training in corporateness. It grounds the faces and network of the movement. It is the "symbolic journey" to the universe which occaisions radical detachment. Odyssey participants belong more to the other-world-in-the-midst-of-this-world and are the embodiment of the other as they return to their local situation. The Odyssey adds to the ranks of "Those Who Care" through an Ebenezer Scrooge-type viewing of concrete need in the world and concrete engagement in a parish miracle which changes the future.

The Global Odyssey has the possibility to serve the movement beyond just the impact it is on the local movement whereever it stops. By going to a new city in each Odyssey basic penetration of unformulated areas can be done. These year the Odyssey can be sensitive to the right location for Social Demonstration, and reprot on this. The Odyssey is a mobile body of consultants whose expertise can be applied in one or more selected locations in an actual engagement in a local task of Centrum, House, Galaxy, or Guild-Parish. Finally the Global Odyssey is a source of colleagues of deepened committment ready for new assignments in covenant with movement and order.

The Global Odysseyis an unpredicatable discontinuity which intrudes on history and shifts the projections of logical futurists whose picture of the future is aimply a deterioration of the present. In this it is a concrete isgn of hope in a resurgent global society.


THE GLOBAL ODYSSEY

The Global Odyssey is a symbol of the movement's ever-exploding most inclusive context. In the encounter with the particular faces of the Other, which the traveler experiences as personal humiliation, he grasps anew his uniqueness and his real power. As a souvenir, and as a gift to all those he represents, he carries back a new screen of mankind's interrelationships and a new sense of transparent integrity.



FOLLOW UP OR REDUPLICATION

The follow-up or reduplication of the Global Tour is that aspect of the tour that provides the means whereby the participants share the trip with the corporate body. This process includes sharing external and internal journies, evaluating the trip for future tours, accountability to the larger body, and extending the possibility to them, also.
