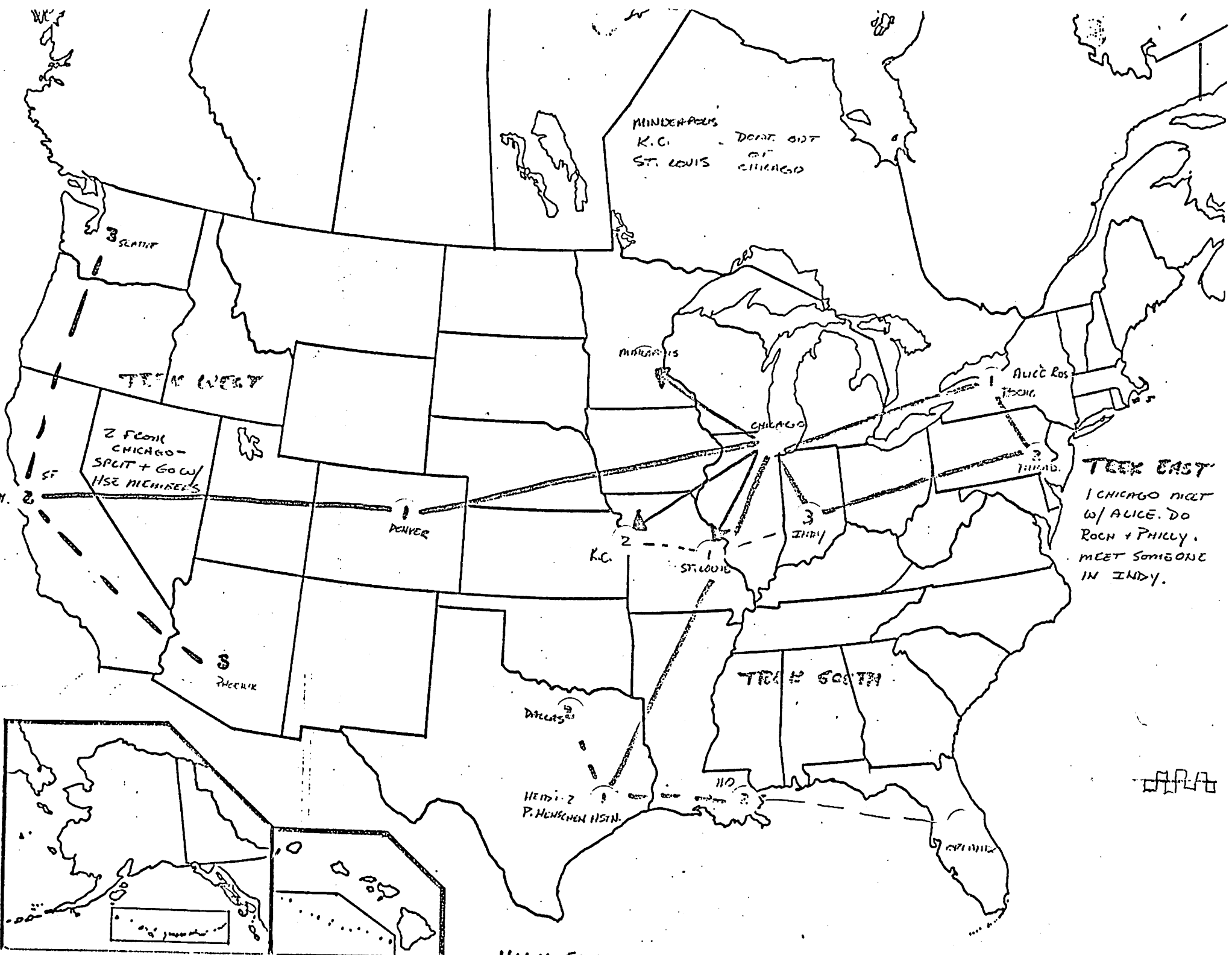

Intent Statements:

The overall intent of the Youth Trek and Presidium is to articulate the profound role of Phase I in society and manifest new possibility into the claim on youth.

The intents of the Trek are: to discern the challenges facing the youth revolution (globally and locally), to form the internal and external youth networks, and to enable the appropriation of the Phase I journey.

The intents of the 1981 Youth Presidium are to write a formal statement on the youth revolution and plan the practical responses; to form images for extension of the Phase I program across the globe and implementation models; and to discern the marks and ways to symbolize the transition years in the Phase I journey.
