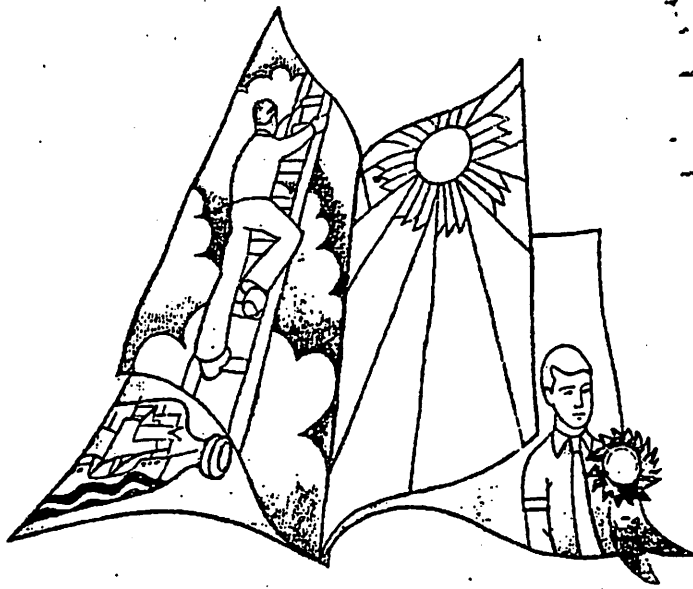

CHALLENGE STATEMENTS

I. In the arena of: ECONOMIC

The fact that: there are not enough jobs

This challenge is illustrated by: people on welfare, youth don't want jobs, people get drunk and smoke because bored with life.

II. POLITICAL

In the arena of Police Protection

The fact that : there is Police Harassment, poor police protection, no walking police, danger of public travel

Indicates that the underlying challenge is: police and community don't work together

The challenge is illustrated by: the fact that when people see crime, they are scared to call for help.

III. CULTURAL

In the arena of: Street Sense

The fact that: lack of community pride and closing their eyes on everyday problems

Indicates that the underlying challenge is: People are not willing to get involved in the problems that effect everyone in the community.

This challenge is illustrated by: the lack of communication of the people in the community, example: student-teacher, child-parent, elder-youth.
