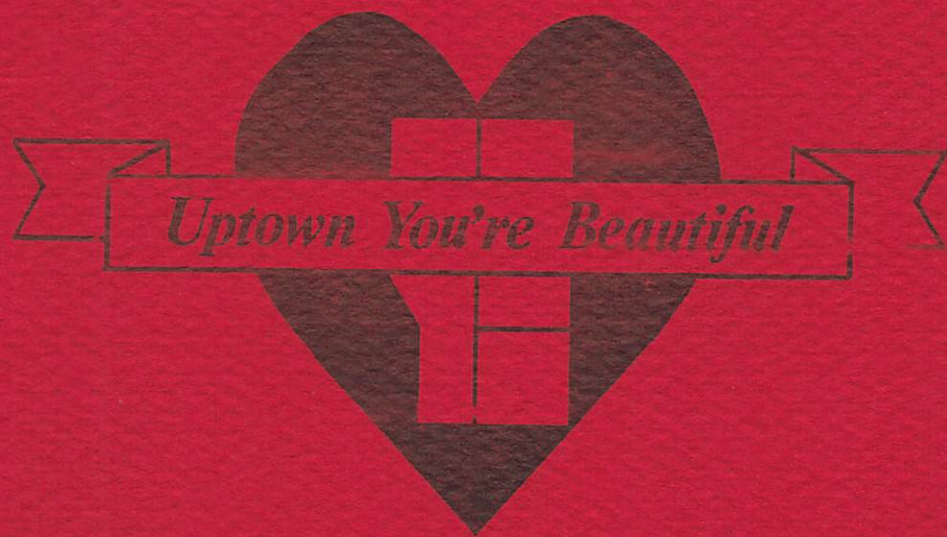

so gather your tools and lend a hand: Resurgence! Now the time!

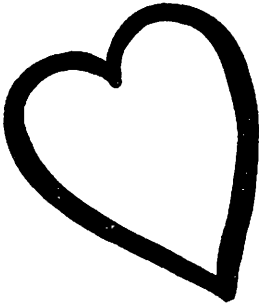
And we are Up, Up in Uptown, global gifts galore,

Your love's put me at the top of the world.*

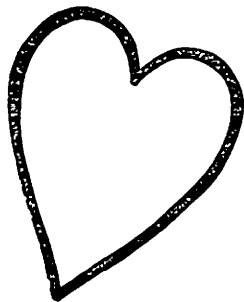
Something in the wind just learned my name
