5 CONTRADITIONS AND PROPOSALS TO THOSE 5 CONTRADITIONS

- 1. We have gone beyond our initiating operating image.

 We propose that we create a new operating image of the relationship of the guild and the galaxy incorporating the cell. Based upon an articulation of our presuppositions and our strategic approach to the protoparish by way of the parish revealing how all of these actualize the Coumonical Parish as a global sign.
- 2. Focus too broad for Ecumenical Parish Experiment
 We propose the creation of geographic and symbolic awareness of Parish,
 Protoparish and ward by creating value screens which will allow the guild
 to decide its geographic focus through use of gridding methods, recruitment
 in Uptown 5, committing the guild/galaxy to doing focused operational constructs as
 a part of the Uptown 5. Demonstration signalling the beginning of the Uptown
 Parish.
- 3. Guild & Galaxy are unembodied in effective forms
 We propose to initiate the auxiliary sodality, Week II Councils, and Clergy
 priorship meetings of the Local Church Experiment, with all other complementary programming, while expanding the forms of the guild by escalating the task force structures, using week II PSU's to plan the task force direction.
- 4. Base too named to do massive reformulation

 We propose to widen the base of the guild and Galaxy organizing them to recruit LENS, PLC, and RS-I systematically through the wards out of a comprehensive plan which holds consensed values of social, ethnic and demominational diversity with course costs commensurate with the community's ability to pay.
- depth comprehensive response.

 In order to create a global awareness, we propose to blitz the guild and galaxy with global symbols and models and engage them in comprehensive problemating with an emphasis on the five pre-suppositions of the 5th City Model and set a guild training plan in operation.

TACTIC 1: OPERATING IMAGES

DESCRIPTION

The intent of the tactic of creating the operating image is to provide the context and rationale for doing the Uptown 5 project in quarter 3. Having outgrown the other operating image it is necessary to create an operating image which adds focus and form to the daily task of the Uptown 5 Post. This tactic includes the creation of an image that will hold for the post and movement the work of quarter 3, the creation of contextual charts to visibly and imaginally create the context for the quarter's task, the articulation of the Uptown 5 story so the work of Uptown 5 can be understood and appropriated by the movement, and finally, the building of a timeline for the Uptown 5 project to add objectivity and necessary practical focus for the day to day, quarter to quarter work of the post.

IMPLEMENTATION

The operating image for quarter 3 is to be created and articulated weeks 1 and 2 of quarter 3 by the Uptown 5 Post as a result of post and centrum battleplanning for quarter 3. Contextual charts are to be created week II of week 2 and then to be displayed week I of week 3. The content for the charts will be created by the Uptown 5 Post. The articulation of the Uptown 5 story is to be pulled together and created week I of week 4 by the Uptown 5 Post. The Uptown 5 project timeline is to be created and displayed week I of week 3 by the Uptown 5 Post from the work of the quarter's pre-planning and PSU-task force work.

TACTIC 2: PROTOPARISH FOCUS

DESCRIPTION

This tactic is designed to relate the EPX story to the Guild/Galaxy and enable it to focus on the Uptown 5 Protoparish which will give concrete form to the Guild contentual images and provide the Galaxy with a directional objective. The protoparish provides a limited piece of geography in which to effect comprehensive reformulation and signal demonstration. Through gridding and other social methods, the geography of the parish and protoparish will establish a common memory of intent and hold the decided focus before the Guild/Galaxy.

IMPLEMENTATION

The implementation of this tactic will take place on week II of week I where contexting on the ecumenical parish, the story of Uptown 5, the intent of the social model, and gridding procedures will be given by George Holcombe or Fred Hess directly in the PSU meeting. Follow-up gridding is to be done successively from weekend to weekend to produce definitive, comprehensive, and inclusive grids. Reports will be given and grids consensed upon by the Guild members at the meeting on January 23 as symbolically holding the socio-geographic data of Uptown.

TACTIC 3: UPTOWN 5 SYMBOL

DESCRIPTION

The Uptown 5 symbol tactic is intended to enable the forging of contextual images by creating and disseminating a story about the symbol and by displaying it at all meetings and events of the Galaxy and the Guild and by practically grounding its use in PSU's, task forces, and workshops.

IMPLEMENTATION

This tactic will be implemented by completing the creation of the story of the Uptown 5 symbol before the January 23 Guild meeting and preparing enough copies to distribute or mail to all Guild and Galaxy members. At least two Uptown 5 symbols created with felt and two on heavy duty poster board or light wood shall be completed for display at Galaxy and Guild meetings and PSU's and workshops by week II of week 4. The symbol shall be appropriately printed on everything we produce throughout the quarter. For practical use an 8 1/2 x 11 size grid with streets and wards marked shall be printed and available in quantities for implementation in any planning and recruiting by week II of week 3.

TACTIC 4: GUILD PROGRAMME

DESCRIPTION

In order that the Guild might move effectively in its initial moves toward direct engagement of Uptown 5, it is necessary to do specific necessary work in order to bring rationality, form, and effective methods into the guild programming. The Post and Guild will forge the task force operating designs including meeting rhythm and calendar necessary enabling constructs for task force, PSU, and regular Guild meetings such as meeting formats, procedures for meetings, symbolic life, leadership briefing sessions, and post assignment rationale. A series of signal activities will be carried out as signals to the community and to sustain the Guild as it forges its total plan. A comprehensive task force -PSU projection will be created in order to provide direction and deepen the Guild's relationship to its task.

IMPLEMENTATION

During week I or week 3 a group of two or three people from the post will pull aside and forge a model for task force enablement to include meeting formats, symbolic life, procedures, and method of accountability and absolution. During week I of week 3 the post will brainstorm a list of enabling constructs for the Guild and an assigned group of three will pull the data together into a model and plan for implementation to be presented for consensus and implementation during week I of week 4. During week II of week 7 a task force meeting at centrum will forge the tactical model for enabling the spring festival to be a major kickoff activity for the revitalization of its business community. During week 8 to 13 of the quarter, guild time will be given over to evaluation of the past quarter and forging the battleplan for the coming quarter including future task force and PSU projection.

TACTIC 5: GALAXY AUXILIARY

DESCRIPTION

The Galaxy Auxiliary tactic is intended to launch the Galaxy in Uptown through the 13 week training period, provide means to support it during that time, and to insure sufficient participants for tactical actualization in quarter III. Recruitment of the four church clergymen and laymen to such core sourses as RS-I, PIC, and RS-IIIA will ground the auxiliary members in both theoretical and practical aspects of the church. The four clergy will meet regularly to determine means of developing their own and their laymen's priorship roles in the auxiliary. The Uptown 5 Post will also develop designs to enable the auxiliary to most effectively complete the 13 week training period before the end of the quarter.

IMPLEMENTATION

The Galaxy Auxiliary with 4 churches from Uptown will begin the 13 week training program on Monday of week 3. The sodality will meet weekly on Monday and the Week II Councils will meet on even weeks. On week II of week 4 the laymen from the auxiliary will attend the RS-I. Those who have already taken RS-I will attend the RS-IIIA in week II of week 5. The clergy couples who have not had PIC will attend during week I of week 7 in Milwaukee. The clergy will meet every other week on Thursday afternoon for two hours beginning in week 3 to develop and plan priorship roles for the auxiliary. Selected members of the Uptown 5 Post and Local Church Post will meet every Wednesday morning to design enabling constructs and assignments for the auxiliary.

TACTIC 6: CONGREGATIONAL SIGN

DESCRIPTION

The congregational sign tactic is intended to raise a sign of the renewed church and the means of building the signal congregation of the ecumenical parish in Uptown 5. Thirty persons will be recruited to courses from Peoples Church and a cadre will be initiated and developed. Special events will be held in the worship services during the quarter with the specific intent of making a significant impact on the community and to amplify the institutional strength of the congregation.

IMPLEMENTATION

This tactic will begin in the second week with a brainstorm list of potential RS-I and LENS participants not less than 100 to be composed by the associate pastor and two other key persons in the congregation. A recruitment model and timeline will be created also in the second week to include visitations prior to courses in weeks five, six, seven, and eight. In addition to this, two key staff members and at least three lay members of the congregation will meet as a cadre every Wednesday at 11:00 in the morning. Another operation of this tactic will include having the St. John's Military Academy sing during the worship services Sunday. January 27 in week 3.

Also the McCormick Boys Club of Chicago will conduct the entire service Sunday, March 31. Publicizing special services on the Monday before and weekly pastoral visits on 5 member families will increase worship attendance and financial income. Plans to include wide representation of churches for special Holy Week Services in week one of quarter IV are to be formulated by week six.

TACTIC 7: POST OPERATION

DESCRIPTION

The Post Operation will be established by designing its spirit life, giving new form to its time and space use; effectively assigning its personnel, and creating functional file and data systems. This will be done in order to release the post to radically engage its task, sustain it for the long haul, matilize gifts and intensify training, and provide the data flow necessary to inform its work, sustain a common memory, and enable effective support of the Global Guild net.

IMPLEMENTATION

Whursday morning of week 2 will be spent in a thorough review of the quarter's plan with specific lists made of forces needed. Out of this an overall rationale will be made as to numbers of staff needed in particular tactical arenas and a daily-weekly design of meetings and work time scheduled to provide the necessary nurture and strategizing to accomplish the quarter's objective. Specific assignments will be made based on the overall rationale to Guild, Galaxy, and with special responsibilities to certain tactics, records and files. A schedule of week II PSU's will be drawn up at this time to utilize forces across the centrums in Uptown 5 work. During the mornings of the third week the first half hour will be used to work on post rites, songs, and decor.

TACTIC 8: LENS RECRUITMENT

DESCRIPTION

An important aspect of panetrating the protoparish is the recruitment and implementation of the LENS course establishing strategic locations and economic basis as well as delineating target audiences such as social agencies in Uptown and various ethnic groups from each ward and these leaders. Another key factor is the development of effective marketing strategies and assigning recruitment and enablement teams. Since LENS is the primary impact tool in developing guildsmen and troops for the task it is critical that courses be focused in relationship to specific objectives such as intensifying guild participation in the guild out of Uptown 5 as well as selected participation from the other four protoparishes and establish the thrust toward the specific target audiences in Uptown.

IMPLEMENTATION

To enable the LEWS course recruitment and implementation as a tool for penetrating the protoparish, during week one of the quarter the post and a representative group of the Guild will establish the basic course calendar and basic target audiences. During week two of the quarter the task force will meet to work through the marketing strategies, course location, course cost, and team assignment rationale in order to release recruitment. The task force will also establish the necessary reporting and marketing evaluation structures necessary to enable a sustained recruitment thrust to guarantee success. One week before each course the task force will meet to work through course enablement structures and make the necessary assignments.

TACTIC 9: COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

DESCRIPTION

This tactic is aimed at expanding the effect and involvement in the work of the Uptown Guild beyond those trained in LENS. It is accomplished through involvement of community people in the Guild PSU's and task forces, through participation in community events planned or supported by the Guild and through strategic contact of guildsmen with the business and agency communities.

IMPLEMENTATION

A list of prospects for involvement in PSU's and task force activities and planning will be drawn up by each task force. These persons will then be invited to the next PSU or meeting of that task force. In this way 5 or 6 extra people should become involved in the work of each task force. The Elders Ball on February 11 will involve many other Elders of Uptown and decor, publicity, and displays should highlight both significant engagement of the Elder and specific re-imaging of Uptown 5 and the Guild's task. The UCC Housing Committee should be the vehicle for Housing Rehab programs for the housing task forces, reporting to them the results of housing PSU's. A meeting with Gloria Carter during week & should begin to explode ways to resurrect the Uptown Chamber of Commerce.

TACTIC 10: GALAXY EXPANSION

DESCRIPTION

In order to enable the formation of an operational Galaxy in Uptown 5 it is necessary to implement specific tactics in order to establish the climate for such an occurrence, provide the trained clergy and lay leadership and prepare churches to begin working corporately. Invitation of selected churches to selected Galaxy events, engaging the Galaxy in recruitment of PIC and RS-I in other churches within their communities, establishment of an Uptown Clergy Collegium, and intentional participation in denominational and congregational events are designed to accomplish the purpose of this tactic.

During week I of week 3 the Galaxy priorship will meet. A list of key churches will be made and assignments made for as well as specific recruitment to PIC and RS-I. During week I of week 3

IMPLEMENTATION

invitations will be sent to all the clergy in the Uptown Parish to a clergy collegium to begin during week one of week 5. The post will establish and implement a phone and visitation model to key pastors in week I of week 4. During week I of week 4 the Galaxy priorship will brainstorm key denominational, congregational, and church events and select four key events around which to engage pastors in their communities in common participation. Plans for these events will be concretized into a timeline for implementation week I of week 5. An additional four people from Peoples Church and two from each of the other three churches in the Galaxy will be recruited to the March Basic Training School. To facilitate this recruitment, which will be going on during weeks 6 through 9 by the current Galaxy auxiliary, a field visit will be held at Peoples Church during week 8 to explain the project to 40 people from the current 4 churches and 40 people from other churches in the protoparish.

TACTIC 11: AUTHORIZATION EXTENSION

DESCRIPTION

Uptown 5 will, during the next quarter, extend the awareness of and interest and support in the work of the EPX by key business, political and agency figures through visits and an imaginal brochure explaining our work. This will enable extended involvement in the project through both course recruitment and program participation. It is a tactic to ease our way and to protect our flank from attack.

IMPLEMENTATION

The creation of a brochure, detailing the tooling of the community and the renewing of the church, will be done by the post during weeks 2 and 3, to be ready for use in LENS recruitment by week 4. Meanwhile the Community Awakenment Task Forces will lay out a strategic visitation plan for the entire business community of Uptown 5, the key agency leadership (on the basis of an analysis by the Social Model Task Force), and necessary local and metropolitan political leadership regarding specific needs of the project, and the coming election strategy.

TACTIC 12: SYMBOLIC LIFE

DESCRIPTION

This tactic involves creating the rites, songs, decor, and images for the Uptown Guild and the post that will enable us to remember the task our lives are about and to punctuate effectively our various work sessions. Such a symbolic life will maintain the global context of our work through constant reminders in every meeting of guildsmen or auxiliary or post. Keeping the global context is critical to maintaining the motivation of social revolutionaries when local conditions seem adverse, and allows necessary decisions to get made at some cost to those making them.

IMPLEMENTATION

During week 2 the post will experiment with several Uptown rites until one begins to take hold—to be introduced at the next Guild meeting in week 3. Global grid placemats, with the 54 areas named on them, will be used at each Guild meeting this quarter. Each Guild meeting will include a new Uptown song or at least a new verse to an existing song. The image of our Iron Man, both in short courses and visible form, will be introduced to the Guild during week 3.

TACTIC 13: GUILD INTERCHANGE

DESCRIPTION

This tactic relates the work of the Uptown Guild to other guild-like activities across the globe in order to create a global "on behalf of" mindset among the guildsmen. By forging models to relate other local situations to itself (Global Guild Report, LENS Report, and Photo Bulletin Board), being aware of the construct of the ecumenical parish experiment, and offering its insights to others, the Guild will become global in its participation in the experiment.

TMPTEMENTATION

The Uptown 5 post will publish a Global Guild Report for each of the six Guild meetings of quarter III. This report will share data from the 84 locations of the Guild Experiment or IENS sites. Further brief IENS reports will be made at each meeting by using the teaching staff of IENS, starting with Don Cramer's report on India on January 23. We will train the guild in the 26 week timeline of the EPX on week 7 at the Guild meeting. A photo bulletin board of Guild activities, here and globally, will be displayed in the Guild Room for the meeting on January 23 and changed for each succeeding Guild meeting.

TACTIC 14: LEADERSHIP EXCHANGE

DESCRIPTION

The leadership exchange tactic is intended to create face to face contacts with the global ecumenical parish experiment. It will provide IENS pedagogy for select Guild leadership and assign Guild leadership to PSU weekends and guild meetings of guilds in other parts of the continent. Uptown 5 Guildsmen will also host continental guildsmen assembled in Chicago. Finally, the tactic should appraise the possibility of holding Uptown 5 Galaxy Week II Consult together with the Chicago Metro Galaxy.

IMPLEMENTATION

Leadership exchange will call for recruiting six guildsmen to the IENS pedagogy on week II of weeks 3 and 5. It will also send out six guildsmen consultants on assignment by the Guild Post of Research Centrum during the quarter. During week I of week 8 Uptown 5 guildsmen will prepare for hosting continental guildsmen at the Continental Auxiliary in Chicago in week I of week 10. In consultation with the Uptown 5 and Local Church posts the Uptown 5 Galaxy shall consider

the possibility of a joint galaxy consult with the Chicago Metro Galaxy during week II of week 5.

TACTIC 15: 5TH CITY STUDY

DESCRIPTION

Tactic 15 is to equip post members and the Guild with an operational grasp of the 5th City model, methods, and history. This is primary practical wisdom in planning and actualizing community reformulation that is necessary to release both post and guild to create The Ecumenical Parish Uptown 5. Accelerating the establishment of parish structures is deeply dependent on this training which is to be accomplished through lectures, workshopping, papers, battleplanning, reflection on planned action, and a visit to 5th City.

TMPLEMENTATION

At the post meeting on Monday of each week I a report and presentation of 5th City will be made to the Uptown 5 staff for the purpose of keeping up with 5th City developments and illuminating its model and methods. Fifth City battleplanning is being used on this present battleplan and weekly reflection on each Friday post meeting will be used to check through its applicability in Uptown 5. At the three PSU's on the Social Model presentations on 5th City will be made with a detailed study of its methods at the first PSU in week II of week 1. Reports on 5th City will be made at each Guild meeting and in sessions of the Galaxy. A special visitation of 5th City will be arranged for the 8th week of the quarter in which Guild members may experience first hand its operation. A report to the 5th City Collegium by an Uptown Guildsman on the plans of Uptown will be made in the 3rd week of the quarter and a report of 5th City made by a 5th Citizen at the Guild meeting January 23 in conjunction with an extended PSU report.

TACTIC 16: PILOT SMS

DESCRIPTION

This tactic is for the sake of experimenting with a pilot school for The Ecumenical Parish Project and preparing Uptown leadership with the social methods and awareness needed to implement Uptown 5. It is to provide a sign for the movement and to indicate to the Uptown Guild its crucial role in pioneering and demonstrating edge constructs for the global experiment.

IMPLEMENTATION

The Guild Post of Research Centrum will be charged with joint responsibility with the Uptuwn 5 Post for building the SMS model. A PSU on the model will be held in week II of weeks 4, 6, and 8 with leadership shared by the Parapost and the Guild Post. Recruitment for the event will begin with the Guild at its meeting on January 23 and will be offered to IENS grads of the 6th week course. The site of the school will be either Peoples Church or Centrum in week II of the 9th week.
