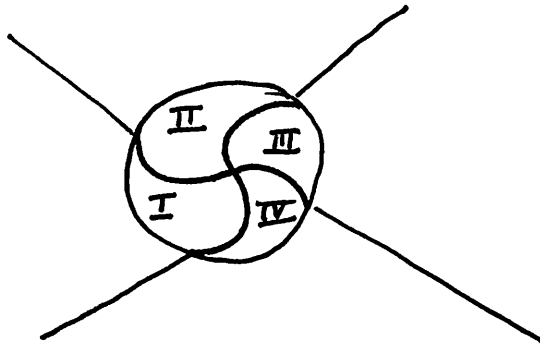

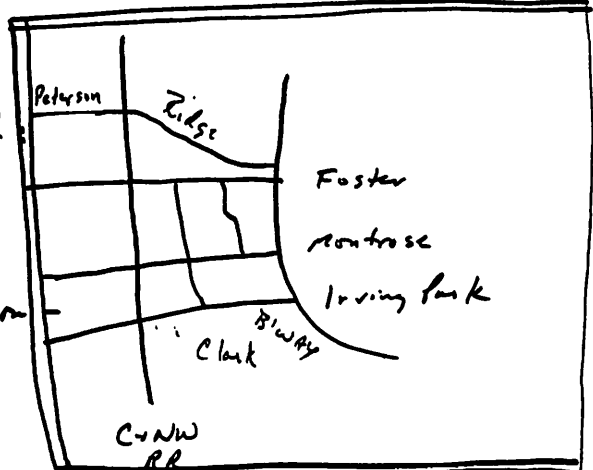

The Uptown Guild meeting began with an introductory spin on the other world in the midst of this world. The conversation discovered the awareness of the deep wellsprings that everyman stands present to in confronting the mundanity of everyday life.

Mrs. Claudia Cramer, who was on one of the six LENS treks across the world, brought greetings from guildsmen in Singapore, Bangkok, Rangoon, Calcutta and Bombay. In India, the TATA industrial concerns have invited the team back to teach the LENS course to their personnel in seeing the possibility of comprehensive community reformulation.

The work done thus far since Summer '73 was recapitulated. The chart below shows the journey with the thrusts of each quarter.

The two LENS courses were milestones in this journey.

Captain Richard Davis reported on the first weekend PSU on the social model and the work done in the arenas of innocent suffering in Uptown, the rating and discerning of social structures in Uptown, and the geographic unit that the Uptown guild would be primarily concerned with.

Mrs. Gloria Carter reported on the initial steps taken in the housing PSU.

Miss Betsy Kirkley announced the next LENS for Uptown residents to be held at the Rogers Park Hotel on February 15-17 at \$30 per person. A workshop listing prospective sponsors and participants was held.

The Uptown guild meeting adjourned with the singing of "I Can See a New Day."
