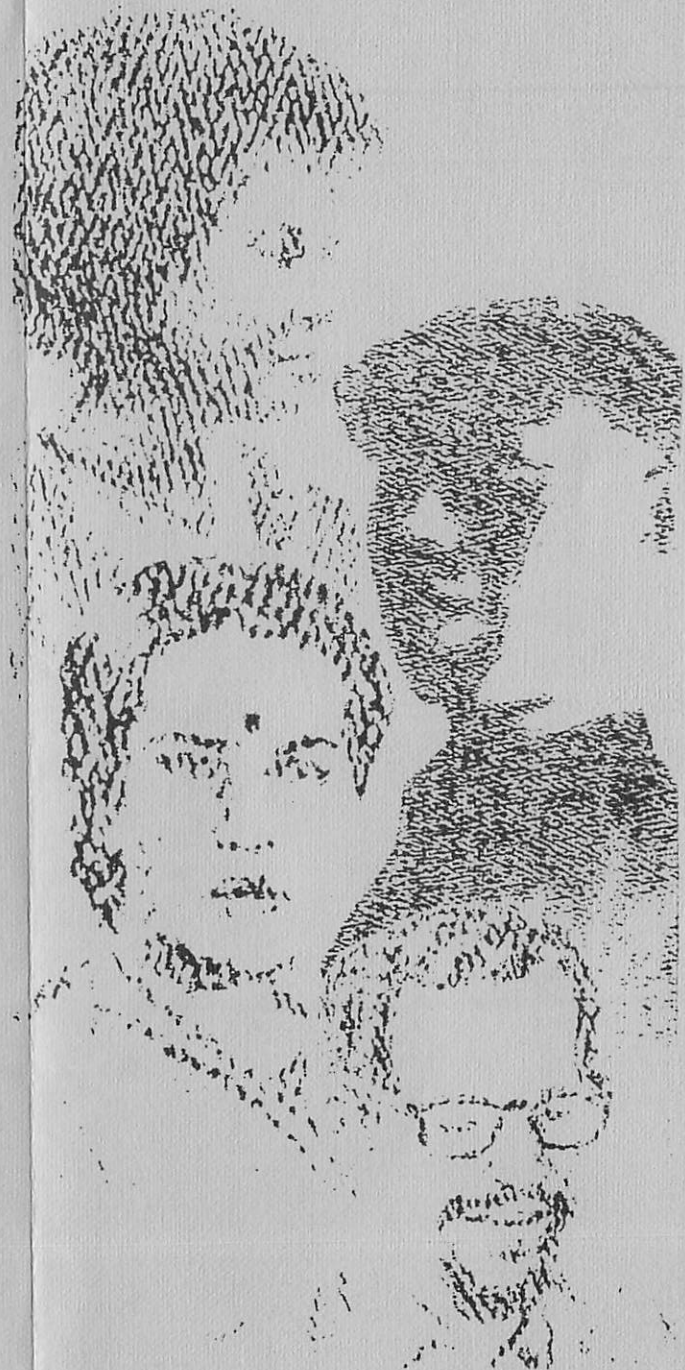

MANILA April 17 - June 12, 1983**

The 37th Global Academy will be held in the Philippines in the midst of the reconstruction work of the Institute with urban and rural structures and communities. These projects provide a direct demonstration of the application of the curriculum.

THE ECUMENICAL INSTITUTE

The Ecumenical Institute was incorporated in Chicago in 1964 as a not-for-profit organization to provide a centre for studies pertaining to the revolution in 20th Century theology, with the emphasis on its social implications. Since that time, the Ecumenical Institute has developed training in religious and cultural studies and has conducted practical research based on a community development project on Chicago's west side known as 5th City.

THE INSTITUTE OF CULTURAL AFFAIRS

The social action dimension of The Ecumenical Institute has been developed and expanded by The Institute of Cultural Affairs. Originally a programme division of the Ecumenical Institute, The Institute of Cultural Affairs was incorporated in 1973 and now operates as a separate, yet coordinate, group with The Ecumenical Institute.

THE ORDER ECUMENICAL

The Order Ecumenical provides the full-time, self-supporting staff for the activities of The Institute of Cultural Affairs and The Ecumenical Institute. The members are from many different national and religious backgrounds. They volunteer to live a life of service based on their concern for creative renewal.
