Global Leadership
Exchange

1. Global Leadership Exchange is a Major Component characterized by exchange programming, insuring global interrelatedness, and consult teams. The intent of this component is to provide a comprehensive exchange program employing impact mechanism which will awaken local man to his global responsibilities. This major component impacts the following other major components: Economic Resource Network, Global Polity Council and Research Exchange System through locating, selecting and assigning local leaders to go to other places in the world according to the needs that have been delineated. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: Movement Communications Network, Economic Resource System, Global Polity Council and Global Education System in the form of keeping the local leadership in touch with the globe and by having a means for locating prospective leaders, selecting them and giving them appropriate training. One illustration of this major component in action is to have every region around the globe participate in sending young men and women who are trained in the depth human wisdom of their culture to be sent to other regions to share their folk myths through song, dance and imaginal lectures.

2. Economic Resource Network is a Major Component characterized by a survey of global resources, local research teams, a resource data exchange, a financial support system, an economic development guild and a global businessman's council. The intent of this major component is to collect and exchange resource data from global and local teams, to receive input from specific function guilds, to channel the human resources of international interns, and to provide a comprehensive global economic structure. This major component impacts the following other major components: Global Leadership Exchange, Research Exchange System, Library Resource System, Movement Communications Network, Global Education System, and Global Polity Council. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: Library Resource System and the Global Polity Council. Illustrations of this major component in action are, a team of global researchers would go into Africa and discover many young Africans are trained to teach English but, as they are unemployed, are deployed to China who is undertaking a program to train its huge population in English to break down its centuries-long isolationism; also, the levying of quotas upon certain professions such as lawyers or engineers in order to allocate more young people into professions where their services will be needed by the time they complete their training.

3. Myth Exchange Process is a Major Component characterized by conversations, demythologizing and projecting myths. The intent of this major component is to research cultural and phase myths, determine the contradictions and create myths to be projected into society. This major component impacts the following other major components: Research Exchange System, Mass Media Articulation, Secular Communications Network and Perpetual Revolution

Dynamo through constantly experimenting and researching with the myths of past and present in order to create ones for the future. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: Movement Style Centrum, Global Education System, Perpetual Revolution Dynamo and Secular Communications Network in the form of new forms of communication between local man, a new style and new ways of teaching and learning. One illustration of this major component in action is providing for the Secular Communicationa Network the conversational constructs for dissemination to local leadership that will enable a new myth of humanness to arise.

4. Mass Media Articulation is a Major Component characterized by visual art forms, news communication system, audio art forms, and mass media models. The intent of this major component is to impact large masses of people systematically and sociologically across the globe with images of human resurgence. This major component impacts the following other major components: Secular Communications Network, Movement Communication Network, Gobal Polity Council and Research Exchange System through informing the other systems of how to make public their own concerns and work. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: Secular Communication Network, Myth Exchange System, Movement Communications Network and Library Resource System in the form of enabling the distribution of data necessary for the comprehensive impacting of society. One illustration of this major component in action is using TV and other media for beginning to get said to man the glory of having four phases and the possibilities in each.

Research Exchange

5. Research Exchange System is a Major Component charaterized by local research network, global research net, research center, and research exchange. The intent of this major component is to develop a research network that would focus on experimental research which would enable a research exchange system and the projection of future needs. This major component impacts the following major components: Perpetual Revolution Dynamo, Guild Research System, Economic Resource Network and the Global Polity Council through making available the necessary data for the work of these systems. Guild Research System

6. Guild Research System is a Major Component characterized by a missionart budget, network meetings, and the transmitting of future trends. The intent of this major component is to determine the resources and needs of a community, utilize its cultural facilities and articulate its future direction in order that the guild may be effective. This major component impacts the following other major components: Mass Media Articulation, Global Polity Council, Cybernetics Guild Function and Research Exchange System through providing information and direction needed. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: Movement Communications Network, Global Education System, and Secular Communication Network in the form of communicating through TV, radio and others forms of communication to educate the people to the needs and purposes of the guild. One illustration of this major component in action is to inform the community of the guild and to supply data to enable it to function effectively.

Global Polity Council

7. Global Polity Council is a Major Component characterized by the council holding the local and global polarity and an international leadership exchange. The intent of this major component is to consense on decisions that hold the local and global polarity and utilizes the wisdom of international exchange leadership, creates channels to communicate decisions, decision-making data and expands administrative exchange to regional meetings and ecclesiola dynamic. This major component impacts the following other major components: Perpetual Revolution Dynamo, Movement Style Centrum, Coordinating Penetration System and Movement Communication Network through providing guidelines to enable the missional task. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: Global Leadership Exchange, Economic Research System, Secular Communications Network and Perpetual Revolution Dynamo in the form of providing tools and action forces. One illustration of this major component in action is to exchange ideas by global councils and open channels of communication for the good of mankind.

Cybernetics Guild Function

8. Cybernetics Guild Function is a Major Component characterized by a cybernetics guild, a data resource staff and data system. The intent of thos major component is to insure a flow of raw data to the guild which can use it to create tactics. This major component impacts the following other major components: Guild Research System, Movement Communication Network and Research Exchange System through providing them quickly with the data they beed upon which to operate. This major component is impacted by the following other major componets: Library Resource System, Rsearch Exchange System, Guild Research System, and Global Education System in the form of disseminating the information they provide and preparing it for the type of educational system being used. One illustration of this major component in action is the Illinois State License Bureau's microfilm bank of driver's licenses and driver's records.

This major component is impacted by the following other major Components: Coordinating Penetration System, Mass Media Articulation, Secular Communication Network, and Cybernetic Guild Function in the form of supplying the data necessary for the system and putting it into usable form. One illustration of this major component in action is the dissemination of E.I. edge papers and reports from across the Movement to those colleagues who do not live in Religious Houses or at Centrum.

One illustration of this major component in action is a Religious House prior maintaining a common schedule with global net while adapting his house to the local situation.

This major component is impacted by the following other major components: Coordinating Penetration System, Movemental Style Centrum, Myth Exchange Process, Perpetual Revolution Dynamo in the form of awareness of needs and receivability of presentations. One illustration of this major component in action is: the summer research assembly where research, training, and consultation takes place at the same time.

This major component is impacted by the following other major components: Perpetual Revolutionary Dynamo, Movemental Style Centrum, Global Education System and Movement Communications Network in the form of maintaining an accelerating momentum of penetration courses by a trained body who embody human life style as imaginal education who exchange forms of humanness present around the globe. One illustration of this major component in action is: The scheduling and execution of RS-I and LENS courses for clusters of churches at the parish level simultaneously in 324 regions.

Guild Research System, Movement Communications Network, Coordinating Penetration System through organizing materials needed for the task which is carried out on the local level. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: Movement Communications Network, Guild Research System, Cybernetics Guild Function, Myth Exchange Process in the form of getting source material and feedback. One illustration of this major component in action is: The Global Report is a symbolic, comprehensive report of the happenings of a week at the grassroots level.

15. Library Resource System is a major component characterized by: screen, file articulation. The intent of this major component is to provide a service to the community and the movement in preserving wisdom, consensus and developing a global brainstorm file for articulation of insights. This major component impacts the following other major components: Guild Research System, Economic Resources Network, Mass Media Articulation, Global Education System through being a particular contract for sharing of wisdom and the kind of troops needed for obtaining the data, also an agent for defining material for mass media use thereby effecting the operating education system. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: Global Research System, Economic Resource Network, Guild Research System, Cybernetics Guild Function in the form of providing the raw data such as current in the form of providing for cataloging identification (location) of available data-reference particular information material already researched. One illustration of this major component in action is: I would see a fully equipped operating facility where micro-films would be available, phonograph records and quick access to movement consensus. The first three steps in implementing this array are committing nations to global economy, develop common monetary system, and common system of credits. This array has a valence of 1632 which indicates that it is important but not high priority. An illustration of this array is European Common Market.

1) Global Business Men's Guild functions to be a cross section of grassroots businessmen.

2) Tax Consultant Guild functions to develop equitable tax structures.

3) International Development Model functions to create overall economic models.

4) System of Credits functions to make credit available to all.

5) Financial Support System functions to subsidize depressed areas.

6) Common Monetary System functions to standardize exchange mechanisms.

7) Material Control Net functions to distribute materials where needed.

8) Financial Control Net functions to prevent economic

13) Population Distribution Guild functions to keep track of skills needs and products.

The first three steps in doing this array are conversations on myths, global myth workshops, and myth construct creation. This array has a valence of 1687 which indicates a middle range priority comparable to Research Exchange System. An illustration of this array is a written myth for public consumption.

2) Corporate Study of Cultures functions to acquaint the whole Order and movement with global culture.

3) Ur Input functions to collect data from events and study for the new myth.

4) Global Customs Exchange functions to have individuals and families directly encounter local customs globally.

5) Network for Projection functions to coordinate the myth exchange.

6) Determine Imbalances functions to analyze the cultural situation in local areas at present.

7) Determine Contradictions functions to discover what is blocking the global myth in local areas.

Demythologizing Tools functions to create means of analyzing, grounding and universalizing existing myths.

9) Analytic Technics functions to develop means of analyzing the inclusive, futuristic, archaic, and intentional aspects of myths.

10) Myth Story functions to develop a model for adequate myths.

11) Wisdom of Phases functions to develop intentionally the memory of all ages.

12) Conversation Methodology functions to create a method for eliciting depth human wisdom.

The first three steps in doing this array are newspaper articles, visual art displays, and research models. This array has a valence of 934 which indicates this is an unimportant array in the whistlepoint.

- 6) Publication Network functions to disseminate the publications strategically.
- 7) Story Dissemination functions to publicize the newsletter through verbal and visual advertisements.
- 8) Multi-Channel Dissemination Program functions to open up increasing numbers of local audiences.
- 9) Transmitting Movement Wisdom functions to collect and produce movement models.

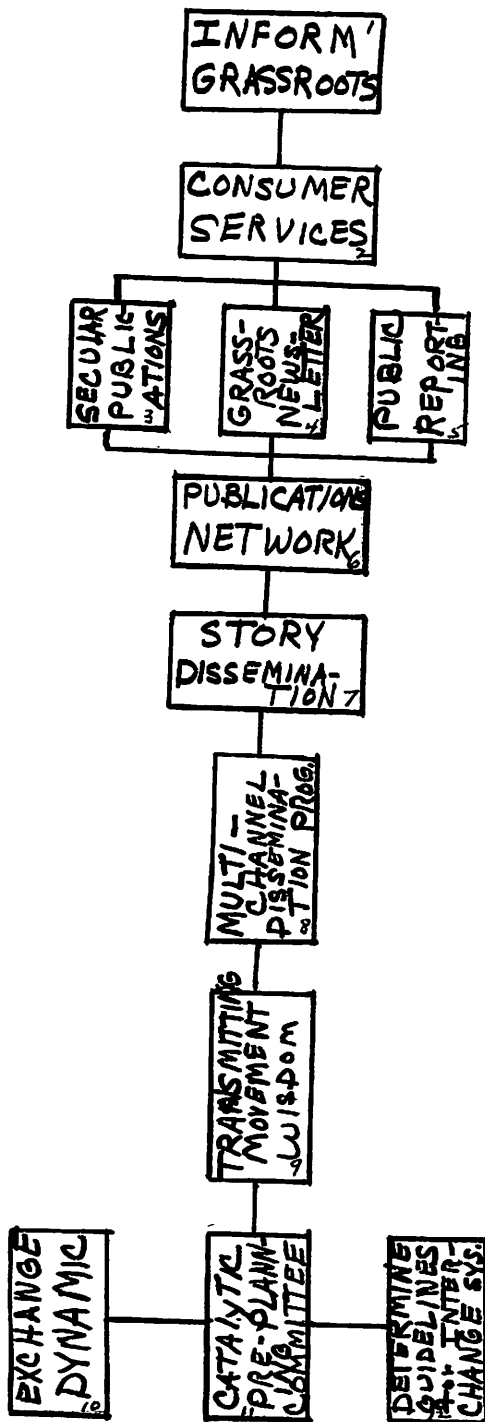
