GUILD
FORMATION
DYNAMO

1. Guild Formation Dynamo is a major component characterised by building a model guild, doing necessary research, and using theoretical and practical models. The intent of this major component is to forge a local guild and bring to it the research, troops, and theoretical and practical models which enable it to create a guild dynamic. This major component impacts the following other major components: Guild Penetration Device,, Global Guild Network, Local Guild Dynamic, and Guild Training System through needed model plans, a demand for troops, being an intermediary for the network, being a key force in defining the dynamic. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: Common Vision Detonator, Local Guild Dynamic, and Guild Training System in the form of Recruitment of troops, use of Commonality, intermediary for network, and key push responsibility for dynamic. One illustration of this major component in action is: guild meeting dinner occasioning vocational conversations.

2. Secular Rites Design is a major component characterized by: Guild Nurture Transformer, Rite Covenantment Device and Symbol Creation Scheme. The intent of this major component is: to remind the guild of its covenant and to nurture and sustain it in being. This major component impacts the following other major components: Common Vision Detonator, Local Guild Dynamic, Missional Family Generator and Covenantal Stance Forms through rehearsing the context, keeping alive the local dynamics and allowing local people to be their authentic roles in the family and vocational arenas. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: Common Vision Detonator, Community Care Overlay, Missional Family Generator and Covenantal Stance Forms in the form of defining the need for, giving a context for and giving a societal structure and atmosphere for secular rites. One illustration of this major component in action is: a structure in each company for rites of passage to take place during a job promotion.

3. Data Processing System is a major component characterized by: Global Information System Networks, Data Processing Guild and Storage and Processing Units. The intent of this major component is: to handle effectively vast amounts of data, both incoming and outgoing at the local and global levels; and to serve as a processing and storage unit and mail service. This major component impacts the following other major components: Global Guild Network, Tactical Operating System and Guild Dynamics through effectively handling communications and

providing accurate statistics and current information on the Tactical Operating System. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: the Global Guild Network, Local Guild Dynamics and the Tactical Operating System in the form of preserving data from research projects, interchange communications between guilds and enabling dynamical action by local guilds. One illustration of this major component in action is: 24 hour day manned computers, running tab sheets, addressing mailing lists, and providing interchange data for research, and compiling reports.

4. World Political Mechanism is a major component characterized by: an economic-political-cultural commission, grassroots empowerment, and financial supports. The intent of this major component is: to allow grassroots man to participate in global decision making through structures that enable his participation. This major component impacts the following other major components: Global Guild Network, Covenantal Stance Forms and External Application Centrum through giving a missional focus, contexting a reason for being in covenant and defining the arena for application. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: Tactical Operating System, Global Guild Network, Community Care Overlay and External Application Centrum in the form of tactics to initiate political influence, forces to carry out the tactical system, a local care structure and an actual carrying out of tactics to influence world politics. One illustration of this major component in action is: grassroots individuals in guilds doing the contradiction-strategic objective methodology for all the continents, and sharing their wisdom with one another to use all the data in forming strategies to influence world politics.

5. Common Vision Detonator is a major component characterized by: common time design, common griders vision, and secular accountability structures. The intent of this major component is: keeping, before the guilds the awareness that they are in being for the sake of the world. This major component impacts the following other major components: secular rites design, global guild network, local guild dynamics, coventual stance forms and missional family generation through creating a vision of possibility and building a context larger than the self. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: missional family generatory local reformation, covenantal stance forms and

guild training system in the form of defining the posture that will allow the vision to be covenantal and receiving data from the guild which authenticates the vision. One illustration of this major component in action is: an honoring and appropriating of all cultures within the guild system.

6. Tactical Operating System is a major component characterised by: common global tactics, evaluational priority development, and permeation models creation. The intent of this major component is: to provide models and techniques for determining objectives and priorities, and for permeating community structure. External Application Centrum thru defining where tactics need to be implemetized, local community reformation by assuring local uniqueness is honored; data process system through defining the arenas of common work, and world political mechanism by assuring a common global thrust. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: global guild network, local guild dynamic, local community reformulation, and external application centrum in the form of troop and input which provide unique local wisdom, implementation and coalution in the context of a global project. One illustration of this major component in action is: several persons carefully planning participation in strategic events in their community.

7. Guild Penetration Device is a major component characterized by: congregation impact system, missional stance generation, and mass support generation. The intent of this major component is: to recruit and engage forces for local church renewal from both secular and religious nodes. This major component impacts the following other major components: common vision detonator, local guild dynamic, training guild system, and guild formation dynamo through the RS-1, missional stance, provision of tools and recruitment. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: the guild formation dynamo, the guild network, local guild dynamic, training guild system in the forms of a purpose, experience, "charisma" (fascination element) and enablement. One illustration of this major component in action is: recruitment, enable follow-up, and intentional symbolic gatherings for impacting clusters of people.

8. Global guild network is a major component characterised by: ongoing research staff, strategy coordination office, and visional research apparatus. The intent of this major component is: to maintain stable tension functions between local and global guild forces,

providing a guild replication base. This major component impacts the following other major components: data processing system, world political mechanism and tactical operating system through providing the global operational basis, recruitment of concerned people, and data systems coordination. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: guild formation dynamo, common vision detonator, guild formation dynamo in the form of dynamic unified network and crucial guild replication. One illustration of this major component in action is: concentration on appropriating incoming reports at area meetings of visiting guildsmen.

9. Guild training system is a major component characterised by: local guild structures, corporate care structures and an ecclesiola dynamic. The intent of this major component is: to provide guildsmen with the structures which will allow them to carry out the concrete task of building care structures for the local community. This major component impacts the following other major components: global guild network, missional family generator, covenantal stance forms and external application centrum through sustaining the individual and the network in their covenantal relationships as well as providing a model of the dynamis for the missional family. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: guild formation dynamo, common vision, detonator, guild penetration device and local community formulation in the form of a missional arena for the dynamic. One illustration of this major component in action is: a dentist guild meeting in which there would be a ritual accountability meal conversation, celebration and a workshop on international dental equipment adoption.

10. Community care overlay is a major component characterised by: concrete battle planning, engaging in grassroots participation and engagement research. The intent of this major component is: to allow the Guild to engage grassroots participation in bringing off human community at every local level, using social and spirit methods to engage troops and to reconstruct community; and create the guild hall as the signal of futuristic corporate responsibility. This major component impacts the following other major components: common vision detonator, missional and external family generator, through defining common vision, keeping present task clear and group ordered. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: local

community reformulation examined in the form of consulting community examining situations, what's needed, what tools are at hand, critically feeding results to community and constant recycling of information. One illustration of this major component in action is: Local church product sets up committee to determine what people they can use, goes to church members listening for what might be the working model (recycling helps) pull in as many area members church members included, hold all members to task with commonly agreed on covenant. Hold all members accountable.

11. Missional family generator is a major component characterised by: authentic phase relations, intentional emerging generation structures, and polity board and strategum. The intent of this major component is: to be a sign of the enabling structure that allows family members to engage themselves significantly in the external task of the guild which cares for the world. This major component impacts the following other major components: secular rites design, common vision detonator community care overlay, and covenantal through: giving a focus for a secular rites and standing as a sign to the community of acted out covenantal relationships. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: common vision, secular and covenantal posture rites, local guild dynamics, a common vision that enables the family to expend itself missionally in the same context, rites of passage, songs and rituals that hold the family to its decision, local guild dynamic which gives the family a common missional place of engagement, and covenantal posture which allows a family a constant sign of their decision to be married. One illustration of this major component in action is: a missional family engaged in the global task of changing the world by participating in local guild structures that care for the community.

12. Local community reformulation is a major component characterised by: tactical renewal of old, presentation designs format and presenting societal alternatives presentation. The intent of this major component is: to bring authentic humanness to all men through the reformulation of the local. This major component impacts the following other major components: common vision detonator, tactical operating system, community care overlay, and local guild training through delineating what is needed and by adding data to the common vision. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: tactical systems, local guild dynamics,

community care overlay and external application in the form of affording the possibilities of tactical and practical reformation. One illustration of this major component in action is: intentionalized gatherings of the community for celebration.

13. Covenantal stance forms is a major component characterised by: a context role statement, style molding exercises and esprit evoking decor. The intent of this major component is: creating symbolic life to sustain guildsmen, invent style of the local-global guild-er, and to use corporate, effective polity structures, including consensus decision making process. This major component impacts the following other major components: secular rites design, common vision detonator local guild dynamic and missional family generator through style, nurture rehearsal of common secular rites and recreation of family unit as mission. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: secular rites design, common vision detonator, local guild dynamic and missional family generator. The intermittent support and impact of each other reflects creative and healthy tension, in the form of holding the family to global missional task, sustaining them and enabling full humanness. One illustration of this major component in action is: the new family will sit and write a family constitution or context statement, use rituals, work out of an assignment rationale to be an enabling aspect of the guild force. This exercise will also serve as nurture.

14. External application centrum is a major component characterised by: the local situation practices, servanthood roles definition, and symbol creation. The intent of this major component is: to serve the community as a force directed at vocational nurture and the cabaret dynamic. This major component impacts the following other major components: data process systems, tactical operating systems, local commonality mechanism through defining needs, testing tactic viability, effecting local change, and contacting and impacting of politicians in their hometown. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: training guild system, local guild dynamic, tactical operating systems world political mechanism in the form of enablement, spirit strength, models and definition of demands. One illustration of this major component in action is: the cabaret.

15. Training guild system is a major component

characterised by: developing training tools, materials, and socio-corporate models which will exemplify time, space and relational dynamics. The intent of this major component is: that the guild training is imbedded in practical tools, pedagogue preparation, and comprehensive training models. This major component impacts the following other major components: guild formation dynamic, guild penetration device, external application centrum through the forging of a common vision. This major component is impacted by the following other major components: formulation and replication in the form of local guild support training. One illustration of this major component in action is: the activation of passion-filled local guildsmen who sacrificially participate in the most effective training structures, such as pedagogical weekends held on a regular schedule.

Interior Array #1, Descriptive Paragraph

16. The Guild Formation dynamic is intended to research, theoreticize and practice the guild as a local social unit. The forces who will implement this array are researchers and experienced cadre members. The first three steps in doing this array are designing the common task for the guild, assimilating historical models, and intensifying inner-vocational identification. This array has a valence of 3290 which indicates a relatively non-crucial role in the whistle-point. An illustration of this array would be the International Youth Hostel Association.

1. Guild Formation Dynamo functions to recruit and form the new guild.
2. Guild Covenant Construct functions to define the rule of the internal discipline of guilders.

8. Contemporary Guild Models functions to illustrate strengths and weaknesses of current "Guilds" for research purposes.
9. Historical Guild Models functions to provide basic working models of guilds for research purposes.
10. Secular Impact Method functions to present guild form to prospective guilders.
11. Secular Altar Implement functions to demonstrate sacred space.
12. Intentional Celebration Transformer functions to draw community together.
13. Vocational Identification Construct functions to show possibilities of inter-vocational co-operation.

Interior Array #2, Descriptive Paragraph

17. Secular Rite Design is intended to create secular rites, symbols and songs which the guild would use to hold its covenant, corporateness and nurture. The forces who will implement this array are the guild members, leaders, and experienced Shamaws. The first three steps in doing this array are covenanting, otherwise instilling corporateness, and grounding the nurturing method in the guild. This array has a valence of 3672 which indicates a moderately below average position in the array. An illustration of this array is the Japanese custom of singing the company song in unison every day.

1. Self-reform Process functions to ground sense of internal discipline and development.
2. Corporate Prior Dynamo functions to lead the rites in an intentionalized manner.
3. Symbol Creation Scheme functions to provide a focal point of the ritual.
4. Guild Nurture Transformer functions to instill care for co-guilders.
5. Guild Covenant Transformer functions to provide contextual meaning.
6. Guild Corporateness Transformer functions to provide universal Guild experience.
7. Resurgence Entertainment Network functions to introduce the Mystery.
8. Secular Workshop Method functions to ground this introduction.
9. Individual Time-Line Model functions to dramatize use of life holding structures.
10. Passage Rites Scheme functions to dramatize the approach of life's end.
11. Ritual Covenant Device functions to bind guilders symbolically.
12. Rite Enactment Device functions to provide form of rites.
13. Secular Rites Design functions to implement those rites.

Interior Array #3, Descriptive Paragraph

18. Data Processing System is intended to effectively store, retrieve, synthesize, and distribute the data needed for guild work on the local and global levels. The forces who will implement this array are data processors, librarians, census takers, computer operators, engineers, and guildworkers in general. The first three steps in doing this array are designing rationales and procedures for data processing; relating and synthesizing incoming data (as in a library card catalog); keeping, filming, computerizing, and storing of current data and up-dating data as needed. This array has a valence of 1856 which indicates that this component is very weak. An illustration of this array would be a global net of task groups, each assigned from a local guild, gathering local information and passing it on to regional guilds which would process local data and relate it to current global wisdom.

1. Wisdom Gathering Net functions to systematically carry out research on a world-wide basis.
2. Informational Global Net functions to distribute processed data as it is needed throughout the globe.
3. Global News Interchange functions to corporately exchange news of signal events and miracle stories.
4. Retroactive Feedback Network functions to correlate data needed with information that is available or can be gathered.
5. Local Distribution System functions to disseminate research findings to the community.
6. Information Publication Factory functions to publish reports and working papers for distribution.
7. Editorial Review Scheme functions to decide to whom and in what form information should be disseminated.
8. Research Training Design functions to train researchers in objective data-gathering and reporting methods.
9. Data Storage Unit functions to keep information accessible for use.
10. Data Processing Mechanism functions to provide technological methods for gathering and processing data.
11. Source Referral System functions to list available sources of information and where they can be found.
12. Parish Profile Computer functions to relate information on the resources, gifts, and blocks operating in a particular parish.
13. Data Skills Inventory functions to catalog people with certain skills and where they are located.
14. Data Synthesizing Scheme functions to relate data to work on current or projected contradictions.
15. Data Processing System functions to arrange, store, and distribute information in accordance with current and future needs of the guild.

Interior Array #4, Descriptive Paragraph

19. World Political Mechanism is intended to allow grassroots participation in global decision making. The forces who will implement this array are a local global polity commission. The first three steps in doing this array are global problemating constructs, issues forum network, and local/global reporting cells. An illustration of this array is a problemat participated in by representatives of international groups.

1. Local Global Report Cell functions to enable interchange of information on issues.
2. Eco.-Pol.-Cult. Commission functions to provide active participation of grassroots in decision making.
3. Local Report Construct functions to inform international leaders of local man's response to issues.
4. Issues Forum Network functions to study issues and report consensus of the forum.
5. World Political Mechanism functions to provide a comprehensive structure for local man's participation.
6. Grass Roots Empowerment functions to stimulate interest and creative input by every man.
7. Financial Support System functions to provide necessary economic support.
8. Voter Enablement Device functions to assist grassroots participation in established political systems.
9. Comprehensive Development Construct functions to hold the global context in the supportsystem.
10. Global Patron Network functions to secure foundation gifts.
11. Global Problemating Construct functions to provide a common model for problemating at the international level.
12. Editorial Distribution System functions to make information and opinions on issues available to all.
13. Local P.S.U. Network functions to provide P.S.U. results on a local level to be distributed.

Interior Array #5, Descriptive Paragraph

20. Common Vision Detonator is intended to enable a common time design and secular accountability structures. Forces which create common symbols, celebrational life, stories, councils, collegiums, and common global odyssey constructs will implement this array. The first three steps in doing this array are create in consensus methodology constructs, common symbols, and story. This array has a valence of 1943, which indicates weak power impact within this array. An illustration of this array would be the symbol impact of the LENScourse.

3. Common rites and rituals function to reinforce common time designs.
4. Secondary symbols such as lapel pins function to remind guilders of their accountability to consensed covenants.
5. Common Celebrational Life functions to create a sense of global citizenship.
6. Common Guilders' Story functions to create global commonness.
7. Consensus Methodology Constructs functions to create a global consensus.
8. The Global Odyssey Construct and global guilders interchange function to provide local guilders with global vision.
9. Global Guilders Interchange functions to sustain comprehensive vision of local guilders.
10. Councils and collegiums function to strengthen, rearticulate and celebrate common vision.
11. Common Time Design functions to interlock self discipline with external demand.
12. Secular Accountability Structures functions to allow local man to redecide and to reflect on his decisional stance.
13. Common Guilders Vision functions to sustain the global implosion, detonating the latent, local interior images to motivate passion for building the common earth.

21. Tactics Operating System is intended to lay out the techniques for guild action. The forces who will implement this array are guildsmen assigned to research. The first three steps in doing this array are determining needed tactics for guilds, determine priorities for the guild, and set procedures for action. This array has a valence of 6979 which indicates strength. An illustration of this array is guilds for every main area of missional engagement in 50 major cities.

3. Regional Guild Office functions to coordinate all guilds in a region.
4. Contentless Model Replication functions to maintain consistent procedures for replication of the guild.
5. Yearly Research Assemblies functions to maintain corporate-ness and constancy across the global guild network by doing corporate research every year.
6. Global Guild Reports functions to keep all guilds in the network informed about current models and information.
7. Global Centrum Apparatus functions to direct global guild network and to act as a central coordinator.
8. Ongoing Research Staff functions to research new strategies and tactics for the network.
9. Regional Research Apparatus functions to do specialized local research for the local guilds and to disseminate materials to the guilds.
10. Strategy Coordination Office functions to maintain all wisdom on strategies for the guild, to seek new formation, and to assemble and disseminate material already written.

24. Local Guild Dynamic is intended to provide guild sustaining and engagement structures. The forces who will implement this array are local guildsmen, churchmen, and order representatives. 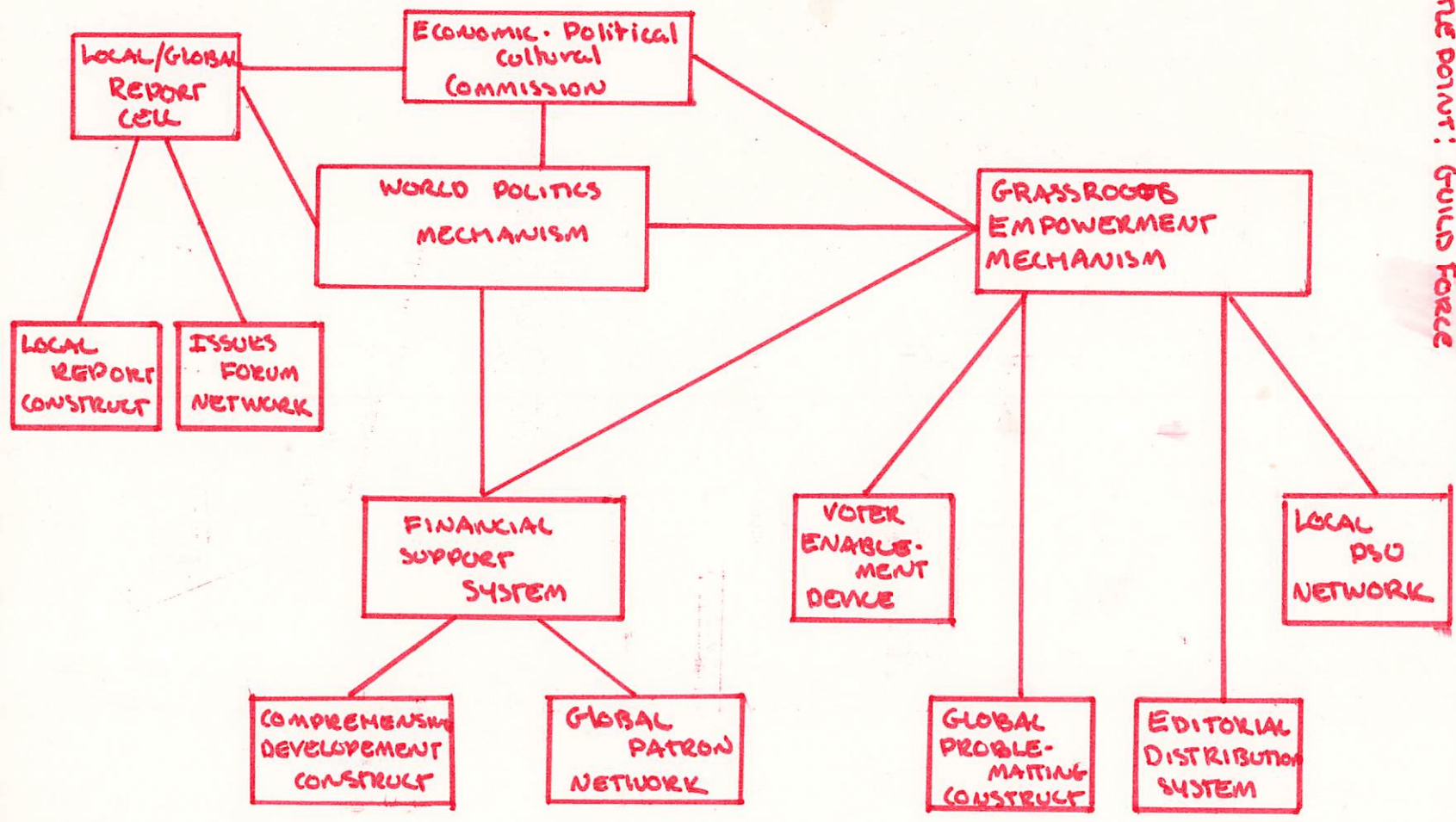

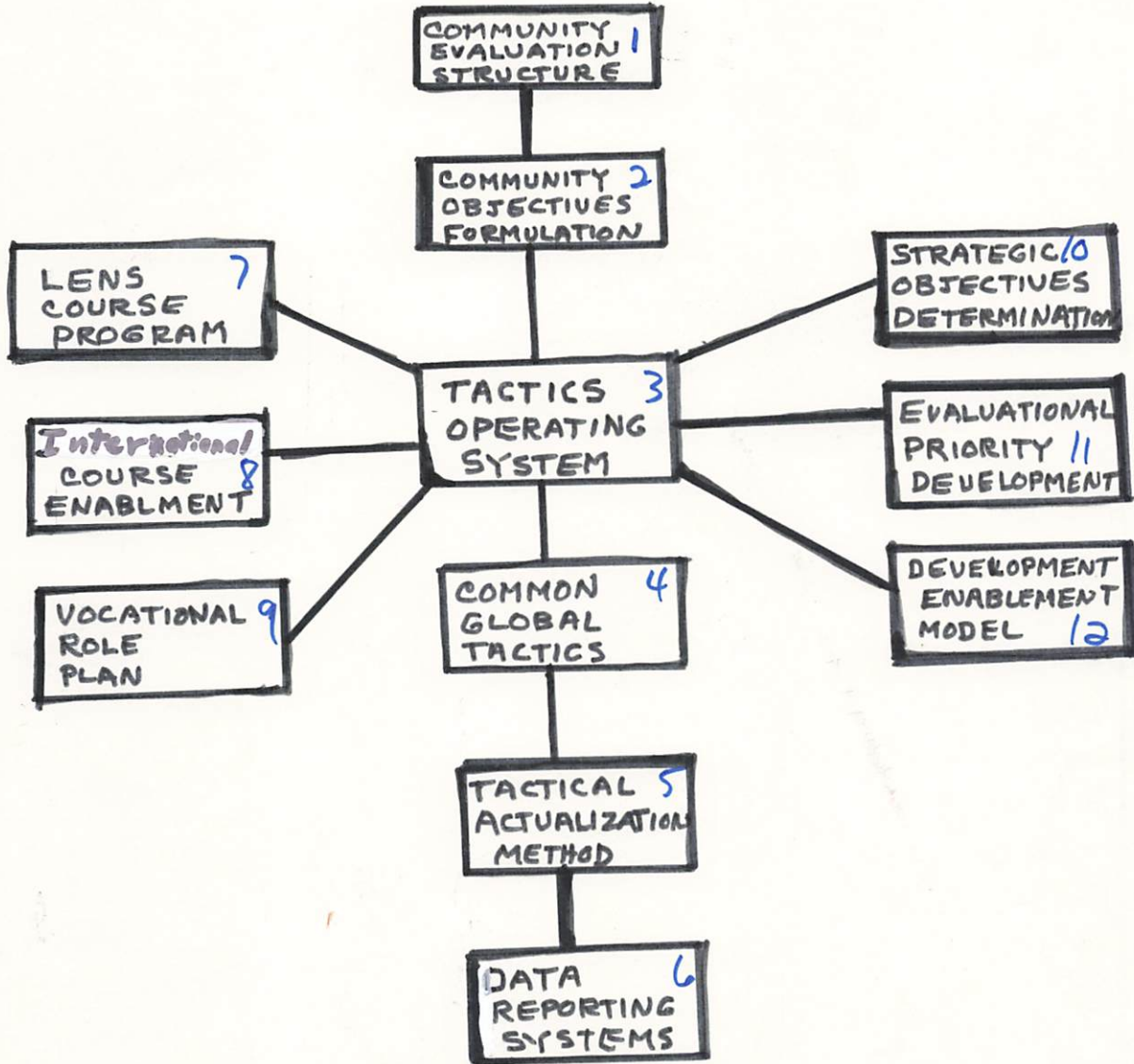

LOGISTICS OF THE GUILD Guild Force

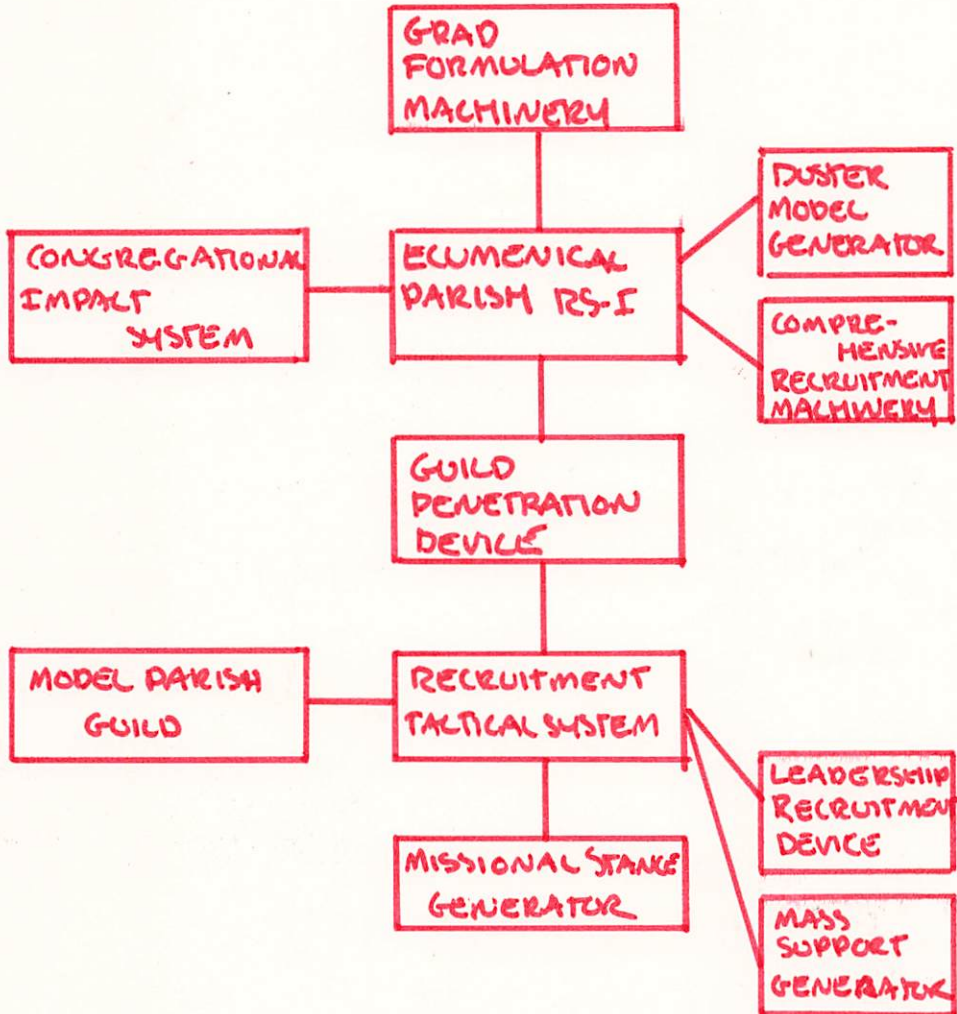
Clump Array Number 6. TACTICS OPERATING SYSTEM
