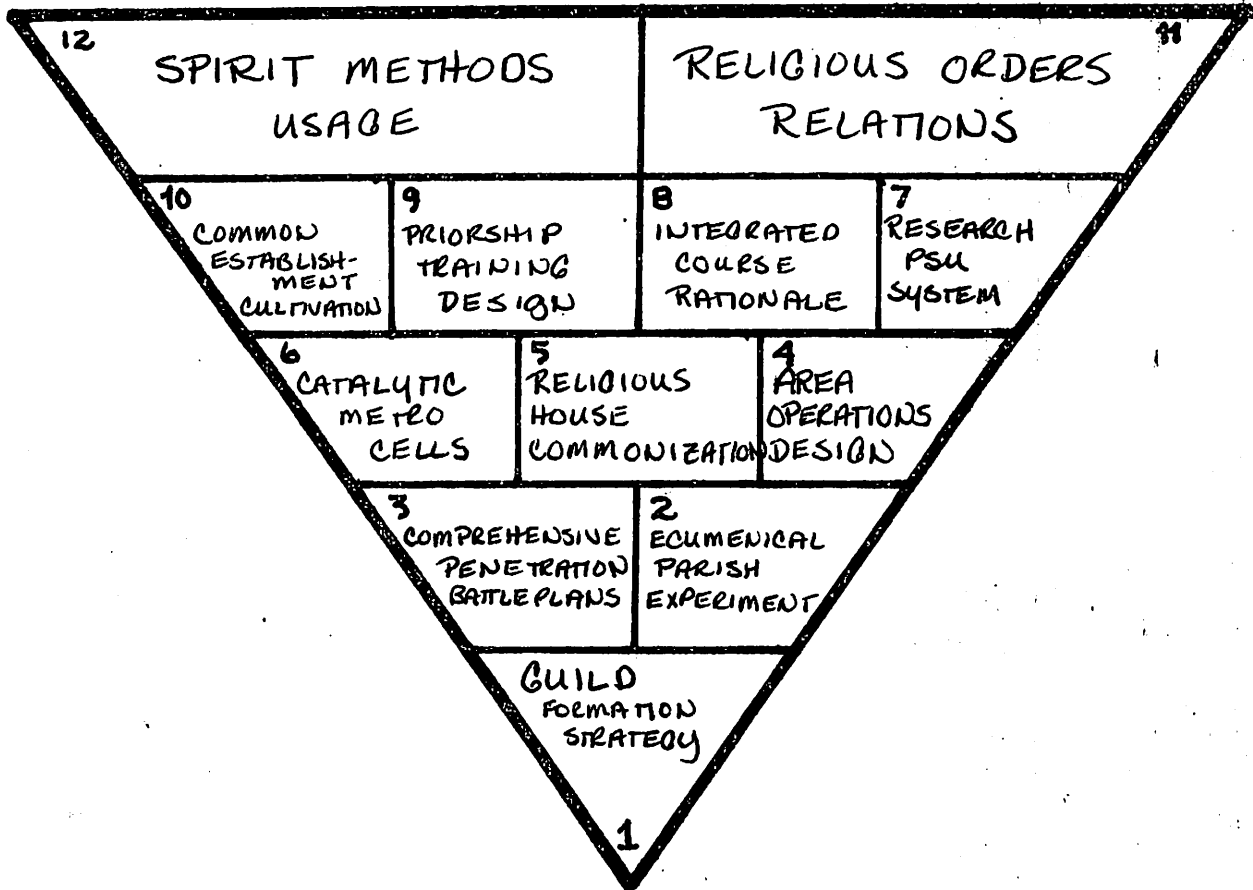
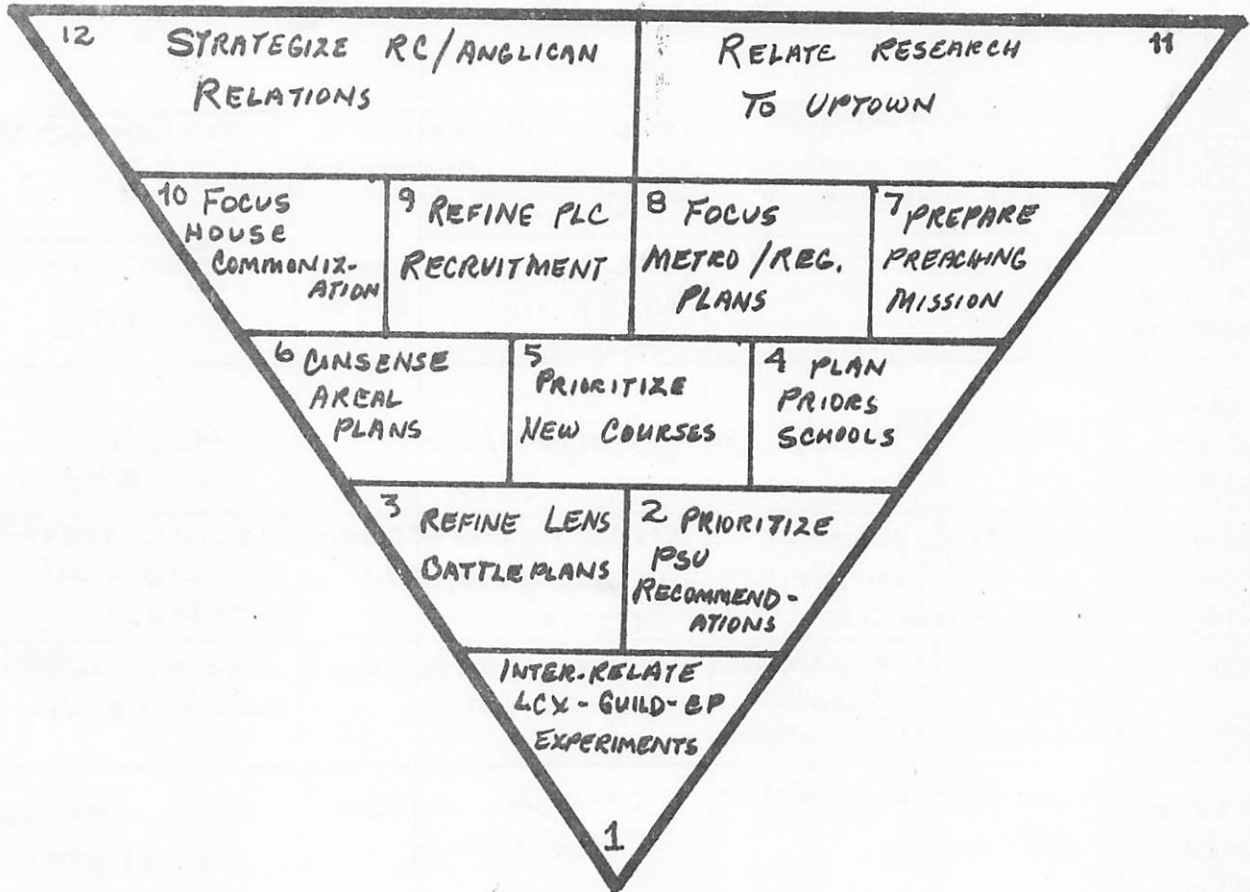


# 12 PRIORITIES OF PRACTICAL PLANNING



1. GUILD FORMATION STRATEGY The guild planning arena deals with the common movement operating image, the strategies and phasing of the implementation and the form of implementation.
2. ECUMENICAL PARISH EXPERIMENT The ecumenical parish experiment as a planning arena is to formulate the consensus of the order on how the experiment will relate to the existing local church experiment, the formulation of local guilds and the replication of the local church experiment.
3. COMPREHENSIVE PENETRATION BATTLEPLANS In the arena of penetration the order needs to create a continental and global battleplan and deal with P.L.C. and cluster recruitment.
4. AREA OPERATIONS DESIGN The order needs to deal with the issue of the areal operations design in order to establish consensus on areal and regional grids, clarify arenas of areal commonality, and develop global and areal strategies.
5. RELIGIOUS HOUSE COMMONIZATION The issues in religious house commonization are: how the R.H. holds the comprehensive through it's own organization, and acts as the symbolic presence of primal community and as a practical training and discrimination center for the metro and region in which it is located while being the experimental center in recapturing depths of humanness through spirit methods both religious and secular.
6. CATALYTIC METRO CELLS The issues in metro catalytic cadre planning are how it acts as a structure for intensifying movemental discipline and practically functions as a tool in bringing into being ecumenical parishes and relates as a functional communicative line between parishes.
7. RESEARCH PSU SYSTEM The order needs to plan the following in the arena of global research: Centrum coordination and scheduling of PSUs called for in the documents to be held over the coming year in Base, Regions and religious houses.
8. INTEGRATED COURSE RATIONALE The order needs to plan the following in the arena of new courses: integrated scheduling, recruitment rationale (special groups, location, etc.), core curriculum changes consensus (to include new data in PLC, other courses).
9. PRIOR
9. PRIORSHIP TRAINING DESIGN includes (1) refining September priorship school, (2) on-going training plan, and (3) design for Academy supplement.
10. COMMON ESTABLISHMENT CULTIVATION includes (1) common cultivation model, (2) screening and recording models, and (3) model for community authorization .
11. RELIGIOUS ORDERS RELATIONS arena is to plan content for relationship of the order to R.C. orders, a timeline and battleplan for working with R.C. orders, and next steps for offering Holy Live course to various orders.
12. SPIRIT METHODS USAGE The order needs to plan how the priorship will be equipped with the Summer '73 spirit methods, whether a new manual should be written, and the critical decor for the year in all movement structures.

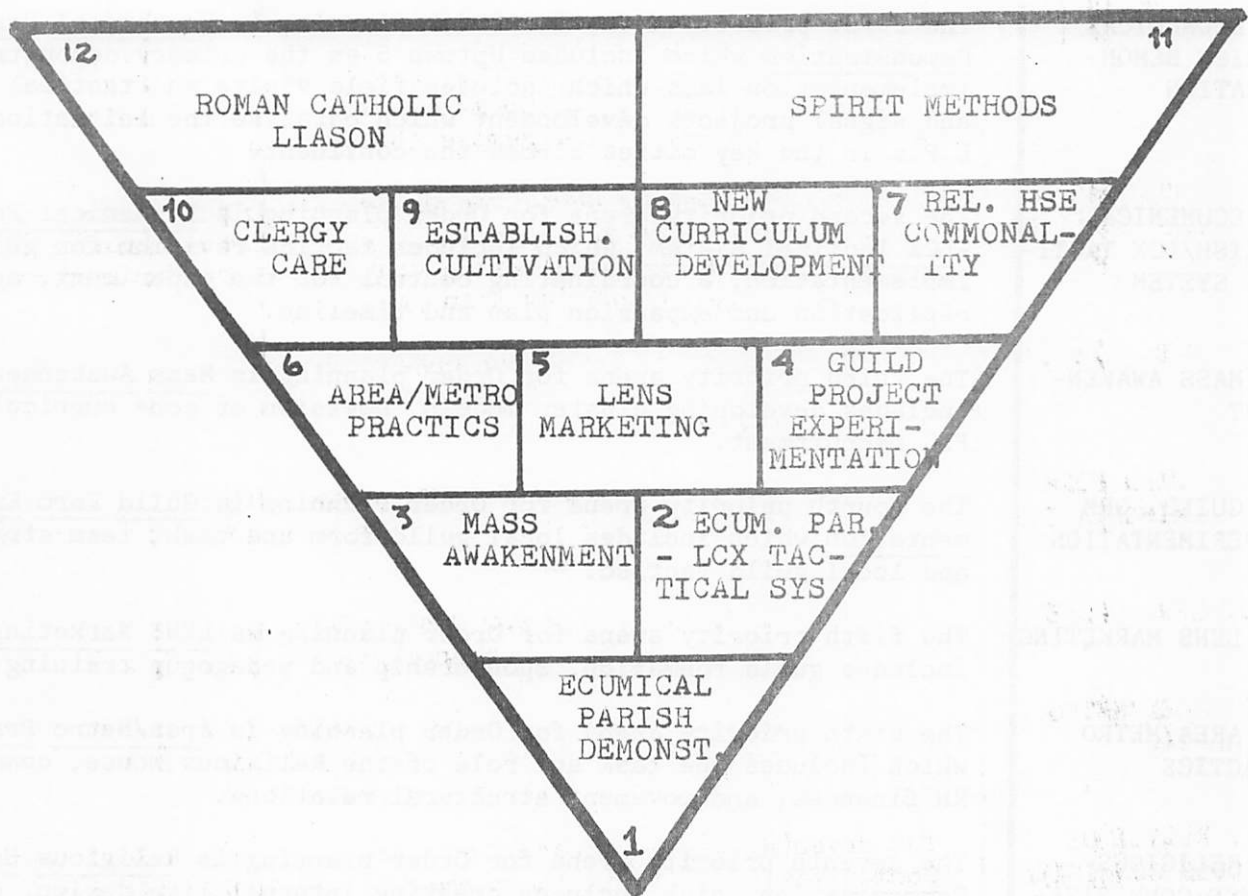

# 12 PRIORITIES OF PRACTICAL PLANNING



12. ROMAN CATHOLIC LIASON

The twelfth priority of Order planning is Roman Catholic Liason which includes missionalizing of Orders, developing guidelines for relations with heirarchy, and strategizing R.C. penetration.

1. ECUMENICAL  
PARISH DEMON-  
STRATION

The first priority arena for Order planning is Ecumenical Parish Demonstration which includes Uptown 5 as the primary demonstration, implementation labs which includes field visits and tactical planning and signal projects development which catalyse the initiation of E.P.s in the key cities across the continent.

2. ECUMENICAL  
PARISH/LCX TACTI-  
CAL SYSTEM

The second priority arena for Order planning is Ecumenical Parish -LCX Tactical Systems which includes tactics revision for guild implementation, a coordinating control for the experiment, and a replication and expansion plan and timeline.

3. MASS AWAKEN-  
MENT

The third priority arena for Order planning is Mass Awakening which includes developing cluster models, revision of core curriculum, and PLC recruitment.

4. GUILD FORM  
EXPERIMENTATION

The fourth priority arena for Order Planning is Guild Form Experi-  
mentation which includes local guild form and task, team structure, and local guild tactisc.

5. LENS MARKETING

The fifth priority arena for Order planning is LENS Marketing which includes guild formation, sponsorship and pedagogue training.

6. AREA/METRO  
PRACTICS

The sixth priority arena for Order planning is Area/Metro Practics which includes the task and role of the Religious House, common area RH finances, and movement structural relations.

7. RELIGIOUS  
HOUSE COMMINIZA-  
TION

The seventh priority arena for Order planning is Religious House  
Commonization which includes creating internal life design, construct for Prior's School, and the Troika dynamic.

8. NEW CURRIC-  
ULUM DEVELOPMENT

The eighth priority arena for Order planning is New Curriculum  
Development which includes NSV courses such as the 5 day course and one day convocation, expansion and development of the Holy Life Sutudies curriculum, and the University 13 construct.

9. EFFECTIVE  
ESTABLISHMENT  
CULTIVATION

The ninth priority arena for Order planning is Effective Establish-  
ment Cultivation which includes locating the critical targets (the 100 men) and discerning how to or what style will adequately culti-  
vate them and what particular devices do we use for the religious heirarchy to get their sponsorship or nod.

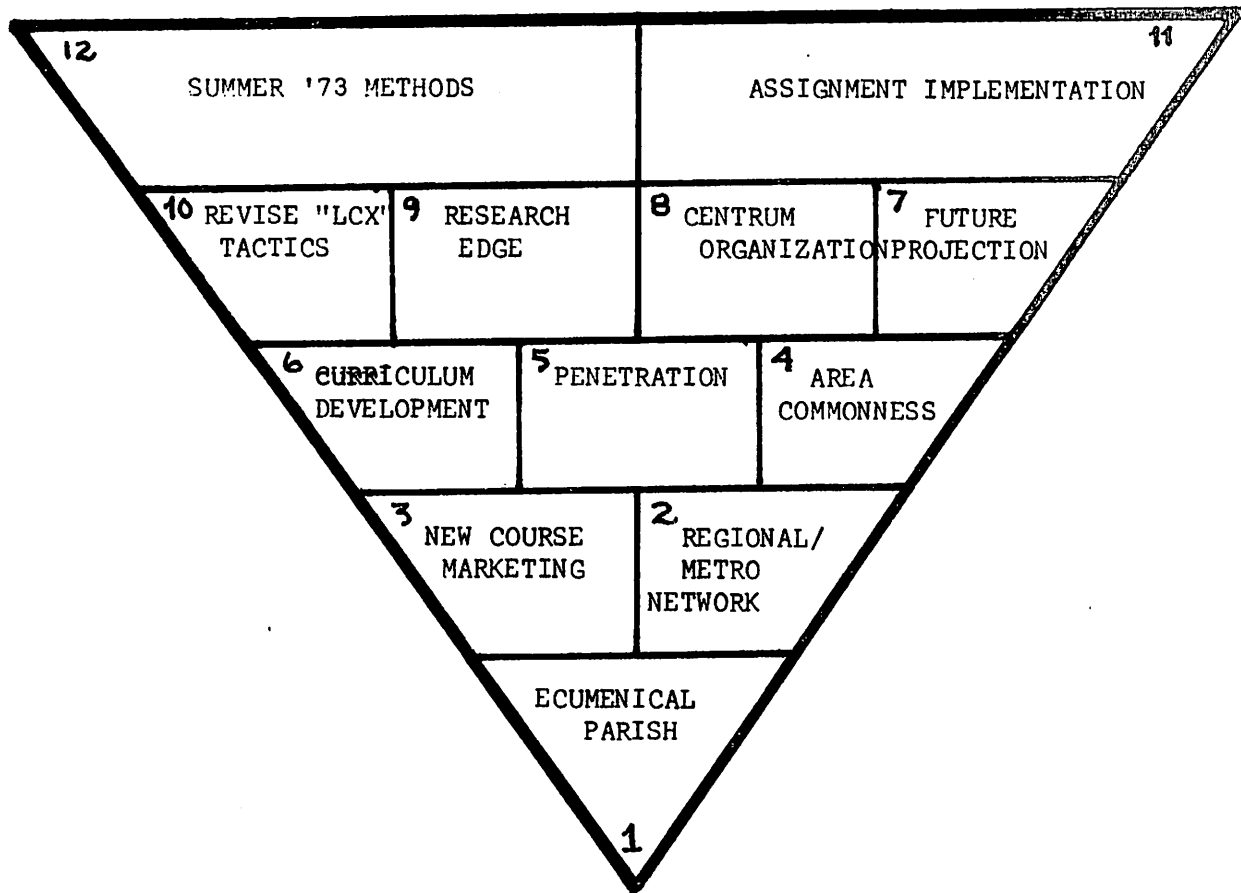
10. CLERGY CARE

The tenth priority arena for Order planning is Clergy Care which includes clergy collegium for spirit method training, spirit analysis of clergy, and collegial care for intensified engagement.

11. SPIRIT METHODS

The eleventh priority arena for Order planning is Spirit Methods which includes recovery of the Scriptures (e.g. 1st John), solitary practices and office, conversation methodologies (especially song conv. ) and garb and devotional readings.

# 12 PRIORITIES OF PRACTICAL PLANNING



ASSIGNMENT  
IMPLEMENTATION

Assignment implementation involves creating the assignment rationale, delineating the specific tasks, and making specific personnel assignments to accomplish the entire task.

METHODS  
OF SUMMER '73

Planning in the arena of the Summer '73 methods includes: P.S.U.'s to pull together the experimentation with secular spirit methods, the religious methods, and the research methods.

ECUMENICAL  
PARISH

Delineate the target parish rationale in conjunction with the guild rationale and guild structures, prepare the central (or aerial) back-up structure, and create the necessary daily and weekly back written materials.

REGIONAL  
METRO  
NETWORK

Complete the procedural design for regional/metro network, distinguish it from past models, and stipulate specific movemental relations such as the relations of the metro to guardians, local church projects and penetration.

NEW  
COURSE  
MARKETING

New Course Marketing will include sponsorship of LENS, Sanctification Odyssey, NSV Course, St. John, and will involve a publicity rationale using the media and creating a global marketing net.

AERIAL  
ACTUALIZATION

Aerial Commonness Actualization will include: deciding the missional priorities, discerning and implementing polity structure, and developing a sustaining structure of commonness.

PENETRATION

The Summer birthed demands for new curriculum constructs requiring further research: 1). Religious courses, sanctification, for the remissionalizing of religious orders, and 2) secular courses such as NSV and LENS, 3). Special constructs for the 1 day convocation, new conversations methods, etc.

CURRICULUM  
DEVELOPMENT

In the light of the Summer, penetration planning requires re-evaluation of penetration models, strategies, schedules; re-prioritizing where penetration needs re-intensification, and where advanced and secular courses need revisions, and the proposed inter-continental course schedule.

FUTURE  
PROJECTION

Future projection involves developing a comprehensive plan: for securing funding for experimental work, for enabling legal authorizations, and sponsorship, and for making the ongoing program self-supporting.

RESTRUCTURING  
CENTRUM

In order to meet new demands rising out of the Summer's work, there is a need for restructuring Centrum in the area of the Ecumenical Parish Experiment, the Guild common thrust, and effective coordination are built in: in the area of the new demands there will be on penetration, coordination and assignment structures: and in the area of development and future projection.

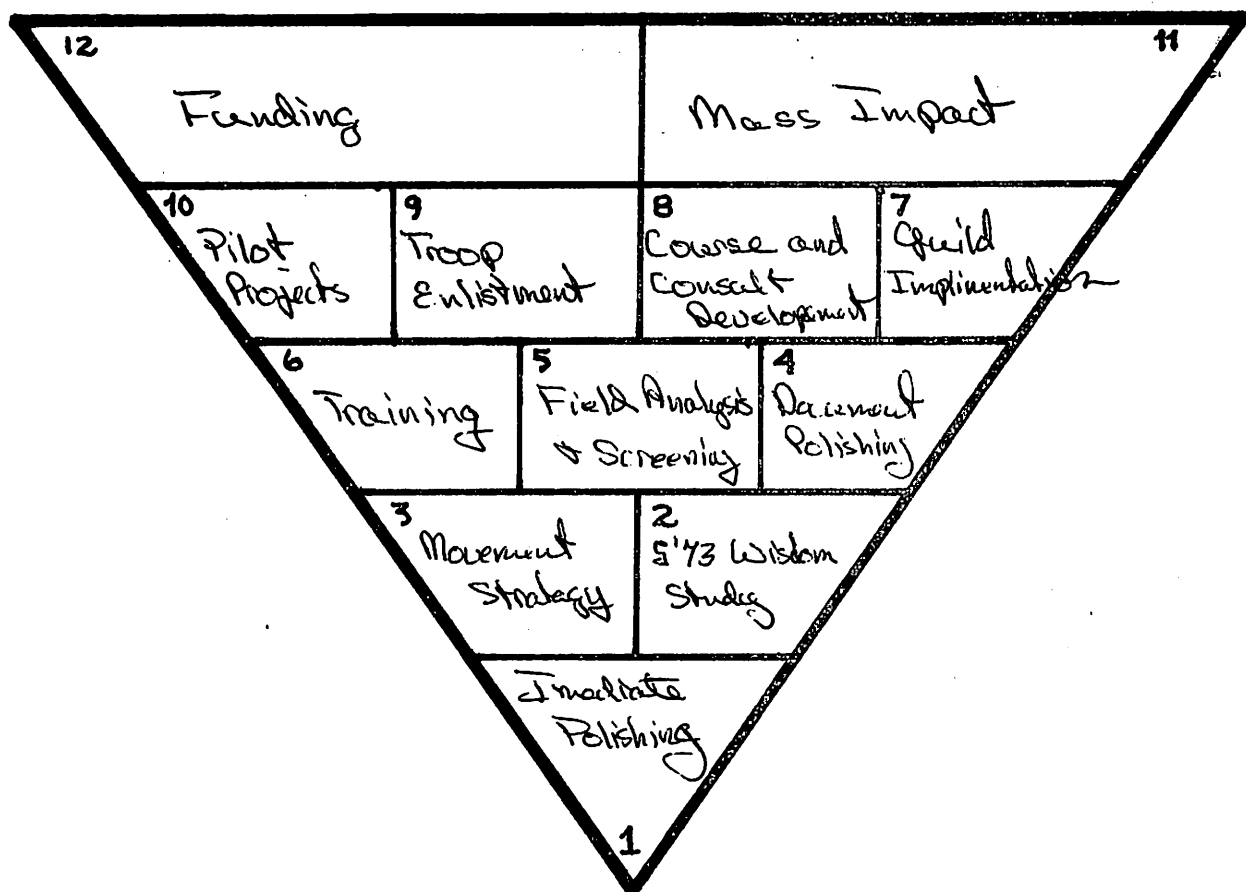
RESEARCH  
EDGE

Planning in the area of the research edge includes planning on-going edge research at centrum, coordinating the aerial research, experimenting with common methods for collecting and disseminating research wisdom on a global scale.

PLANNING  
LCX REVISION

Planning in the arena of the LCX tactics includes the P.S.U.'s for revising the LCX tactical system, the plan for incorporating the galaxies wisdom and the mechanisms for implementing revised systems.

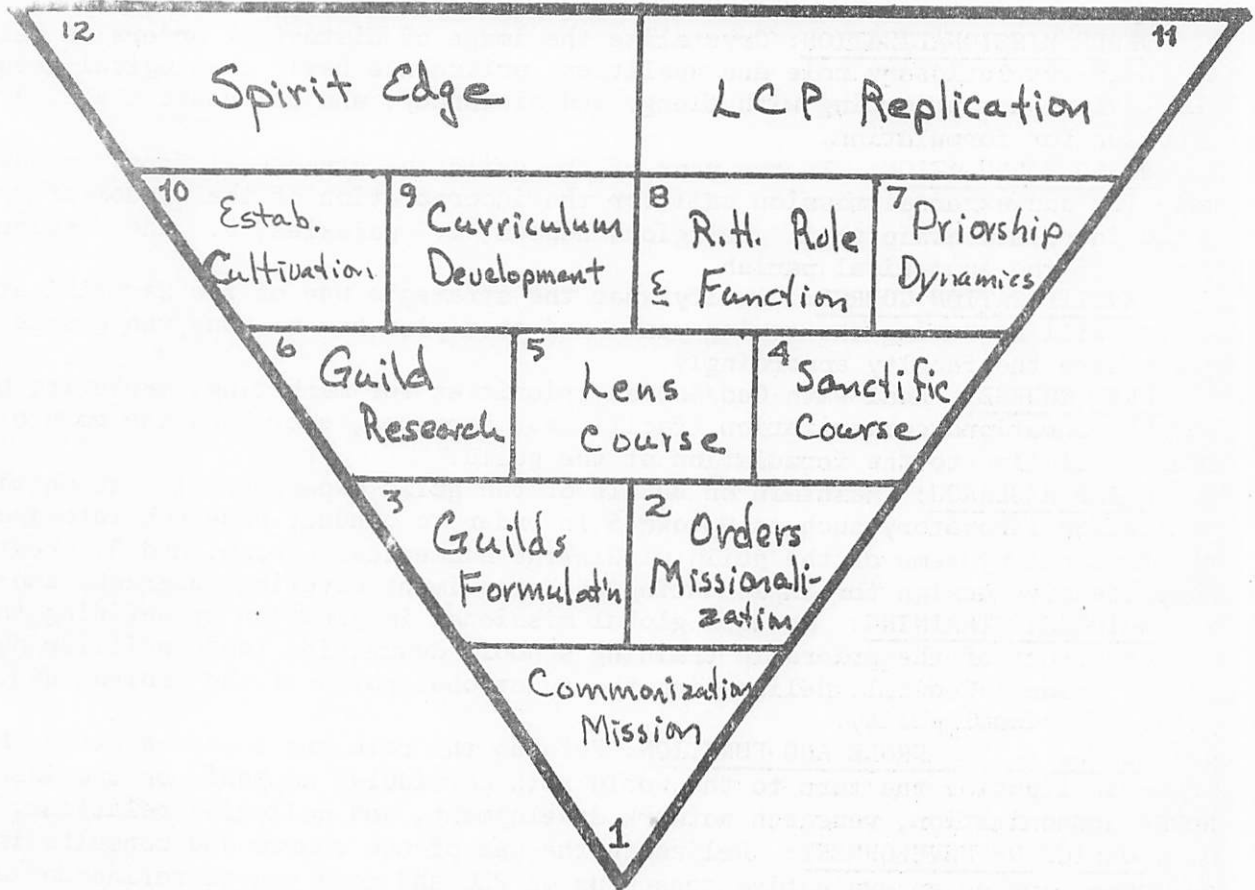


1. Immediate Polishing is needed in priorship training School, Spirit manual, Religious House Common Decour.
2. Summer '73 Wisdom Study, involves updating the Common memory of high Axi, the Galaxy and Movement colleagues in Uptown 5 Doc, Guild Documents, and Regional Council Document.
3. Movement Strategy involves the creation of timelines for implementing the E.P. through Guild establishment, religious order revitalization, and cluster plan penetration.

5. Field Analysts and Regional Screens are needed, i.e., guiding the metro to Parish level, Readiness criteria of metro catalytic cadres, and Parish analysts.
6. Training needs to be imported to Priors in terms of leadership, <sup>also</sup> ~~and~~ marketing strategies; to Clergy in Cluster requirement, and Uptown 5, the movement in PSC methods and University 13.
7. Guild implementation need calls for a guild experiment Post at Base, a PSC dealing with its Symbols (and symbolic life) and a 1<sup>st</sup> year meeting timeline.
8. Course and Consult Development is needed to sharpen the P.C. construct a new B.T.S. construct lesson plans and trial runs for 1<sup>st</sup> John and Holy Life course.
9. Troop Enlistment calls for articulating our operating models of enlisting clergy and galaxy leadership and with use of 1<sup>st</sup> John study, and a requirement plan for Guild leadership.
10. Pilot projects calls for practical planning and experiments in the area of Univ 13, L.C.X. Consults, <sup>3rd day</sup> use ~~for~~ <sup>for</sup> call meetings and teaching of the "Holy Life" course.
11. Mass Impact calls for Movement mailings and Mass P.R. use of Lens Global Report.
12. Funding calls for strategy and cost projection on the Guild Univ 13, and a common penetration financial model.

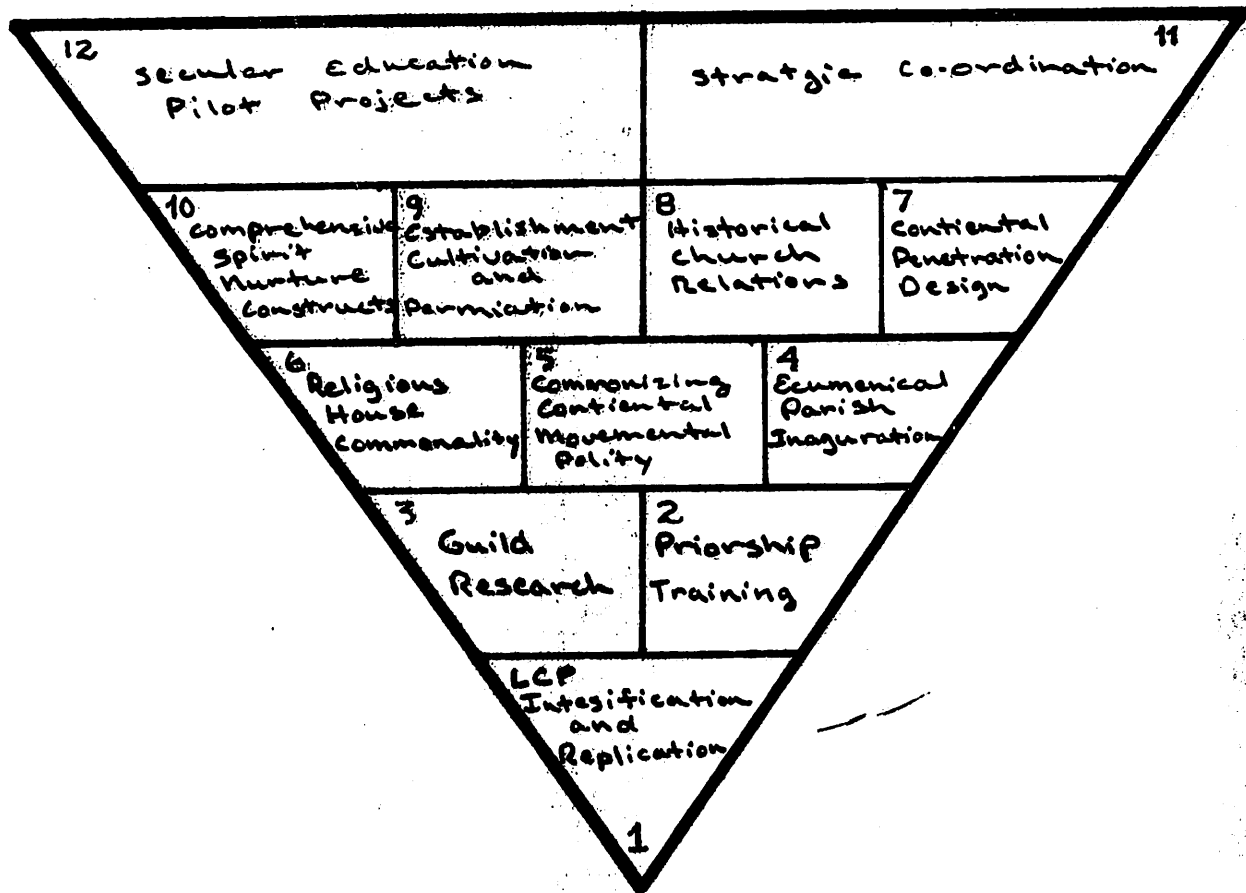


# 12 PRIORITIES OF PRACTICAL PLANNING



1. COMMONIZING THE MISSIONAL THRUST: Create a one page imaginal design for the new face of the movement; articulate the values held in going arealand establish priorities for new experimentation; and delineate the most effective formulation methods and penetration systems.
2. ORDER MISSIONALIZATION: Crystalize the image of historical orders in relation to their revolutionary role and qualities, articulate basic theological grounding relative to communicating with clergy and hierarchy, and delineate the strategic approach for formulation.
3. GUILD FORMULATION: In the year of the guild the structural forms in the internal life and external mission call for the incorporation of the wisdom of the guild in relationship to 1. religious houses, 2. galaxies, 3. the missional thrust of the ecumenical parish.
4. SANCTIFICATION COURSE: Clarify what the strategic use of the Sanctification course will be during the coming year, and then plan how to hone the course and prepare the faculty accordingly.
5. MARKETING COURSE: Deal with Geo/Social priorities for marketing; marketing practices; course operations commonization (facilities, services, etc.) and the role of the course relative to the formulation of the guild.
6. GUILD RESEARCH: Maintain on behalf of the guild experiment 1. an ongoing evaluating laboratory such as Uptown 5 in order to conduct research into operating the tactical systems of the guild within the ecumenical parish; and 3. create the comprehensive design for implementing the experiment covering geography and timeline.
7. PRIORSHIP TRAINING: Reshape global missional imagination by defining the two construct of the priorship training school, describing the conciliar dynamic of the Priors' Council, delineating the functional roles of the troika, quatrain and missional polity.
8. RELIGIOUS HOUSE ROLE AND FUNCTION: Refocus the role and function of the Religious house in light of the turn to the world with particular emphasis on the issues of house commonization, research network development, and collegial relations.
9. CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT: Delineate the use of new course and consults in training guildsmen, offer an evaluative consensus on PLC and core course refinement and determine next steps in launching the University 13 experiment.
10. ESTABLISHMENT CULTIVATION: Prioritize the key arenas and key figures for facilitating ecclesiastical and civil authorization, outline key arenas of funding to be developed and create a concrete image of how the movement will operate with sophistication as the incognito transestablishment.
11. LOCAL CHURCH REPLICATION: Delineate the preparation process by which new churches would journey to replication galaxy participation, offer an evaluative consensus on the timeline for ordered expansion and create the priorship training model to prepare the replication priors.
12. SPIRIT EDGE: The heightening demands and the expansion of the mission coupled with the larger number of spirit tools available calls for a discipline in the use of tools which call for clarity in 1. the use of methods, 2. the two faces of the order, 3. cabaret forms.

conversions, transposition exercises), build these constructs into a common order-training model and decide how and when to make them available to the movement.

XI. STRATEGIC CO-ORDINATION

As the movement embarks upon (new frontiers of mission in) the ecumenical parish and the guilds, their respective time-lines in relationship to galaxy timelines demand new means of strategic co-ordination requiring a new role of the Religious House in co-ordinating on the local level and the intervention of control centrum on the area level.

XII. SECULAR EDUCATION PILOTS

Secular education pilot projects create models which would enable implementation of the Five Day NSV Course, the One Day Convocation and University Thirteen, particularly in relation to refining the respective curriculum designs; scheduling financing and evaluating initial trial runs and initiating the projects on a regional or area level.

## TWELVE PRIORITY PLANNING ARENAS

## I. LCX Intensification &amp; Replication:

In addition to refining the specific plans and support constructs for replication (Documents 81 & 82), this group needs to pull together wisdom and spell out the arenas of intensification of existing Galaxies relative to greater depth, movement involvement, and preparation for the creation of ecumenical parishes.

## II. PRIORSHIP TRAINING

This group needs to devise the curriculum and constructs of the Advanced Priorship Training School to provide firm grounding in the decision-making dynamic, to describe the uses of the school and its methods, and to develop the constructs for the Religious House catch-up this fall, covering the work and life of Summer '73.

## III. GUILD RESEARCH

In Guild Research there is a need to look at the work from the research and PSU groups of the Summer Assembly and then the spelling out of the theoretical & practical dynamics of the task of the guild under the guidance of a guild experiment post.

## IV. ECUMENICAL PARISH INAGURATION

In the inaguration of the Ecumenical Parish first we need to determine the model that would grid the North American continent down to the parish level, also what a post at centrum would look like or what a similar regulation post would be and getting further clarity on how and where you would have an Ecumenical Parish.

## V. COMMONIZING MOVEMENT POLITY

This group needs to pull together specific common plans and out procedures for implamenting area operations, regional councils, and metro constructs.

## VI. RELIGIOUS HOUSE COMMONALITY

Keeping in mind that global expansion of the Religious House dynamic is taking place there is a pressing need for commonality in areas of worship, such a D.O., H.C., & the common meal; common strategic battleplan; and the global dimension of Wayside Inn.

## VII. CONTINENTAL PENETRATION DESIGNS

The planning arena of continental penetration designs will include the gridding of the North American Continent to the parish level, the clumping and selecting of cluster recruitment models and clairifying of financial models.

## VIII. HISTORICAL CHURCH RELATIONS

The planning arena of Historical Church Relations includes refining models for clergy care (pre- and post PLC) and recruitment, and familiarizing denominational leadership with the Local Church Experiment, and a specific plan for Roman Catholic cooperation projects.

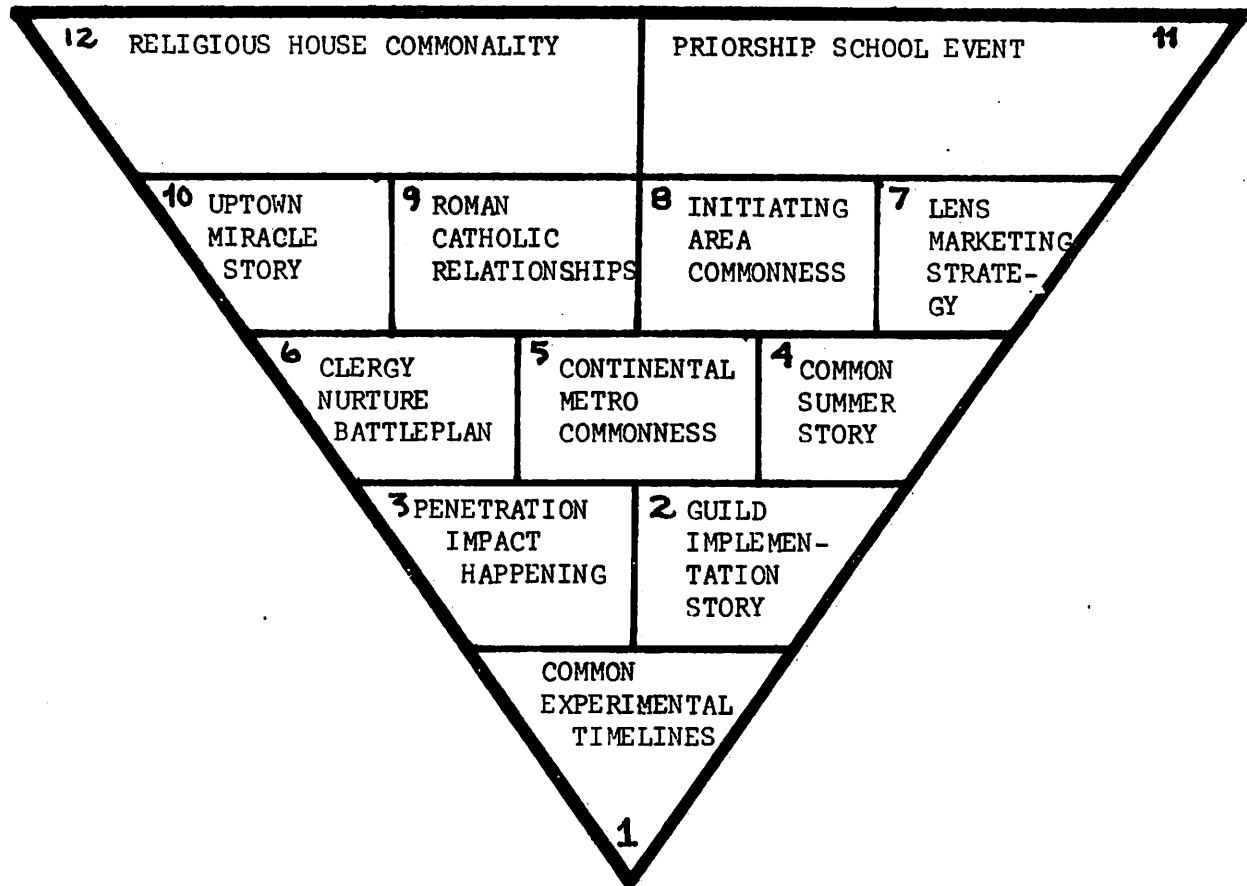
## IX. ESTABLISHMENT CULTIVAT &amp; PERMEATION

Included in this arena are the issues of local LENS marketing models, systematizing establishment contacts and cultivating and providing common images of style and tactical approaches the establishment at the local (metro) level.

## X. COMPREHENSIVE SPIRIT NURTURE

Spirit Nurture constructs should be set up to evaluate and refine present forms of the Sanctification Cource, the Cabaret, the Solitary Office and Summer '73 spirit methods (song

RELIGIOUS HOUSE COMMONALITY  
The twelfth priority for the Order Council is Religious House Commonality, including common internal frame, external mission methods and common style.

#### COMMON EXPERIMENTAL TIMELINES

The first priority of the Order Council is to determine the master image, the fundamental presuppositions, and the common timeline for the Ecumenical Parish, the Local Church Experiment and the Guild Experiment.

#### GUILD IMPLEMENTATION STORY

The second priority for Order Councils is the implementation plan for the guild which includes common story about the state of war, the guild training design and image of guild experiments relationship to the Ecumenical Parish.

#### PENETRATION IMPACT HAPPENING

The third priority of the Order Council is penetration impact which deals with the issues of cruciality of RSI and annual course schedule.

#### COMMON SUMMER STORY

The fourth priority for the Order Council is to create a summer story including by clarifying depth spirit happening stating guild creation implications and mythologizing new movement emergence.

#### CONTINENTAL METRO COMMONNESS

The fifth priority for the Order Council is to consense on one master image to tell the story of new metro commonness, with an accompanying 4X4X4, including vasic brooding on care models for non-Religious House, non-galaxy colleagues.

#### CLERGY NURTURE BATTLEPLAN

The sixth priority of the Order Council is the Clergy Nurture Battleplan which determines the Movemental Clerical Role of the future, actualizes parish leadership clerical recruitment strategies and re-articulates the importance of prior-clergy relations.

#### LENS MARKETING STRATEGY

The seventh priority of the Order Council is to image the Lens Marketing Strategy as presentation to a body of people as opposed to a pitch to an individual in a rational consensed model of implementation over a limited amount of time.

#### INITIATING AREA COMMONNESS

The eighth priority for Order Council is to decide what are the crucial arenas to begin area commonness with, what the timeline would be, and how area consensus is formed while holding regional autonomy.

#### ROMAN CATHOLIC RELATIONSHIPS

The ninth priority of Order Council is to develop: the basic strategy toward local churches, orders and heirarchy, the key tactics, the timeline for Roman Catholic consultations.

#### UPTOWN MIRACLE STORY

The tenth priority for the Order Council is to articulate out of the Summer's work in Uptown the miracle which holds the summer happening: consensus common movement story about the happening and state the vision for the Uptown Ecumenical Parish.

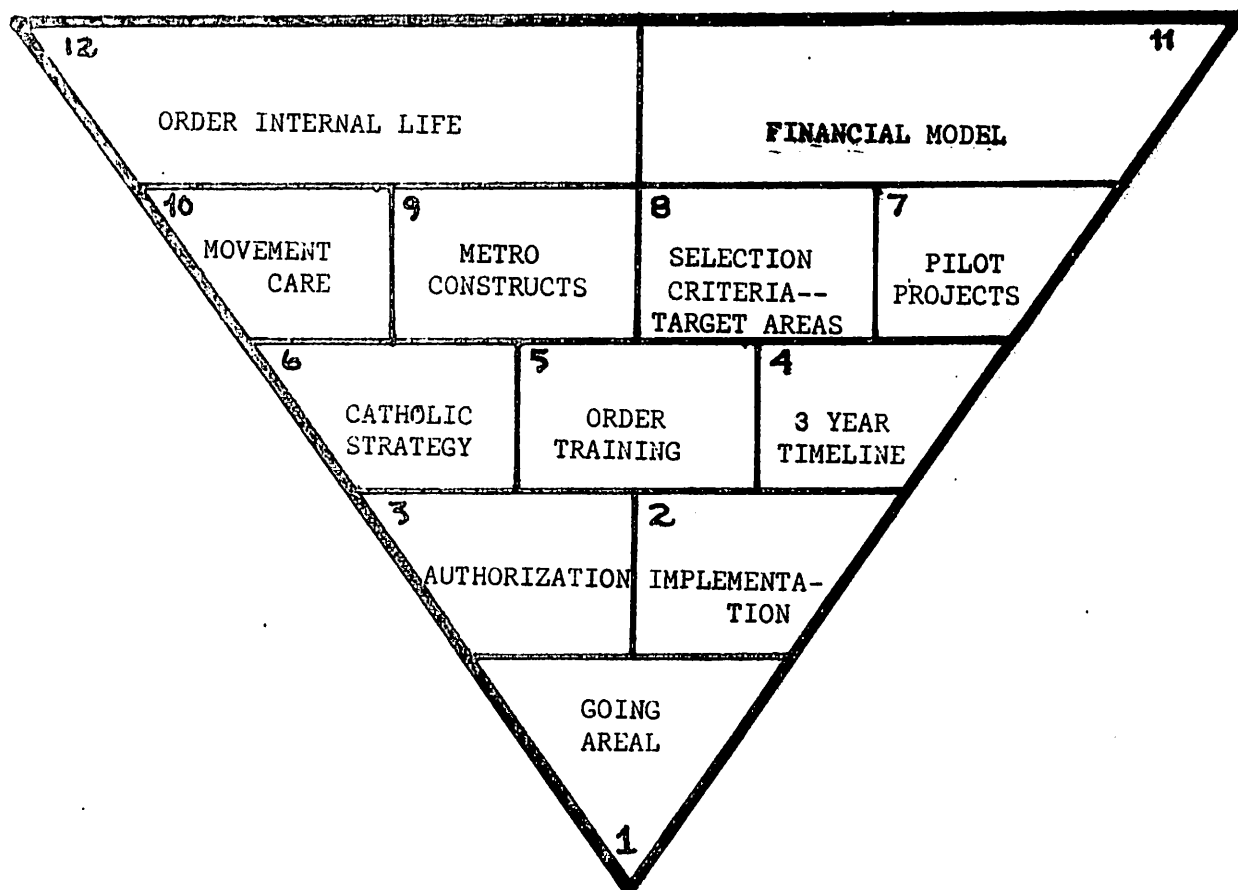
#### PRIORSHIP SCHOOL EVENT

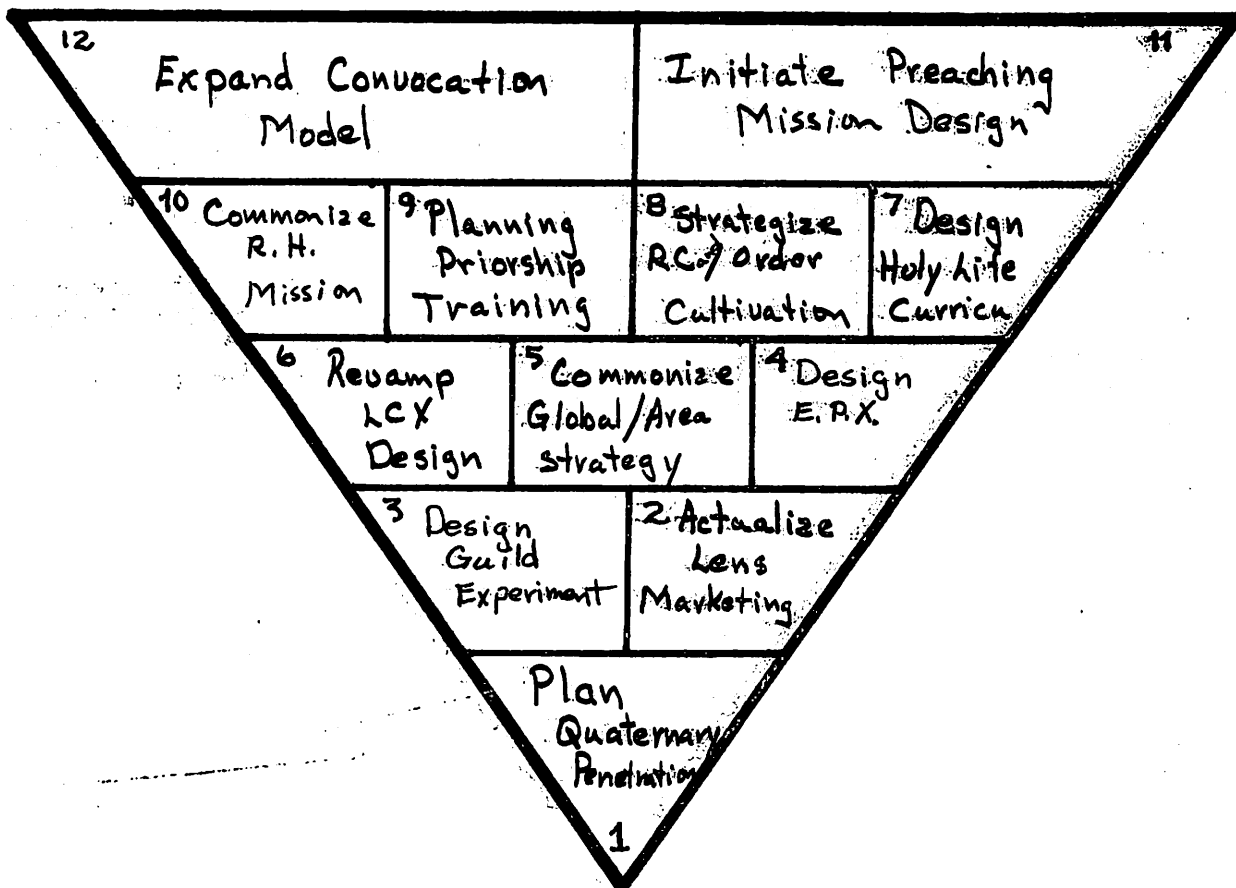
10. The tenth priority is a PSU or special study on Movemental care structures to be implemented in the coming year, by evaluating existing care structures, thinking thru care for non-attached grads, and emphasizing clergy care commonality.

11. The eleventh priority is a PSU on financial models covering the following points; the value and methods of ensuring commonality, the Ecumenical Parish Experiment and its funding, and the financial implications of going areal.

12. The twelfth priority is further consideration of the internal life of the Order and the implications for the fall quarter, falling under three headings: creations of a study timeline for the summer documents, establishment of newly created Centrum posts, and PSU;s for fall implementation of summer proposals.

1. The first priority to be dealt with during Order Council, 1973, is the issue of "going areal", specifically what that means in terms of Order polity i.e. Religious House priors, demonstration projects, and the creation of an areal Religious House and how that is a different reality than a regional House or a metro House.
2. The second priority has to do with extensive PSU's in the areas of the Ecumenical Parish Experiment, its function as spelled out in the Summer '73 documents, practical implementation and timeline; the Local Church Experiment, evaluation and planning in light of the Ecumenical Parish Experiment; and the Guild, its function and relationship to the Local Church Experiment and the Ecumenical Parish Experiment, its training and nurture.
3. The third priority is defining and creating guidelines for authorization, meaning determining what is necessary authorization, delineating the strategies for obtaining the nod, and dealing with both the religious hierarchy and the secular establishment.
4. The fourth priority is the creation of a three year timeline for the broad Movement strategies involving the comprehensive nine continent strategy the North American strategy, and a fall quarter timeline particularly in the area of demonstration projects.
5. The fifth priority is in the area of Order Training. Plans must be made for a Priorship Training School to provide priors with the necessary tools for the coming year, and at the same time long range training schemes must be developed to produce the giants necessary for the movement in the future, and goals and models are needed for the 7-8th grade school/Religious House Exper.
6. The sixth priority are PSU's on Roman Catholic strategy to decide overall strategy; the use of courses such as RS-I, PLC, LENS, Santification, and Holy Life, and defining the necessary protocol, style, and sensitivity needed in the movements relations to the Roman Catholic Church.
7. The seventh priority is the area of Pilot Projects - to develop a plan for implementing and refining Mass Awakening instruments such as the preaching mission, and the one day convocation; Religious training tools such as the First John study and the Holy Life series of courses; and Social Vehicle Training such as University 13 and the 5 day NSV course.
8. The eighth priority is selection criteria and a plan for creating target in the areas of sociological-geographical signs such as Mowanjum and 5th City, signs of dealing with key points of malaise such as the elders or youth, and signs of resurgence.
9. The ninth priority is planning for the work of the coming year in terms of clarifying metro constructs with a special emphasis on developing leadership, implementing catalytic cadres, and experimenting with cluster recruitment.

1. The basis of all other of our plans for the next four years is quaternary pene, and therefore careful attention must be given in the next month to the strategies and tactics called for to focus the attention and passion of the movement in this direction.
2. To actualize Lens marketing practical planning involves regional and metrol cooperation and assistance in creating and implementing, plan to elicit permission and wisdom of business movtl guardinas and involves promoting sturctural blessing of RH priorship.
3. Design of Guild: the intent is to consense on the model of the guild exp and strategize its implementation in early 1974
4. Design for implementing the EPX which projects 1)penetration prioties in relation to core course and Lens, and 2) projects troop training and 3)troop deployment
5. Commonize global areal strategies in relation to penetration, polity and financing
6. The LCX design s/b revamped in terms of the total tactical system update, of the happenings withing the EPX and of the need for the need of intensificatiion of reduplication.
7. Designing the Holy Life curri involves finalizing the Sanct. Cse., revamping the spirit methods in light of sanct., and planning the strategic of Sanct. Cse. and spirit practics in enable the new religious life.
8. Strategizing Religious Orders and Roman Catholic Church cultivation requires 1) research and study of the Hist Orders, Vat II and the great wisdom of the past. 2) building the tactical system to enable the task and 3) drawing up a specific

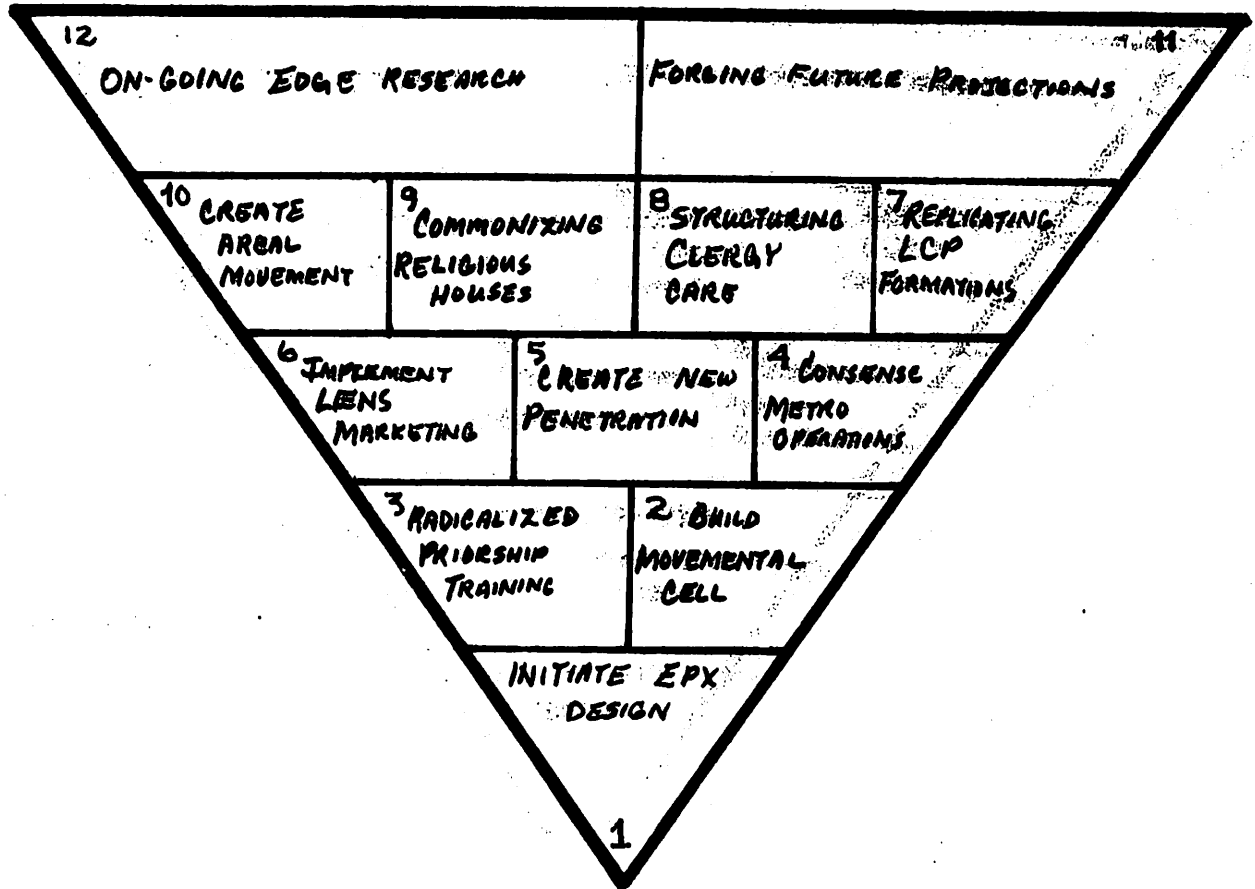
B/P and T/L relating to Movemental Goals.

9. Planning priorship training requires consensing on the initiating of pilot experiment, relating priorship training to the total movt training experiences and designing the supplemental training experiences required for a total priorship training journey.
10. State the consensus of the internal life and external mission priorities of all Religious Houses for fall quarter.
11. Initiate preaching mission designs involves practical planning in the areas of 1) global plan for mass impactment 2) relationship to EP implementation 3) staff training and practical planning for actual local use.
12. Expanding convocation model requires the design of a construct for the EPX, for the mass evangelism strategy and for movemental usage.

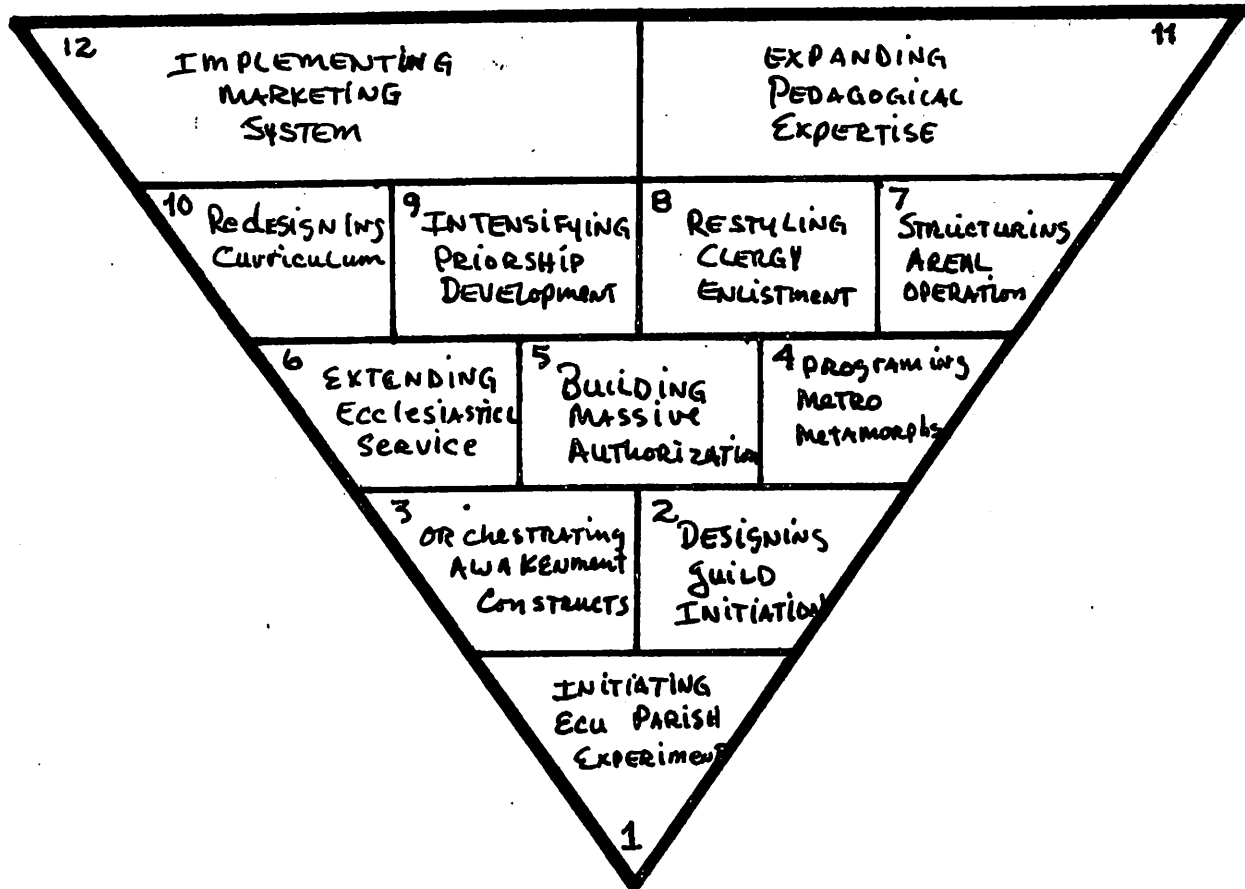

1. Initiate EPX Design points to the guild, the LCX, the direct tactics, the logistics, and the establishment of an experimental centrum post.
2. Build Movemental Cell points to its relationship to the metro, and to the historical order.
3. Radicalized Worship Training points to the new 5-day course, the 13-week staff school, and the long-term design.
4. Consense Metro Operations points to the metro cell, the metro catalytic cadre and the EPX.
5. Create New Penetration points to the continental consensus, the North American battleplan document and the new evangelism style.
6. Implement LENS Marketing points to the establishment cultivation, tract consensus, and relation to EPX.
7. Replicating LCP Formations points to galaxy replication, global expansion, and intensified continuity.
8. Structuring Clergy Care points to setting up a clergy collegium, initiate a study of the vocational malaise of the clergy and develop a continental clergy recruitment model.
9. Commonize Religious Houses points to developing and disseminating common global models for practical manifestation, implementing the missional task through the internship program and demonstrating the dynamic of sacred space in any society.
10. Create Areal Movement points to launching Area Councils in December, standing before the 54 Areas of the globe, and scheduling area leadership presidiums from representative regions.
11. Forging Future Projections points to building the model for the self-support of all movemental components; forging the special funding sources for edge research and projects, and designing the plan for Areal-based finances.

12. On-going Edge Research points to model building for the sanctification course, University 13 and establishment collegiality.

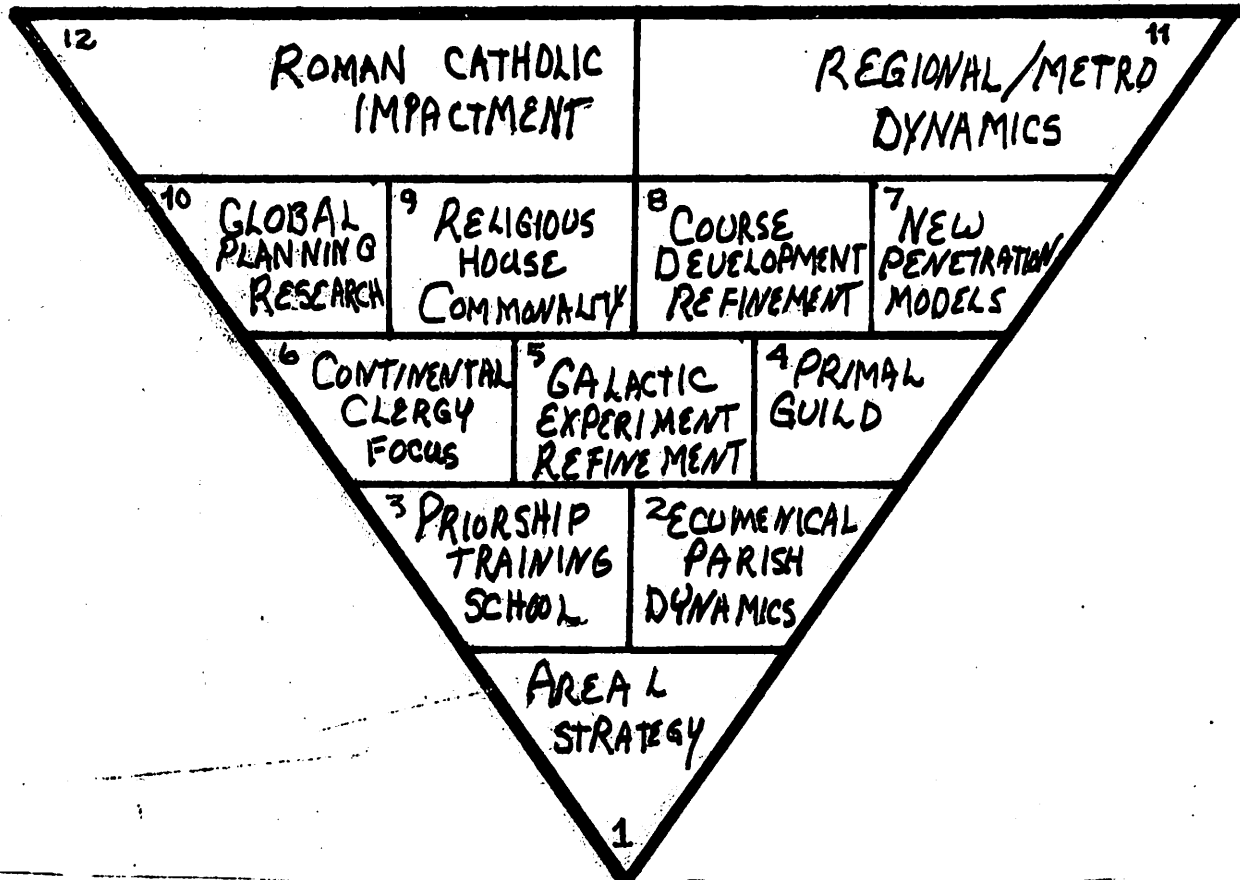


1. Initiating the Ecumenical Parish Experiment which will require 1) developing a tactical system, 2) integrating the EPX into the LCX design, 3) laying out the first practical steps for those galaxies who will begin the experiment in January, 1974.
2. Designing guild initiation that holds global commonness at the local level and yet facilitates its implementation.
3. Orchestrating the awakenment constructs by prioritizing the demonstration arenas through a PSU series and by conducting controlled experimentation in priority arenas.
4. Programming metro metamorphosis involves intensifying the role of the Metro catalytic cadre by relating it to the Guild and the Galaxy, building a strategy to enable 50 man religious houses, and bringing regional commonality to its internal life.
5. Building massive authorization calls for the creation of a public image which cultivates strategic establishment support in order to gain necessary approval and funding for movement activities.
6. Extending Ecclesiastical service allows for the Movement to come to the surface relative to the denominational hierarchies and religious orders.
7. Structuring areal operation involves developing the models for effective area information ~~for~~ interchange.
8. Restyling clergy enlistment has to do with fresh recruitment tactics and a more beckoning style of clergy recruitment in a time of resurgence.
9. Intensifying priorship development involves intensive intern formulation, advanced priorship training school and more engagement of movemental cadre members.
10. Redesigning curriculum constructs involves looking at the curriculum thru eyes of sanctification to see what refocusing may be needed, looking at academy construct to

11. Expanding pedagogical expertise has to do with increasing the methodological rows and number of courses present, teachers available, as well as increasing the number of regional galaxy teachers.

12. Implementing the marketing involves choosing key men to introduce the course into the designated areas, making appointments by phone prior to flight.

The planning task of Global Planning/Research is to 1) design the organization of centrum to maximize its ability to coordinate and serve the Order and the Movement 2) to structure and implement the embryonic Global Research Net including planning the year's PSU's for the Order across the globe and the Movement and 3) to project and timeline global penetration and formulation for the coming year in relation to our long-range global plan.

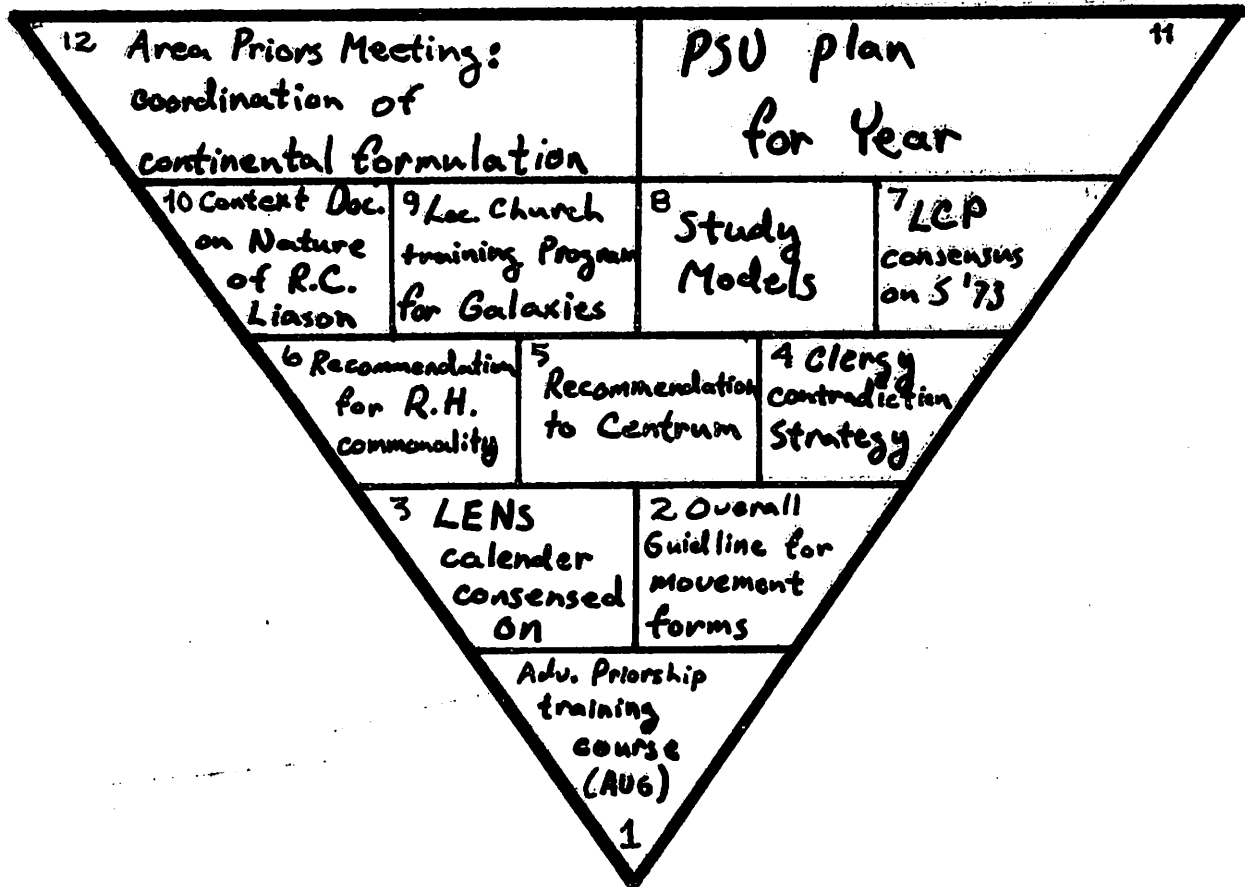
The planning task of Regional/Metro Dynamics is to consider all the work that has been done in the area of giving form to the resurgence of our time; the metro catalytic cadre, the cluster local church development or metro ecclesiola and the guild; simplify work of the assembly and create an image of the structure and dynamic necessary to enable local parishes to come into being in strategic locations of every region and to allow iron men to rise up in every metro.

ROMAN  
CATHOLIC  
IMPACTMENT

The planning task of Roman Catholic Impactment is to write a contextual statement to move directly on religious order recruitment and development; to timeline and battleplan the happenings necessary for that impactment, then to evaluate the appropriateness of Holy Life Practics and Sanctification courses as primary Roman Catholic impactment tools.

- IMPLEMENTING AREAL STRATEGY** The planning task of implementing areal strategy will include deciding which centrum dynamics need to be moved to the area level, area priors battleplanning to get a common image and timeline of these dynamics at the area level, and battleplanning post-turn areal dynamics such as guardians and development.
- ECUMENICAL PARISH DYNAMICS** The planning task of Ecumenical Parish Dynamics is to authentically simplify the wisdom of the Summer by redoing the theoretical model of the Cadre, Congregation and Guild dynamics and relations and pulling together practical implications of their work.
- PRIORSHIP TRAINING SCHOOL** In the area of Priorship Training School, this construct must be ready to be presented to the Order Council the first week of September and therefore preparation must go on to see to it that the wisdom from Summer '73 is included and the implementation model built for the next three weeks.
- PRIMAL GUILD IMPLEMENTATION** The planning task of Primal Guild Implementation is to create the model for tactical action at the Regional, Metro, and Parish levels for the Fall quarter in anticipation of launching a full-scale Guild model January 1, 1974.
- GALACTIC EXPERIMENT REFINEMENT** In the area of Galactic Experiment Refinement, clarity must be discerned relative to refining the Parish Tactics in the direction of Pre-Guild or Guild Implementation tactics, the replication model needs to be amplified, and a description of the usage of new constructs such as LENS, the preaching mission, and the sanctification course is needed.
- CONTINENTAL CLERGY FOCUS** The planning tasks of the Continental Clergy Focus are the creation of continental recruitment models, the development of spiritual nurture constructs, and movemental leadership training.
- NEW PENETRATION MODELS** The planning task of New Penetration Models is to plan the continental recruitment strategies and the coordination of their implementation, discern the use of the new pre-core courses (e.g., preaching mission, LENS, Sanctification, St. John, etc.), and create a possible timeline for impactment of a metro with these new possibilities.
- COURSE DEVELOPMENT/ REFINEMENT** The planning task of Course Development/Refinement is 1) to delineate, describe, and project the development and refinement of our curriculum as we continue to create new courses and teach established courses 2) to bring together and focus all of our curriculum in one comprehensive rationale and 3) to establish a consensus on teacher training for the fall quarter.
- RELIGIOUS HOUSE COMMONALITY** The planning task of Religious House commonality includes reworking the document written last week (from which Section IV was missing), cleaning documents which are intended to be a statement of our consensus on practical operating matters, and restating the operating principles for Religious House Commonality.

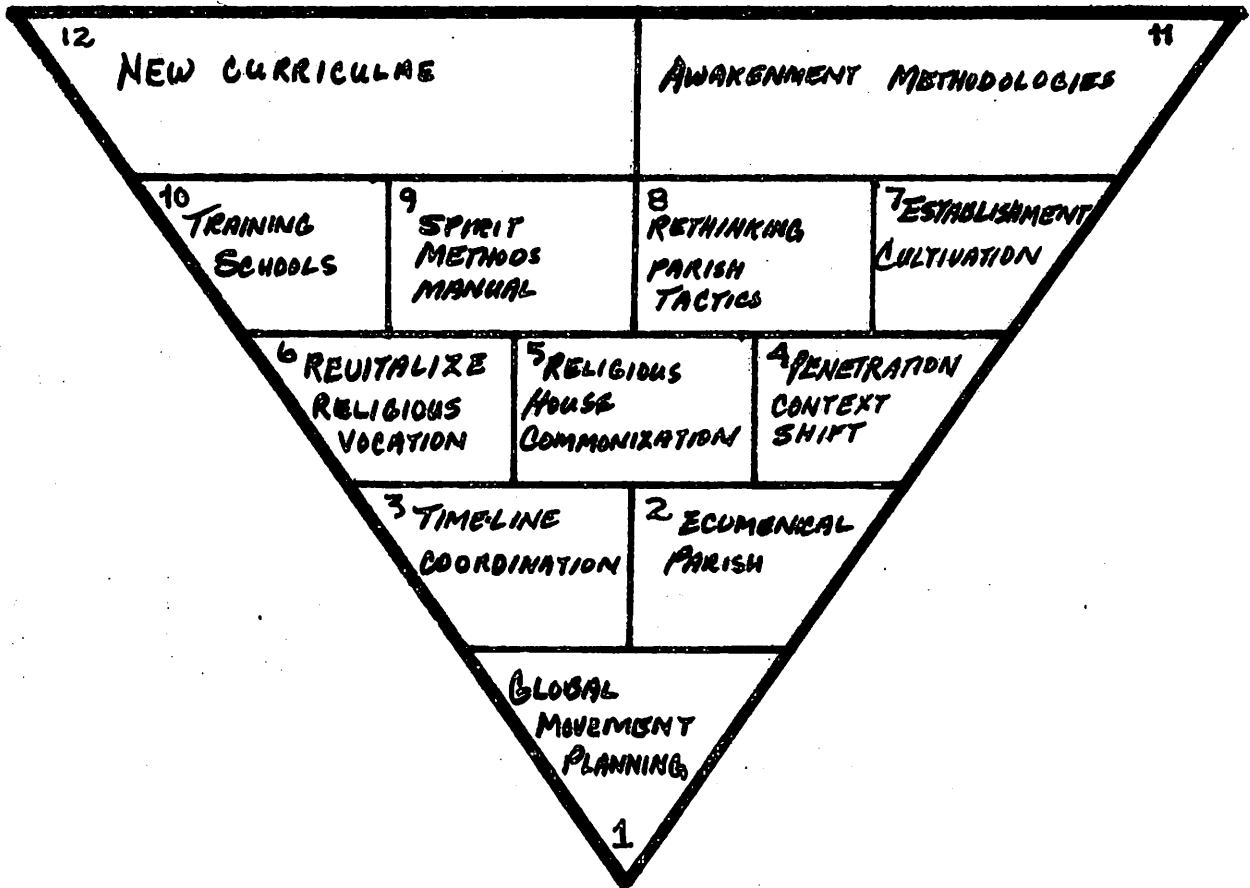


1. The advanced priorship training school requires that 6-8 centrum priors (some with past house experience) be assigned to refine and prepare for teaching during the August/September Order Council and that the construct be polished and the course repeated on an Areal level during the spring quarter.
2. Movement forms consisting of the cell, metro catalytic cadre and the guild need to have clearly delineated the relationship between the three forms and have an imaginal holding image in order for the implementation of these forms to take place in the fall quarter.
3. The global LENS calendar is to be consensed upon immediately in order to enable development of initial lists of sponsors whereby systematic contacts can be made according to a priority listing.
4. The number of documents produced in the last 2 years on clergy care and recruitment indicate a major contradiction requiring a new strategy, temporary relief through a consensed shift in the PLC construct, and beginning to evaluate the basic ITI effectiveness versus the PLC.
5. Having visioned the emergence of four new Centrum posts--Ecumenical Parish, Movement, Guild, and Curriculum Expansion--we recommend prioritizing these posts and determining the necessary assignments.
6. Recommendations for Religious House commonness need to include the incorporating of the implications of S'7e on the House (planning, mission, style) study plan of the documents of S'73 and a training model.
7. The planned reporting weekend in the Galaxy Wk II design calls for consensus on what to say about the Ecumenical Parish experiment, the Guild, and the Sanctification course.
8. We recommend that in order to create the common memory of summer '73 study models for documents be created for metro leadership, Religious Houses, and galaxy.
9. We recommend to the local church experiment that before the fall quarter begins that prior preparation for replication, ecumenical parish relationship fo the tactical system, and creation of a training program to brief the galaxies on S'73 be dealt with.
10. A contextual document on the liason with the Roman Catholic Church would include our times in terms of the dynamics of Historical/Movemental Orders--within the church, the state of Roman Catholic Orders today, and the contradiction with the Movemental Order interms of relating to Roman Catholic Orders.
11. PSU's will be focused on curriculum expansion and revision, regional strategy polity and nurture, and the relationship of local church to the future of the Ecumenical Parish and Guild.
12. A study of the state of the Region and the House(s), a missional theme for the next year, and a common movemental calendar will be the focus of a R.H. priors meeting held by Areas.

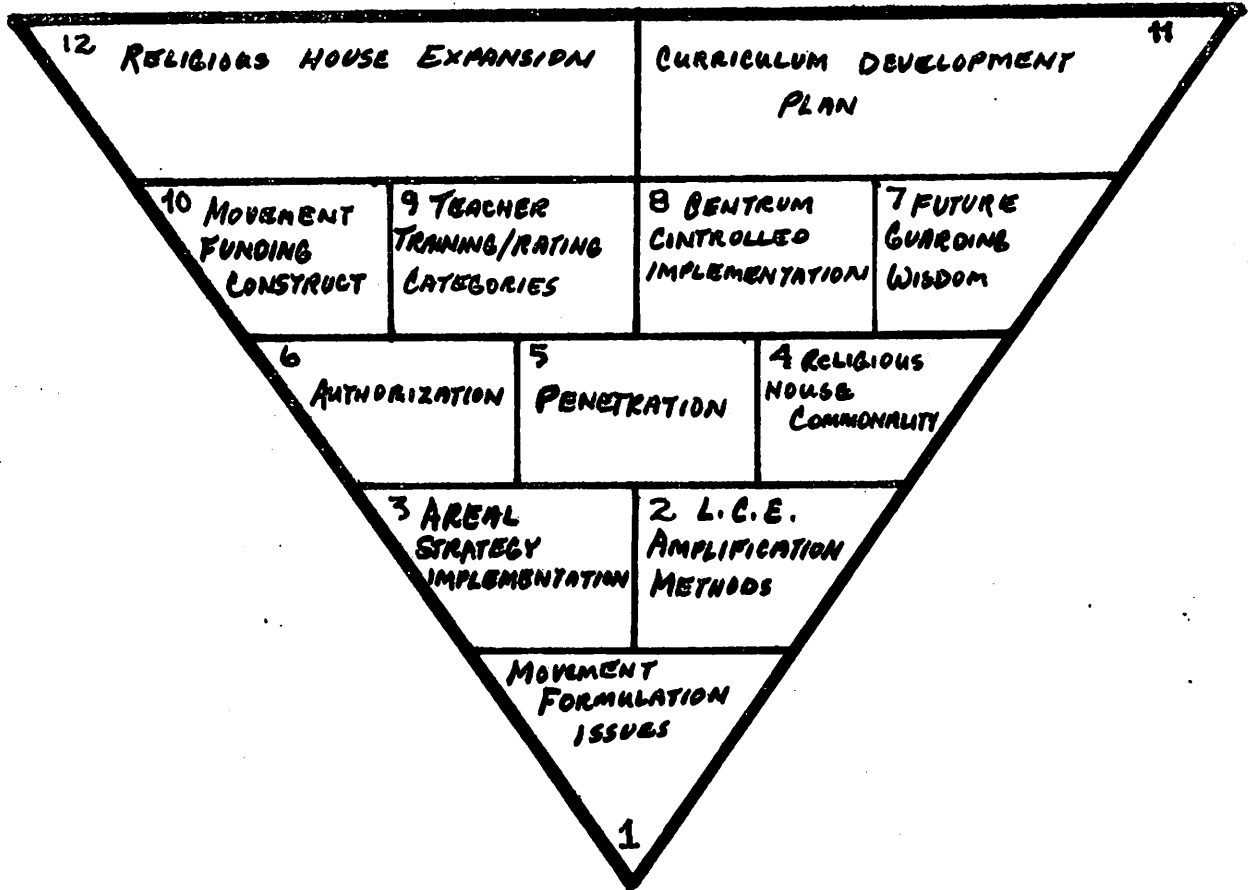


1. Global planning PSU will articulate the implications of areal economic self-sufficiency, areal polity and create a four year time line for areal development with a special emphasis on Religious house expansion and signal projects.
2. The Ecumenical Parish PSU will articulate criteria for selection of the first Ecumenical Parish sites, pull together the wisdom of the present research and time-line ecumenical parish-guild-galaxy implementation.
3. The Time-line Coordinations PSU will pull together the timelines from the other PSUs and construct a movement one, four and twenty year timeline.
4. The Penetration Context Shift PSU will create new penetration designs from the past wisdom on cluster recruitment and articulate a way to relate all the courses into one penetration thrust.
5. The Religious House Commonality PSU will focus on establishing order consensus for the Commonality document, the implementation of the document.
6. The Revitalizing Religious Vocations PSU will pull together the latest wisdom and methods for addressing the religious vocation collapse and use the above screen to evaluate and push further the new PLC construct and clergy recruitment style, and evaluate and push further the Holy Life Sanctification course and religious order engagement plan.
7. The establishment Cultivation PSU will articulate the basic objectives and strategies for obtaining establishment support and authorization especially considering LENS as a tool.
8. The LCX parish tactics need to be rethought practically and theoretically in the light of the new insights relative to the Ecumenical Parish and the Guild
9. The Spirit Methods Manual PSU needs to create a montage of suggested uses of the movements spirit methods, do a final evaluation and publication of the manual and create a suggested distribution model.
10. The Training School PSU will create a rationale for implementing the Advanced Priorship School, the creation of a New Social Vehicel training model and the refinement of existing curriculae such as the BTS relative to the the Ecumenical Parish, the PLC . ITI and Academy.
11. The Awakenment Methodologies PSU will gather the evangelistic tools, catalogue them as instruments of the year of the Guild and complete the model for the Preaching Mission including a rationale for implementation.
12. The New Curriculum PSU will pull together constructs for the NSV Course, University 13, the Holy Life Course and the Advanced Priorship Training School need to be polished and published for the purpose for further experimentation.

1. Movement Formulation Issues Begin forming movemental wisdom on formulation by defining formulation tools/methods and prioritizing the top 10, spelling out the various formulation methods and how they are best used (e.g., ecclesiola, psu's, preaching mission, recruitment, etc.), and articulating the comprehensive formulation strategy.
2. L.C.E. Amplification Methods Specify the amplification of the Local Church Project by looking at what revisions of tactics are necessary in light of the Ecumenical Parish Project, consensing on replication guidelines, and timing the incorporation of revisions and amplifications.
3. Areal Strategy Implementation An Areal strategy PSU would deal with common financing plans including development strategies with gardian co-ordination and cross Religious House funding models, polity arrangements including areal councils and area training including area academies, area teachers, and areal local church consults.
4. Religious House Commonality The issues of R.H. commonality center on the concrete operating role of the houses play in the region, (ie penetration) the extent and form of experimentation with edge missional areans, (ie guild) and the questions of house size, locstion, snf ownership.
5. Penetration Penetration could be improved and more effective by lowering levels of attraction to draw in all men, (this might include UR studies and festivals.) step in-cognito methods of speaking, (get beer and wine license,) and by screening jobs for maximal affluence.
6. Authorization Authorization will become increasingly important in the future as the movement impacts local man at the offensive edge of his life. This will take the form of moving into an area, scouting the territory, raising up signs and ferreting out the contradictions.
7. Future Guarding Wisdom Guarding the future means identifying and avoiding the pitfalls that have in the past led to the collapse of other movemental forms, and discerning future contradictions so that as the spirit of resurgence rises the movement is sustained and does not fail in its task.
8. Faculty training and rating With the creation of new courses a new complexity is introduced relative to teacher training and rating, rationales for rating teachers may be different for LENS and RS-I, and then there is the question of who or what category of movemental people will teach a particular course.
9. Teacher Training/Rating Categories This planning arena is to design the training flow for quantity as well as quality RS-I teachers, to plan the channelling of troops to other critical teaching arenas such as academy, LENS, new courses, and BTS, and to refine the rating system to indicate who across the globe is able to teach which courses.
10. Movement Funding Construct In the area of funding a PSU will decide how the movement is to be funded, particularly in the arenas of new projects and North American enablement of global expansion, who will do this funding, and how we go about getting this funding.

11. Curriculum Development Plan The priority of curriculum development entails the construction of new courses related to the movements current missional thrusts, which must then be integrated with existing movement curriculum and refined for mass penetration of secular and ecclesiastic society.

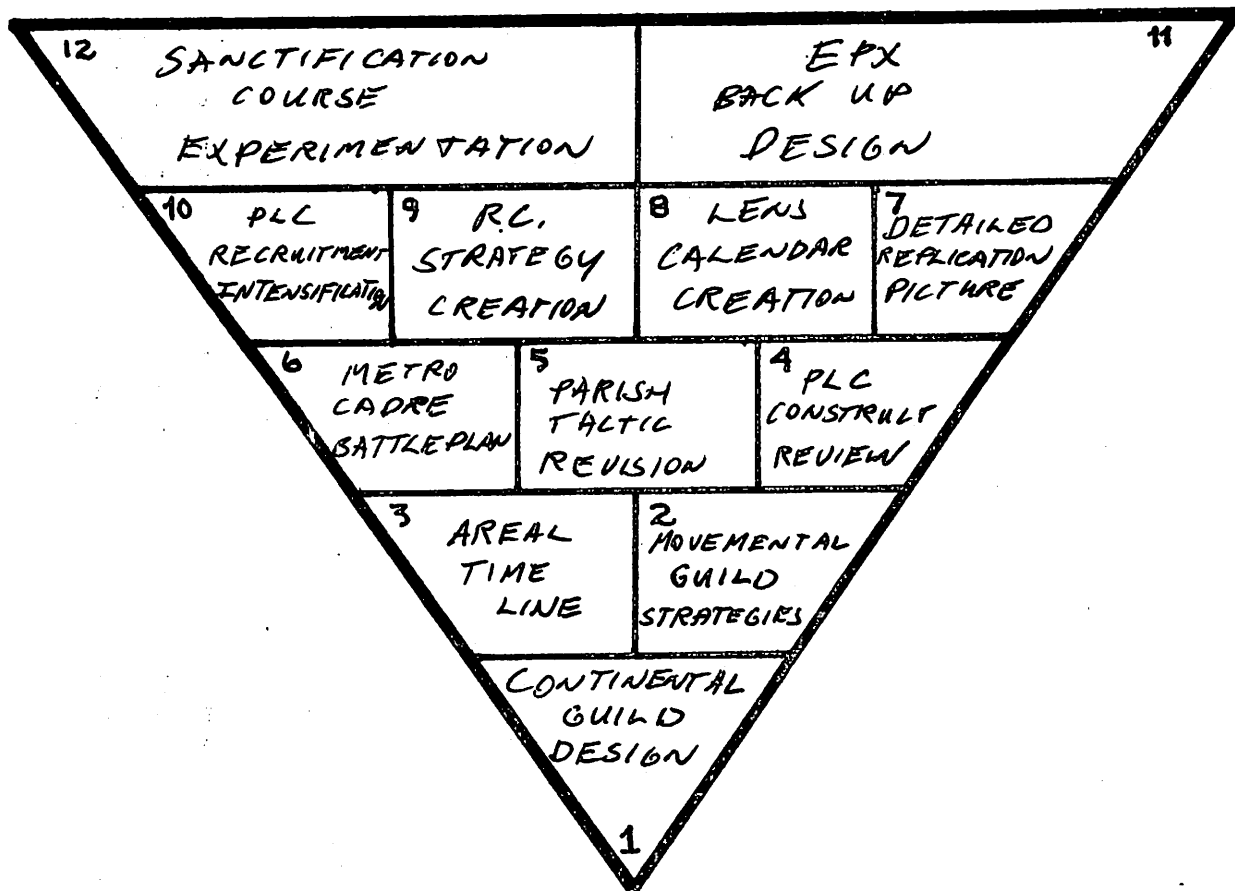
12. Religious House Expansion The priority of R.H. expansion must be dealt with out of a strategic timeline for the globe which relates the expansion to the overall thrust of the movement in accord with consensed revolutionary criteria.



the concrete steps for this coming year in such arenas as faculty assignments, intern distribution, and movemental funding.

6. The Roman Catholic Strategies planning arena includes choosing the target groups (orders, etc.) for the coming year, formalising the liason, and projecting the impact of the new course on the Holy Life.
7. The Style Shift Statement planning arena includes clarifying the incognito stance, elaborating the Cabaret stance and refining the sophistication stance in the context of cultivating establishment relations.
8. The Uptown 5 Projections planning arena includes unifying the strategic social vision of Fifth City, the Local Church Project, the Ecumenical Parish and the Guild, implementing further experimental strategies and tactics, and providing for the training of the local troops in required methodologies.
9. The LENS Course Implications planning arena includes expanding the use of the LENS global report in recruitment, follow-up and public relations, delineating marketing audiences, methods and troops for the next year, and exploring the consistency of the LENS Lab work and Guild implementation research.
10. The Sanctification Course Polishing planning arena includes completing the established construct, designing the pedagogues manual, and creating the strategic penetration model.
11. The Spirit Methods Manual planning arean includes providing the master contextual framework, fine-tuning the particular constructs, and checking the Odyssey manuals.
12. The Collegial Formation Models planning arena includes building steps toward the commonizing of key metro constructs, articulating the common underlying context for movement nurture and collegial relations, and researching the implications of mass awakening on the arena of formation.

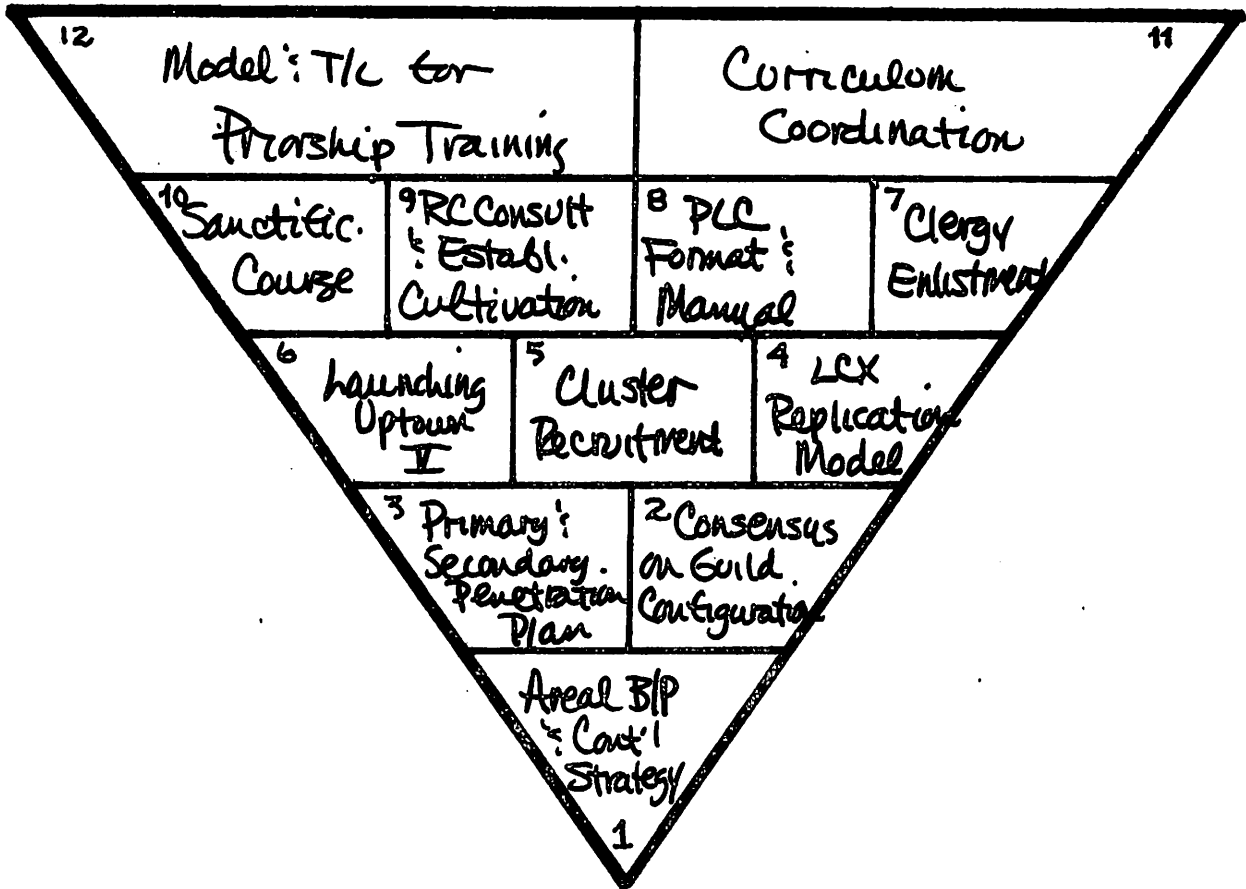

11. The order needs to create the Ecumenical Parish Experiment centrum back-up design consisting of training structures and site selection system, and a centrum based consulting network.
12. The Sanctification Experimental Course needs to be put into a complete teaching manual, a planned pedagogical training program, and guidelines as to whom, when, and where it is initially taught.

1. The order needs to work out a continental design for the guild experiment including a clear operating image, common four year model, and a continental time-line.
2. In order to implement the Global Guild Experiment, the order needs to decide what the common movemental strategies are, differentiating them if need be, from the Local Church Project Master Strategies, spelling out the relationship of direct tactics to the Master Strategies, such as Lens, PSU's, and the Cabaret; and clarifying the interrelationships of the functioning dynamics of awakening, caring, and justicing to the Guild.
3. This document raises the primary issue of "Going Areal" by January 1974; we suggest that this issue be examined by the order as to the time/line of implementation and its actualization relative to other missional demands, how this time/line relates to other on-going structures, and that consideration be given to strategic building of areal consciousness through demonstration projects and/or areal academy.
4. The order needs to consider the revision of the PLC construct with particular attention to 1) the last three lectures, 2) the workshops, and 3) the spirit conversation suggestions.
5. The order needs to consider the revision of local church parish tactics in relation to the coming into being of 1) the ecumenical parish system, 2) the tactical system of the guild, and 3) the shift from emphasis on cadre and congregation to parish system in preparation for intensification of the Ecumenical Parish Experiment.
6. The order needs to discern the consensus on the concrete function of the Metro Catalytic Cadre, create a clear image of the MCC as it fits in the structure of the spirit movement, and build a common plan for strategic location of the MCC's.
7. The order needs to decide on the detailed picture of replication in the areas of: 1) criteria for replication, 2) regulation of the replicated galaxy, and 3) relation of replication prior to Regulation Centrum, the symbolic order, and the replication galaxy.
8. The order needs to create a continental calendar for Lens considering geography, staff, and guild implementations.
9. The order needs to spell out the operating context for participants in choice, expanding and strengthening the relationship between the Roman Catholic Church and the movement through the special fall meeting.
10. PLC recruitment intensification needs a movemental style shift of collegial sophistication in relation to the historical church, intensifying effective existing recruitment models and creating a battleplan of recruitment for the upcoming year.

1. Our #1 priority has to do with areal battleplanning, North American strategy in relationship to global strategies. The issues here are what is our new move relative to the area and what does it mean to build the movement in North America with brackets on the continent.

2. Before this week ends, the Order Council needs to consense on: 4 year, 1 year and quarterly images for how we move on the Guild; criteria for first continent-wide Guild location (Guild without previous galaxy) and Uptown V replication location; discerning the demands that the Guild work will make on other aspects of movement thrust as well as the new force it will provide.

3. In this arena, the following needs to be done: maintaining our penetration priorities in the light of heavy formulation demands, many new courses, consultations and training constructs related to guild formulation and galaxy intensification.

4. The Council needs to consider the over-all design for replicating the Local Church Project in the light of the wisdom on the Ecumenical Parish gained in Summer '73-which would inform geographic planning, strategies and tactics and the relation to the Guild.

5. Planning for cluster recruitment includes clarification of what a cluster is and what we are out to accomplish through its use; the analysis of existing cluster recruitment models and creation of comprehensive models incorporating their wisdom; and clarification of how cluster recruitment relates to formulation models, especially in regard to development of galaxies and Ecumenical Parishes.

6. In light of the global consensus to establish twelve City V experiments within the next year, it is crucial that we consider: 1) a concrete timeline and battleplan that includes criteria for discerning the geographic locations of these experiments, 2) developing the design of the two-week kick-off consultation, and 3) the form of the feedback and research functions and to sustain the corporateness of the experiment.

7. Priority Clergy Enlistment describes: 1) the use of a sophisticated package of tools, 2) such as clergy collegiums, one day convocations, 1st John commentary, St. John of the Cross study and spirit methods which are relevant to local pastors in their own situation in a geographical and denominational context and 3) which creates a new climate of clergy support.

8. PLC Format and Manual raises the issue of the clergy journey, the recruitment stories leading to course actualization and calls for a consensus on the format itself, a demonstration of its supposition-

9. Roman Catholic Consults and Establishment Cultivation has to do with: 1) Building a consult format, 2) Building a model for cultivating the establishment of the Church, and 3) a long-range model for what is to happen to the Catholic Orders and to the other orders.

10. The necessity for the practical planning relative to the Sanctification Course takes the form of discerning the most effective time to broaden movemental exposure to the course; the drawing up of a penetration rationale that would include the provision of the necessary faculty and the role the course will play in Roman Catholic and Establishment formulation.

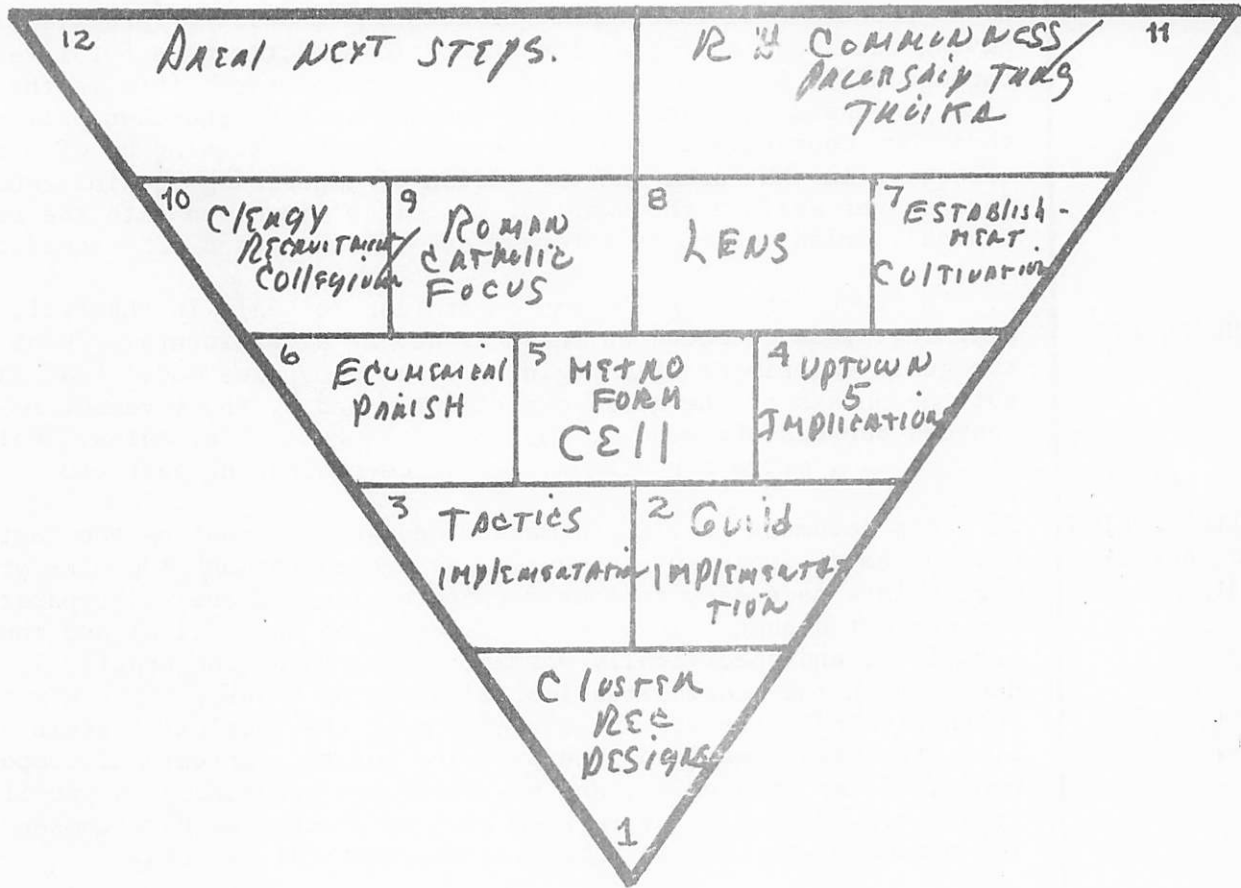

11. Our #11 priority, Curriculum Coordination, has to do with, fitting in the new courses and training curriculum into an arena that is not putting new wine into old skins and then deciding how and when we use the new courses and what their relationships are relative to the existing core curriculum.

12. Priorship Training Construct leaves several questions unanswered regarding: 1) when and where the model is enacted, 2) to whom does the model apply as far as where the training sessions are held, and 3) what is the concrete form for this training beyond the Sanctification Course.

CLUSTER  
RECRUITMENT

1. To move in on and engage congregations in the local Church renewal process will involve new efforts and models for practically giving the local churchman the chance to directly care for lives through RS-I. A major decision about whether or not this is the time to expend the kind of energy needed to have churches pull off their own courses will have to be made by the weighing up of past successes in that area and the vision of empowering the indigenous forces over against the swarm of priorities involved with the Ecumenical parish, metro cell forces and the increased LENS schedule.

GUILD  
IMPLEMENTATION

2. In order for the guild implementation to begin in the fall, planning needs to occur in three areas: 1. a continental T/L of when the guild experiment will begin, 2. a 4 year phase model that lays out the phases of the guild experiment, and 3. the movement resources can best be used to implement the guild e.g. galaxy, religious house, metro structures, a base co-ordinating post etc.

OPERATING DESIGN  
OF THE TASK OF  
THE GUILD

3. This document provides a master design for creating the tactical system to implement the guild, as meshed through the nine pressure points necessary for our corporate planning are: 1) separating the present document into two key arena: the theoretical and the practical, and specifically working on grounding the practical document in the local situation. 2) devising a series of PSU's to further clarify the essential elements of the tactical systems - i.e., the relationship of the pressure points, contextural components, master strategies, and how these are grounded in a specific locale e.g. Uptown 5. 3) Further work on whether we have chosen THE paramount tactics to actualize the tactical systems.

UPTOWN 5

4. The Uptown 5 model will raise signs of possibility to local man after refining the practical wisdom of summer '73 into a 2 week training lab, by articulating the dynamics of temple, guild and galaxy, and by delineating the tactics used to cultivate the historical church in the protoparish.

METRO

5. In order to launch metro formulation this year, the key arenas of planning include: 1) the systematic formulation of the metro cell, 2) the exploration of procedures to do the actual gridding of metros to the parish and protoparish level, 3) and finally, the training and catalyzing of key metro leadership.

6. The ecumenical parish document synopsis suggests that more work be done in the areas of revised parish tactical systems, parish experiment control centrum and the creation of a training system so that implementation of this area be ready by January 1, 1974

ESTABLISHMENT

7. The next steps for this Priors Council with respect to the cultivation of the establishment are: the development of a comprehensive structural plan, including the use of university 13, the development of an E.I. story and the clarification of the relationship between E.I. and I.C.A. and a statement of the necessary style for the work involved in cultivating the establishment.

LENS  
MARKETING

8. Future work that needs to be done in order for the order to market Lens to the fullest extent are: 1) develop a workshop that can be used in the region to train recruiters in pitch, style, story. 2) develop a workshop that can be used in the areal, regional, metro or parish level to discern key contacts who need to be recruited to LENS because of their key position. and 3) develop a LENS penetration strategy for each region plus implementing means.

9. The Roman Catholic Liason will 1) produce a contextual document showing the necessity for its existence; 2) choose strategic religious orders and timeline them for cultivation; 3) issue guidelines for contacting grads and build profiles on key individuals.

10. In order to break open the movemental dynamic in the church, there must be models built for the year that will enable massive recruitment in both Catholic and Protestant denominations which will require comprehensive establishment cultivation to obtain permission to move, as well as developing careful and powerful follow-up structures that will move clergy toward the local Church Project.

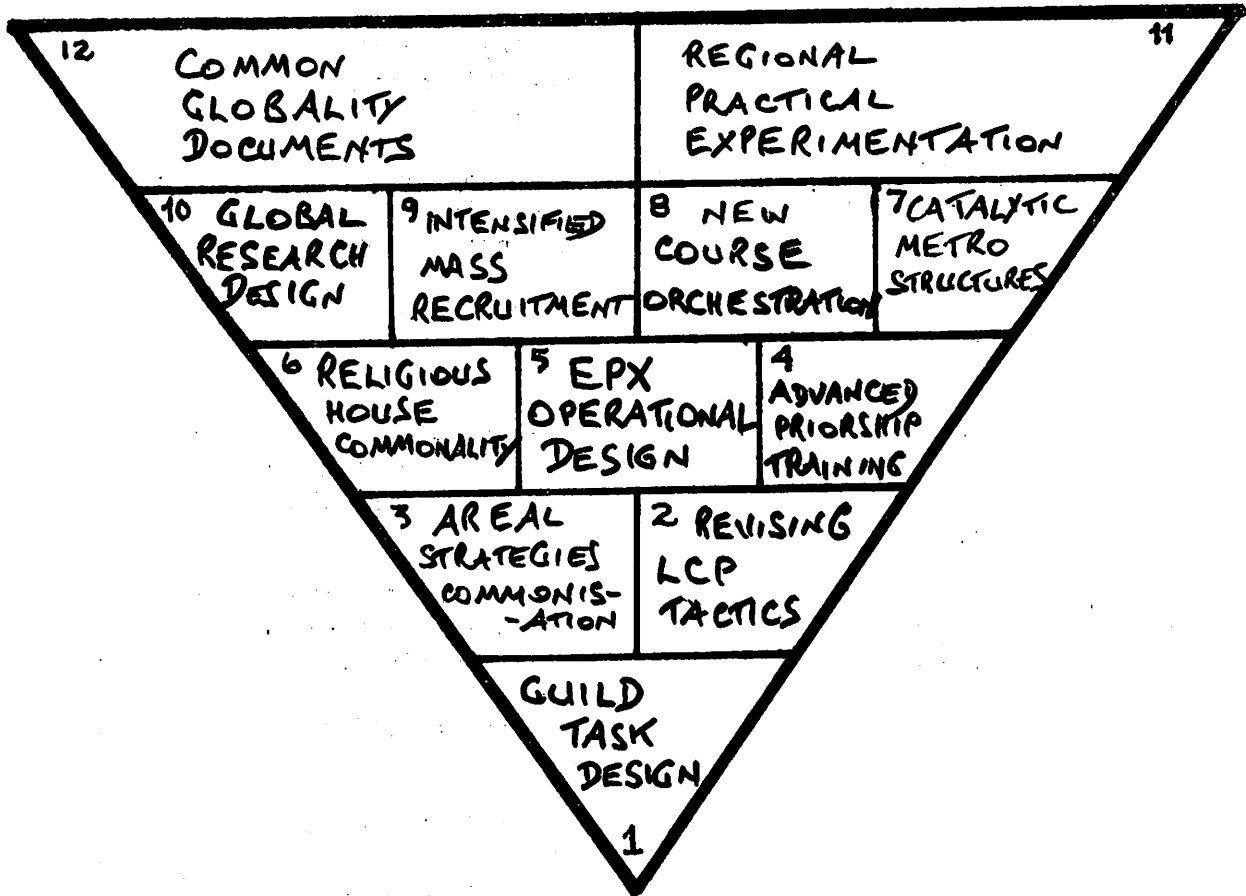

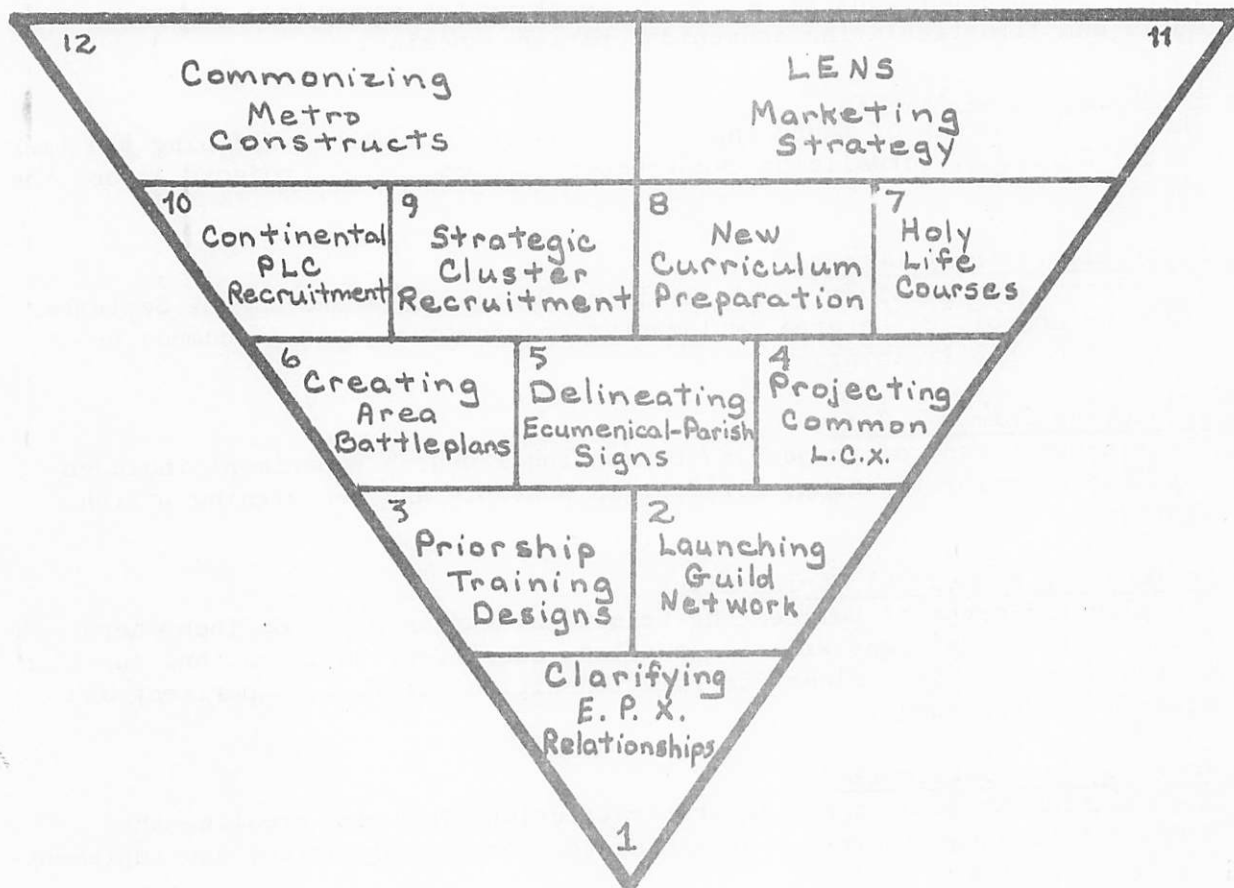

1. GUILD TASK DESIGN. This arena needs to produce working clarity about the practical task of a local guild, including a handbook of methods and a global design of preparation and operation.
2. REVISING LCX TACTICS. This arena involves delineating the practical and imaginal steps necessary for integrating the work done this summer on the Guild, Uptown 5 and the Ecumenical Parish into the tactical plans for the LCX.
3. AREAL STRATEGIES COMMONIZATION. This is a planning arena which concerns itself with establishment cultivation, comprehensive scheduling of courses and teaching assignments, and the delineation of experimentation projections.
4. ADVANCED PRIORSHIP TRAINING. This involves the immediate issue of the design of the August training, how the work of the summer is pulled together and what practical wisdom is crucial priorship equipment.
5. EPX OPERATIONAL DESIGN Practical Planning must be done in the arena of EPX OPERATIONAL DESIGN in order to decide the kinds of practical manuals needed on the guild, the end-run strategy, and the preparation and phasing of the experiment
6. RELIGIOUS HOUSE COMMONALITY. The practical planning for the commonality of the Religious Houses needs to include the new style of the Houses in the external mission, the internal structures, and revising the R.H. S'73 document.
7. CATALYTIC METRO STRUCTURES This arena includes effective mass awakenment tactics, local church recruitment, and grad formation.
8. NEW COURSE ORCHESTRATION This Order Council needs to consense on how we will design, polish and experiment with the teaching of the new courses which are bursting forth in secular and religious areas, such as Holy Life Studies I, NSV courses or convocations, and possibly an experimental course using the I John commentary.
9. INTENSIFIED MASS RECRUITMENT. In the arena of broadening and intensifying recruitment: how do we broaden care for clergy; where and what models for cluster courses do we experiment with, and what do we do with PLC in light of insights from LCX?
10. GLOBAL RESEARCH DESIGN. The Summer has revealed a plethora of research continuation needs beyond what we can deal with this month, and simultaneously demonstrated that the movement-as-a-whole has decided to be the research force; this requires that we design a system by which such questions as the Preaching Mission and University 13 will be researched.
11. REGIONAL PRACTICAL EXPERIMENTATION. This arena includes deciding where cluster recruitment, odysseys, and preaching missions will occur, and the form in which the data will be reported.
12. COMMON GLOBALITY DOCUMENTS. Documents authored by the total order have been found helpful in providing the base of the spirit life, but too many documents are confusing, whereas key documents elucidate the crucial issues around which the creative spin can take place; also in this arena a well contexted song-book is essential.

# 12 PRIORITIES OF PRACTICAL PLANNING



11. LENS Marketing Strategy

The planning arena of LENS Marketing Strategy includes regional marketing of fall courses, long-range strategy for international business community, and cultivation of LENS grads.

12. Commonizing Metro Constructs

The planning arena of Commonizing Metro Constructs includes the role of the metro cell, the metro components and their interrelationship, and the metro as the key geo-social unit of global reformulation.

1. Clarifying Ecumenical Parish Experiment Relationships  
The research arena of Clarifying E.P.X. Relationships includes 1. relating local church experiment to Guild; 2. relating the ecumenical parish to the Guild and 3. articulating ecumenical parish dynamics.
2. Launching Guild Network  
The research arena of Launching Guild Network includes 1. defining the task of the Guild; 2. actualizing constructs; 3. commonizing projects across the globe.
3. Priorship Training Designs  
The planning arena of Priorship Training Designs includes 1. the September training school, 2. an area implementation construct, and 3; common on-going priorship training.
4. Projecting Common L.C.X.  
The planning arena of projecting common local church experiment includes replication prior training, replication schedule and redesigning parish tactics.
5. Delineating Ecumenical Parish Signs  
The planning arena of Delineating Ecumenical Parish Signs defines where Ecumenical Parish signs will be launched, clarifies the intent and function of the sign and makes clear its relationship to the L. C. Experiment and movemental structures.
6. Creating Area Battleplans  
The planning arena of creating area battleplans includes creating the North American battleplan, diagramming the movement dynamics, and implementing the timeline.
7. Holy Life Courses  
The planning arena of Holy Life Courses includes the Sanctification course, the Religious Orders course, and the implementation design.
8. New Curriculum Preparation  
The planning arena of New Curriculum Preparation includes the research, refinement, and implementation planning for the study of 1st. John, the five-day NSV course, and the One-Day Convocation.
9. Strategic Cluster Recruitment  
The planning arena of strategic cluster recruitment includes the collection of past wisdom, the construction of innovative tactics, and the implementation of careful follow-up.
10. Continental PLC Recruitment  
The planning arena of Continental PLC Recruitment includes the image of course participation, the construct of the course and the network of clergy recruiters.
