In the arena of Industrial Park, the following conditions exist: high price of land, lack of available land, and lack of interest to support a bond issue. This indicates that the underlying challenge is providing an industrial park.

In the arena of Supporting Services, the following conditions exist: need for child care, need for more housing, and need for resreation. This indicates that the underlying contradiction is providing services that working people need.

In the arena of Energy, the underlying challenge is using wood as an alternate source for heat, and getting people to turn down heat at night.

#### THE PROPOSALS

1. Check with M,P & L about their energy survey and get information from the Dept. of Energy and distribute.
2. Start a Day Care Center.
3. Create a Tennis Court.
4. In order to inform people of what and industrial park is, and find out if there is support in town for one, we propose to do a survey for support of an industrial park through having a phone survey, have an explanation of what an industrial park is, get information on acreage, price and tax impact, state the Board, Chamber, etc. position on the issue, go through churches, lodges, civic organizations, and factories.
