

TITLE: Coahoma

Coahoma, founded by Indians, was given the name Coahoma after Mr. Cambiell Coahoma. It is probably one of the smallest, uniincorporated struggling towns ever to exist. We have come from shurch school to a water system. The water system is needed so that we wen't have to go far to get it, mainly because it is a small town. Because we are a samll town, we don't have a fire department and cannot prevent fires. Water had to be transported from stores and to the school, Huil, which got it's name from a plantatio n owner named Mr. Hull. The school has always been an important factor in our town. Because everything that takes place revolves around the school. We, the people of Coahoma, dependon the school for political rallies, meetings, entertainment and everything else that concens the town. The school is also important because we are not importanted. Incorporation of the thun would mean electing a mayor as well as a city council. These people would, in termsaact as a common bond between Coahoma, the state and natical government. Incorporation would mean INNEXITE industries and Cactories which would prowide jobs, smar sewage systems and all other things that Coahoma is lacking and needs desparately.

ECONOMIC CHALLENGES

Housing, Sewage & Jobs

In the arena of community development, the fact that there are no jobs, no industry and we have an agricultural background, indicates that the underlying contradiction is that there is no committee established for the research of community needs. This contradiction is illustrated by the fact that there is no program to update homes, no job possibilities in Coahoma, and no housing or sewage projects

Community Funds

In the arena of community services, the fact that there are no ectivities for recreation, no facilities and no organizations in town, indicates that the underlying contradiction is that there are no funds available for unincorporated towns. This contradiction is illustrated by lack of activities for youth & senior citizens, no recreation organization and a possible loss of an assembly location. (school)

POLITICAL CHALLENGES

Organization of Groups

In the arena of executive authority, the fact that there has been a cultural heritage of listening to others tell us what to do, that people cannot read well enough to vote, indicates that the underlying contradiction is that Coahnon people arenet organized. This contradiction is best illustrated by the fact that the town is not incorporated, there are no Blacks on the county school board or board of supervisors from their beat, there is no law enforcement authority, and the Hull Elementary School is closing.

Town Incorporation

In the arena of city government, the fact that we are de endant on the county for services indicates that the underlying contradiction is that we are not incorporated. This contradiction is illustrated by the fact that there is no fire department here, and that people have to travel far for health care.

CULTURAL CHAILINGES Building Leadership

In the arena of community relations, the fact that there is a lack of interest in working together, we have not realized the benefits of working together, there are no ongoing organized clean-up days, indicates that the underlying contradiction is emerging leadership has not been established and built. This contradiction is best, illustrated by no ongoing meetings to plan for community events, no clean-up, fix-up days, no organized clubs.
