INTRODUCTION

SAN VICENTE BARANGAY

The San Vicente Human Development Consultation is the initiating step in a demonstration of comprehensive barangay development. The Consult represents the intention of the residents of San Vicente to work in the spirit of balikatan in improving the quality of life of their community. This resolve compliments on of our national priorities of strengthening the barangays, the smallest political unit, and of training effective local leadership. The focus on total development was reinforced with Presidential Decree No. 1396 affirming the government's policy to "foster the growth and renewal of our communities, both rural and urban, in an integrated manner that promotes optimum land-use, adequate shelter, rational inter-dependence amongst self-reliant communities, all towards the fullest development of man as a civic person and as a human being, involving in this process the coordination of the public and private sectors." It has become clear that the events of history are calling for methods to assume the task of renewing the local community. For this reason, the San Vicente Human Development Project promises to be of critical importance, not only to its 89 households, but also to the other barangays in the Municipality of Mahayag, Zamboanga Del Sur, as well as the communities throughout the Philippines.

THE PARTICIPANTS

The Consult took place in San Vicente February 28 to March 5, 1983. In a village meeting prior to the Consult, it was decided that one representative from each of the 89 households would be present at all times. There were 35 outside consultants. Expertise represented by these people covered a broad spectrum of skills and expertise including agriculture, livestock, law, accounting, finance, day-care, rural health, midwifery, business management, education and community development.

CONSULT DESIGN

During the Consult this diversified group used the following method for comprehensive community reformulation. First, the consult charted the Operating Vision of the people of San Vicente. Second, they discerned the Underlying Contradictions which were blocking the realization of the Vision. Third, they built a set of overall Practical Proposals for dealing effectively with the contradictions. Fourth, they created a set of Tactical Systems by which the proposals could be realized. The time of the Consultants was divided between work in teams, workshop sessions and plenary gatherings in which team reports were formed into the corporate product of the Consult.

The aim of the Consult was to assist the residents of San Vicente in accelerating the expansion of the project and empowering its impact upon the village.

CONSULT DOCUMENT

This Consult Document is the tangible product of the Consult. It is intended to be a highly practical tool. It summarizes the results of research which involved representatives of each household of the community. As such, this document symbolizes the residents decision to participate in practical decision-making about the future of their community and thereby serves to call forth incentive needed for project actuation. The document will also function as an educational tool for rapidly training local leaders in the principles and methods of comprehensive community reformulation.

ICA

The Institute of Cultural Affairs is an intra-global research, training and demonstration group concerned with the human factor in world development and has offices in 30 nations. The ICA is convinced that effective human development must be initiated at the local level and is, therefore engaged in planning and implementing community development projects. ICA's aim is to develop methods through which a local community can become economically self-sufficient, socially self-sustaining and spiritually self-motivating. The Institute's programmes around the world are supported by grants, gifts and contributions from government departments and agencies at the national, regional and local levels and from private foundations, corporations trusts and concerned individuals.

PROJECT ORIGIN

The Institute of Cultural Affairs: Manila, Inc., is incorporated in the Republic of the Philippines as a not-for-profit corporation. In 1976, a Human Development Project was launched in Sudtonggan, Lapu Lapu City, Mactan Island, Cebu at the invitation of the residents of the community, the mayor and concerned citizens of the municipality. The success of this pilot demonstration prompted ICA to expand the Sudtonggan experiment to 23 more communities on Mactan Island and to five remote rural communities in the Tolomo District, Davao City. The ICA has a coordinating office in Manila, a Training Centre in Sudtonggan and project residences in Davao City and Albay Province.

Kon bulanon ang kagabhiom madungog ang tingog sa binaw nga alang-alang tingog sa baboy ug alang-alang tingog sa iro.



Ginganlan kini kaniadto ug Panagaan C tungod kay ang Panagaan dako nga lugar ug gihimong tulo ka balangay. Ang Panagaan A mao ang compound, ang Panagaan B mao ang balangay sa Panagaan karon. Ang nangulo sa balangay niining panahona mao sila si Tenyente del Baryo Pastor Ocania ug mga konsehales Segundo Peregrino, Claudio Gella, Alfonso Cartalla, Faustino Mavida, Germogenes Sarsaba ug si Jose Motuerto. Niini usab nga panahona wala pay balay tulunghaan. Adunay usa ka magtutudlo sa mga kabataan nga giabaga sa mga ginikanan ang suhol ug diha gipahiluna ang pagtudlo sa kapilya.

Gikan sa unang nangulo ug hangtod nga nagkapulipuli ang pagpangulo daghan ang kausaban nga nahimo. Nabuhat ang balay tulunghaan, nahimo ang barangay hall ug aduna nay puso nga sarang kakuhaan ug tubig. Ang panginabuhi sa mga katawhan sa wala pa ang produkto sa lubi mao ang pagpanguma apan sa dihang dili na maayo ang pagpanguma ang kalubihan mao na usab ang gisaligan. Ang uban usab ngā mga katawhan nanagtrabaho sa plantasyon sa guma.

Karon bag-o na usab ang namunoan dinihi sa balangay sa San Vicente. Sila mao si Kapitan sa balangay Claudio Gella Sr. Ug uban sa iyang mga konsehales. Sila uban sa ilang mga katagibalangay nangandoy sa mga butang alang sa kaayohan sa ilang balangay sama pananglit sa balay tigumanan sa konseho sa balangay, butanganan sa mga galamiton sa balangay, basketball court nga sementado, karsada nga modugtong ngadto sa kasilinganan nga mga balangay ug uban pang mga butang nga makahatag ug maayong abot sa balangay.
