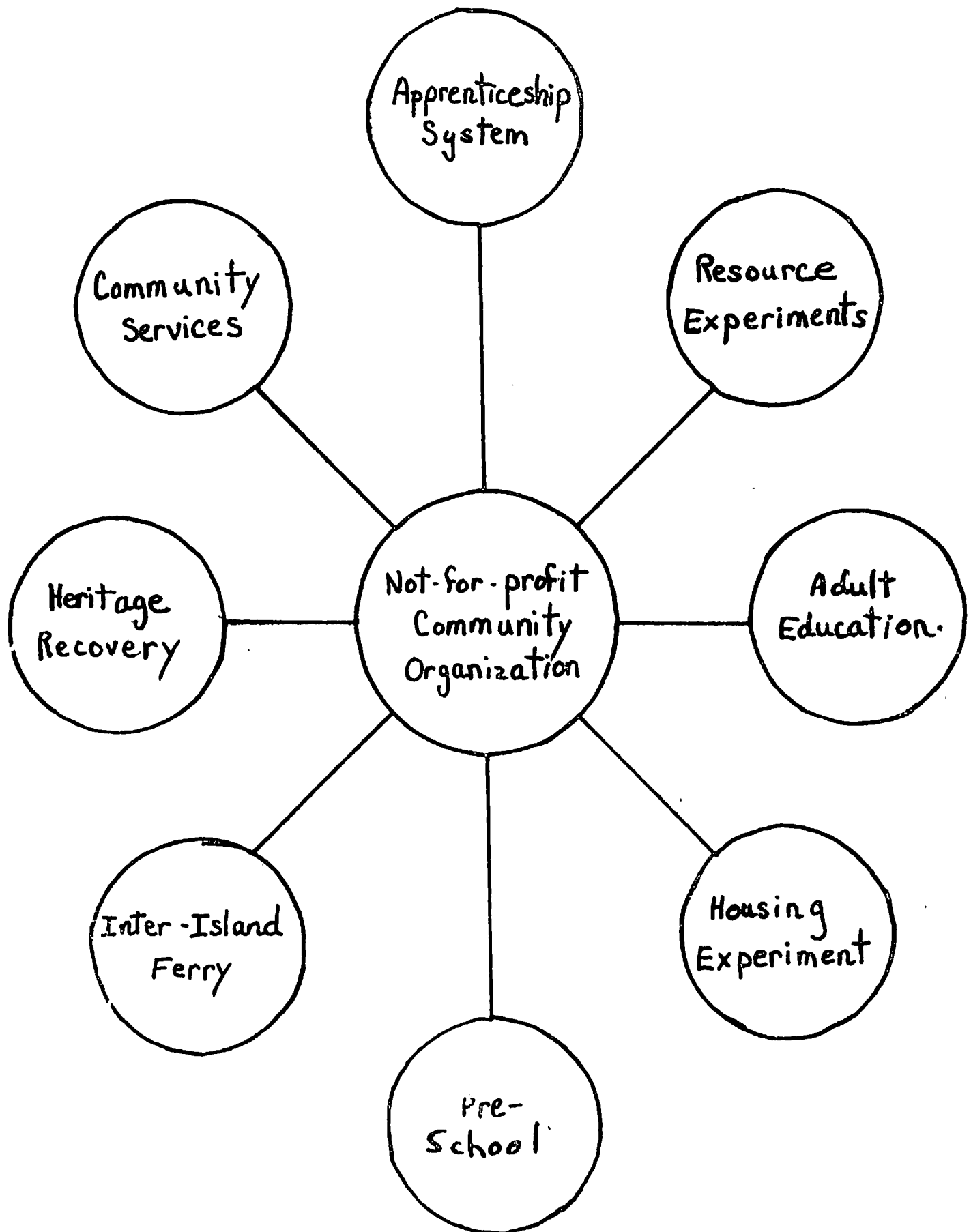

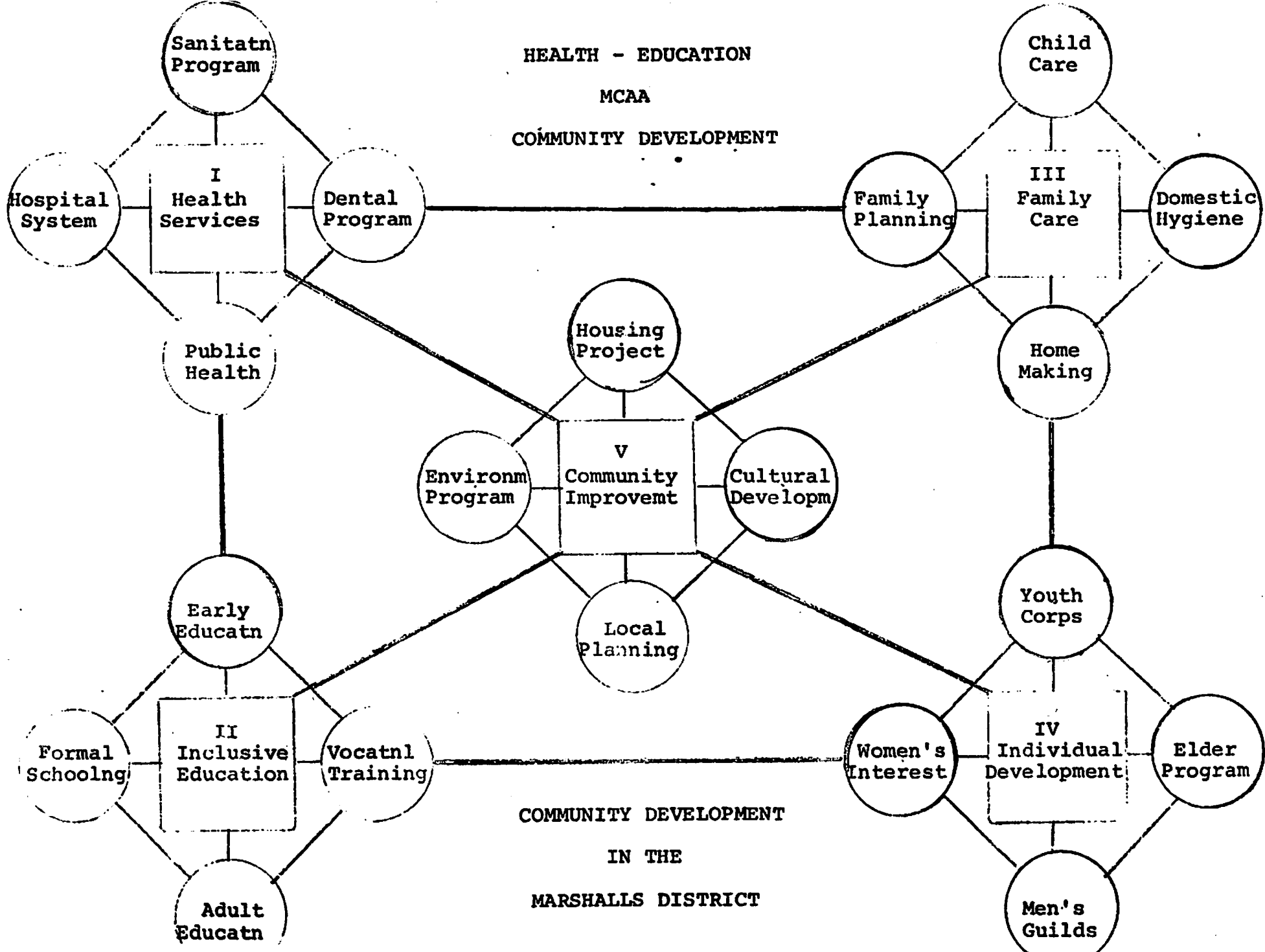

THE INTER-ISLAND FERRY SYSTEM Enabling frequent regular movement of people through all the islands which is foundational to all other programs. COST \$50,000 plus army "T" boats	I. THE SMALL INDUSTRY PROGRAM A program to develop a variety of small businesses and industries to enlarge the economic base of the Marshalls. COST \$65,000 covering research and promotion		
	II. THE MARSHALL TRAINING CORPS Training youths aboard an LST in practical skills including copra harvesting which also will increase production. COST \$300,000 above what is earned	II. THE COPRA-LAGOON SYSTEM Tripling copra production by a program to increase shipping, upgrade methods and develop outer island warehouses. COST \$50,000 plus construction and ships		
	III. THE ALL ISLAND PRE-SCHOOL A program to provide early learning for three, four, and five year old children on all of the atolls and islands. COST \$39,400 plus educational equipment	III. THE MULTI-PURPOSE REPAIR CENTER A community repair center for gas, diesel, and electronic equipment, on land and sea, which is an essential program. COST \$36,000 plus heavy machine tools		
	IV. THE HERITAGE-TOURISM PROJECT An Elders care and engagement program joined with Marshallese heritage recovery and locally promoted tourism. COST \$143,200 plus local materials	IV. THE MAJURO BUSINESS CENTER A management consultant program coupled with a Business Training School providing the community with business skills. COST \$32,000 plus office equipment

Bringing a far world near.

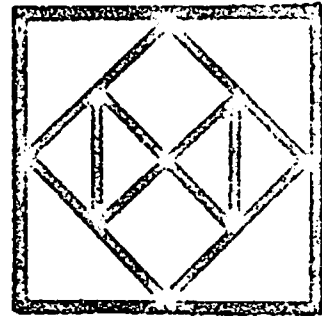
Missions were built upon the coral;
