

## FIFTH CITY REPORT



## FHDP AUXILIARY

The Fifth City Human Development Project Auxiliary meets the first Sunday night of each month at 7:30 pm at the Project House, 410 S. Trumbull Street, in the FHDP Guilds and Stakes Room. Reports are made from each 5th City group giving a comprehensive picture of the state of the Project as well as making major decisions representing the consensus of 5th City. 25 and 30 have attended the January and February Auxiliary Meetings and are sensing the importance of this monthly event.

Great things have happened since the first of the year, the beginning of Quarter III.

These can be outlined according to the XIV Programs from the April Consult Document:

I. Light Industries—the Industrial Development Building is fast preparing for two new industries to begin this Spring.

II. <u>Automotive Service Center</u>—the 5th City Auto Service Center looks forward to ground breaking in March.

III. Commercial Development Complex--the Iron Man Plaza will begin construction in March and is moving on the expansion of the 5th City Shopping Center.

IV. Finance Services Center -- the Auxiliary consensed to pursue a branch Savings and Loan Company to come into 5th City at the February meeting.

V. Business Management Association -- the 5th City Commercial School began early January with full paid enrollment and is mostly enrolled for Quarter IV.

VI. Neighborhood Environment Corps—the Forty Blocks Campaign is underway with the promise of three large roto-tillers and the use of a 4-wheel jeep.

VII. Community Housing Enterprises—all 12 of the 5th City housing buildings are fully occupied with some 600 persons with 300 on waiting lists, and new house prospects are signing up to build.

vill. Neighborhood Safety Network--the 5th City Safety Patrol continues its dedicated nightly service to the community and is launching a local fund raising drive.

IX. Child Development System—the Infant Care Center proposals are in and the Kinder School drawings are finished; by July some 224 children will be the expanded capacity for all 4 schools.

X. <u>City Life Institute</u>—the Elders' Action Center space is nearing completion and the Graphic Arts Center is begun at the Project House.

XI. <u>Urban Student Program</u>—the 5th City Recreation Center officially opened February

12 with all age elementary and high school age youth participating
in its creation and program.

XII. Social Activities Project—the 5th City Congress is scheduled for March with a magnificent series of events, groundbreaking's, dedications; a very prominent group of visitors will be with us from Chicago.

XIII. <u>Urban Agriculture Project</u>—beautification, renovation and maintenance supplies and materials are on their way through a concentrated blitz of Chicago donations.

XIV. Community Engagement Services--5th City is now divided into 5 Stakes, temporarily, using large painted boards to draw up their practical landuse plans through Stake forums for consensus at the Congress.

The Auxillary members present have been amazed at the work being done on all fronts. Support for our 5th City efforts is breaking loose in new ways from Chicago resources. Participation of 5th Citizens is becoming broad-based as never before. The skeptics are beginning to believe that 5th City is on the move. The Auxiliary knows this movement to be fact. Let us maximize the building momentum. — Wetzel Connie, Sr.
