There were 192 of us around the table, doubling the size of last November's meeting, but even so your presence was indeed missed. My reflections on the weekend have been in the arena of authentic vocation and what the weekend did to expand my thinking on that point. It was a great event in our lives and in the life of the movement.

Among the key happenings were the reports on the global trip with JWM given by Bob Springs, Jon Thorson, Ben Ball and Martin Pesek. Those coupled with Joe's report on our present global expansion made us realize that we are indeed serving the whole globe. The recommendations that came out of Saturday's Think Tanks are a clear indication that the global mission is "ours" and that our wisdom and expertise is greatly needed in every arena of concern.

Dear Guardian:

Enclosed is a study document done by a group at Base Centrum the weekend following the Fourth Guardian Consult.

The data from the Guardians' Final Recommendations was studied and gestalted in several different ways to make it readily accessable for implimentation. In order to follow the methods used, it will be necessary for you to number consecutively the major recommendations on the work handed out at the end of the Consult. There are 129 recommendations by numbering each Roman numeral in the left hand margin.

Shown on pages 3 and 4 are general flow charts of the gestalted data. There were 9 major recommendation arenas as listed on pages 6-15. There were 47 tactical arenas found under the 9 recommendation arenas (pages 5, 41-91). One group in the PSU pulled these 47 into tactical thrusts which each have 5 elements of action suggested (pages 21-36).

Another group in the PSU pulled 5 prime activities out of the 9 recommendation arenas and described them on pages 16-20. And, finally, a list of the meetings, data lists, PSU's, boards and commissions and training programs and courses that the Consult suggested be given consideration are on pages 37-43.

The next steps might be to timeline the 5 elements of action and assign them to specific groups and/or develop ways for the on-going Movement structures to be used whnever possible.

Several arenas are already being actualized, such as, the inkind work on the summer program and Kemper renovation, research on popular preaching, LENS pedagogy and regional development network. We are excited about these activities and look forward to seeing you this summer.

Dear Colleagues,

Everywhere we look now days things are happening that point to the resurgence in our society. Here in Chicago they are having cabarets on LaSalle Street. In Calcutta, the employees of the India Air Corporation began dancing around the office after "just another dull day at the office" was turned into a happening. They succeeded in ordering the chaos when given the challenge by the Global Odyssey of arranging, on short notice, a flight for 50 from Calcutta to Agra. The key ingredient was the vision of possibility that one of the Guardians kept painting for them as they surmounted one obstacle after another. Even the billboards in Uptown have a new look, as you can see from the enclosed photo.

John Gardner, the founder of Common Cause, stated recently that the breakloose in human creativity that will carry us to a new level of development as a society will come only through a release of energy in people. I am convinced that he is right about what will release that energy, and that is what he calls "perceived challenge". We are beyond the point of being challenged by hacking out a new frontier in the woods. Our challenge is to enable individuals to regain a sense of their own role in tackling the pressing social concerns of our day, and provide them with the tools to engage their energies in building the society of which they dream.

Enclosed you will find a copy of our new LENS brochure that just came off the press last week. As you can see, LENS is aimed directly at the world-wide business community. You and I as a part of that community carry the responsibility of ensuring that LENS and the broader strategies of which it is a part are actualized across the globe. The work of this past month at the Research Assembly on the parish guild has brought new focus to our practical task and has given us a sound platform for our Guardians' meeting in October.


Many exciting things have gone on since the 4th Guardian meeting was held in April in Chicago, the Summer Research Assembly being one of the highlights. Guardians have participated in the Global Odyssey, assisted in the incorporation of the Institute of Cultural Affairs, enabled numerous in-kind gifts, including reduced-cost steel walls for the renovation of the Kemper building, staffed LENS courses on four continents, held an ITI funding banquet, advised the Order on its' investments, acted as Regional Development Coordinators, participated in proceedings leading to the transfer of the assets of a foundation to the Institute, assisted in acquisition of several properties for Religious Houses, and in one case, a Guardian family began experimenting with living on 50% of its' income as a symbolization of decision to be the Movement.

I did not intend for this letter to be so long, when all I really had to say was "See you on October I2 in Chicago for our 5th Guardian meeting". We will start on Friday evening and finish up after lunch on Sunday. We will meet at the Kemper building, 4750 N. Sheridan Rd. I am looking forward to seeing you then for a great weekend of hard work and fellowhood.

Dear (First name),

At the close of the Guardians' Consult this fall, an old man said, "Take care of yourself. This care for the self is like not caring for yourself, in order that you can care for the World." I wonder if you have reflected as I have on how caring for the world produces agony over the price which each deed exacts. We find ourselves limited over and over by our own weakness, and suffer humiliation in the face of the demand for continual risking. And yet in the midst of this, I suspect you and I have experienced a strange gratitude for the opportunity to live as the ones whose risking shapes many destinies.

The last months have been fun and full as we've been preparing for December 15. In conjunction with the dedication of the new shopping center, we've had meetings with Mayor Daley and the Fifth City Community leaders. His Honor has agreed to block off Fifth Avenue to create a community plaza around the shopping center. Three buildings are to be turned over to the community on the 15th for use as a community center, preschool and men's service club. These events are exciting enough, but we're also preparing for the launching of guilds in fifty parishes across the continent. How many of us ten years ago really believed the day would come when we would literally give Fifth City to the world? We're going to have a real happening on the 15th, and it would be great if you could share it with us.

In order to symbolize the end of the experimental phase of Fifth City, it is important to turn over the three buildings debt-free, which will be possible only if an additional one hundred and forty thousand dollars are raised. We know many of you have given this year, yet we need to raise with you the question of considering a special gift at this time. Some of you have already told us that after a preliminary tax review, this is possible not only for yourself, but also for friends whom you have interested in our work.

After the time we shared at the last gathering of the Guardians, Joe thought you would like these tableaux on the Holy Life. They are very special for us; we hope they will be for you. Anyway, we are glad to be able to send them to you during this Christmas season.


