

Two minutes before the hour of six, the liturgist shall start the prayer walk, ringing the bell. Promptly at six, he shall ring the bell once to begin the evening prayers.

with prayers by the first liturgist.

THE L1: The Lord is with you.

BENEDICTION C: And with thy spirit.

L1: Amen.

C. Amen.

Here the bell shall be rung once to conclude the evening prayers.

Wednesday - The 2500 Village Staging

O Lord, creator of all life and foundation of all community, who ever requires more than seems possible or reasonable of those who are awake to the coming of a new day, we pray for the third phase of the Maharashtra experiment, that through careful framing, guardianship and advanced training, the 2500 villages may become a sign of authentic new response to the new gift of humanness on planet earth and may be a sign of hope for all the suffering villages of the world. Thursday - The U.S.A. Mass Impact

O Eternal Light that awakens all people to the reality and the possibility of their lives, we pray that this year the Town Meetings and impact courses may be done in the 15 state campaigns in the United States in such power and depth that the residents will be so enlivened to care for the future of the world and for their own lives that a new Golden Age may come into being for all mankind. Friday - The Kenya Wedge
