THE 20TH CENTURY SCIENTIFIC REVOLUTION: The Museum of Science and Industry	8:30	Travel by teams to the Museum of Science and Industry. As you board the "E1" train ask for a transfer. Take the Congress "A" train east toward Chicago and get off at Jackson. Take the stairs to the State Street "E1" and travel south on the "B" train. Get off at the Garfield (55th St.) station and take the 55th St. bus east to the museum. This bus has "55" on the front and stops right outside the "E1" station. Your transfer lets you ride this bus with no extra charge. The bus takes you right to the door of the museum.
	9:30	1. Visit the Museum. Be sure to visit the Money exhibit and the Food and Nutrition exhibit (both on the entrance floor to the left of the main door). Also visit The Health and Medical exhibit on the Balcony Floor and the Buckminster Fuller Exhibit on the Ground Floor. All these exhibits are circled on your museum map. Then spend some time exploring exhibits that particularly interest you. 2. As you are experiencing the museum reflect on what you are seeing: *What is making a powerful impact on you? *What is deeply exciting you? *What do you wish people in your community could see? Why? *What do you think the response would be? *What have you seen here that could be of service to the needs of your community.

	1:00	Travel back to the Chicago Loop. Take the "55" bus from outside the museum to Garfield "E1" station. Take the "B" train north to Jackson
THE 20TH CENTURY URBAN RE- VOLUTION: The Chicago "Loop"	2:00	1. Visit the Sears Tower. Walk west on Jackson Street until you arrive at the tower (at Jackson and Franklin). It will cost you \$1.25 to go up the tower. Explain that you are with the Human Development Training school and that pre-arrangements were made for this price of admission. 2. As you gaze upon the urban world, ask yourself: *What really grabs my imagination here? *How has this reality effected the life of my own community? *What does this experience do to you / Why is this important?
	3:00	Gather as a group ^{TF} for a cup of coffee/tea and a brief conversation: *What scenes from the day are still spinning in your mind? *When did you want to spend more time? What were you glad to get away from? *What fascinated you? What filled you with dread? *What is the importance/role of a trip like this? *What name would you give the day?
	4:00	Individual discontinuity and time to explore the Loop.
	5:30	Return to the 5th City residential building. Supper will be at 6:30 in the collegium room where we will begin the Town Meeting Lab.
