

ORDERS OF THE DAY
FOR THE LITURGY OF THE
COMPLETED LIFE OF MARGARET ELAINE HOCKLEY

SUNDAY

9:00a.m.

-The four funeral watchers will gather in single file at the prayer room. The coffin will be moved from the prayer room to the great Hall, carried by Harold Williams, accompanied by Pat Scott, Symond Kock, and Martha Talbott.

-The Order will line the route from the Prayer room to the Great hall.

The liturgists: Charles Lingo, Dolly Mannen, Lucille Tessier, George West, Lela Campball, Edward Vegara, Rebecca Yost, and Cathy Bayer will line up at the entry to the Great Hall in the order of Daily Office, with the Cross and Bible.

-When the watchers arrive, the liturgists will in reverse order proceed into the Great Hall, followed by the watchers.

-All the liturgist except the 1st and 2nd will line up as usual in their regular location.

-The first and second liturgist will proceed to the Panchayat table, turn and face the world end. The watchers will also take their place in front of the Panchayat table with Harold Williams standing in front of the watchers.

-After the 1st Liturgist finishes the Assurance: I am the Resurrection..., the 2 liturgist and 4 watchers going 2 by 2 will proceed to the Word Table where Harold Williams will place the coffin on the table.

-The 1st Liturgist will put the pall on the coffin and proceed with the liturgy.

-At the conclusion of this rite, the liturgists will proceed to their places. The Watchers stand and the Liturgist sit.

-The Ushers will begin to escort persons to their seats making sure that all seats are filled in the center and that all reserved seats remain unoccupied.

-The Panchayet will enter as a group at 9:45. Merrell Thorne will enter behind the panchayet with the symbols, pass them and place them on the table, in order.

10:00 a.m.

-Mary Ann Wainwright will seat the family and other special guests assigned to sit with them.

-When the family is seated, Barbara Alerding will begin the song "Amazing Grace", and the "Sign"

-Lingowill stand at the 1st Liturgist place during the singing. The other liturgists and the community will rise at the ringing of the gong 3 times at the conclusion of the singing.

-Holy, Holy, Holy will be sung as usual without a procession.

ACT THREE


Following the prayers, Pierce will stand at the Witness stand and read the Obituary. then returning to his seat.

-The two sons, Mark and Matthew Hockley will proceed to the witness stand together and read the Words of Faith. They will then return to their seats.

-After the Gloria, Sarah Allen, Symond, Matha Talbott, and the four symbol bearers will come to the word table surrounding the coffin.

-Symond will remove the pall, fold and place it on his arm and open the lid of the coffin. He and Martha will step back from the coffin.

-Sarah Allen will come forward facing the East and the coffin and give the . She will step back.

① -Len Hockley will stand before the coffin, read his statement, place the wedding band in the coffin and ~~return~~ step back.

④ -Joseph Hsu will stand before the coffin, read his statement, place the cross in the coffin and step back.

③ -Carrie Neff will stand before the coffin, read her statement, place the blue in the coffin and step back.

② -Shelly Hahn will stand before the coffin, read her statement, place the ring in the coffin and step back.

-Symond will step forward and replace the pall, closing the lid.

-All return to their seats. except Symond and Markha

After the litany and during the singing of the Doxology, Martha will pick up the coffin.

-At the same time the 2nd Liturgist will come forward. The 2nd Liturgist(Dolly) followed by Martha and Symond will proceed to the High Altar.

-The 1st Liturgist will join the 2nd Liturgist going to the High Altar, Lingo Leading.

-Lingo will stand to the right of the coffin, facing the world end. Dolly will stand to the left of the coffin, facing the world end.

-Dolly will go to the high altar and bring the bowl of dirt to the coffin. She will hold it during the rite.

-Harold and Pat will remove and fold the Pall and place it beside the coffin.

-Lingo, on the line Ashes to Ashes takes dirt from the bowl and sprinkles it on the coffin. He finishes the rite.

-At the clacker, the Community rises facing the table. and

-Barb. Alerding begins the song Those who wait on the Lord.

-During the singing of the song, Len, the family come forward, take dirt from the bowl and sprinkle it on the coffin. When the family comes forward, Lyn Mathews, ~~Lela~~ and Barb Hawley follow them. The last person to put on dirt is Lyn Mathews. These people return to their seats.

-Dolly places the bowl on the altar and returns to her place at the world end.

-After the benediction and during the singing of For All The Saints, the ~~xxx~~ procession begins in the following order.

1. The Cross and the Bible liturgist take their place at the Word table.
2. Lingo and Rebecca Yost
3. Pat Scott (carrying the coffin) and Harold Williams
Symond - Martha
4. The Hockley Family (Ushens indicate)
5. Lela and Edward
6. Dolly and Cathy

The procession goes to the prayer room, Pat placing the coffin on the table. All remain singing "Amazing Grace" Lingo makes the sign of the cross with the inscription In the name of.... The Cross leaves the room followed by 1st L. The rest may remain or leave at will.
