

Our Common Future

is the second in a series of biennial conferences sponsored by the Institute of Cultural Affairs. At the first conference in Mexico in November of 1988, over 500 global citizens looked at the issues and opportunities facing the planet as it evolves into a whole system. Four working networks were formed to become channels of activity and interchange across the world.

The Organisational Transformation Network is exploring means and methods to bring about effective work environments with sensitive and responsive organisations, principally in the private sector

The Lifelong Learning Network is exploring the means of effective education and individual learning capacities in both structured and unstructured situations.

The Planetary Ecology Network is working on both physical and cultural ecologies of our world, empowerment of the myth factor and individual consciousness capacities.

The Sustainable Development Network is focusing on the ways of comprehensive local development by people in both rural and urban environments. It is actively training groups of people in methods of development and linking macro-micro change processes.

Our Common Future

is being held in Taipei, Taiwan, geographically the centre of the world's fastest economically growing area. Asia, from India to China, to Australia, to the Pacific Islands encompasses rich divergent cultures, over 3 billion people and a breathtaking "Environment of Change". It will provide a stimulating context for exploring our Common Future for the 90's. It will be a time to expand our planetary perspective and create a local focus. It will be a time to interchange ideas and models, and a time to chart out future directions for those working in and through the global ICA networks.

Both morning and evening presentations will be open to the wider public of Taipei.

Module Two will continue the themes of the first three days through the "windows" of the four networks. The networks will be discovering their catalytic role in planetary transformation.

Module Three will focus on the ICA and its future as a networking organisation. One day in the Third Module will be devoted to Cultural Excursions in Taipei and the surrounding vicinity. Trips can be taken to see art treasures of China, beautiful gardens and temples, folk arts and dance. Asian cuisine is available in Taipei to please every palate.
