THE PANCHAYAT COMMISSIONING

It plays the role of the symbolic in the Order and enacts that role as it stands in the tension between historic wisdom and futuristic necessity, announcing and embodying the consensus of the whole Order.

We commission you to Guard the Comprehensive: rehearsing historic intents and the future task; to Defend the Deeps: protecting and creating morale, and calling forth profound engagement; and to Watch the Election: caring for the individual spirit of those engaged in mission, empowering the vocational decision and demonstrating the wholeness of our common task.

Year of Order Council '84

Dear Colleagues,

The programme year 1983-84 has been event-filled. Most of the activity this year has centered around the International Exposition of Rural Development. In the fall, Canadian and United States Steering Committees selected the delegates, in January held orientation events in Ottawa and Washington D.C., and in February sent the delegates to New Delhi for an experience that has propelled all of us into a new universe.

We find ourselves standing in 31 nations, with a multiplicity of diverse opportunities for service in those and 50 more. To which invitations do we respond? Where is it that history is beckoning us? A rethinking of our operating modes, strategies, financial systems and spirit practices is required.

July 1-August 12 is the time during which major decisions about the next 16 years of the Order will be made. Six hundred and eighty four (684) members of the Symbolic Order are assigned to participate and full participation by representatives of the Extended/Movemental Order is encouraged. At least two weeks participation is required.

The fee for the total six (6) weeks is \$1,000 or \$400 for any two week segment. A \$200 pre-registration fee will be due on June 15th.

As one who has continued to demonstrate practical care through structures of the Order, your input is critical. Your participation in the Global Order Council will help determine the future shape and direction of the Order: Ecumenical.
