

GLOBAL SOCIAL DEMONSTRATION

Recommendations

1. We recommend that Global Social Demonstration Post explore the possibility of a commodities and services corporation in order to enable the social demonstration projects.
2. In order to build on past wisdom as well as make available the insights from all working models and current thinking we recommend the establishment of a resource bank and interchange system in the Global Social Demonstration Post in Chicago.
3. We recommend the articulation and corporate common dissemination of a story delineating the unique sign each social demonstration is for its area and the globe.
4. We recommend that the Global Social Demonstration Post in Chicago work closely with Global Development Centrum to formulate the principles of GSD budgeting and funding and play a watchdog role relative to the longrange solvency of each of the projects.
5. We recommend the implementation of an intensive social demonstration training program providing theoretical and practical models on social methods & vocational skills within a movemental context.
6. We recommend that a comprehensive list of global guardians be compiled including their areas of expertise in order to invite guardian participation in global social demonstration consults; and that a rationale and rhythm for guardian meetings throughout the globe be researched and recommended.
7. We recommend the refinement and distribution of a screen for selecting the future demonstration projects.

PRIMAL COMMUNITY EXPERIMENT RECOMMENDATIONS

1. We recommend that Global Research Centrum creates an introductory document which would clarify the underlying assumptions, forms and structures of the PCE and which could be used as a public statement.
2. We recommend that Global Research Centrum create a common operational manual for the year holding the global forms, the indicative battleplanning method, the phasing design, tactical system and secular forms and this would be supplemented by quarterly additions.
3. We recommend that Global Research Centrum review and revise the present PCE Field Visit manual to be used globally.
4. We recommend that that the Research Centrum take the present consult model and globalize it by indicating the dynamics that need to happen, (e.g., global context, edge workshops, celebration and practical battleplanning) and any consult indicating specific recommendation for local adaptation.
5. We recommend that the Primal Community Training School be made available to the global experiment during this year and that this be done through determining the specific dates, locations and geographic coverage of each by the areas and Research Centrum in consultation.
6. We recommend that there be quarterly accountability reports based on a PCE phase checking form filled out at the consults and pulled together by Research Centrum in chart form (suitable for decor) with the first report distributed by January 1, 1976.
7. We recommend that Global Research Centrum create a new form of weekly data interchange which would include key happening, significant breakthroughs, and one selected miracle story description to be sent in in conjunction with the Global Order Report.
8. We recommend that Global Research Centrum gather, categorize and title a materials bank of Global PCE formats of conversations, studies, workshops and other resources.
9. We recommend that each area create its area replication plan for the PCE by June 30, 1976. In order to implement that, each House needs to complete the four year metro phasing for each of its metros or regions by December 31, 1975. The signal catalytic role of the parish surrounding the Religious House needs to be continued by designating it as one of the power base stations.

2. Issues and Questions:

- I. Area Implementation: The issue is clarifying the plans to be built by local and areal councils and the form of local accountability to the area and the area to the globe.
- II. Multi-lingual Materials: The issue is obtaining and/or translating world and movement literature appropriate to local metro cadre development.
- III. Communications and reporting: The issue is how can operations centrum band care for the MCN campaign through reflection on general progress of the campaign, analyzing and offering catalytic suggestions based on the practical breakthroughs and perplexities encountered. One approach might be to amend the global report format to focus on the 3 campaigns arenas and avoid simply pyramiding reports from religious houses.
- IV. Quarterly Study Materials: In order to provide a comprehensive screen for study, the issue is deciding the basic arenas any group needs to deal with in its study and symbolic life, and then indexing the basic documents and tools effective for those purposes with selections that would be appropriate to various backgrounds and situations.
- V. Common Visual Symbol: The sustenance of metro cadremen as a global service force calls for an emblem to wear or a plaque for the wall.

GLOBAL PROGRAM STRATEGIES RECOMMENDATIONS

August 3, 1975

1. We recommend that areas in councils will create program schedules for their assigned geography.
2. We recommend that a phasing chart of three campaigns and programs, the 20 programs, and other imaginal tools related to the nine continent's global strategies be created by Global Operations Centrum.
3. We recommend that Global Research Centrum explore our service to the established church by considering the possibility of Quarter IV consult(s) to be held with movemental lay and clergy, Protestant and Catholic, who have symbolic roles in the established church.

GLOBAL FINANCE DESIGN RECOMMENDATIONS

1. It is recommended that the Religious House program budget be established at the area councils in consultation with the Centrum nexus, not to exceed last year's budget by more than 10% in 1975-76.
2. It is recommended that each Religious House participate in raising funds equal to their global program budget in conjunction with the Global Development Centrum.
3. It is recommended that the Order: Ecumenical advance up to a maximum of three months global program budget payments to the Ecumenical Institute/ICA, thereby guaranteeing initial regularity of the program budget.
4. It is recommended that the available program funds will be distributed to the houses at the budgeted level. In the event that sufficient funds are not available to the EI/ICA to cover the global program budget, and the maximum loan has been advanced, then the available funds would be distributed to the houses at a reduced level until full payment could be achieved.
5. It is recommended that the EI/ICA repay the Order: Ecumenical within the calendar year.

LEGAL RESPONSIBILITY RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Global Management Centrum will collect copies of all existing legal registration and incorporation documents relating to the Ecumenical Institute, the Institute of Cultural Affairs and the Order: Ecumenical.
2. Global Management Centrum will survey the local jurisdictions in which operations make it necessary to consider legal structures and make recommendations to the Legal Commission

FISCAL YEAR RECOMMENDATIONS

1. It is recommended that the various Order structures be informed on methods and procedures to ensure auditable records at Religious Houses and Centurms around the globe, through drafting audit guidelines which establish the appropriate level of audit, and enable houses to keep journals and back-up records to support Centrum books.
2. It is recommended that to establish commonness in fiscal procedures, provide auditable accounts and create more realistic and sophisticated methods of cost accounting, each religious house and centrum nexus will maintain three separate internal accounting systems for Order: Ecumenical, EI/ICA.
3. The Safeguard Accounting System for all accounts will be used in all locations with Global Management Centrum providing all materials, account codes and procedural manuals by September 1.
4. Each location will make necessary adjustments to meet local banking or governmental restrictions or establish special accounts to minimize currency transaction expenses or honor local funding restrictions; these adjustments will be made only after consultation with the Centrum Nexus.

MEMORIAL: SYMBOLIC LIFE STRUCTURES

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. It is recommended that Research Centrum produce a rationale for the Fast which includes any new Houses, the Fasting context, and suggested ways to symbolize and stand present to each particular House or Nexus on its assigned Fast Day.
2. It is recommended to Global Operations Centrum that simultaneous data access through Global Communications Systems be continued and intensified by a time/cost/rhythm/content analysis of different forms and distributed through the Centurms Band for further clarity of operation.
3. It is recommended to Global Operations Centrum to create guidelines to produce a revitalized comprehensive Global Order Report, inclusive of the three campaigns, and at the same time the Centrum create a format to enable the weekly House Church presentation.
