THE TWENTY FIVE MEMORIALS



In the arena of **COMMON STRUCTURE GROUNDING** it is the intent of the Global Order to continue to demonstrate its intra-globality through the commonness of its time design and symbolic life as summarized in the Order:Ecumenical Customary. These include Daily Office six days a week, weekly House Church celebration on Sunday, weekly Ecclesiola celebrations on Thursday evening, prayers held daily at 6:00 PM, capital verse/news conversations at breakfast Monday through Friday, collegiums held daily at breakfast Monday through Friday and fasting according to the Global Fasting Design.

In the arena of **GLOBAL MISSION REPORTING** it is the intent of the Global Order to intensify its reporting systems through the addition of a Global Social Demonstration newsletter, and the revision of the Global Order Report to provide for this reporting.

In the arena of **GLOBAL POLITY DYNAMICS** it is the intent of the Global Order to continue the experiment in being one disciplined body across the globe, gathering at designated intervals and in various configurations to reforge our consensus and symbolize our common task through the ongoing Global Panchayat dynamic meeting representatively at the Chicago Nexus, the four Global Commissions, the four Global Centrum Bands, a Global Priors' Council annually, a rhythm of quarterly continental/areal/regional gatherings, quarterly movement planning activities around each house, all symbolized by a global annual calendar.

In the arena of **GLOBAL SUSTENANCE SUPPORT** it is the intent of the Global Order to hold the principle of the self-support of every Religious House, in tension with necessary missional assignments, including locally developed House Program Funding by each Religious House. This will be done through the planning of Religious House Support models, the assignment of forces to income support and development, and at the Quarter I Area Council, the careful examination of House budgets and the creation of Area budgets. Each Religious House will be reviewed monthly by the Area Troika.

In the arena of **GLOBAL GUARDIAN ENGAGEMENT** it is the intent of the Global Order to engage a global network of 1000 Guardians through involving Guardians and their acquaintances in GCF implementation, participating in short and long term assignments to GSD consults and projects, teaching on LENS treks, and attending semi-annual meetings on each continent where the movement is presently established.

In the arena of **GLOBAL COMMUNITY FORUM PHASING PLAN** it is the intent of the Global Order to accelerate GCF in North America and to initiate the campaign strategically across the globe in the coming year, through deployment of circuit teams according to each area's battleplan, catalyzation of networks, expansion of funding, acceleration of training new Community Forum leadership, and coordination by Global Operation Centrum, all are to be implemented through Area Councils and Global Operations interchange.

In the arena of the **PRIMAL COMMUNITY EXPERIMENT** it is the intent of the Global Order to maintain the Primal Community Experiment around each Religious House at its present momentum, and to evaluate its current trends in light of the effect Global Community Forum and Global Social Demonstration may be having on the given community. This will be done through the PCE Post evaluating the current state of the Experiment, appropriating this wisdom and disseminating it through a Primal Community Consult with each House in Quarter II, 1976-77.

In the arena of **TRAINING RESEARCH PRIORITIES** it is the intent of the Global Order to intensify experimentation in accelerated Movement training through the Replicating School annual assignment, special assignments to training and research events such as the Global Research Assemblies and International Training Programs, and the selected use of LENS, Core Curriculum, etc. determined in consultation with Area priors and Area Council battleplanning Quarter I.

In the arena of **GLOBAL SOCIAL DEMONSTRATION BAND EXPANSION** it is the intent of the Global Order to accelerate and intensify the Global Social Demonstration campaign by launching twelve new Human Development Projects in 1976-77 and by initiating the replication experiment in the state of Maharashtra, India, through holding consults in selected sites and assigning project auxiliary staff to catalyze the implementation of all programs. The replication school will be conducted in Maharashtra beginning Quarter II, 1976, in order to equip local leadership for the replication task.

In the arena of **GLOBAL FISCAL ACCOUNTING** it is the intent of the Global Order to maintain common global recordkeeping, accounting and reporting systems for all Order:Ecumenical, Ecumenical Institute, Institute of Cultural Affairs and Human Development Project funds and for other assets such as inkind contributions, through the creation of a finance manual by a Management Centrum Band Task Force, the establishing of Human Development Project accounting systems and by securing professional accounting advice in order to be knowledgeable of accounting and legal requirements.

In the arena of **GLOBAL CONTINENTAL PLANS** it is the intent of the Global Order to intensify the degree to which movement forces operate out of the continental and program priorities and the continental strategies devised in GRA: Chicago and the Global Priors Council. Through common Continental and Area battleplanning, Operation Centrum task forces will gather and distribute models and plans, and annual and semi-annual reporting and accounting.

In the arena of **GLOBAL PROGRAM BUDGETING** it is the intent of the Global Order to create a global budget design through considering the costs for area programs, global campaigns and nexus operations, a transrational formula from which each house, area and nexus can calculate its budget, areal deliberation and consensus, and a global development budget which is apportioned by areas.

MEMORIAL #1

GCF PHASING PLAN

In the arena of Global Community Forum Phasing Plan it is the intent of the Global Order to accelerate GCF in North America and to initiate the campaign strategically across the globe in the coming year, through deployment of circuit teams according to each area's battleplan, catalyzation of networks, expansion of funding, acceleration of training new Community Forum leadership, and coordination by Global Operations Centrum; all are to be implemented through Area Councils and Global Operations interchange.

OPERATING PRINCIPLES

1. We operate out of a global strategy.
2. We maintain geographical comprehensiveness.
3. The campaign is operated areally.
4. Troops are deployed areally where needed to accomplish metro circuit strategies.
5. GCF funds are developed concurrently with set-up.
6. In North America, the one per polis image for the 1,000 and the one per micro for the 5,000 Town Meetings.
7. GCF is relevant to the current moment in history.
8. We move immediately--time is of the essence.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Global Operations Centrum would publish periodic reports reflecting the global acceleration of the GCF campaign.
2. Guidelines could be created in all Area Councils for discerning where and how signal explosions of GCF's will occur.
3. Each Area in North America would implement the five strategies developed during the Continental Rally, July, 1976.
4. Area Chicago would do 400 Town Meetings and Areas Houston, San Francisco, and New York would do 200 each for the 1,000 in the 1,500 model.
5. Area Montreal and Edmonton will accelerate Community Forum Canada by holding 132 Forums during 1976-77.

MEMORIAL #2GCF TRAINING AND MATERIALS

In the arena of GCF Leadership Training and Materials it is the intent of the Global Order to assure common quality of the Town Meeting across the globe by providing training in Town Meeting set-up procedures and workshop methods, maintaining excellence in the consultant and orchestrator roles, contexting the entire Movement on the profundity of the Town Meeting, and maintaining commonality in the Town Meeting materials, while allowing for local relevance for use in the different nations. This will be done through area, regional and local training and assignment structures, Religious House and Nexus collegium and study life designs, and the Global Operations Centrum taskforces.

#2

OPERATING PRINCIPLES

1. Town Meeting is a global campaign and is to be implemented through the Movement.
2. The cruciality and effectivity of our campaigns demand quality in all dimensions.
3. The Movement programs are global and common, and are to be guarded as such, while making necessary continental and national adaptations.
4. Role clarity, excellence in skills and appropriate style empower the GCF event.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Religious Houses need to take responsibility for creating training days, weekends, collegiums, reporting sessions, reflections and other such means so as to context, train and build finesse in the bringing off of Town Meeting.
2. All GRA manuals and materials relevant to quality training of Town Meeting consultants, orchestrators and workshop leaders need to be distributed to the entire Movement as quickly as possible, along with previous materials still being in effect. In particular, the following items:
 - A. The 14 strategies and 5 contradictions packet be included in the Priors Box.
 - B. The 4 GRA talks by Scott, Booher, Bailey and Vance be included in Priors Box.
 - C. The Consultant Training Format be mailed to Religious House for use in North America in August or September.
 - D. Mail the Orchestrator Inclusive Role Chart (page 5 of new Orchestrator's Guide) in the Week 6 Prior's packet.
3. New materials being created by various nations and continents should be examined by the Centrum Bands and appropriate priorship (i.e., area, nation, continent) before massive printing is done and distribution made.

MEMORIAL #3

GLOBAL SOCIAL DEMONSTRATION BAND EXPANSION

In the arena of Global Social Demonstration Band Expansion it is the intent of the Global Order to accelerate and intensify the Global Social Demonstration campaign by launching twelve new Human Development Projects in 1976-77 and by initiating the replication experiment in the state of Maharashtra, India, through holding consults in selected sites and assigning project auxiliary staff to catalyze the implementation of all programs. The replication school will be conducted in Maharashtra beginning Quarter 11, 1976, in order to equip local leadership for the replication task.

#3

OPERATING PRINCIPLES

1. GSD operates on a rational and global program scheme.
2. GSD is based on a world-wide expansion plan.
3. Final selection of GSD sites is made by the selection team.
4. GSD riders are national.
5. A replication scheme requires an adequate back-up system.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Initiate at least 12 GSDs in the year 1976-77.
2. Develop an adequate support system for Maharashtra replication.
3. Hold a replication school in Quarter 11 in Maharashtra.

MEMORIAL #4

GLOBAL SOCIAL DEMONSTRATION ECONOMIC SIGN

In the arena of Global Social Demonstration Economic Sign it is the intent of the Global Order to bring about an economic leap forward in all eight of the existing Human Development Projects of a magnitude comparable to tripling the income of Maliwada through the accelerated and intensified increase of local industries and the development of a full-fledged back-up system with special emphasis on the repository of goods, technology, information, forces and funds.

#4

OPERATING PRINCIPLES

1. Don't confuse sign with goal--impact the community and economic establishment.
2. Credibility of local man to solve the national economic contradiction.
3. Use the five economic presuppositions, especially local economic autonomy.
4. A gun without a trigger industry is as useless as a pilot without a plane.
5. Stand present to every occasion when you leave the project site to engage in economic activities.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. The criteria for insuring the leap to be worked out by each project auxiliary in consultation with the GSD Post.
2. Each project start five "trigger" industries immediately.

MEMORIAL #5GLOBAL SOCIAL DEMONSTRATION RESEARCH EDGE

In the arena of Global Social Demonstration Research Edge, it is the intent of the Global Order to insure the completion of the two year Acceleration Phase of the Global Social Demonstration and establish the social and economic conditions whereby the local auxiliary dynamic can be assumed by the community leadership itself. This will be done through identifying the common marks of the completion of the Acceleration Phase of any HDP, plotting the journey of the currently activated projects by the GSD Post interchanging of each local project's practical models and evaluation reports.

#5

OPERATING PRINCIPLES

1. The four phases of the HDP are Initiation, Acceleration, Stabilization, and Maturation.
2. Although the completion of the Acceleration Phase needs to occur within a period of 2 years, it shall be considered complete when the common marks are in place for each project.
3. In the completion of the Acceleration Phase, community leadership are equipped for Project Management as well as responsibility.
4. In the completion of the Acceleration Phase, structures are in place which anticipate the future.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. The Implementing Handbook be distributed to the Global Priors for study during the coming year.
2. An Acceleration Manual be written during the GRA: Chicago, 1977.

MEMORIAL #6

GLOBAL DEPLOYMENT ASSIGNMENTS

In the arena of Global Deployment Assignments it is the intent of the Global Order to increase the effectiveness of troops in the global campaigns by placing people with particular skills in the locations where those skills are needed, through creating systems of skills inventory, maximizing the use of additional short term troops, and using a configuration of troops selected from the Houses, Nexus and Human Development Project's.

#6

OPERATING PRINCIPLES

1. The relocations of present Religious Houses is always considered in the tension between
 - a) the long established symbolic value of staying where established, and
 - b) the effective accomplishment of the long-term global campaign.
2. The combining of personnel within the area intensifies the missional effectiveness of all three campaigns.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. For most effective coverage of geography it is recommended that a contingent of 4-8 persons from the Houses and the colleagues of an Area be made available by Areal decision to move to any contradictory location for a designated period of time.
2. Area Priors do circuits with each House in their Area twice during the year.
3. It is further recommended that in strategic locations the dynamic of House and Nexus or Social Demonstration be performed by the same body of people.
4. The Assignment Procedures in the backup documents of this Priors Council be used in July 1977 and evaluated.
5. All Houses be contexted annually relative to global assignments under the principle that each year is a new assignment.
6. That Order members be in their new locations by August 14.

MEMORIAL #7

PROGRAM LEADERSHIP ASSIGNMENTS

In the arena of Program Leadership Assignments it is the intent of the Global Order to maximize program effectivity through holding the following values in making ITI, LENS, GCF orchestration and other course assignments. The primary values to be held are the male and female dynamics, master teachers and journeying teachers, and the Symbolic Order presence and movemental colleague training. Assignments need to be made to include indigenous local leadership and to maintain the Global context with consideration to minimizing travel cost.

#7

OPERATING PRINCIPLES

All assignments are global assignments.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. ITI faculty will consist of nine faculty assigned by Chicago Operations Centrum including three Master teachers, more than one continent, men and women. Other faculty in training will be assigned in consultation with local priorship.
2. LENS faculty assignments will utilize global guardians and continental LENS faculty if available with consideration given to minimizing travel costs.
3. GCF orchestrator assignments will be made by Operations Centrum utilizing one local or regional orchestrator and one orchestrator from outside the region where possible.

MEMORIAL #8

GLOBAL GUARDIAN ENGAGEMENT

In the arena of Global Guardian Engagement it is the intent of the Global Order to engage a global network of 1000 guardians through involving guardians and their acquaintances in GCF implementation, participating in short and long term assignments to GSD consults and projects, teaching on LENS treks, and attending semi-annual meetings on each continent where the Movement is presently established.

#8

OPERATING PRINCIPLES

1. Guardian engagement is catalyzed when the guardian experiences his skills and knowledge as a critical factor in global care in the midst of assuming responsibility for a particular task.
2. A key service of guardians is their influence and skills which unblock quickly major contradiction arenas.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Beginning September 1st, 1976 the repository will mail a monthly global communication including GSD needs and accomplishments.
2. Special GSD evenings at the Institute will be held.

GUARDIAN'S MEETINGS RECOMMENDATIONS:

3. Enlist participation of every guardian in the three campaigns:
 - a) Global Community Forum by means of taskforces in funding, coordinations, circuits and workshop training.
 - b) Global Social Demonstration by means of participation in consults and special task forces.
 - c) Intra-Global Movement by means of LENS treks and non-North American Guardians Meetings.
4. Every participant in the Guardian's Meeting works in one of the 5 GSD guilds, Services, Industry, Resources, Business, and Social, as well as in working committees in the repository, promotion, strategies of special task forces, and corporation development, and in GCF working committees such as TM development, sponsorship, and steering committees.
5. Format will include guardian taskforce reports.
6. Special events may include: a) Fifth City and Kawangware films, b) Guardian's GSD slides, c) Habitat slide show, d) TM commercials, e) International bazaar.

MEMORIAL #9

ORDER YOUTH ENGAGEMENT

In the arena of Order youth engagement it is the intent of the Global Order to continue the student house while at the same time evaluating its present operations and forging recommendations for the assigning of all youth in the Order through the Panchayat and Global Council Regulatory as they prepare for July of 1977.

#9

OPERATING PRINCIPLES

1. Children symbolize the rite of passage to adulthood by their deployment at age 12 or sixth grade.
2. The Student House is no longer an experiment, but a fully operational care structure in North America.
3. The assignment of children to join their parents is the responsibility of the assignment commission in conjunction with the house and area priors and the family concerned.
4. Creative structural care is crucial in raising up Order youth into Those Who Care.
5. Children are assigned with families out of their home country only to situations of economic and political stability.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. It is recommended that the following guidelines be followed in deployment of Phase I members of Order families:
 - That North American youth beyond the 6th grade be deployed to the Student House, which will continue to be located at Chicago Nexus.
 - That for non-North American youth, the House and Area priors decide what educational structure and deployment assignment would best mark this rite of passage in a way similar to the student house.
 - That senior high youth be deployed using the primary value of preparation for full participation as a responsible global citizen, using the values of a) quality of educational experience, b) broad experience in carrying out the mission, and c) the viability of of the whole team at any location.
2. It is recommended that a task force be convened to articulate these guidelines more fully, to evaluate the student house experiment and to report to the Order. This task force will include Student House staff, senior fellows, and youth participants in the Student House.
3. Student representatives participate in all phases of the evaluation.

MEMORIAL #10

GLOBAL PROGRAM BUDGETING

In the arena of Global Program Budgeting it is the intent of the Global Order to create a global budget design through considering the costs for area programs, global campaigns and nexus operations, a transrational formula from which each house, area and nexus can calculate its budget, areal deliberation and consensus, and a global development budget which is apportioned by areas.

#10

OPERATING PRINCIPLES

1. All funds are global funds.
2. Absence of funds do not restrict missional requirements.
3. Budgeting related to actual missional needs releases motivity and planning for development.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Management Centrum creates a transrational plan to be distributed to all Religious Houses by Week 6.
2. Development Centrum projects global budget and area apportionment to be distributed to all Religious Houses by Week 6.
3. Each area consenses on its program budget and its development apportionment at Area Council during Quarter I.
4. The consensed budgets are pulled together into a global budget by Management Centrum by the end of Quarter I and distributed to all locations.

MEMORIAL #11

GLOBAL PROGRAM FUNDING

In the arena of Global Program Funding it is the intent of the Global Order to insure support for all programs, through the global development band; the deployment of special forces to break loose funding from national governments, area constituencies, and local sources; and the development of a computerized data retrieval system.

#11

OPERATING PRINCIPLES

1. Common images of participation in a global corporate force are key to motivation.
2. Our programs require authorization on a global scale.
3. We need to maintain a coordinated thrust on major international funding sources.
4. We operate out of the image that everyman is a developer.
5. Development is part of the missional task of every house.
6. The global development intent of the Global Order is to include every house and metro in the development task in order to expand funding sources.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. The Global Management Centrum Band, during the week following the prior's council, will develop a formula for dispersing program funds and method of covering the first month of operation in North America.
2. A special taskforce will be deployed in order to break loose major funding internationally.
3. An Area Development taskforce will be formed in each North American Area of three development personnel and movement colleagues as may be necessary. (In the other continents this may be implemented by continental taskforces.)
4. Each House form a development task force and require that taskforce to raise the House funding goal each month.
5. An amplified regular input and retrieval data system be devised which includes reports on companies, contacts, categories of contribution of authorization, such as cash gifts, grants, goods, services, referrals, etc. to be readily available to every local development taskforce. This would be implemented by Development Centrum, Chicago Nexus with adequate assignment of troops and investigation of the use of appropriate sophisticated technology.

MEMORIAL #12GLOBAL SUSTENANCE BUDGET

In the arena of Global Sustenance Budget it is the intent of the Global Order to continue its common sustenance budget construct by maintaining its stipends at poverty levels, yet adequately caring for the total Order with stipends and funds. This will be accomplished through a re-evaluation of stipend bases at the Quarter I Area Councils, a phasing model for moving toward a more adequate stipend base and experimenting for one year with a supplemental medical costs.

#12

OPERATING PRINCIPLES

1. Health needs are totally cared for.
2. Comprehensive health care at lowest possible cost.
3. Stipend levels are determined in the tension of the local poverty level in a Area and missional operating costs necessary to relate to the establishment. (i.e. cost of a suit where poverty people do not have a suit)
4. Each Area had the discretion of setting its stipend level, holding budget needs in tension with the ability to remain self-supporting through earned income.
5. Stipend level is linked directly to the Trust/Task funds which affect the well-being of each Order member, and which need to be maintained at a level to ensure adequate accrual.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. During the next year the Order is building a comprehensive health care plan and to protect Order families from excessive uninsured medical cost, we experiment with a plan to reimburse families all uninsured medical costs beyond 20% of the family stipend on a monthly basis.
2. Area priors refer to the stipend base screen created during Order Council S'75 as a guideline for determining this years stipend base.

MEMORIAL #13

GLOBAL SUSTENANCE SUPPORT

In the arena of Global Sustenance Support, it is the intent of the Global Order to hold the principle of the self-support of every Religious House, in tension with necessary missional assignments, including locally developed House Program Funding by each Religious House. This will be done through the planning of Religious House Support models, the assignment of forces to income support and development, and at the Quarter I Area Council, the careful examination of House budgets and the creation of Area budgets. Each Religious House will be reviewed monthly by the Area Troika.

#13

OPERATING PRINCIPLES

1. Every unit in the Order operates out of the principle of self-support.
2. No house sets its own budget; budgets are created areally.
3. Religious House program money comes from developed sources in each location and is accounted for areally.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. In cases where we maintain a missional focus on Town Meeting and Social Demonstration campaigns, we recommend that we get paid for what we know how to do.
2. In cases where these funds come from consulting opportunities or special program grants, they may be credited as earned income for the Order or developed income.
3. This decision is at the discretion of the Area, taking into consideration the missional program, legal responsibilities and the house budgets consensed at the Area Councils.
4. The Nexus will receive a copy of every grant awarded, legal requirements levied, etc.

MEMORIAL # 14

METRO CADRE CIRCUITS

In the arena of Metro Cadre Circuits, it is the intent of the Global Order to beckon and engage Those Who Care in the major Campaign maneuvers of a given geography, and in many instances using the "shadow principle." This will be implemented through the Metro Circuit strategy, prepared at the Quarter I Area Council, 1976.

#14

OPERATING PRINCIPLES

1. The Metro Cadre is the foundational revolutionary unit of the Spirit Movement.
2. Those Who Care are located in every piece of geography in the globe, and circuitry provides a means for beckoning and engaging those TWC's in a self-conscious thrust of the Movement.
3. A Metro Circuit is the vehicle for systematically maintaining a "Presence of the Blue" in every region, metro, and polis of the globe, and is carried out by every Religious House.
4. A circuit maneuver is a special missional trek for the purpose of intensifying or winning a particular battle in the missional thrust of the Movement.
5. A circuit rhythm is a carefully designed time design to penetrate the geography, and can be built yearly/quarterly/weekly.
6. The shadow principle points to the role of the Order, in enabling the local TWC to assume a primary role in the missional thrust,

RECOMMENDATIONS

A Six Point Plan for Area Council

1. Determine Yearly/Quarterly circuit strategies of Area, Region and Metro in keeping with global and continental consensus.
2. List key campaign maneuvers needed to meet campaign directives.
3. Create holding images for maneuvers (illustration of Chicago Area 6-month Push)
4. List expanded forces by Region who could be made available for circuit maneuvers.
5. Write significating story for troops to engage in circuit maneuvers.
6. Create a common weekly circuit reporting form to be utilized by all circuiters, with missional thrust listed, geography covered, forces engaged, significant victories listed, missional contradiction named, and reflections on the sustaining spirit happening of the circuit.

Supply circuiters with a spirit sustenance packet, to include:

MEMORIAL #15

TRAINING RESEARCH PRIORITIES

In the arena of Training Research Priorities it is the intent of the Global Order to intensify experimentation in accelerated movement training through the Replicating School annual assignments, special assignments to training and research events such as the Global Research Assemblies and International Training Programs, and the selected use of LENS, Core Curriculum, etc. determined in consultation with Area priors and Area Council battle-planning Quarter I.

#15
OPERATING PRINCIPLES

1. That Order training is best accomplished through annual Order assignments that maximize engagement.
2. Effective training research holds the tension between the Global Movement Edge and continental priorities.
3. Relevant training creates spirit giants who will engage local community in the present resurgent trend of history.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. That each ITP participant be responsible for return travel, trek fare and expenses.
2. That the ITP program include as one of its options participation in a Social Demonstration project.
3. That special order training assignments to Academy, Social Demonstration projects, etc., be coordinated by the Area and Nexus.
4. Research GTI through doing Human Development Methods School in India in October.
5. The Global Movement Academy will continue training sessions in Quarters II and IV in Chicago, with Quarter III left open for experimentation with new aspects, perhaps an Academy in another continent.

MEMORIAL # 16PRIMAL COMMUNITY EXPERIMENT

In the arena of the Primal Community Experiment it is the intent of the Global Order to maintain the Primal Community Experiment around each Religious House at its present momentum, and to evaluate its current trends in light of the effect Global Community Forum and Global Social Demonstration may be having on the given community. This will be done through the PCE Post evaluating the current state of the Experiment, appropriating this wisdom and disseminating it through a Primal Community Consult with each House in Quarter II, '76/77.

OPERATING PRINCIPLES

1. The PCE operates in delimited geography out of a global context.
2. Maintain global commonality in PCE design.
3. The recreation of Primal Community is one of the pillars of our missional thrust.
4. Engagement of awakened troops in the GCF and GSD campaigns as a way to care for the world.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Prepare a questionnaire for circulation to all Religious Houses for evaluation of current state of the Primal Community Experiment.
2. Create PCE holding image which reflects focus for this year, and suggested guidelines for maintaining PCE.
3. Design Primal Community Consult model, to be used in Qtr II, with flexibility for edge research in given location.

MEMORIAL #17

GLOBAL FUNDS APPORTIONMENT

In the arena of Global Funds Apportionment it is the intent of the Global Order to move toward fuller implementation of the principle that all funds are global funds and of the principle that the purpose of the funds is the enablement of the Order in its task. This will be done through the apportionment of Global Council funds on a global basis and through data gathering by Management Centrum: Chicago toward the product of the realignment by next year's Global Council of the percentages of the Trust/Task Funds.

OPERATING PRINCIPLES

1. All funds are global funds.
2. Task funds are for global use.
3. Trust funds are inviolate.
4. Loans from the Order to E. I. or ICA are formally made and scheduled for repayment.

7. Any deficit in the health funds over the next year will be absorbed by the other trust funds and payment for the deficit be handled in a plan put before the council next year by the insurance commission on the basis of the analysis of health insurance and needs done by the legal trek.

MEMORIAL #18GLOBAL FISCAL ACCOUNTING

In the arena of global fiscal accounting it is the intent of the Global Order to maintain common global record keeping, accounting and reporting systems for all Order:Ecumenical, Ecumenical Institute, Institute of Cultural Affairs and Human Development Project funds and for other assets such as inkind contributions, through the creation of a finance manual by a Management Centrum Band Taskforce. the establishing of Human Development Project accounting systems and by securing professional accounting advice in order to be knowledgeable of accounting and legal requirements.

OPERATING PRINCIPLES

1. We live off the land.
2. Each location has all it needs.
3. Non-cash assets are auditable items.
4. Monthly reporting to Global Management Centrum for O.E., E.I., I.C.A. and H.D.P.

MEMORIAL #19GLOBAL LEGAL SYSTEMS

In the arena of Global Legal Systems it is the intent of the Global Order to evaluate its present legal framework to ensure that in all aspects of its work it meets legal requirements, has adequate insurance coverage and administrates its property ownership. This will be implemented through a Global Legal Trek which will compile data, evaluate the nature and extent of the present status of The Order: Ecumenical, The Ecumenical Institute and The Institute of Cultural Affairs and recommend appropriate action.

OPERATING PRINCIPLES

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. During quarter III and IV a Global Taskforce Team of Guardians and Order members be assigned to compile the data for legal and insurance guidelines globally through a Global Trek.
2. Creation of an Insurance Commission made up of Guardians and Order members early in quarter II to create a questionnaire for the Legal Trek and to implement a comprehensive review and evaluation of current insurance coverage and make recommendations of insurance guidelines for the Order: Ecumenical, The Ecumenical Institute and The Institute of Cultural Affairs.

This will be accomplished through a re-evaluation of stipend bases at the Quarter I Area Councils, a phasing model for moving toward a more adequate stipend base and experimenting for one year with supplemental medical costs.

In the arena of **GLOBAL PROGRAM FUNDING** it is the intent of the Global Order to insure support for all programs, through the global development band; the deployment of special forces to break loose funding from national governments, area constituencies, and local sources; and the development of a computerized data retrieval system.

In the arena of **GCF LEADERSHIP TRAINING AND MATERIALS** it is the intent of the Global Order to assure common quality of the Town Meeting across the globe by providing training in Town Meeting set-up procedures and workshop methods, maintaining excellence in the consultant and orchestrator roles, contexting the entire Movement on the profundity of the Town Meeting, and maintaining commonality in the Town Meeting materials, while allowing for local relevance for use in the different nations. This will be done through Area, regional and local training and assignment structures, Religious House and Nexus collegium and study life designs, and the Global Operations Centrum task forces.
