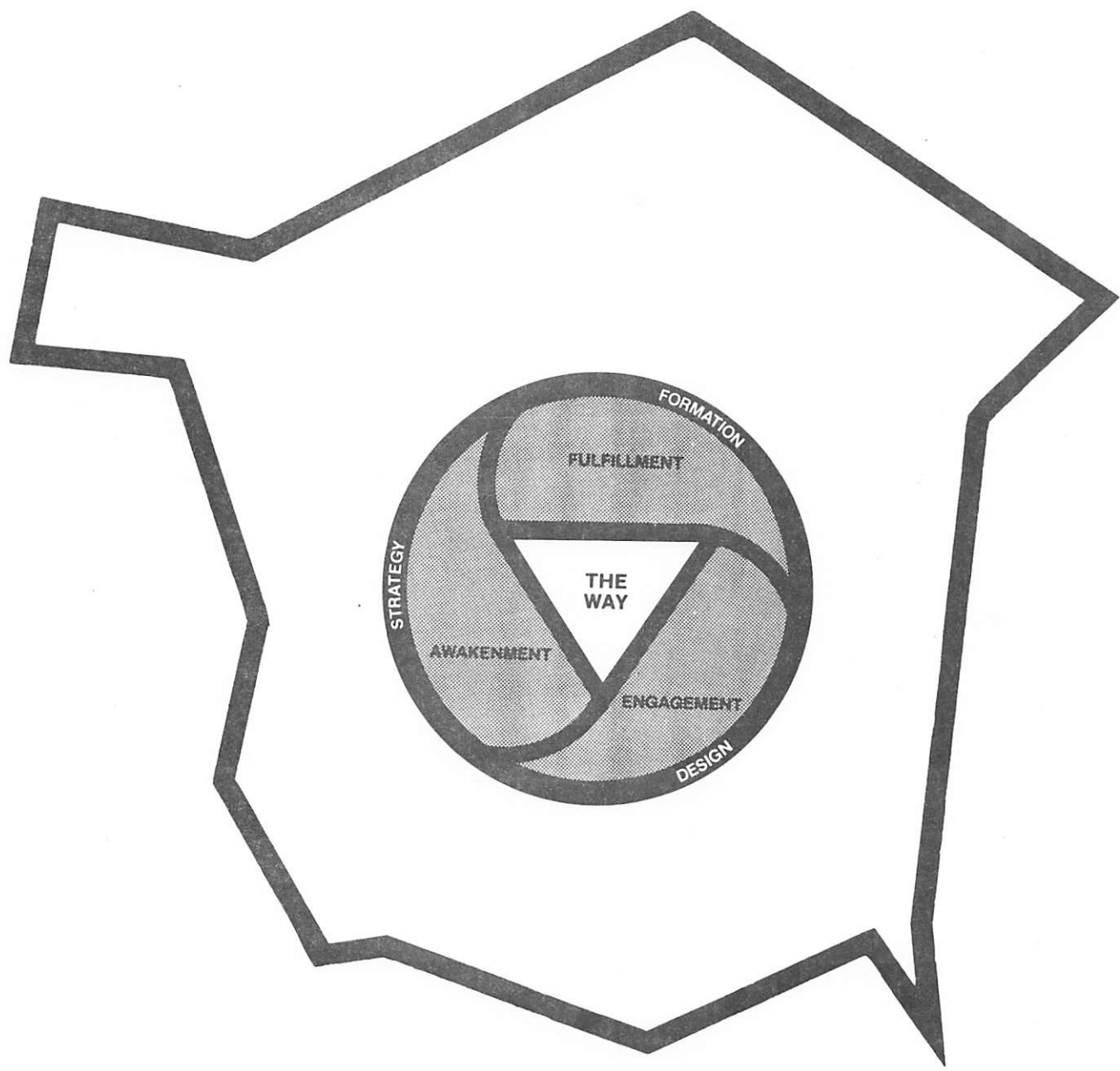

ADVOCACY & TRAINING

1. Framing Systems
Share models and expertise for framing. Create a framing interchange system so offices can be currently informed of the status of national, state, etc. frame.
2. ICA/EI/ORDER Story
Create and print an articulation of who we are for use by colleagues and to be available for handing out to interested parties.
3. Campaign Documentation
A system for continuing documentation of the accomplishments of the HDP's and campaigns and periodic publication and distributions of the results.
4. Media Relations Training
Institute a program of training at the Area and/or Regional level of all active colleagues in media relations.
5. Quality Publications
The creation and distribution of quality publications, both recurring in nature, such as news letters, and special one time pieces.
6. Press Office at each Location
Establish an office or at a minimum appoint an individual at each ICA office to be responsible for media relations, including not only responses to inquires but the initiation of strategic contacts.

HDP TRANSITION

7. Signal Community Cluster
Each project would move out into selected nearby communities to begin journeying these signal communities through training residents in campaigns and participating in regional and area manuvuers.
8. Regional Networks
The projects should have staff and local citizens visit one another, share resources and authorization, and create strong regional support networks:
9. Passing the Torch
Transition requires structures be established in the projects that will continue and leadership in the community be trained in methods of profound living.
10. Maturation Logistics
We need to decide which projects are sufficiently mature to release their auxiliary staff. For those which are ready, a transition story must be created and written, and an event held, and follow-up decided on.
11. Continental Transition Coordination
Symbolic transition of HDP's. This could include scheduling of simultaneous events, co-ordination of phasing, and a shared story.
12. Project Transition Documentation
It is proposed that each project do detailed documentation of project actuation as a component of transition. This could include strategic outside evaluations.

(URBAN PROBE cont'd)

21. STRATEGIC GUIDELINES:

Strategically use impact courses to move beyond initiation phase to prepare for the mass impact stage in the urban e.g., Special Economic Forum in Cleveland.)

22. CONTINENTAL INTERCHANGE:

Devise an interchange system where winning models, event reporting, special focus forums, network contacts, are shared with all 36 regional cities.

23. LAUNCH GUILDS:

Launch guilds in each urban situation where training and nurturing would occur.

26. HDTS QUALITY FACULTY MAINTENANCE

The Council strongly recommends that the quality of the HDTS be maintained and safeguarded. This includes the recommendation that fewer schools be held if quality faculty are not available. To increase quality faculty, it is recommended that the deans be continentally assigned and the remaining faculty be regional or areal. Possibly a training event should be scheduled in January or February. Also the components of the school should be evaluated and refined.

27. HDTS RECRUITMENT

The Council proposes strategic HDTS recruitment in order to effectively use the school's gifts. This would include strategic recruitment of residents from projects as well as from regional agencies and core representatives from other communities. Guidelines include a broad range of ages, ethnic groups, and human development experience.

28. HDTS SET-UP MANUALS

The Council strongly recommends that HDTS Set-Up Manuals be created to ensure that the HDTS will be a quality happening. Included in these manuals, should be readiness evaluation charts, recruitment plans, funding models, materials lists, timelines and preparation checklists including such things as housing requirements, facility requirements, food services, staffing, etc.

DEVELOPMENT FUTURE

29. PROGRAM SELF-SUPPORT

We propose that a development pitch be developed to be given at the end of an impact event. It is recommended that a marketing strategy be planned to insure funding from public/private sources and also that monies be developed from an identified source for each impact event held.

30. GRASSROOTS PLEDGE BASE

We propose to increase the size of grassroots mailing lists so that a broader pledge base can be built.

31. REGIONAL DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY

We propose that more emphasis be put on house responsibilities for initiation and follow-up of local development efforts and 2 Quarter strategies be planned jointly by houses and development centrum on a regional basis.

32. EXPERIMENTAL VENTURE

It is recommended that "Winepress models" be looked at in the next six months that would bring in additional program monies.
