## 1. GLOBAL COMMUNITY FORUM PHASING PLAN

The intent is to accelerate GCF in North America and to initiate the global campaign through area battleplans, network catalyzation, funding expansion, acceleration of leadership training and Global Operations Centrum coordination.

This memorial was fully implemented. Fifteen hundred Community Forums have now been held in 25 countries with all support systems well developed.

## 2. GLOBAL COMMUNITY FORUM TRAINING AND MATERIALS

The intent is to insure quality GCF set-up procedures, workshop leaders, consultants and orchestrators, and to insure commonality in GCF materials and the Movement contexting on the profundity of the Town Meeting.

This memorial was implemented. A dramatic expansion of training for quality leadership was achieved, especially in relation to statewide campaigns, and commonality was maintained in materials.

## 3. GLOBAL SOCIAL DEMONSTRATION BAND EXPANSION

The intent is to accelerate and intensify the GSD campaign by launching 12 new HDP's and initiating the replication experiment in the state of Maharashtra, India, with a replication school beginning Quarter II, 1976.

This memorial was fully implemented. The global band of 24 was completed in June. Sixteen replication projects have been initiated in Maharashtra state, for a total of 40 HDP's. Three Training Schools have been held in Maliwada.

## 4. GLOBAL SOCIAL DEMONSTRATION ECONOMIC SIGN

The intent is to leap forward economically in the 8 existing GSD's to an extent comparable to tripling income in Maliwada through a full-fledged back-up system and repository.

This memorial was implemented. A major effort was made to catalyze an economic breakthrough in the 8 original projects. An Economic Acceleration Team visited 3 projects.

## 5. GLOBAL SOCIAL DEMONSTRATION RESEARCH EDGE

The intent is to insure the completion of the two year Acceleration Phase of GSD and to establish conditions whereby the auxiliary dynamic can be assumed by local leadership, by plotting the journey of each HDP and exchanging models and evaluation reports.

This memorial was implemented. The intention to complete projects in 2 years was reaffirmed and shadow training intensified. A World's Fair was held in Kwangyung Il in anticipation of the completion of the first regular 2 year project on October 15, 1977.

## 6. GLOBAL DEPLOYMENT ASSIGNMENTS

The intent is to increase the effectiveness of troops through using a skills inventory in deployment, adding short term troops, and utilizing configurations from Houses, Nexi, and HDP's.

This memorial was implemented. A strong effort was made to maintain a minimum of 5 per House. A skills inventory of Order members was added to the computer banks. Mobile team assignments included acceleration treks, GCF maneuvers, the development Wedge, Centrum visits, consult teams, and Human Development Training School and International Training Institute faculties.

## 7. PROGRAM LEADERSHIP ASSIGNMENTS

The intent is to maximize program effectivity through a course assignment rationale of male/female dynamic, master/journeying teachers, Order/Movement presence, using indigenous local leadership, and maintaining Global context when financially possible.

This memorial was implemented. An effort was made to hold these values in all program assignments, with many such assignments originating in the local House or Area.

## 8. GLOBAL GUARDIAN ENGAGEMENT

The intent is to engage a global network of 1000 guardians in GCF implementation, as GSD consultants and LENS teachers, and as participants at continental semi-annual meetings.

This memorial was implemented. Approximately 1000 guardians have been involved in GCF set-up and leadership, GSD consults and treks, and in general development and authorization.

## 9. ORDER YOUTH ENGAGEMENT

The intent is to continue the Student House while evaluating its operations and recommending the assignment of all Order youth through the Panchayat and Global Council Regulatory.

This memorial was fully implemented. The evaluation led to overseas assignments, treks within the United States, and, for the first time, an integrated program which includes all ages in Phase I.

## 10. GLOBAL PROGRAM BUDGETING

The intent is to create a global budget design, a transrational formula to calculate budgets, and a global development budget.

This memorial was implemented. A global budget manual was created and common procedures encouraged through Finance Treks to the Houses. The Areas consensed on expenditures and the raising of program budgets.

## 11. GLOBAL PROGRAM FUNDING

The intent is to insure support for all programs by the global development band through special forces deployment and a computerized data retrieval system.

This memorial was implemented. The Wedge Team was initiated and the transrational "bastion" model launched. The givers data file was improved.

## 12. GLOBAL SUSTENANCE BUDGET

The intent is to continue the present sustenance budget construct, but re-evaluating the stipend bases at Quarter I Area Councils, and experimenting for 1 year with supplemental medical costs.

This memorial was implemented. Stipend levels were re-evaluated at Quarter I Councils. A one-year experiment was conducted during which the Order has covered supplemental medical costs.

### 13. GLOBAL SUSTENANCE SUPPORT

The intent is to hold the Religious House self-support principle in tension with necessary missional assignments by creating models, assigning permeators, examining House budgets, and creating Area budgets.

This memorial was implemented. The principle of self-support was held in tension with other missional assignments and local development emphasized.

### 14. METRO CADRE CIRCUITS

The intent is to engage Those Who Care in the Campaign maneuvers of a given geography through strategies prepared at the Quarter 1 Area Councils.

This memorial was implemented. Those Who Care were involved in the 3 campaigns and assisted in GCF circuiting.

### 15. TRAINING RESEARCH PRIORITIES

The intent is to accelerate Movement training through assignments to Replication School, GRA, International Training Programs, and Area-planned LENS and Core Curriculum.

This memorial was implemented. Areas have enabled participation in training events, especially by sending people to attend GSD consults.

### 16. PRIMAL COMMUNITY EXPERIMENT

The intent is to maintain the Primal Community Experiment around each Religious House at its present momentum and evaluate it in the light of GCF and GSD.

This memorial was implemented. Certain PCE's were continued on a low key basis, and many held Town Meetings. The future of primal community reformulation was examined in the light of the acceleration of GCF and GSD.

### 17. GLOBAL FUNDS APPORTIONMENT

The intent is to implement the principle that all funds are global funds through the apportionment of Global Council funds on a global basis and data-gathering by Management Centrum.

This memorial was implemented. The apportionment of global funds was implemented through data gathered by Management Centrum.

### 18. GLOBAL FISCAL ACCOUNTING

The intent is to maintain common global record-keeping, accounting and reporting systems for all of the Order through the creation of a finance manual by a Management Centrum band task force.

This memorial was implemented. A finance manual was created with a common system of record keeping, accounting and reporting.

### 19. GLOBAL LEGAL SYSTEMS

The intent is to evaluate the present legal framework of the Order to insure its legal adequacy through the implementation of a Global Legal Trek.

This memorial was implemented. The Global Legal Trek visited all Nexi and Area Houses to investigate all aspects of legal requirements and to assist in registering several offices.

### 20. COMMON STRUCTURE GROUNDING

The intent is to continue the demonstration of intra-globality by having Daily Office 6 days a week, weekly House Churches, Ecclesiola on Thursday evenings, prayers at 6 p.m., capital verse/news conversations and collegiums at breakfast, and fasting according to the global fasting design.

This memorial was implemented. All Houses followed the common practices while experimenting as necessary with flexible implementation.

### 21. SPIRIT LIFE DESIGN

The intent is to maintain the corporate and solitary spirit life of the Order through the use of Order common memory, quarterly ecclesiola manuals, and imaginal rehearsal of the profound function of the 3 campaigns.

This memorial was implemented. In the midst of intensive engagement, corporate study and reflection, using common material in various forms, was maintained to care for the troops.

### 22. GLOBAL MISSION REPORTING

The intent is to intensify reporting systems by adding a GSD newsletter and revising the Global Order Report.

This memorial was implemented. A new form for reporting to the Global Order was created, and the Campaign News launched.

### 23. GLOBAL CONTINENTAL PLANS

The intent is to intensify the degree to which Movement forces operate out of continental and program priorities, through area battleplanning, use of Operation Centrum models and plans, and annual and semi-annual reporting and accounting.

This memorial was fully implemented. Plans were created at all levels and reporting procedures improved.

### 24. CONTINENTAL ACCELERATION PRIORITIES

The intent is to launch the Year of Canada, intensify the continent of Africa, and prepare Latin America through the 3 campaigns.

This memorial was fully implemented. Two projects were initiated in Canada, 1 in Latin America, and 2 additional in Africa. Community Forums were held on all three continents.

### 25. GLOBAL POLITY DYNAMICS

The intent is to continue being one disciplined body across the globe through using the dynamics of the Global Panchayat, Global Commissions, Global Centrum Bands, and Global Priors gatherings.

This memorial was fully implemented. Regular meetings were held, in addition to which a task force at Chicago Nexus has prepared a document outlining the Order's polity and operating principles.
