-Across the nation and at Base there were 15 courses taught with a total participation of 350. Signal course was Jacksonville, Florida--first course in that Area for a long time had 41 participants.

-The children of the Order at Base spent their week of Spring vacation: Monday-Forest Preserve, Cookout, Brookfield Zoo/ Tuesday-City Library, Movie Rob Roy at E.I./ Wed.-Day in Suburbia at Trinity Lutheran Church in Des Plaines gridding and picnicing/ Thurs.-Columbus Park creative playground, YMCA/ Friday-City of Chicago, Movie and E.I. Rain dampened several days of the activities, but it proved a week of school discontinuity for the children and Divisional discontinuity for the adults.

-18 gallons of daffodil yellow paint was expended by the Academy in the halls of the Administration building last week which symbolized the coming of great things in Summer '70.

Contradiction: Only 35 registrations for Summer '70 with 465 needing to come in to insure the future of the Local Church.
