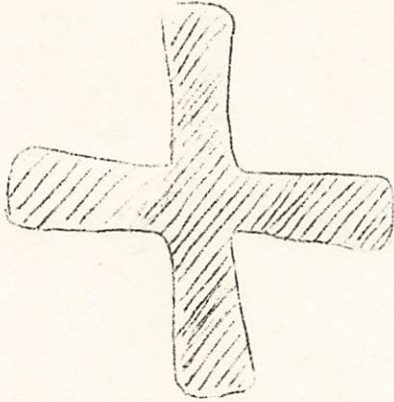

GLOBAL WEST

UNITED STATES :

NORTH

Religious House: Chicago North

External: Participation in circuit riding teams calling on all Chicago Region metros and preparation for spring quarter, and house recruitment teams out night and day actualized the demand to fill all courses scheduled this quarter.

Internal: A great celebration held before sending the John Cock family to base to receive a new assignment.

Contradiction: Having to build a new recruitment model in the middle of recruiting for 2 courses at the 1st of the quarter.

Religious House: Chicago South

External: Sent House member to a St. Louis regional meeting with 25 in attendance and where four of the six metros were represented.

Internal: Galaxy meeting the the house with a continental consultation by Martin and Betty Pesek of the North Shore Cadre.

Contradiction: Straining to launch into the new quarter before all the goals have been established.

Sign: Conversation by galaxy children on the role of teams and units in the local church situation.

Religious House: Rockford

External: A circuit ride through the region enabled the metros to be held accountable as working units.

Internal: A contextual address at the 1 in 3 house meeting made a deep impression on us. Our house celebration ending the month of discontinuity was seeing Cromwell and we were addressed by the life style.

Contradiction: In the midst of needing registrations for upcoming courses we need 7 metro calling teams to get the job done.

Sign: Lucille Nolan, our new metro coordinator is a sign of new possibility in Rockford.

Religious House: Cleveland

External: Held special Regional Council during which the consensus was reached to launch a common movement discipline experiment for spring quarter, with the signal focus being the agreement to be under assignment all quarter

for the Week II's: regional penetration/formulation - 4; training/teaching - 2; metro -2;councils -2;local church -2;family discontinuity -1. Sixteen colleagues committed themselves to be under assignment and assumed responsibility for contacting other colleagues in their metros. Galaxy celebrated House Church with the house to signal the implementation of the tactical system.

Internal: Total house spent the week working out 5 year model for regional penetration/formulation (using the Houston models as base). Image: 600 (churches) by '76. Models presented at the special regional council. New division structure for spring: house people assigned to particular metros.

Contradiction: How to internalize the impact of everything that has happened this week!!!

Religious House: Detroit

External: Detroit galaxy continental consult was a signal event.

Internal: Spring planning completed with an extensive "stages of preparation model" created to enable all churches to see themselves at some stage in the local church experiment.

Contradiction: Creating corporateness and a common model across the region.

Sign: Large number of new colleagues expressing a willingness to move.

Religious House: Kansas City

External: In circumstances that would seem we could not go on with the mission, made crucial call on District Superintendent of Kansas City, Kansas.

Internal: Preparing to double number in house on 72 hour notice.

Contradiction: Too many troops!

The Alvin Williams Family: Des Moines

External: Family participated in the rebirthing of the St. Louis region.

Family pushed local church to see importance of celebration through a Latin American fiesta.

Internal; Team structures established to enable the family in spring quarter.

Contradiction: Heavy secular demands pushes the need for intensified religious structures.

EAST

Religious House: Boston

External: Implemented tactical plans for formation of modules. House families in corporate missional relationship to regional families in every metro of the region; simultaneously undergirding the recruitment of courses for quarter. Supported the final galaxy council of Winter Quarter where actual timelines for each congregation for the first week of the quarter were completed.

Internal: Finished evaluation of house internal structures. At House Church Palm Sunday celebrated the new quarter with the receiving of the Leroy Willoughby family and Richard Green as interns for the year; and the sending of Phil and Beverly Smith to their new international assignment in Australia.

Contradiction: Breaking loose contextual images of regional corporateness (grounded in NRM) that provide the comprehensive vision of local church reconstruction through the experiment, and a tactical plan for the regional structures to carry out that vision.

Religious House: New York

External: Recruiting and planning continue for formulation Project "90 for 90 for all", with 75 adults and 30 children plus the house present for planning and visioning weekend. Local church project priors return from Chicago with clarified and renewed vision. Regional presidium of 30 meets to plan spring thrust of region.

Internal: Discontinuous Week I time design plus Luke conversations and intellectual preparation building momentum toward "90 for 90 for all". David Horn and children Elizabeth and Timothy and Jane Wheeler arrived as sojourners.

Contradiction: Galaxy schedule and hosting planning weekend, plus 4 adults and 4 children on sick call.

Religious House: Washington D.C.

External: Regional planning weekend highlighted by creating 6 year course timeline for region down to sector level and then "assigning" 36 sector coordinators.

Internal: Spirit boost from sojourners: the Bud and Jan Ames family from Columbia, Missouri, St. Louis Region, and Hank Pierson, Columbia, South Carolina, Atlanta Region. Radical address came in final Otto study with grounding of the mystical experiences of the resurrection in our own lives.

Contradiction: Lack of pre-lanning for spring quarter in face of immediate PLC and Odyssey recruitment demands.

Religious House: Rochester

External: Buffalo blitz - first penetration there with youth participating in calling. All went well.

Internal: Preparation begins for the open house. Poetry study in mornings opening up new awareness of spirit deeps.

Contradiction: Mobilizing time and troops for open house preparation.

The Howard Family: Philadelphia

WEST

Religious House: Los Angeles

External: Intensive regional planning and implementation in all metros.

Internal: While odyssey in progress, the house moved to Pasadena for intensive planning while experimenting with fasting which was climaxed by a feast.

Contradiction: Space for incoming interns and sojourners.

Religious House: San Francisco

External: Sacramento metro priors weekly meetings begun; and total house assigned to Roman Catholic penetration.

Internal: Spring quarter planning: major contradiction, master goals, quarter goals, quarter tactics, 13 week timeline, weekly time design.

Contradiction: How to create 48 hours of spirit from 24 hours of matter.

Religious House: Seattle

External: House team report on 4 days in Sitka, Alaska, join with strong colleagues, the Bucks, to make 70 calls and recruited an RSI, push on academy recruitment netted two more for a total of 10 going from region; PLC calling continued.

Internal: Hosted local church galactical sodality; high excitement helped new recruits work toward completion of quarter's battle plan before April 4th. House received new monk for a month, Ann Stinder, and prepared to send Bob Lingenfelter to academy and Tolmans to Kansas City house.

Contradiction: Setting our house in order for new quarter in midst of shifts in priors and continued recruitment, penetration and local church project demands.

SOUTH

Religious House: Atlanta

External: An Atlanta sector meeting with 15 present, in which a conversation revealed unexpected signs of possibility in local churches; and a trip to Gainesville, Florida to a Miami regional council with 12 present, and their decision to recruit a PLC in Miami.

Internal: Spring quarter planning for intensified catalyzation of Atlanta region, in the midst of which we did pedagogy and end of quarter celebration.

Contradiction: Broad spring quarter planning completed, but timeline and details yet to be planned.

Religious House: Oklahoma City

External: After 4 weeks preparation, the Weatherford sector catalytic cadre and four Weatherford primal cadres (Lutheran-Missouri Synod, Roman Catholic, United Methodist and Federated Deciples Congregation) were formally commissioned. Lo! new galaxies beyond the horizon.

Internal: Preparing for arrival this weekend of new intern family (the Hatha-ways) which will add to the house two adults, one youth and two emerging generation, as well as preparing for the arrival of two friars.

Contradiction: Completing old assignments in the midst of planning for new quarter.

Religious House: Houston

External: The metro penetration guild met and evaluated the PLC calling and recruiting structures.

Internal: The entire house was involved in an all-metro formulation weekend.

Contradiction: How does the entire house participate in the local church experiment.

Sign: Two new intern families due in May.

Religious House: New Orleans

External: Regional planning weekend with 26 in attendance - 5 metros represented.

Internal: John Jackson's announced internship as of May 1.

Contradiction: Still no jobs for two house members.

Religious House: New Orleans

External: 18 participants for spring academy; taught course for Church Federation in New Orleans.

Internal: Welcoming Lynn Bailey with all her long religious house experience.

Contradiction: The mission demands 3 more intern families.

CANADA EAST

Religious House: Montreal

External: First comprehensive clergy recruitment push with regional colleagues into all six Montreal metros with emphasis on Ottawa and Montreal, and sent two persons to first ever Toronto regional weekend spirit-practices course.

Internal: Welcomed new intern Duncan Holmes from Kingston, Ontario and new sojourner Gay Kennedy from Halifax, Nova Scotia.

Contradiction: Inadequate recruitment for two PLC recruitment consultations places overwhelming demands on visitation structures.

CANADA WEST

Religious House: Winnipeg

External: Systematic PLC recruitment push intensified. Grads from one galactic congregation say yes to being the cadre.

Internal: Evaluation/planning sessions gave birth to three-point spring quarter thrust: 1) radicalize our spirituality, 2) multiply leadership proficiency and 3) maximize regional involvement.

Contradiction: Lack of clarity on how to rapidly involve regional people in the regional mission.

GLOBAL EAST

AUSTRALIA Religious House: Sydney

External: Received reports from trips to:

Brisbane: A formulation trip visiting Brisbane, Rockhampton, Armidale, Quirindi, Gunnedah and Toowoomba. Cadre meetings were held in both Brisbane and Toowoomba.

Hobart: A planning meeting of clergy was held.

Melbourne: A development trip.

Internal: Two interns were received into the house: Steve Rhea from Beaumont, Texas who was formerly a member of the Beaumont University cadre.

Gail Braithwaite from Perth. The whole house celebrated the end of twelve intensive weeks by deciding on impulse to visit the drive-in to see Zorba The Greek.

Contradiction: Of 10 registered for PLC, only 4 turned up.

There is still no hot water and autumn is definitely here.

Religious House: Perth

External: RSI brought off with 22 participants, local church group already planning to meet as a result. PLC mailing out to 200 metro clergy.

Internal: Collegium on "corporateness" addressed house with Order's wisdom in this area. Sodality on Perth churches and weekend trip of children to Swan Valley winery were highlights.

Contradiction: Getting ready for next weekend's odyssey.

Religious Outpost: Derby

MALAYSIA Religious House: Kuala Lumpur

External: A great odyssey for 11, including Peggy Heng and the Mother Superior of the Holy Infant Jesus Convent, with two of the older youth silently enabling.

Internal: The High School Sector led the whole house in successfully bringing off a permeation dinner for their vice-principal and his wife, and Dr. and Mrs. Param. (She is the senior and seventh grade English teacher.) The Work's professional Visit Passes are now cleared for one year, although Mary's work permit will not be granted until her job comes through.

Contradiction: Closing out and appropriating a quarter that was experienced as having begun three times and really getting on top of the imperative while at the same time planning for the Week II house gathering, and sojourners arriving Monday for 10 days.

Religious Outpost: Singapore

External: A productive trip to Bangkok to attend the Church of Christ in Thailand conference on evangelism, providing an opportunity to meet 75 leaders, set up ITI invitations and development, and meet with the cadre at the International Church.

Internal: Attendance at Mass at the Roman Catholic Cathedral with a student colleague (her first visit to a Roman Catholic church) enabling spirit nurture, while the style of the service illustrated the impact of Vatican II even in a arch-conservative diocese.

Contradiction: The house scheduled as the April PLC location was vandalized last week, probably requiring a shift to another facility with no good low cost possibilities presently in sight.

Sign: The discovery, 2 weeks later, that the Daily Office was used at the Trinity College Chapel under the leadership of Dean Guy Garrett.

HONG KONG Religious Outpost: Hong Kong

External: The movement sent out the Lonni Turnipseed family on a five month "global odyssey"; 1/2 of Hong Kong ITI participants recruited; five days of funding calls in American business community reveal an unexpected wealth of potential and goodwill.

Internal: Hosted Joe Pierce for one week; celebrated end of the quarter with a meal at a Swatow restaurant.

Contradiction: Need to create a wider denominational base of ITI participants in Hong Kong.

Sign: Good Shepherd Anglican Church experimented Sunday with an adaptation of the Daily Office including songs (Free to Decide, Amazing Grace, The Church - all in Chinese), prayers from the congregation and passing of the peace.

JAPAN Religious Outpost: Osaka

TAIWAN Religious Outpost: Tainan

External: First RSI by the Outpost held March 26-27 in Kaohsiung, 17 participants. Came off well.

Internal: David McClesky visited from Philippines to help us with RSI pedagogy and evaluation, and laying out models for penetration and cultivation. He also helped teach RSI course. Week spent in preparation for RSI.

Contradiction:

Sign: RSI course taught.

INDONESIA Religious Outpost: Djakarta

External: A revised penetration schedule for Indonesia for the last of April and the month of May is in the process of being announced.

Internal: Recent effort to co-ordinate planning with the Kuala Lumpur house has been most helpful.

Contradiction: The need for penetration push to serve as a base to fulfill present ITI advanced preparations for recruitment and fund raising.

Sign: At this time limited but positive affirmative response coming from local Archbishop. A historical statement on the work of the Ecumenical Institute is now in memo form and in Indonesia. (Very much need this kind of useful statement of credibility done in an attractive international format complete with photos and a listing of all past and present ITI sponsors.)

Religious Outpost: Djakarta

External: Thirteen course/consult invitations and schedule mailed during week to 8 key metro areas in Indonesia while stepping up permeation in Djakarta.

Internal: Bed ridden for four days with "tropical hives" gave occasion to read and brood over lectures and reports sent from base.

Contradiction: The securing of a second faculty person and travel expenses for two for the upcoming penetration and pre-ITI push.

Sign: Nathan - local cadre colleague and ITI grad has translated all four RSI papers into Indonesian for future use.

SAMOA Religious Outpost: Samoa

External: We made calls to follow-up the cadre meeting of two weeks ago. We decided, after long effort, the design for the Easter card we are sending out and took it to the printer.

Internal: We attended lectures given by Fr. Hoffinger, a 70 year old Jesuit who spent several years in China and is now teaching in the Philippines. He lectured on ecumenism and the theological revolution evidenced by Vatican II. He is quite lively and addressed us all as one of those many spirit men around the globe who are waiting for the signal "now is the time." His lecture tour will take him to New Orleans and Houston.

Contradiction: We have not begun raising money for the ITI yet.

MARSHALL ISLANDS

Religious Outpost: Majuro

External: Return to RongRong in time for start of final quarter of school.

Plans set for Ministers Training School ("Mini ITI"), April 19-May 4.

Internal: Catching up on mail, correspondence, ordering materials and classes.

Contradiction: How to create signs and enable teachers in the school, while being gone so much of the time.

Sign: Decision of the church on Ebeye to fund 4 Marshallese delegates to ITI: Manila.

PHILIPPINES

Religious Outpost: Manila

External: The Philippine area sent David McClesky to the first course to be held in Taiwan by local staff in order to enable teacher preparation and planning, and to help initiate the local penetration thrust.

Internal: George Walters arrived from India/Pakistan; and a Painting Party was assembled to paint and decor the new operating base on 20 Ubay Street, Quezon City; Donna has received a raise for teaching summer school at St. Mary's.

Contradiction: Incoming mail takes up to three weeks to arrive at our Post Office Box 2120 GPO, Manila due to the chaos in the Manila Postal System.

Sign: Nine visitors to the Outpost Launchpad (6 ITI grads) this week.

Several prospects for some college, worship and House Church participation by grads.

SUBASIA

Religious Outpost: Bombay

External: Broken back on ITI set up-recruitment, located another adequate ITI site in Jabalpur, and forged practical models for accomplishing nitty-gritty.

Internal: Fortress structures forged for transitional outpost as preparation for ITI is continued; celebrated common meal with Joshi family and called together 20 colleagues at Robinson Memorial to enable mass mailing.

Contradiction: Holding tension between building foundation for urban ashram and preparing for the ITI as outpost lacking both staff-time to penetrate West India region and also lacking kitchen facility.

Announcement: BORN: ADAM TDUSSAIENTA LINGO March 24, 1971. Rejoice!

WEST

EUROPE

International Team: Hahn Family

External: Several appointments with key Anglican educational people (all suggested by Bishop of London.)

Internal: Decor additions and changes addressing us and colleagues who come by.

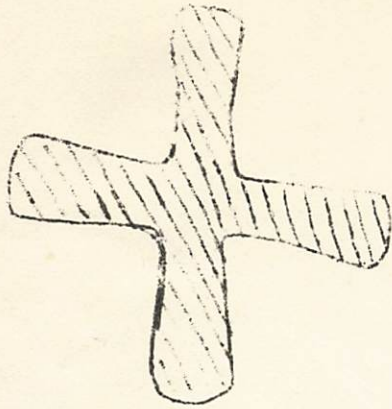
Contradiction: Finding right place for summer program.

ORDER BASE

External: Two send outs: Ken and Anne Filipski to Japan and Ike and Charlene Powell to Bombay.

Internal: Total Order NSV PSU on weekend about social theoretics, phenomenological sociology, futuric manifesto and a reading construct for Order NSV research. Began spring quarter with study of the Radical Alternative by Jean-Jacques Servan-Schreiber (London: Macdonald, 1970) which exploded our work out of the weekend. Received at House Church as interns: The Dan Smith family from California, James Roland from Rockford, Cindy Mohn from Pittsburgh and Steve Westlund from Rockford. Participants in the international leadership training program: Michiko and Toshifumi Aso with their son Tabito from Japan and as international academy participants; also received Shelly Hart from England for same.

Contradiction: How to get the academies off the ground in DeKalb and the Program Center not knowing how to provide the equipment needed for two large academies.

GLOBAL WEST

UNITED STATES

NORTH

Religious House: Chicago North

External: Locally recruited PLC on Easter weekend resulted in 20 turned-on churchmen; one pastor anticipating his 1st PLC recruited his friends for the same.

Internal: A work day was great fun and enabling for six youth guests and their minister leader from Kalamazoo, Michigan. The study of Scriber was begun.

Contradiction: Absence of micro networks on North Shore necessitated recruitment by house members in order to bring of courses.

Religious House: Chicago South

External: Helping recruit ten people for PLC from Champaign-Urbana metro.

Internal: Week 1 ended with the Olin Stockwell family projecting future missions in Southeast Asia and America. Newly weds assigned three-year old twins for the duration of the Academy.

Contradiction: Struggling to integrate new quarter goals with local church experiment which is ever-changing.

Religious House: Rockford

External: The victim image we had relative to RSI recruitment was broken through fervent prayer which resulted in 13 recruits in a five-day period and a course pulled off in Week 11.

Internal: Our first night of Ecclesiola with Scriber's The Radical Alternative with 8 guests present began to break open our vision to Summer '71 and its relationship to the local church. Our daily goals for recruitment and more metro people showing up for ecclesiola are symbolic of the radical increase in the number of prayers being lifted up for the Rockford metro.

Contradiction: Out of 34 recruits for upcoming PLC's, 26 are from one metro - 2 of our 3 metros are not being adequately prepared for the local church experiment.

Religious House: Cleveland

External: Twenty regional colleagues left for academy with 10 more going later; breakthrough with clergy in Cleveland metro: developed a weekly training, corporate planning and accountability structure for cadre development in their local churches, 2 strong black pastors participating; galaxy churches discovered power of the tactical system, and electric grid principle is true! High school youth witnessed in youth service Easter Sunday on "The Resurrection can happen to you!" Laywoman (non RSI grad) opened circle meeting with 20 minutes of 'spirit' singing,

rituals, etc. When asked, in middle of singing, if they shouldn't move into the meeting, she told them there was nothing more important they could do than sing.

Internal: Sent Dick Talbott, 3rd prior, to academy, welcomed Lois Reeves as intern and Church and Jackie Byrd (two youth) as sojourners. Rest of Byrd family sojourning in Chicago. Tom Hoshiko and children sojourning while Barbara attends academy.

Contradiction: With colleagues going to academy and focus on regional restructuring, inadequate recruitment done: 1 PLC cancelled, 1 RSI and 2 advanced.

Religious House: Detroit

External: Eight regional colleagues at regional presidium decided to operate out of the image this quarter that all time is assigned time. They came up with 55 hours a week of "alterable time" during which they are under particular assignment from the region. Spent two days in the Toronto region and contacted 45 clergy there. Regional "assigned time model" is being pushed back into the metros.

Internal: Children took a weekend trip to Mammoth Caves. We were addressed by the fact that there were colleagues to stay with everywhere we went.

Contradiction: How to build a regional "assigned time model" holding the tension between broad participation and a significant push.

Religious House: Kansas City

External: Call on one fine Sister results in her mailing 900 brochures (79 houses) to all the Sister in Kansa, Missouri, and Nebraska. Metro Collegium colleagues met in RH:KC great hall for ovrk on quarter's timeline -- all experienced intensification of family timelines as questions like "When are you going to begin your intern year" and "When...sojourn" were raised.

Internal: Two new permation fronts established. Went on intern recruiting call, ended up untying two colts for the Master (cars) -- intern recruit's mind blown at skillful handling of used car dealer. Resurrection accomplished -- Allisa returns to corporate structures after her solitary vigil over hepatitis. Salted water (tears) and bitter herbs (pain) punctuated Last Temptations of Christ readings on Maunday Thursday. Regional colleagues levitating when guests at college and House Church. We're levitating after Gary Davis' (RH:OkC) timely sharing of cadre formulation models.

Contradiction: On Good Friday, VW descended into Hell; awaits resurrection!! Our own space and time models intensified as we see that our one guest room and one new intern room will very soon be filled.

EAST Religious House: Boston

Religious House: New York

Religious House: Wasington D.C.

External: The house opened its ecclesiola doors on Thursday night to regional colleagues and received 15 as we began a quarter study of Nigg.

Internal: The house went through the local church training school during Easter weekend culminated by a feast of resurrection at morning House Church.

Contradiction: Constructing our Odyssey format for this week II as we try to incorporate the insights from the Boston and New York Odysseys that we participated in last quarter.

Religious House: Rochester

External: Simultaneous penetration/formulation work going on in Watertown and Buffalo with exciting colleagues and possible colleagues in both.

Internal: Welcomed new sojourners Donovan Roberts, daughter and son for the month of April. Wife Peg is in the academy. House/region PSU on regional nurture lays new demands and possibilities. Also welcomed Mr. and Mrs. Schlesinger and Judy for Easter weekend visit.

Contradiction: Where do we get the troops for fulfilling radical regional possibility.

WEST Religious House: Los Angeles

External: Gathering of 35 regional colleagues (mostly new) in which new regional plan was forged including ecclesiola in metros and sectors.

Internal: Massive penetration continues with house in all six metros this week.

Contradiction: Need to create comprehensive model of common regional ecclesiola format and study plan, etc.

Religious House: San Francisco

External: Entire house attended Easter vigil procession, renewal of baptismal covenant and Easter Mass at St. Michael's Church.

Internal: Nine colleagues at first spring quarter ecclesiola representing galaxy churches and metro priors.

Contradiction: Need to intensify the local church experiment by house training massive numbers of colleagues in the corporate spirit life.

Religious House: Seattle.

External: Nine months of steady recruitment finally producing 1st 4-metro PLC east of mountains in this region. PLC at Othello with clergy from Portland, Spokane, Pasco and Eugene metros. Claudia Kinsey sent from house to 3rd teach PLC. Local church sodality: another week of tertiary battle planning with deep excitement and commitment.

Internal: House imploded by 3-day Easter vigil and fast while pushing Hebrews to bottom and reflecting on past quarter and visioning new quarter. New quarter exploded with new assignments throughout house, beginning NSV study and Rev. and Mrs. Richard Gasset and son sojourning for a week with us. In house training in tactical system and large guest night made this first week of quarter seem like a month on spirit toboggan (or rocket).

Contradiction: Intensified doing and rapid spirit break loose catching us in thrust forward in midst of no concrete battle plan and timeline for metros, region and local church project.

SOUTH Religious House: Atlanta

External: Raleigh PLC and first week operation of new Atlanta sector net.

Internal: Local church training school for all religious house adults on Easter Week II.

Contradiction: Atlanta PLC 2 1/2 weeks away with registrations not tied down.

Religious House: Oklahoma City

External: Two courses pulled off in Durant and Oklahoma City, 1 year model built for cadre development, spirit profiles completed on 100 regional colleagues.

Internal: Davis family's decision in reflection of 10 years of marriage to renew their marriage covenant.

Contradiction: Housing 42 house members and sojourners in 14 bedrooms.

Religious House: Houston

External: Metro council meeting with emphasis on planning for the spring regional council. Two PLCs come off in Houston region on the same week.

Internal: Guest night exploded (positively) with seven guests from around region.

Contradiction: The necessity of sending out to work one full time and three part time to enable the house financially.

Religious House: New Orleans

External: Signal church gave approval for experiment, budgeted \$1200 and sent all three of its priests to spring academy.

Internal: First family discontinuity of the year from Maundy Thursday to Easter House Church. NSV study at collegium and seminary proved mind-expanding.

Contradiction: How to cover simultaneously appointments in New Orleans and Jackson Miss. with one prior working in.

CANADA EAST

Contradiction: Co-leagueship with ITI grads and missional task sky-rocketing without clear flight pattern.

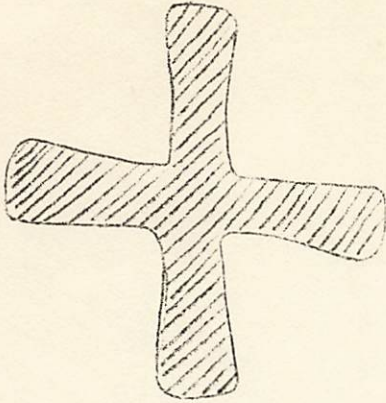

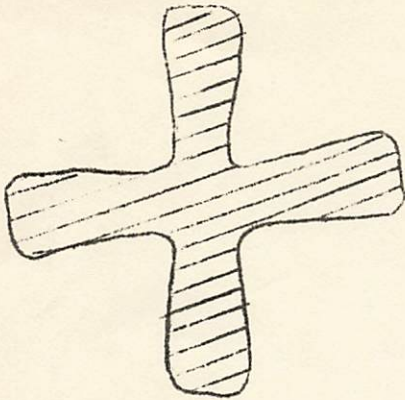

External: Modules experiencing hard-headed, practical reality of building recruitment structures that enable comprehensive strategy to catalyze colleagues, for recruitment in 36 sectors. The "long march" of tertiary actualization continues in the Experiment.

Internal: Six Spirit Units met for 2nd Friday evening in six metros involving 75 people from across the region. Ten guests at House Church on Sunday.

Contradiction: Embodying the resurrectional style in the midst of overwhelming demands and possibilities, formulation and development.

✓ Religious House: New York

External: First RSI in 3 years in Long Island metro comes off with 22 participants; PLC of 23 held in Episcopal Guild House in Queens. Week IV RSI and CSIIIA confirmed with over the top recruitment (without relaxing the formulation thrust of 90 for 90 for all).

Internal: Preschool curriculum begun with a.m. and p.m. structures containing imaginal education, basic skills, physical skills and relational journey.

Mobility of preschoolers (including infants) demonstrated by subway rides to Central Park involving 3 trains.

Contradiction: Turing metro assignment structures into spirit.

✓ Religious House: Washington D.C.

External: Large local church experiment group taking over great hall and kitchen Friday night and relegating house members to small local church room.

Internal:

Contradiction: Creation of radical new time design which enables accomplishment of necessary in house tasks in midst of sector focus and all but one adult assigned out. It & keeps out being our situation.

✓ Religious House: Rochester

External: Week I calling in Buffalo to follow-up RSI. Week II calling in Utica for nurture and recruitment. Anticipate galactic consult for Syracuse.

Internal: Permeation colloquy held in house on Sat. Forty year and four year goals, permeation symbol and ritual formed with great excitement for house and regional participation.

Contradiction: Materials for both NRM and NSV studies.

WEST

Religious House: Los Angeles

External: Regional meeting developed common ecclesiola study plan and assigned 176 people to regional enablement of remaining quarter.

Internal: House penetration and formulation teams present in all six metros this week.

Contradiction: Coordination of all thrusts.

Religious House: San Francisco

External: Exciting RSIIIA held with 5 of 6 metros represented; decision by regional presidium to hold another PLC in May.

Internal: House begins participation in CRRP--reordering internal time design to enable 3 study sessions a week; use of burning candle during all study sessions holds image of monk at study/work.

Contradiction: Summer '71 recruitment in midst of intensified course recruitment.

✓ Religious House: Seattle

External: When first you don't succeed try, try again -- Sitka course came off with 26 + grads.

Internal: Experienced the mystery of NSV reading research project (Lord have mercy).

Contradiction: How hold tension between demand for immediacy (galaxy) and future (NSV) and be the sign NOW.

✓ Religious House: Denver

SOUTH

Religious House: Atlanta

External: Week II formulation work in 4 metros/10 sectors: Atlanta, Athens; Charlotte, Anderson, Spartanburg; Columbia, Greenwood; Raleigh, Greensboro, and Winston-Salem. 1,600 miles traveled.

Internal: Corporate Reading Research Project begun by altering time-design to include 4 hours reading on Wed. evening.

Contradiction: Old forms/programs still producing "success" churches in Atlanta. Have not broken clergy illusion that they can avoid the despair, nor their fear that new involvements will threaten "successfulness".

Religious House: Oklahoma City

External: Circuit riders of the house made a revitalizing tour of the region, resurrecting lagging cadres. We rejoiced to receive Lyn Mathews for the OCU symposium where she gave a signal address on the spirit movement; other participants included Gregory Baum and Ben Johnson.

Internal: We would hold up a renewed global image through internal decor; also the ascent to heights heretofore unscaled in our house exterior painting project, which in its third week II module assignment is now approximately 1/6 completed.

Contradiction: Continued zestlessness on the part of regional colleagues in picking up on course responsibility.

CANADA EAST

✓ Religious House: Montreal

External: Initial penetration into the town of Rawdon signals the birth of the movement in the St. Jerome Metro of the Montreal region, leaving only one metro, St. Hyacinthe, untouched.

Internal: A day of recruitment visiting was supported by prayer-letter writing vigil inside the house, its internal effect reminiscent of the same exercise in Move 222.

Contradiction: The time and troop demands of the external mission have postponed our response to the imperative to be deep into the NSV research project.

EUROPE ✓ International Teaching Team: The Hahn Family

External: Meeting with local churches as recruiting tool for projected RSI produced positive responses -- their clergymen set the context through a personal witness, saying: "the things which I've always preached have come alive in my own life as I've worked with the Ecumenical Institute."

Internal: Great excitement at receiving the NSV reading material which arrived as we finished Otto; have begun shuffling for the right books.

Contradiction: Adequate models for tying together and focusing some of the excitement and power -- need a self-conscious corporate sign.

✓ Religious Outpost: Derby

External: A big new Mowanjum Sign went up as the tall summer grass was cut to put a new face on Mowanjum. Another turn was made by the community collegium when it concensed to continue to determine it's own future in regards to managing and directing their own tribal dances and to join the Aboriginal Theatre Foundation. Government Preliminary Reconaissance team for future survey spent two days looking over Mowanjum and Kummunya. A future yes could mean 1/2 million dollars for cattle and related industry for Mowanjum.

Internal: Celebrated the arrival of a new intern, Phillip Dowsett. House study began for the quarter -- The Idea of the Holy.

Contradiction: Enabling the community to meet the demands of their own decisions requires our style to be more nonchalant while chaos prevails in order for them to make a leap into the future rather than security of the old forms.

✓ Religious House: Perth

External: Significant RSI with 17 including staff opens up possibilities in four new congregations in Perth itself and in one area out in the metro.

Mailing to all grads for RSIIIA completed. Flyer and literature for Aboriginal Heritage Course ready.

Contradiction: Bunbury course collapsing-hope to get those ministers to the PLC.

MALAYSIA ✓ Religious House: Kuala Lumpur

External: Titus Jayasekara, house member, flew to Singapore on one day notice and taught an RSI primarily for the Foochow Congregation. The Works made a five day metro visit north to four cities, speaking with 30 colleagues regarding ITI participation and course recruitment. Strong possibility of first Chinese R C priest and Chinese Methodist Conference minister going to Manila ITI from Malaysia.

Internal: Joe Pierce, the ITI Development Messiah, finally arrived only to tell us that there is no Messiah and we are it.

Contradiction: Exciting local church possibilities and need for colleague nurture in north Malaya (Penang) with distance too great for frequent trips from KL therefore, need one Order couple.

✓ Religious Outpost: Singapore

External: RSI held with 30 participants, all young adults; five congregations represented, with 21 from Foochow; Malaysian faculty member Titus Jayasekara joined teaching staff.

SEAPAC collegiality was dramatized when Mr. and Mrs. Henry Chey of Shum Oi Church, Hong Kong, visiting in Singapore, joined us for dinner on Friday and worship on Sunday at Foochow.

Internal: Christina began an 8 week substitute teaching job at the American School afternoon session; added to her regular morning kindergarten job, it means a 12 hour working day for the next two months.

Contradiction: The Singapore Reginnal Cadre exists but has no clear image of its function or any long range plan for its development.

INDONESIA

✓ Religious Outpost: Djakarta

External: Three key colleagues sent out as delegates and permeators to General Assembly of Council of Churches in Medan where many of the ITI grads will be present as delegates.

Internal: Secured new temporary housing for 9 day period prior to May penetration travel, plus working out financial obligations for past 3 months.

Contradiction: No way to understand the lack of response toward letters sent to key ITI colleagues in early March and again at the end of March re: course schedule.

HONG KONG

✓ Religious Outpost: Hong Kong

External: The three outpost youth have begun an 8 week workshop with 12 Western youth on the youth culture course; a powerful new Hong Kong grid down to sectors has been created.

Fifteen hundred dollars promised with \$500.00 received with the big push to begin next week.

Internal: Preparations have been made for the outpost to fully participate in the screening research for Summer '71.

Contradiction: A comprehensive construct and operating structure for the Hong Kong region.

JAPAN

✓ Religious Outpost: Osaka

External: Pedagogy course in Osaka with 11 participants. Bishop Watahabe of the Hokkaido Episcopal Church offered his name for sponsorship of the ITI. Things seem to be "GO" for Joseph Iida to teach at the Manila ITI.

Internal: Joe Pierce visits outpost -- five people overnight during pedagogy course. Continuing grounding of NRM through study of collegium papers.

Contradiction: Nine courses between now and June in the midst of intensified funding. Yamashita waiting on visa clearance to attend Academy.

Religious Outpost: Fukushima

External: Fukushima sector meeting of 19 people, mostly grads, was held in the Fukushima Anglican Church to consider further training and plans. A follow-up meeting set the date for an RSI in the metro and the beginning dates for studying Saviors of God.

Internal: New weekly time schedule constructed and file system developed.

Contradiction: Absence of a consensed polity system is keeping the region from having a global vision.

TAIWAN

✓ Religious Outpost: Tainan

External: Individual preparation for RSI

Internal: Taiwanese RSI course April 23-24 at Chaghua with 18 participants.

Contradiction: Not wanting to deal with ITI development in that we have yet to build that model.

SAMOA

Religious Outpost: Samoa

✓ Religious Outpost: Majuro

External: Welcomed David McCleskey to Rongrong on Monday. He was delayed two days because Air Micronesia decided not to fly to Majuro on Saturday. The Training Institute for World Churchmen in Micronesia began Wednesday, April 21 with 12 participants from Marshalls and Ponape.

Internal: Celebrated Marilyn's birthday.

Contradiction: The indefinite scheduling of the field trip ships mean that only six Marshallese could come to the training school from the outer islands.
