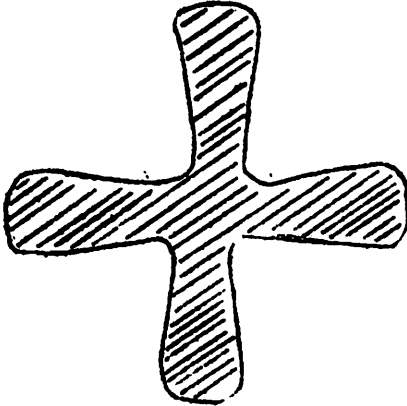

NORTH

Religious House: Milwaukee (Nov. 19-25)

External: Galaxy Consult with 30 people enabled by the youth with all adults except prior couple assigned out.

Internal: Thanksgiving Celebration highlighted by the attendance of Madison outpost, processing around the House in the cole; singing in the Daily Office; reading the Mayflower Compact, and an old-fashioned prayer meeting. Nancy gets job as weight-losers' instructor with two classes of last fat ladies a day.

Contradiction: How to elude the building inspectors in our December time design.

Religious House: Milwaukee (Nov. 26 - Dec. 2)

External: The weekly Metro Cadre meeting hit a new high mood as all systems appeared to be "go" for Winter Quarter.

Internal: PSU on NSV included both the economics of Russia and Proposal #22, Futuric Development.

Contradiction: Inadequate permeation vision and formulation models to sustain our stepped up penetration plans for Winter.

Religious House: Rockford

External: 5 Churches present at Field Visit from Base: 1 old galaxy church and 4 new strong requests, all of whom will be present at training schools. Also significant participation by metro colleagues during Visit.

Internal: Arrival of Bob Rye at the beginning of his intern year and Jeanne Lewis arriving to begin a month of sojourning.

Contradiction: In some ways a delightful contradiction: two pastor families seriously considering internship, the contradiction being in the fact that they are two of the four strong signal church possibilities.

Religious House: Peoria

External: Development Team half-way through week and met goal of \$3,000, in midst of doing radical spirit nurture of metro. Local Church visit clarifies that spirit decision is the key, not promise of success.

Internal: The lease is signed! Glory be to Thee, O Lord! And signal House Church with Development Team and Betty Kersh, returning from Acad.

Contradiction: Getting people broken loose to Training School 9 days away and to Regional Council in 3 days.

Religious House: Champaign/Urbana

External:

Religious House: Minneapolis

External: In building a model for "Spirit Colleague" formulation at the Sector level, we discovered Adult RSI grads in all 36 sectors, and clergy grads in 29 of them, and have begun working on two families per sector as key to regional formulation. "72 in 72" becomes context for Academy recruitment.

Internal: Arrival of Paul Dietrich Gergen, born Nov. 26 to Mr. and Mrs. Michael Gergen. Last assigned job begun. First guest night held.

Contradiction: Enabling projected 500% increase in RSI's in Winter Quarter, while finishing uncompleted Fall Quarter Research.

Religious House: Detroit

External: As plans for Regional Council were finalized, a 90 degree angle turn was made to focus on missional strategy evaluation and planning for Winter Quarter.

Internal: Happening of Thanksgiving, in context of intensive PSU work on Communal Wisdom occurred at the collision point between the explosion of the future in midst of celebration of past heritage and imperatives of present in the midst of the articulation of historical contradictions in specific social form.

Contradiction:

Religious House: CCleveland

Religious House: Indianapolis

External: 20 colleagues from 4 sectors going to Regional Council; struggling with 5 possibilities for Galaxy, deciding the necessary configuration for history. Clergy cadre entered into covenant to be responsible for PLC recruitment in Indianapolis.

Internal: shifted to December Order Council with Canonical Hours, 5:30 rising, breakfast/collegium, evening family buffet, research and planning council in evenings. This week conducted quarter evaluation and celebrated with ice-skating and Shaky's Pizza.

Contradiction: How in the midst of old colleagues do you call forth symbolic leadership?

Religious House: Cincinnati

External: Odyssey proved to be signal event for Metro participants by enabling new decision for depth commitment and by signalling emergence of potential iron leadership. Louisville Module conducted an Ecclesiola for 22 grads, out of which came new decisions by laymen and clergy to take responsibility for movement in Louisville. Lord has shown us how much of a possibility the Galaxy really is by having 4 potential churches say "yes" to participating in the experiment.

Internal: 25 adults and 11 children showed up for the House Ecclesiola after a quarter of beggin Metro colleagues to participate. The crowded conditions heightened the sense of collegiality and people actually par- in the "St. John of the Cross" conversation. Blocks being removed from all sides and a house (religious type) is about to be secured.

Contradiction: All events of the past week actually point to the Lord letting us win --- Contradiction: experiencng the life urge instead of death urge in the midst of winning.

Religious House: Kansas City

External: All 41 people invited to Local Church Visit came, all had positive response. With 5 churches present, the question of the hour is, "Can we=be it?" Clergy guild, last of 4 sessions held with Visitation Team, being very helpful in the few minutes they had before running to airport.

Internal: Bishop James Mathews spends evening spinning stories of Mathews' boys' journeys through Ada; Langtree, Texas and the hills of Virginia.

C Thanksgiving weekend house renovation adds 9 rooms to House; rewiring task (previously est: \$1,180 job) led by a 51-year old Mother-in-law sojourner; new wall inspirèd new black-on-white 7'x4' regional grid.

Contradiction: experiencing victimage relative to getting research task completed.

EAST

Religious House: Rochester

Religious House: Boston

External: House and Regional colleagues gathered during WkI in the second of 3 PSU's to push on regional tactical system battleplans for winter. Follow-up of pastors who attended the continental visit turns up inter-ested potential galaxy pastors. Extensive PLC drive launched for Jan. course.

Internal: Commissioned Portland and Manchester Outpostsfamilies and sent them to their new location. Gogarten spinning the house to new depths and becoming a close meditative colleague as in responsibility to God for the world intensifies activity during discontinuous month.

Contradiction:

External: Galaxy prospects careful and continuous nurture. Recruitment for Regional Council sees 17 strong colleagues of metro.

External: Working on battleplans for 36 regional tactic dynamics.

Internal: Moving to breezy 3rd floor apartment in Portland; holes in walls but great view of the Bay. Address: 20 Sheridan St. #3, Portland, Maine 04101; Phone; 207-772-6083.

Contradiction: Child care and heat.

Religious House: Pittsburgh

External: Preparation of invitation for first Open House. Planning session with Regional coordinator for upcoming regional meeting.

Internal: House wrote another chapter in "Coming of Age in Pittsburgh" with its first Odyssey attended by 10 house participants and 10 regional colleagues. Grappled with upagaintsness of Pittsburgh hills with advent of first snow. Celebrated first Thanksgiving with proclamation of regional colleagues stating that "like many missionaries of the past, we see that you have already carried off many of our women folk and much of our treasure."

Contradiction: Waiting for churches to make critical galaxy decisions when time is so critical.

Religious House: PhiladelphiaReligious House: New York

External: Preparing House and Region for Regional Council so that it will be the sign to all of radical possibility.

Internal: Quarter Evaluation was occasion for the realization of the Promise in the Word that new life is given to all who look directly into their actual situation.

Contradiction: Creating signs of momentum in month of discontinuity for Winter discontinuity.

Religious House: Washington D.C.

External: Sending out Galaxy pastor couple Perry and Joyce Miller to Miami Metro for participation in Local Church Consult.

Internal: House celebrated the end of our Fall teaching quarter with purchase of new set of spirit movement red dishes, and the hanging of the Order Cross along with new decor in the Great Hall.

Contradiction: Lack of adequate context for bulk mailman holds up Regional Council mailings.

Religious House: Montreal

External: 1st RSI pedagogy course offered in Montreal region uncovers 17 emerging pedagogues.

Internal: Initiated discontinuous Time Design for December with completion of research projects as a priority.

Contradiction: How to produce quality in the midst of onslaught of demands.

Religious House: Toronto

External: Seven pastors indicate serious intent to be Galaxy Church.

Internal: Surprise bowling party and hanging of the greens celebrates the end of the teaching quarter and "on-timeness" of research assignments.

NORTHWEST

Religious House: Winnipeg

External: 1st Odyssey of this year deepens collegiality in Region. 4 Churches for LCX beginning January 1st clearly identified and ready to go.

Internal: Renewal House decor in preparation for Open House. We'll. "Happy Hour" takes on increasing Canadian flavour.

Contradiction: How to finish up 6-8 weeks of NSV with 2 weeks left.

WEST

Religious House: Seattle

External: Participated in small but signal Regional Council at Portland; a more rational and less suicidal Winter Course calendar condensed on and Regional Communication net set up.

Internal: celebrated first week in new house with re-ordering of internal models and hosting galaxy for House Church in our new Great Hall; welcomed sojourner Tim Crane and visits from regional colleagues, clergy guild and wives welcomed, NSV Research on Middle East Political completed.

Contradiction: Maintaining Poverty and Detachment in relating to new facility while pressing on to finish NSV Proposal and Winter battleplan.

Religious House: BillingsReligious House: Rapid CityReligious House: San Francisco

External: Tenth and last course of Fall Qtr. came off with 31 participants making it the second largest and also most varied in age span, with participants ranging from 10-70. Regional Office kept spinning with preparation of Regional Councils and mailing of PLC brochure with 25 clergy endorsements from all 6 metros.

Internal: House was center of activity over Thanksgiving with the senior Order youth of Area West congregating; a three day Thanksgiving celebration and NSV PSU on Proposal 32, "Interior Structures," which intensified the struggle and the vision of the family for the next 1000 years.

Contradiction: Creating sustaining dynamics for Dec. evaluation and planning month while maintaining metro engagement for recruitment and form.

Religious House: Denver

External: 3 galaxy clergy couples assist in continental consults in San Fran, Blgs, and Amarillo and one in attendance at Great Britain's Nat'l Presidium.

Internal: Baby Luke Travis Gilbert arrives midst pedagogy in time for gala Thanksgiving celebration.

Contradiction: House has not enabled Denver metro to assume responsibility for penetration.

Religious House: Los Angeles

External: In midst of plans for Regional Council significant decision by region to embody the demand to formulate the metros. Phoenix Region planning for Regional Council happening.

Internal: New depths of awareness of enabling dynamical relationship of Knowing and Doing pushes us to deeper levels of Being in Odyssey.

Congradiction:

SOUTH

Religious House: Oklahoma City

External: Regional Council held on Dec. 3-4 with 60 people at the end of a snowstorm which paralyzed some outer metros. Fri evening we saw "Bless the Beasts and the Children" and spent 3 meal conversations on it, ending up seeing that we have to be the transestablishment bringing into being the new society.

Internal: All house Council created new sense of one house in the region in 3 locations; Tulsa and Amarillo colleagues no longer guests but house members.

Religious House: Amarillo

External: 1st meeting of Metro Presidium marks shift to new depths of corporate responsibility for planning for winter quarter.

Internal: "3 in 1" Thanksgiving celebration and planning with Oklahoma City and Tulsa Houses recollects blessings of past and looks to possibilities of the future.

Contradiction: Looking beyond possible to necessary in terms of December school, Presidium and Academy.

Religious House: Tulsa

External: Field Visit for LC Project came off, impacting new and old colleagues with globality and the comprehensive. On the other side of visit have gotten yes answer from Souther Baptist clergy for 13 week training construct. PLC recruitment strategies for Winter taking solid form with concrete recruitment to start full tilt in a few days.

Internal: Arrival of our first intern family: Hallelujah! along with a sojourner for a month, has swelled our ranks and again pointed out need for large permanent facility.

Contradiction: In the middle of people arriving and preparing to leave for training school, having to pick up and move to another temporary facility.

Religious House: Houston

Religious House: New Orleans

External: Continental Development arrives in the Crescent City! In form of Bill Holmes and Bill Ragsdale. Great opportunity made available for old regional hands to have their context exploded and for recent course grads to define their financial relationship to the Global Spirit Movement.

Internal: 2 Division nights of evaluation preceded WkII PSU in which the 6 year pene. and form. requirements of the reg. movement were objectified. Planning for Regional Council flowed out of the data assembled in PSU. Issues to be dealt with at Regional Council include: state of the global movement, 50 year vision of region, recruitment net and communications net. Gift in Fall evaluation and planning was being able to plan for particular events and still hold intact our comprehensive context.

Contradiction: How to enable the region to sense that structures are not an end in themselves, but are only designed to bring off particular calendar events; fall regional guilds became a bureaucratic opportunity to limit individual responsibility for regional movement. Bringing the New Social Vehicle into being is the ultimate issue.

Religious House: Atlanta (Nov. 19-25)

External: Local Church Field Visit held with 4 clergymen and one lay couple. Busy Wk II with 20 young churchmen in CSIIIA, 20 signal RSIIIA and a visit to the House by 30 member Sociology class from Erskine College.

Internal: Presence of Judy Hess during Week I adds significantly to the dynamic of House as research on the Historical Order generates excitement.

Contradiction: Naming and defeating the demon of course shrinkage, or how to turn rocks into colleagues when they all want to be rocks.

Religious House: Atlanta

External: Held metro college night at the House with all returning Academy grads present.

Internal: Powerful Thanksgiving celebration held with 4 guests, highlighted by reading and artforming the Mayflower Compact. A knocking in the night revealed a new sojourner, Anna McPherson, just returned from Academy.

Contradiction: How to enable clergymen to decide to go to December Training School in Chicago while struggling to build recruitment models for massive winter course schedule.

Religious House: Miami

External: All attention focused on preparation for the first regional presidium in Orlando, the first Local Church Field visit in Miami, the First regional Council in Miami and the scheduled development team. Isn't this the end of the quarter?

Internal: The house celebrated Thanksgiving with a pie-baking fest, worship and then dinner with regional colleagues, the Scott Stahr family (Summer '68). The Mayflower Compact was read during the feast--alongside the pool.

Contradiction: Should we have one PLC or two next quarter?

EUROPE

Religious House: London

External: A day long conference of Teesside Council of Churches made exciting contacts for the movement in Britain and especially Teesside, opening strong possibilities for 8 consults and 2 courses.

Internal: Reflection on the words of St. Paul to the Corinthians and St. John of the Cross relative to weakness and brooding on England's gifts to the west heighten our awareness that our weakness is what the Lord demands.

Contradiction: The need to have courses in 36 metros across Britain to catalyze the Spirit Movement and local church experiment over against limited mobility and troop strength.

GLOBAL EAST

SEAPAC

Religious House: Sydney

AUSTRALIA

External: RS-1's in Grafton and Sydney Metros. Participants and faculty addressed by the power of the course.

Internal: Wednesday morning pedagogy highlighted as the House views the Film "This Man" and participates in art form conversation.

Contradiction: How to fill the gaps in the front line, with troops out sick, and on teaching and formulation trips.

Religious House: Perth

External: Rejoice with strong RS-1 at South Fremantle. Signal regional roles in teaching and enablement staffs.

Internal: Five guests at House Church include the celebrant, Baptist pastor Pedro Aquino and family and recent RS-1 grad, Dr. Padma Rameshina.

Contradiction: How to get re-wound for the rest of the quarter.

Religious House: DerbyReligious Outpost: Melbourne

External: 40 grads present at Melbourne "4th Annual Celebration" at the Australia Hotel were deeply addressed by the corporate style of the outpost colleagues and the strong show of interest from many old and unsuspected friends. 13 clergymen were present at the Southlands Macro Clergy Consult led by John Hannon, Lendsey Pace and David Morton on "Methods of Parish Planning and Its Theology." The decision to cancel Dec. 3 RS-1 was postponed a week during which 15 registrations and 7 possibles were recruited.

Internal: Summer recruiting picks up momentum with 20 "likely" prospects but much hedging on final commitments and registrations.

Contradiction: Trying to remember during visitations whether the visitor is recruiting for RS-1, Summer '72, or the celebration dinner--or all three.

PACIFICA

Religious Outpost: Apia

External: Preparations for summer are going well as the brochure for the Pacifica Training Institute is completed and marking is done for end-of-year grades.

Internal: Breakthrough on clarity of specific task in proposal writing. Also, Outpost celebration reveals our discriminating taste in movies.

Contradiction: Lateness of brochure blocks calling and, therefore, slows up recruitment.

Religious Outpost: Majuro

JAPAN

Religious Outpost: Sendai

External: Preparation launched for mid-January RS-1. A planning meeting for upcoming Regional Council re-enforced in regional colleagues the image of total responsibility for leadership of the movement. New mood of serious reflection pervaded local catalytic cadre as it began its new scriptural study of the Gospel of St. John.

Religious Outpost: Sendai cont'd.

Internal: New Church season brings shift in House decor and a spirit conversation yielding a new sense after penance.

Contradiction: Allowing authentic leadership of the movement to emerge "as the sons of God coming into their own." Train pedagogues. . .train pedagogues. . .

Religious Outpost: Osaka

External: Full week with PLC of 26 in Fukuoka (island of Kyushu) and 33 in RS-1 in Tokyo signaling the ending of the teaching Quarter with 65 persons through PLC's during the Fall.

Internal: Quiet with all assigned out for teaching: now planning the design for the planning month both for regions and house.

Contradiction: Creating the Myths, rites and symbols to deal with the Spirit Problem of Japanese Christians who by that very decision are outside the social order and are torn by the tension--the need is for self-conscious embracement of that as a gift.

Religious Outpost: Tainan

HONG KONG

Religious Outpost: Hong Kong

External: Open House for over 100 regional colleagues on the first Sunday of Advent and filling pulpit at Kowloon Union Church the same day.

Internal: On completion of NSV proposal writing we celebrated by going to the night market, the walled city, the Peninsula Hotel for dessert, and a mountain top for a spectacular view of nearly all the region.

Contradiction: How to enable the region to take responsibility for the courses and have fully recruited courses immediately.

MALAYSIA

Religious House: Kuala Lumpur

External: Continued visitation to set up this week's pedagogy guild and to recruit December RS-1. Attended Selangor Council of Churches fellowship dinner. Designed Area Newsletter with regional colleagues.

Internal: Earned one month salary of substitute teaching at International School (equivalent to 3 Malaysian scale jobs). Renewed contact with colleague Mother Lawrence to research Convent of the Holy Infant Jesus. Celebrated Malay Muslim feast day, Hari Raya Pular.

Contradiction: How to affirm while blasting loose evangelical pious colleagues.

SINGAPORE

Religious Outpost: Singapore

External: Spent a busy week in the Katong Metro: Wednesday, met with St. Hilda's (Anglican) corporate pastorate; Saturday, Christina was guest speaker at the Ecumenical Fellowship at R.C. church; Sunday, Don was guest preacher at Christ Methodist; and Tuesday, met for lunch with men from Christ Methodist.

Internal: Shared a great Thanksgiving celebration (turkey and trimmings) with 3 Chinese colleagues, who enjoyed the food as an introduction to an American tradition.

Contradiction: With the PLC only 4 days away, the only appropriate text is Luke 14: 16-24, with vs. 23 raising the question of "How?"

PHILIPPINES Religious Outpost: Manila

External: Mega/Micro Net calling continues. Brochure held up due to sickness of printer. It sure is a blessing to have control of your own printing. Manila Presidium meeting in preparation for Dec. grad meeting shows increasing commitment on part of these colleagues.

Internal: Birthday and deaths celebrated in House Church lift up again the gifts of standing before the constants of life.

Contradiction:

SUB-ASIA Religious Outpost: Bombay Urban Ashram

INDIA External: Penetrated three new regions with courses and consults in Area West: Ahmedabad, Rajkot, and Aurangabad regions. Development in Area Central: Nagpur region and Area North: Delhi region.

Internal: At a dinner given by Bishop Joshi the House sent out Dr. and Mrs. Robert Leslie, Pacific School of Religion, from their three month teaching experience in Bangalore.

Contradiction: Developing the style methods of the House and creating the time in the midst of Penetration and Development schedules in order to catalyze the decisions of twelve families to undergo intensive movemental training.

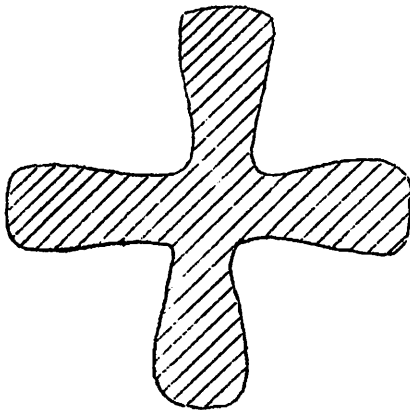
Contradiction: Movement training schools and Continental Presidium are occasions of intensive engagement.

Religious House: Milwaukee (Dec. 3-9)

External: RSI recruiting reveals old colleagues who did not know RSI was being taught in Milwaukee. Now they know that and more.

Internal: Into the "other world" with Gogarten every morning this week led us into depth reflection on the Jesus Christ Word. Hosted Waukesha L.C. Cadre at Ecclesiola (the oldest cadre in the Spirit Movement) --- they all wanted to come back next week!

Contradiction: Lack of comprehensive training models.

Religious House: Milwaukee (Dec. 10-16)

External: Recruited in 3 sectors for their winter RSI's. Fall RSI Monday night follow-up sessions hit a new spirit high. Academy registrations from the Metro reach 9.

Internal: Finished our research assignment by doing an additional Wk II PSU. Ecclesiola witnessed spirit-filled Christmas carols.

Contradiction: Lack of image for Winter Quarter.

Religious House: Peoria

External: A week of weaving warp and woof of recruitment puts new and old grads to work.

Internal: First House Church in new house brought our first guest. The address was that the intentional use of symbols is the power of the Church.

Contradiction: Enabling Metro planning to be one thrust.

Religious House: Champaign/Urbana

Religious House: Minneapolis

External: First Regional Council held in region in which 5 out of 6 metros were represented by 32 people, signalling the emergence of regional consciousness.

Internal: Long, long hours of burning mid-night oil over proposal writing brings out steadfastness in sticking to the task in midst of overwhelming demand to complete work.

Contradiction: Lack of model that would enable us to complete the Research in NSV, China Political, and Maryknoll Order and at the same time to recruit RSI the first week of holiday-recovering Winter quarter.

Religious House: Detroit

External: RSI and Academy recruitment intensified, generating many possibilities but few registrations.

Internal: PSU completed the research proposal on philosophical humanities despite shortage of troops. We sense in a new way what it means to live in the city, as well as the need to bring off the proposals we developed.

Contradiction: Suburban families see the need for RSI but refuse to come into the city for a weekend.

Religious House: Cleveland

Religious House: Indianapolis

Religious House: Cincinnati

External: Chicago Training School participation, massive penetration in West Lafayette and Mansfield, PLC recruitment days in Louisville and Columbus and modular activity in Piqua reminded us of need for the community to be scattered to be about the Church's task.

Internal: We accepted the Lord's assignment to: 501 Garrard St., Covington, Ky 41011 and moved 6 families into the "now in being" Cincinnati Religious House", a structure which is magnificent, dignified, artistic, well-built, in good repair and generally magnificent to behold. NSV research and document writing sessions have mustered new affirmation of creative writing. Sessions were most productive when we trusted in the methodologies

Contradiction: Resisting the temptation to unpack, settle, arrange, organize, decor and enjoy our house while doing NSV research "around the edges."

Religious House: Kansas City

External: Region picks up calling -- LCE pastors and regional colleagues make up teams for recruitment. House team embarks on Academy and Course recruitment week-long circuit ride--horse collapses in Salina.

Internal: NSV/PSU Week II allows house to corporately overcome our victim image and convinces us that all men need RSI (Proposal #4: Self Awareness: Basic Decision).

Contradiction: Region is running from spirit odyssey.

EAST

Religious House: Rochester

External: 4 Regional people to Continental Presidium. 1st prior family to continental training; academy recruitment off the ground and moving.

Internal: Week II research on SEAPAC in area of Communal Wisdom ended with a tree decorating-cookie baking-rosette making-candy making-symbol creating-song writing House decorating party.

Religious House: Rochester (cont.)

Contradiction: Switching regional colleagues' image of the summer recruitment from "we're finished" to "we begin again".

External: Mailing out to 250 clergymen for the PLC in 1972! Planning with Applecross cadre an end-of-year celebration. House working on Summer 72 image and constructs.

Internal: House prepares for dispersal. Youth spend a week camping at Roleystone in the Darling Ranges while adults have discontinuous Saturday at the beach. Work-Collegium on Sat. saw all house out pulling weeds in the yard at 4:30. Christine Hughes put on train for summer. Childrens' structures continue in full force. Last House Church before Summer- sent out all but the Rippels.

Contradiction: Communicating the radicality of the movement to the region and historical church.

Religious House: Derby

External: The Nowanjum Community has begun decoring for Christmas while 97 bullocks and 1 Brahman bull are added to the cattle herd, 154 major accomplishments listed for the Bungungul Quarter and final Ecclesiola celebrates the end of YEAR ONE. Community Elders spend weekend planning 1972 in Broome despite Cyclone Sally.

Internal: House teams set up to bring off the last 3 weeks of the Quarter. Proposal writing for funding from Canberra continues for capital loans for economic projects.

External: Preparations underway for next weekends RS-1. A core of regional Chinese colleagues met one afternoon to plan for the 3 Chinese courses (Im. Ed., RS-1, L.C.) which will be run consecutively the week after Christmas.

Internal: Carol began her job as secretary for the American Chamber of Commerce, which enables the mission side of our budget to be renewed.

Contradiction: In the light of the need to teach courses during Christmas holidays, how to structure in an "off month" for reflection and respiration.

External: House and 3 regional colleagues enable and teach first English RS-1 in the region for 19 months. Twenty Western and Eastern

session Pedagogical Training Institute with decision to continue in Jan.

Internal: Franciscan sisters and Chinese teachers attended Ecclesiola and were caught up in the address of the Gogarten study. David and Betsy

Morton were present for House Church reminding us of the farthest corners of Seapac and Australia's summer program.

MALAYSIA

Religious House: Kuala Lumpur

Religious Outpost: Singapore

PHILIPPINES Religious Outpost: Manila

External: Philippine ITI graduates meeting held in Manila. A depth push on using the ITI tools in the Philippines. Common Island wide course schedule created. Full report in preparation.

Internal: Many demands of Advent diffuse house thrust, yet build excitement plus vision of house role in complex renewal effort. Psalms an address to house and grads.

Contradiction: Regular scheduling and recruitment of courses.

SUB-ASIA Religious Outpost, Bombay Urban Ashram (Nov. 29-Dec. 5)

INDIA External: Our 10 week teaching quarter is completed with 14 courses, 303 course grads; 3 consults, 115 consult grads; and two area meetings in Areas East and South.

Internal: The House becomes the hub for spirit care as 5 out of 8 visitors last week decide to attend RSI in Bombay in Week 9.

Contradiction: As the teaching-development teams return to the house, we discover the need to completely reimage in the minds of our colleagues that development is grassroots support of genuine global human needs.

Religious Outpost: Bombay Urban Ashram (Dec. 6-12)

External: The House kicked off the ITI '72 timeline by making 10 visits to possible sites in Bombay.

Internal: Week 10 house evaluation/planning was intensified with a three-day fast during Week II and climaxed by Gogarten study of Chapter 12, "Jesus and History".

Contradiction: While doing evaluation/planning in midst of the national emergency, how do you create an appropriate spirit network to care for the whole of the sub-continent?

AMERICA External: A meeting was held with 3 colleagues to lay plans for a metro catalytic cadre in Caracas. The Covenant Group gestalted data toward a 6 month timeline.

CARACAS

Internal: House Decor finally taking shape. Permanent visas will be received in 2 months, hopefully.

Contradiction: Maintaining corporate study.

Religious Outpost: Caracas (Dec. 6-12)

External: Covenant group builds a 6 month timeline to be implemented Jan. 1. Caracas Metro catalytic cadre has first meeting with 8 present.

Internal: House Church continues to be held with invited colleagues from Region.

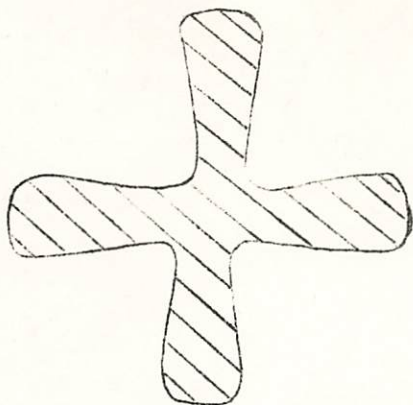
Contradiction: Accountability/Absolution structures tend to become abstract.

Academy recruitment reaches halfway mark toward goal of 300.

The Wendell Refior and Jim Meyers family were sent out to Sydney, Australia. The coming of Christmas was realized with decoration of a giant pine, hanging of the greens, decorations created by families appearing in all the halls and stairways, and the return of many Order youth to Base.

Contradiction: Creating the models which organize Order Base troops at two locations, holding the values of the congregation-station experiment and effectively continuing the missional task.

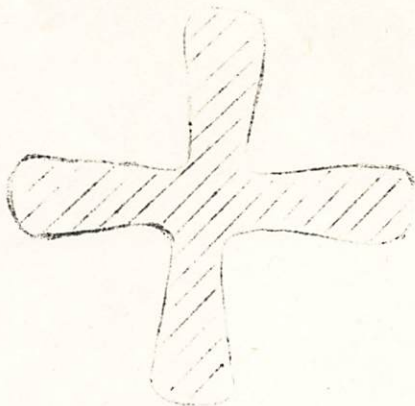
