GLOBAL WEST

United States

NORTH

Religious House: Chicago North

External: Over 20 colleagues from Milwaukee metro in Winter Academy.

Internal: Finalizing of quarter time design which gives Divisions a work night on Wed. in addition to regular meeting explodes fantastic possibilities for the next 3 months. Exciting plans for participation of House in season of Epiphany come out of the meeting of combined Chicago House.

Contradiction: Being well into the quarter's work with factual models not yet finished.

Religious House: Chicago South

External: Intensive recruitment for January PLC, seminarian weekend, base advanced courses, and RS-1 in the region and at Base.

Internal: Symbolized the opening of Epiphany and the end of Week I with the Base Ecclesiola 3 and the House meeting at the House for the beginning festivities of the Williams-Moore wedding.

Contradiction: Maintaining intentionality and decorum in the midst of the miracles of the wedding at Cana.

Religious House: Rockford

Religious House: Cleveland

External: Cleveland Metro experienced its largest week since courses have been offered here: 130 through courses, including 45 registered for the PLC. The Black Church was represented significantly in both the RS-1 and PLC.

Internal: Intensive model building going on in all the sectors in response to the intensified demands of Winter Quarter. The Black Penetration team has been with the House while they work with the Black Church in the Cleveland Metro. They and two of the three clergy from the Phase II black church celebrated House Church with us Sunday night.

Contradiction: Adequate formulation models for course follow-up in the midst of all the other demands.

Religious House: Detroit

External: During Week II the House, along with 16 regional colleagues participated in the continental celebration marking the beginning of the experiment. During Week I a regional trip and the Black Academy Team visits resulted in 3 new RS-1's being set up. A high point was Friday with the completion of our galaxy with 2 more churches.

Internal: It was a "God" week with Elaine Hockley in the hospital for removal of a tumor and the sending out of one of our regional interns.

Contradiction: The struggle to decide that we have enough knowledge and troops to move ahead in the experiment.

Religious House: Kansas City

External: First auxiliary trip - to Omaha and Lincoln. A successful trip in spite of the semi which encountered them on the way.

Internal: Began quarter with new division rationale - with a heavy downbeat on formulation.

Contradiction: Meeting the demands of the 6-front war (new division rationale) with limited troops.

The Alvin Williams Family: Iowa

Had second session of RS-I follow-up in Perry with 10 good possibilities for upcoming RSIIIA. Recruitment in Des Moines and Pella continues for both RS-I & RSIIIA.

Internal: Quarter evaluation and plans for winter quarter completed. Being snowed in for 2 days came as a great gift of time that we had not expected.

Contradiction: Methods to create enthusiasm for the upcoming courses in the midst of below zero weather and much snow.

EAST Religious House: Boston

External: Understanding the total design of sodality function relative to region while actually acting out that function in the region.

Internal: Spent week in preparation for weekend of Loc. Ch. galaxy meeting and Friday nite group and how it is we practically handle that number as well as also sending most of House out into region to do calling to make room for those coming in.

Religious House: New York

External: First week of Local Church project training sessions exposed disciplined commitment of cadremen and their willingness to reorder time around the project.

Internal: Epiphany Feast of fruits, bread and cheeses celebrated abundance of life in the Word.

Contradiction: Continuing the momentum of region into a signal quarter of penetration.

Religious House: Washington, D.C.

Religious House: Rochester

External: Meeting with Phase II congregation to obtain second level permission. All systems go!

Internal: Welcomed a new intern family and our first sojourner and ushered in the new year by celebrating the world, the movement, and the house with regional colleagues.

Contradiction: Observing, judging, weighing up, deciding, and acting on galaxy and regional demands.

The Simms Family: Sommerville

External: Harrison resumed role of imaginal education consultant to Postal Academy during interim month at Tufts.

Internal: Family discontinuity - Harrison in Dayton, Ohio and Nancy and Patrice at Order Base.

The Howard Family: Philadelphia

WEST Religious House: Los Angeles

External: Three consecutive open houses enabled many new and old grads to experience ecclesiola construct. Many possibilities for Sector ecclesiolas in L.A. metro.

Internal: Four day trip to Mexico gave 16 adults plus children of the house a chance for reflection around a roaring fireplace, impaction of small village midnight Christmas mass, and experience of Mexican culture.

Possibility: Creation of modules and quarter battle-planning gives new possibility in midst of immense penetration/formulation task.

Religious House: San Francisco

External: Local church sodality, galactic weekend council, and 30 resurrected "old grads" in one week point to cruciality of the local church experiment.

Internal: House studied Gealy New Testament paper bringing even more excitement into breakfast scripture conversations.

Contradiction: Holding tension between grounding movement memory and vision and overwhelming multiplicity of immediate demands.

Religious House: Seattle

External: The New Year's Eve celebration with 25 regional colleagues was an experience of awe-filled and ecstatic ritualizing. Highlight of the evening was the midnight procession beginning with the Common Litany, continuing with historical Church and spirit songs, along with gong and bell ringing and ending with the Seattle Religious House's own litany.

Contradiction: Lack of adequate space for intensified activities and prospective interns.

Religious House: Denver

External: 25 PLC recruitment calls, regional cadre formulation guild builds model, grads and prospects have been recorded on the infamous IBM card of vocations conversation, permeation model for 19 churches developed.

Internal: Tribal resettlement enacts detachment and winter arrangement for prep school and Monk-for-a-Month; Week II enables RS-I recruitment (included a surprise wedding reception on a call), PLC nurture and recruitment, youth Week II model for winter quarter.

Contradiction: Below zero weather and blizzard alters car, heating and assignment models; moving into full schedule after missional discontinuity and decreased house forces.

SOUTH Religious House: Atlanta

External: Columbia PLC held with 7 clergy when 8 other pre-paid registrants failed to arrive.

Internal: Reports from Joe Pierce during his visit after PLC and regular rehearsal of the canonical offices during Week II held us over the global movement and historical religious while building quarter tactical plans.

Contradiction: Addressing the despair of the clergy while recruiting for RS-I.

Religious House: New Orleans

External: Movement exploding - galaxy meeting with 52 people in attendance on same weekend which saw 4 metros visited by house members and 3 of them picking up responsibility for courses with old grads coming out of hiding with new decisions.

Internal: Began quarter with new divisions, time design, and polity construct.

Contradiction: How maintain one thrust when missional objectives are so diversified.

Religious House: HoustonNo ReportReligious House: Oklahoma City

External: Marked beginning of galaxy with New Year's Eve celebration. First formal meeting Monday night with 18 present representing all four churches. Teams and units organized for enablement and leadership of each coming session. Timeline for quarter layed out.

Internal: Arrival of Friars and expectation of two new intern families necessitated expansion to a "fourth floor" (one block down the street) of the Mansion to house 5 single family units and two families.

Contradiction: Juggling cars to cover the distances and bodies to cover the assignments to keep all of the balls spinning in the air at once.

CANADACanada EastReligious House: MontrealNo ReportCanada WestReligious House: Winnipeg

External: Took leadership role at a Mennonite youth conference at Moose Lake, Manitoba. Conducted RS-1 recruitment seminar with 6 clergy from the Winnipeg metro.

Internal: Built recruitment model for Feb. RS-1 with a goal of 50 participants. Put down initial stakes re a nurture model for 70 key course grads.

Contradiction: Keeping a balance of our manpower expenditure between penetration and formulation.

EUROPEInternational Team: Hahn Family

External: Christmas letters out to key colleagues on continent.

Internal: Visit from Mathews and Townley on their way to Addis Ababa helped catch us up on recent Order work and look to the future.

Contradiction: Winter courses in two more regions.

GLOBAL EASTAUSTRALIAReligious House: Sydney

External: Buses "Pachomius" (from Sydney) and "Anthony" (from Adelaide) crossed the desert to Perth for the Summer Programme - adults and children. High School Youth to Mowanjum, Primary School children on 3-states car-camping journey, pre-schoolers & Kindergarteners at Sydney House.

Internal: Malina Richmond arrived in House assigned to childrens' faculty. Ecclesiola three nights by three people assigned to House. New Year's Eve celebration raising significant events of past year and imperatives for 1971. Guests included Robert Shropshire briefly between flights to Perth and Father Noel Mansfield and Sr. Anne O'Brian at House Church.

Contradiction: Structuring enablement for children's programme - House & external tasks. State mail disruption.

Religious Outpost: DerbyNo Report

MALAYSIA

Religious House: Kuala Lumpur

External: Monsoon rains lasting for 5 days have caused extensive flooding and the country has virtually come to a standstill with K.L. isolated except for air travel - state of national emergency declared by the Prime Minister.

Internal: Odyssey held for regional colleagues - a first for Malaysia and also children's structures held for the children at the same time - again a first for the region. Extensive quarterly planning held for five days culminating in sending forth the Singapore Outpost, staffed by the Clarks, the Penang Satellite, staffed by the Knutsens, and the Kuala Lumpur Centrum, staffed by the Works, Carol Walters, and the youth assigned to Malaysia, as initiating experimentation of the Religious House dynamic within the Malaysian context.

Contradiction: Actualizing models through timelines and battleplans within crisis existing within the country - i.e. Clarks have been stranded for Week 1 of the quarter in a remote town somewhere between K.L. and Singapore.

Sign: Participated in a special celebration on Jan. 1st to mark the beginning of the local church experiment in N.A. and sent out George Walters for travel through SEAPAC with destination Korea.

SINGAPORE

Religious Outpost: Singapore

External: Completed final week of Quarter planning in K.L. with: 1. House goals, strategies, tactics and timeline; 2. Self-support budget; 3. Quarter teaching assignments; 3. Local church experiment celebration on Jan. 1 highlighted by attendance at Mass.

Internal: Creation of new image of House as enabling dynamic in two regions, composed of K.L. Centrum, Singapore Outpost, and mobile regional satellite make two week visits in homes of colleagues.

Contradiction: Being marooned by floods for four days in Segamat, halfway between K.L. and Singapore.

HONG KONG

Religious Outpost: Hong Kong

External: Both Kenneth and Katherine Fung (Holy Nativity Church - ITI:HK) are teaching in the Summer 71 program in Perth, Australia.

Internal: Decision by Kwok Nai Wang and Kwok Tao Lai while they were in Chicago to become part of the Global Order and to experiment as the religious in the local church.

Contradiction: Postponement of the Odyssey (although with 14 registrations) in order to enable a broader base of the movement to attend.

JAPAN

Religious Outpost: Osaka

External: Course recruitment and enablement model completed.

Internal: House Advent-Christmas celebration culminated in attending Midnight Mass. Building construct for the next quarter's collegium, grounding of NSV, NRM in cultural setting, brooding on what are the basic questions we need to deal with. Children's holiday education emphasized community-polis including gridding and problematting of the neighborhood.

Contradiction: Developing comprehensive house financing model

Sign: ITI potential list now includes 45 persons.

External: Osaka Cadre began once-a-month experiment with Eucharist Celebration.

Internal: Seminary study on Heer completed. Study of Church History papers being held in interim until word comes on next Order study. Participated in Japanese New Year (primary celebration of Japan) by Inui's returning to house of the family (father's) - the most important part of the 3 day festivities - and the Morrills visiting Meiji Shrine in Tokyo along with thousands.

Contradiction: How to fund coming Seapac Research Assembly both nationally and internally, and how to deal with course conflicts because of the dates set for it, as it falls in the middle of our teaching schedule.

Sign: Breaking-down of traditional structures of R.C. orders, as yet in beginning stages, making openness to possibility of new structures to take their places.

TAIWAN

Religious Outpost: Tainan

External: At Phok-Ai Church Xmas celebration, 6 people representing the 6 Urs told what Jesus would have done if he had been born in their culture. Participation in Seminary Xmas events. George McDonald (Summer 69 Academy 5) had special celebration and house guests for Xmas.

Contradiction: Tired after Xmas and having to gear up for island consultation II.

Sign: George's gift from his (non-movement) wife of a framed, hand embroidered, family coat-of-arms.

SAMOA

Religious Outpost: Western Samoa

External: Preparing for orientation week with new teachers.

Internal: Discontinuity of several days as solitary/family opens up depths.

Contradiction: Planning and scheduling without some critical data, or ambiguity is a great gift.

MARSHALL ISLANDS

Religious Outpost: Majuro

External: On the island of Ebeye, Kwajelein in midst of a series of 4 evening lectures with Jude Sampson's (ITI Sing.) congregation (80 persons), a series of 5 2-hour sessions with school teachers (10), and 3 speaking engagements (Women's Fellowship of 50, Youth Fellowship of 200, and a group of parents of Rong Rong students - 80)

Internal: Developing stamina and graciousness to accept all the breakfasts, lunches, and dinners our various hosts and hostesses keep in front of us - many times two full meals at once!

Contradiction: All of the above-mentioned groups need workshops and seminars in addition to the lecture times.

THE PHILIPPINES

Religious Outpost: Manila

External: Seapac preparation for February conference begun. Lorenzo set to leave for Chicago Jan. 24th. Core group planning session Sat. Dec. 26 revealed many strong advantages of ITI:Manila. Speaking engagement Central Meth. Church.

Internal: Baked fish Christmas dinner. Conversations with Bacerras leading to decision to create a cadre in Faith Baptist and work with Jessica Fernandez's (ITI:HK) social center in squatter area.

Contradiction: Keeping momentum in midst of periods of total confusion on how to build a movement among faction-oriented people who prefer good personal relationships to effective work.

Sign: Monthly house church of 2 Pilipino couples and 1 single person to begin Jan. 30 with family economic research and planning.

External: Plans for the Winter Quarter include monthly Manila ministers meeting, creating plan for YMCA ecumenical centre, an RS-1 and a signal project at Faith Baptist Church and two ITI grad meetings: one all grad symbolic gathering and another regular monthly meeting to begin collegial covenant of the Manila cadre. Willard Hunter, U.S. Navy, established desire to help and participate by working with Americans overseas. Walters (George) arrived to begin ITI development plan.

Internal: Trip with Bacerra's to Lucena City revealed ties of Philippines to Pacifica culture and the feasibility of a nation-wide series of simultaneous four-week institutes in local congregations.

Contradiction: We must begin recruiting and raising funds for Seapac Research Assembly (SRA) and ITI:1971 before consensus is reached on the location.

Sign: Worship on New Year's eve led by Loel Bacerra at Faith Baptist, 65 church members present, raised good and bad events of 1970 and claimed the promises for 1971. The seating arrangement of the sanctuary was that of the cathedral choir. It went one hour overtime.

SUBASIA

INDIA Religious Outpost: Bombay

Accomplishments: We have taught the stories: theological heritage (post modern era), Australian heritage, world religions, and Christian heritage (civilisation era).

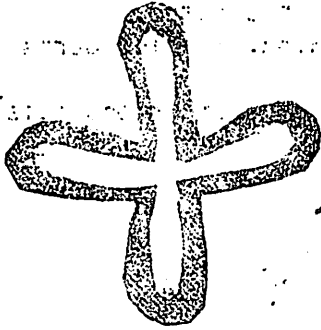
Insights: We are walking through the fiery furnace and have seen the angel/shadow presence with us. We are two people/one people in a land we have seen but not won.

NORTH Religious House: Chicago North

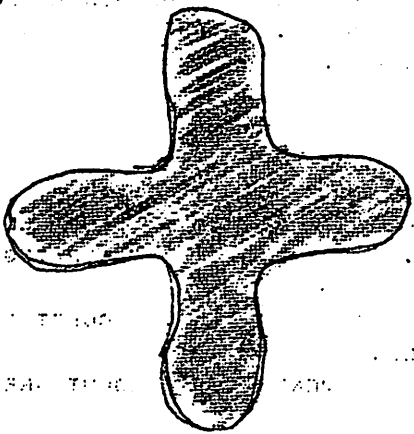

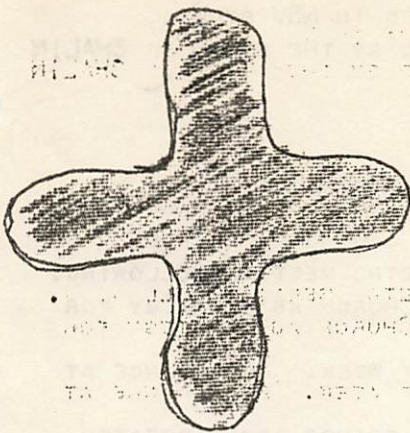

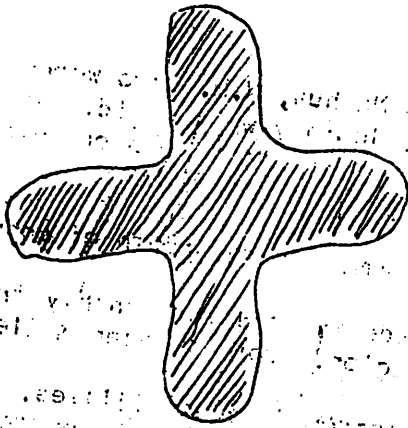

Religious House: Kuala Lumpur

External: Kjell Knutsen was sent out on a 9 day visitation and teaching trip to East Malaysia; the extended rule experiment was begun with three families; extensive visitation with prospective iron men continued.

Internal: KON HEE FATT CHOY! House celebrated Chinese New Year January 26; first house gathering from Penang, Singapore and KL staff built SEAPAC probemat, local church selection model and timeline for next three weeks; first spirit conversations held on strange foods and fear.

External: Twenty-four from SEAPAC participating in planning staff have been invited to the SEAPAC Research Assembly "Local Church Renewal in the Asian Context" to be held in Hong Kong, February 22 - March 6, 1971.

Internal: In the city where nothing ever closes everything closed to celebrate the new "Year of the Pig" -- complete with family visitation and celebration, elaborate decor, good eating and the famous Lion Dance.

Contradiction: Funds for SEAPAC Research Assembly.

Sign: Tribal resettlement opened a room for the projected infant school at Shum Oi Church.

Internal:

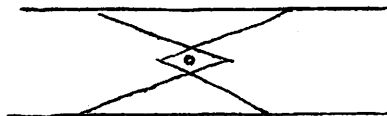
First corporate time schedule came out of a self-conscious house planning session. Execution of the plan has proceeded with greater effectiveness.
