Internal: The six houses of the Chicago Region celebrated at the end of regional council with "Guns of Navarrone," beer and popcorn and an all-day evaluation of the year. Chicago House did a mini PSU creating models to deal adequately with the summer, finances, and moonlighting jobs. Amended with a celebration at the Top-o'-the Hancock on Thursday night.

Contradiction: In times of intensive demands, teams and rationales are in between-quarter limbo.

Religious House: Madison

External: Awefilled galaxy meeting to locate the cross and Jerusalem during the month of July provides punctuation for Regional Council at base with three hundred colleagues.

Internal: Economic intensification continues with the house student intern winning \$4000 scholarship and taking two part-time jobs while attending summer school.

Contradiction: S'72 recruitment is an up-hill struggle to enable promises to turn into registrations and "I'd like too!"'s.

Religious House: Milwaukee

Religious House: RockfordReligious House: PeoriaReligious House: Champaign/Urbana

**External:** Development Team visit, S'72 recruitment, sector and galaxy activities climax high point of quarter in Week 10!

**Internal:** Once again the house and metro spiritized by the global dimension of the Development Team visit and presence.

**Contradiction:** Many prospects, but only half our quota of registrations for S'72.

Religious House: MinneapolisReligious House: DetroitReligious House: ClevelandReligious House: Indianapolis

**External:** Ended teaching year on a joyful note with knowledge that total grads in Indiana had a little more than doubled this year. Fourteen signed up for S'72, fourteen more to go.

**Internal:** Celebrated entry of the Brown family as interns; Larry, Sherry, James, and Angelica. Sent out the Naylor family after a period of internship.

**Contradiction:** Releasing Galaxy and Training Institute to assume total responsibility for the Movement as something which they are, not some mysterious other "out there."

Religious House: Cincinnati

**External:** Formulation by module team into Lexington sector with imperative to movementalize new grads and enable their journey into spirit deeps produced exciting signs. Their first encounter with NRM during an Ecclesiola study of Prayer paper resulted in the inquiry: "This is great! Are there any more papers like this?"

**Internal:** The Lord increased our numbers by 6 as Dale Haplight family begins month sojourn and Bill Benysh re-enters structures following 8 weeks in the Academy just when we had decided that if Gideon could work miracles with half as many troops as he thought he needed, we could too.

**Contradiction:** Maintaining intensity of recruiting, formulating and penetrating following Regional Council's high celebration of quarter recruiting-formulating and penetrating.

Religious House: Kansas City

**External:** Our quota for S'72 is so close at hand, we hear the Lord calling us for more than the 40. Regional Council with more than 100 colleagues present is awe-struck at the powerful witness of a "6-month old" galaxy (Telling their story also awe-struck the galaxy!).

**Internal:** With Cock in Wichita; (for the week) and Tolman in Lincoln/Omaha, the House plumps headlong into task of overpowering the economic demon. Nine more jobs secured this week through daily "possibility" workshops and pounding the pavement in 90° weather.

Religious House : Kansas City (cont.)

Contradiction: Enabling us to see \$1.65/hr is more adequate for the task than \$0/hr and is better than \$5/hr when no one's offering those jobs.

Contradiction: The day of Judgement fast approaches with an inadequate mode for meeting financial responsibilities.

Religious House: Rochester June 2-June 8

External: Region gathered at Irondequoit Presbyterian Church for Regional Council-Global visioning and Local Church Practics with a taste of S'72 thrown in created a sense of collegiality and excitement for the summer and fall quarters.

Contradiction: Maintaining the house dynamic as members prepare for order deployment. Imaging a house with only 5 members.

Religious House: BostonReligious House: ManchesterReligious House: PortlandReligious House: PittsburghReligious House: Philadelphia May 26-June 1

External: Simultaneous adult and emerging generation CSIIIA courses deeply address 17 regional and galaxy families (50 people) at the point of reordering family structures for mission; three day trip across region elicits 5 more possibilities for S'72 in Harrisburg and Allentown metros and calls six unknown grads forth from the tomb; attendance at opening session of Methodist annual Conference enables solid contact with new D.S. in Scranton; preparation for Regional Council grounds fear and fascination relative to the next 20 years; galaxy couple journeys to Miami for initial continental consultation.

Internal: Titus and Augusta Jayasakera share new world religions context for House and Regional Colleagues during Ecclesiola-seminary presentation; Saint of the week-Dominic-contexts study as crucial tool in preparing for witnessing in world while S.K. enables radical grounding of power of incognito.

Contradiction: House and region has not grounded model building techniques for moving from comprehensive to particular in decision-making.

Religious House: Philadelphia June 2-June 8

External: Regional Council deals with 20 year vision, consenses on regional grid, creates summer regional Week I and II assignment schedule, nets 3 more paid S'72 recruits and raises \$450 as symbolic act to catalyze the region's meeting deficit penetration expenditures.

Religious House: Philadelphia June 2-June 8 (cont.)

Internal: Research team of three faces impossible task and experiences radical demand of rehearsing self-story in order to sustain stance of representational responsibility; House celebrated the completion of David Horn's intern year in the Order at Ecclesiola; the pushing of contradictions to their sociological manifestations yielded new insight on summer imperatives; spirit edge workshop revealed context for actualizing imperatives.

Contradiction: Resisting paralysis which sets in when individual brooding must take place during corporate engagement in battle.

Religious House: New York May 26-June 1

External: House engages in basic human activity of providing, procuring and preparing for the morrow in the midst of a diverse spectrum of tasks. Four man Development Team arrives making visits in all 6 metros enabling colleagues to meet the demand to help finance the Seoul ITI. Regional council plans take on concrete shape around the one concern of capturing S'72 registrations in a spin of excitement. Locations for the New Haven and Long Island Religious Houses are explored-demonstrating that even an old Nike missile site and now Friends World College could be a Religious House.

Internal: The building we once thought would hold anyone, begins to bulge at the seams with the Bob, Marion, Laura and Beverly Ramage family becoming interns and the Gribble family-Chuck, Kathy, Karen, David and Matthew-and the Michael Harvey family coming as sojourners. There's always room for more!

Contradiction: Cutting through our own posture of mutual blackmail with colleagues in order to lay claim on their participation in S'72.

Religious House: Washington

Religious House: Montreal May 26-June 1

External: Odyssey held with participants from 3 metros (children's RS-I held simultaneously with 12 participants) breaks loose new colleagues for summer programs.

Internal: Traditional bachelor's party held for Duncan Holmes, found to be great discontinuous male formulation tool for regional colleagues.

Contradiction: Finding the tactics that will allow colleagues to continue to deal seriously with their participation in S'72.

Religious House: Toronto

External: Toronto Region celebrates last quarter of movement quadrennium by penetrating all six metros and creating offices in 5 of 6 metros.

Internal: House members breathe a sigh of relief as new washer and dryer are installed, and embrace new tasks as new division structure is implemented.

Contradiction: Recruitment for S'72 blocked by pre-conceived defeatist story that key regional leaders are just not going to attend the summer programme.

External: Regional Council held with 40 colleagues present indicated a significant shift in Council style from "just business" to symbolic celebration of the year's work. Signal happening: New Academy grads pushing old colleagues to the points of intentionality, commitment, and spirit depth.

Internal: The study of HRN's Toward a New Other Worldliness in the midst of a 3 day fast, symbolizing the life and death seriousness of S'72, gave us new images of the importance of S'72 to humanness in the 20 and 21st Centuries.

Contradiction: We have a vision that speaks to colleagues who are close to a "Yes" decision for S'72 and know they need to be there, but have not hit on the story that convinces those who don't already feel that demand.

Religious House: San Francisco May 26-June 1

External: Regional Council is great Spirit Happening with 110 attending. Summer '72 confirmed registrations topped 42 with 8 hot prospects yet to be confirmed. With 3 metros requesting outpost/galaxy establishment, 7 families announced decision to intern in house or outposts next year, (totaling 20 people) while 8 others are known to be considering this decision to be made by August 1st. Two families were sent out to other regions; one to intern in the LA House and one to sojourn in the Washington D.C. House.

Internal: House celebrated the end of the year with its annual picnic and football game of the year joined by several regional colleagues for abounding abasement with choice steaks; House rejoices to have two intern families moving into the house in June: the Jess Mark family and the Bob and Sue Hayes family. Tim and Sue Wegner, now sojourning in house also announced their decision to become interns.

Contradiction: With a six month derth of interns gone by, all belts tightned still does not conquer financial deficits.

Contradiction: Turning seriously considering prospects for S'72 into paid registrations.

Religious House: Amarillo

External: Church dinners recieve new form as 12 local RS-I grads give personal witnesses before Portalise NM Presbyterian Church, drama produces deep address on spirit life of local congregation. Development

teams harvest \$622.50 from stored up energy of metro.

**Internal:** Late night discipline of Canonical Hours and summer planning hold much needed corporateness and model building time for House.

**Contradiction:** Maintaining momentum to recruit summer and formulate accurate summer plans.

Religious House: TulsaReligious House: Houston May 19-May 25

**External:** Moved into 3rd session of Clergy Guild with 20 participants. Wheels spinning and touched ground for S'72 recruitment with 24 firm "Yes"'s on first survey. Houston Metro Ecclesiola seen as key formulation tool.

**Internal:** Continuing the meditative journey with St. Francis in Solitary Office.

**Contradiction:** How to maintain momentum of missional thrust with increased number of people assigned to work out.

Religious House: Houston May 26-June 1

**External:** Preparation for a 100 man Regional Council in full swing. S'72 recruitment stands with 12 registrations in hand. Houston Metro Clergy Guild of 15 continues to open up new possibilities for the House in the future.

**Internal:** House Ecclesiola addressed by Bishop Mitchell of Hyderabad, India while here for Methodist Conference. Williams return from Academy with a deep committment that "All must go."

**Contradiction:** Releasing colleagues to see that the Lord requires 4 weeks of their life this summer to be spent in Chicago.

Religious House: New Orleans May 26-June 1

**External:** Regional Council seriously analyzed the regions structures and images for last quarter and created images of summer and course calendar for '72-'73. 50 plus colleagues participated....lot's of new faces.

**Internal:** Study of Training in Christianity proves to be a dichotomy..... very offensive to some, very permissive to others, as Ecclesiola continues to be THE Symbolic Event to enable depth Spirit Journeys.

**Contradiction:** How to build a climate of possibility around Summer '72 prospects rather than the House leaning on them to register.

Religious House: Atlanta

**External:** Regional Council held with every metro present for the first time in history; 62 colleagues gather Friday night for a wild spirit happening at the Grecian Village. Belly dancer (authenfic) set the style of intentimal, frenzied celebration.

**Internal:** 5 new jobs secured for summer: cab driver, theatre manager, construction worker, floor taper, and a moonlighting teacher. Fred Fife graduates from Columbia Seminary as the whole house attends. School is out and children now rule the roost.

**Contradiction:** How to decide we are one body, one thrust in the midst of heavy and widely diverse work schedules.

External: The iron men in the Glasgow Region are joining together as a cadre making assignments to S'72; British Isles and to visit Chicago; regularly reporting to this Religious House. Summer '72 intensive recruitment launched.

Internal: Global strategies break open house imagination, culminating in our own imaginal regional goals in the midst of high celebration-- very English, very good!

Contradiction: How keep the perspective of global strategy while engaged in a million minutiae-like trying to find ways to cut S'72 participants' cost.

ASIAReligious House: Sendai

**External:** A 4-month formulation plan built, and put into action with Sue Williams manning permeation teaching post full-time. Parish fishing party nets 80 fish and two I.T.I. contributions. **Sign:** A local surgeon (whom the house tutors English) paid an hour's tutoring fee to hear the I.T.I. funding pitch in English, and insisted on raising his lesson payments and arranging a special fund-raising luncheon for his club in response.

**Internal:** A year's guest night model constructed, a global map of religious house locations completed. A movie, "The French Connection" regroups house in the church lecture.

**Contradiction:** An affluence of small donations for I.T.I., with a crucial need for large donations.

Religious House: Osaka

**External:** First totally Japanese RSl held in Tokyo with 11 participants and fully staffed by Japanese pedagogues. First RSl in Hiroshima metro with 14 participants, opening up a new area. \$1,000 received this week for ITI. Letter in invitation sent to 120 colleagues for the Area Council to be held in Tokyo on June 16,17.

**Internal:** New time design for discontinuous month enables intense effort for corporate planning and for intensification of spirit journey.

**Contradiction:** Creating the story and images to seduce local churchmen into training programs.

Religious House: Seoul

**External:** Increased pace and commitment experienced as ITI Grads meet to establish funding strategies in Korean business and church and own personal contributions.

**Internal:** The Religious House is received by the parish as a significant strategy of the global renewal of the Church: Guest Nite hosted Church Elders and class leaders where the story and purpose of The Spirit Movement was given; the evening also revealed that House English Training Lesson # 52, "The Local Church Dynamic" is embodied when Mrs. Kang introduces an elder as a cadre member of Yang Kwang Church.

**Contradiction:** Moving from goal formation models to detailed tactical timelines at Regional Cadre Meetings.

## PACIFICA

Religious House : Majuro.

**External:** Two day trip to Ebeya resulted in a good and long awaited talk with Jude Samson about ITI delegates and the future of the Religious House. Rong Rong's graduation was held at the Protestant Church in the District Center and struck us with its integration of Western and Pacifica traditions - caps, gowns. shces and English along with leis and Marshallise.

**Internal:** The outpost has moved into new summer housing in the Youth Center in Rita, which puts us in a better position to move freely and maintain closer contact with Majuro people.

**Contradiction:** How to grasp our current situation and move decisionally on it even though none of the ambiguity has gone way.

Religious House: Apia

**External:** Began second term of school year with an evaluation on first term and prospects for more teachers than ever before. Had an exciting conversation with Bishop Pio concerning the long range vision of the Catholic Church as the invisible nothing working to serve the needs of all Samoans. First attempt to make financial demands on grads as letter goes out concerning ITI.

**Internal:** Report from the Tonga/Fiji trip gave us a new gestalt of the possibilities of the Movement in our region and helped us get a good sense after concrete regional training demands. Sign: Sam and Akanese Tupou have translated all the prayers from the Canonical Hours into Tongan. The Global Semi-Annual Report came as the structure we've all been waiting for.

**Contradiction:** No confirmation of our ITI delegates with ITI just 4 weeks away and visa preparation not begun.

## EAST SEA

Religious House: Taipei

**External:** ITI grad nurture visits continued and ITI participant enablement begun.

**Internal:** First full week of employment as teachers at Language Center and Taiwan National University calls forth Taiwan citizens learning to speak English with a Brooklyn accent.

**Contradiction:** Absence of the blackboard dynamic clouds objective ordering of the priority of demands.

Religious House: Tainan

**External:** Completed Officer's training in workshop methods at Kua-Sai-Ke Local Church, leaving Pastor very excited and eager for more. Sent Prior to Taipei on two day trip for ITI enablement. Upon introductory conversation with head of U.S. Information Service, Rod Rippel asked to participate in Pollution Seminar in Kaoshung. Made favourable strategic permeation and development contacts as story is told. (University and Industrial heads.)

**Internal:** Move completed into 200 year old still very liveable Chinese house. First week of employment for new English teachers. Also first week of full enablement structures.

**Contradiction:** Deciding most effective timeline in light of need for self support and greater missional emphasis.

Religious House: Hong Kong

**External:** A leadership training program was begun at Shum Oi Church, conducted from Friday evening through Sunday evening for three months by the leadership cadre residing at the church, using collegium time for training and preparation.

**Internal:** Hosted by the Shum Oi Leadership Cadre for dinner and meeting of visioning. Hosted by the Neal Hunters with a group from China Travel Service to see Chinese Film Ballet "The White-haired Girl" with discussion afterwards. Received youth Peter Clements from the States as youth member at the house.

**Contradiction:** ITI funding and delegate deadlines: all the birds are in the bush.

Religious House: Manila

**External:** Penetration push continues with two consults: The United Church of Christ in the Philippines (UCCD) Conference in Manila and

a Methodist Conference in Mindoro where first conversations were held towards courses in Palawan (an untouched Metro) . In permeation - an open house was held for UCCP Conference participants - also conversations with two of the three Anglican Bishops. In Formulation the quarter 4 grad meeting was small in number but significant. A closing celebration with Korean Feast to celebrate ITI Seoul includes send-outs of Don Quimby visiting from Tokyo, Eric Gower from Austria, on his way to Chicago - the Solis Family to Chicago and representatives of the Seoul Faculty and participants.

Internal: House is transformed by completed decor, by visits of Quimby and Gower and by Grad meeting.

Contradiction: How to make development priority while continuing work in all areas and how to turn promises into cash.

## AUSTRALIA

Religious House: Sydney Node

(May 26 - June 1)

External: Development mailing prepared and sent to Perth in preparation for development trip. Voucher prepared and printed for Development calling. Most of the house members participated in courses as pedagogues or participants.

Internal: New life comes to the Minister's study with the renewal of the carpet and shifting of furniture. Welcomed Maxim and Aiya Wilson to the house as interns.

Contradiction: Inadequate/unfocused corporate self-story of Node.

Religious House: Sydney Node

External: Rod Andrews returned from four week Development trip to the South of Australia which to date has netted \$1600 cash. Full day meeting on Tuesday with Village Church pastor turns a corner for the local church. Permanent off-set Press arrives and is installed on Thursday.

Internal: House study of Poverty paper in Ecclesiola pushes again to the encounter with dread. House participates in Week 11 discontinuity. House member disappears during the night to re-appear late next day - participated in renal transplant in professional capacity as Doctor not patient!

Contradiction: Holding the tension between house evaluation/planning and preparing for Priors Meeting and Praesidium.

Religious House: DerbyReligious House: BrisbaneReligious House: SydneyReligious House: Melbourne

External: Regional Council brings 10 colleagues and House into a firm covenant with concrete models in relation to penetration and formulation. 43 Churches as possible participants in the Local Church Experiment and prioritized to the 9 most likely and the 4 ready to proceed.

Internal: Colleague Eric Gowers sheds some of this world's goods at the House on way through to intern at Base. Ecclesiola with Development team present proves to be a spirit celebration.

Religious House: Melbourne (Cont'd)

Internal (Cont'd) Odyssey Gowns in the making fill regional visitors with wonder.

Contradiction: Deciding to authentically abound in our abasement.

Religious House: Adelaide

External: Held second session of Adelaide follow-up Course; visited follow-up meeting in Whyalla of 32 including children, Regional Council preparation included a planning meeting by key leaders.

Internal: Quarter 2 evaluation climaxed with Thursday night with children's own evaluation and adults' reflection on the House journey. We named the heart-beat of this quarter to be "The Preparation and the Cry."

Contradiction: Assignment of Prior to Brisbane courses leaves no one assigned to in-house to continue clergy calling and impact weekend preparation.

Religious House - Perth

External: Surprised by yeses -- Two P.L.C. grads stop by and suggest fortnightly clergy guild and council response increases.

Internal: Three University interns and six house youth decide to improve school grades by participating in a corporate study weekend - amazed by results.

Contradiction: Molding a diverse region into one movemental thrust and honoring demands from congregations and denominations.

## SOUTH SEA

Religious House - Kuala LumpurReligious House - Singapore

External: ITI Development continues: sent 60 individually typed letters to U.S. friends, while a two hour visit over cocktails produced a solid commitment for \$1,000 from a Chinese colleague.

Internal: Built several models to hold hard-won wisdom about Singapore and its churches.

Contradiction: Increasing the momentum of the Development push until the actual cash begins to flow.

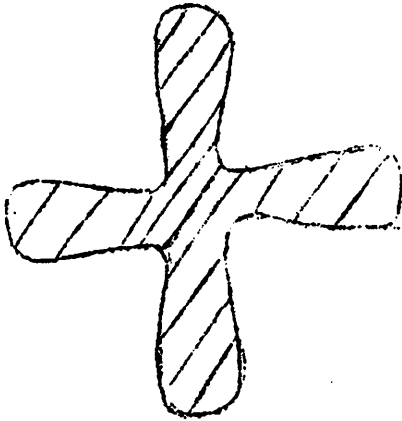
## ORDER BASE

**Internal:** Temple (6 in 1) gathering at Chicago House with showing of the movie, "Guns of Navarone," plenary and House Church. Sending out of sojourners, the Fran Denman family and the David Middleton family, and the reception of sojourner Carla Reed from the Phoenix Region.

**Contradiction:** Finding the key that releases our formulation weaponry on the new grads of this last year into the summer program and other channels for fall preparation.

Religious House: Milwaukee June 2-8

**External:** Reach 80% mark of S'72 quota during Regional Council "happening" colleagues bring their registrations "forward" to join those already registered.

**Internal:** Phantasmagorical/celebration at 5:00 AM held in "Promised Land" to symbolize the end of the spring quarter and send out our youth, children, two sojourner families and first prior.

**Contradiction:** Experiencing the completion of this year when there are still two months of frightful possibilities left to be created.

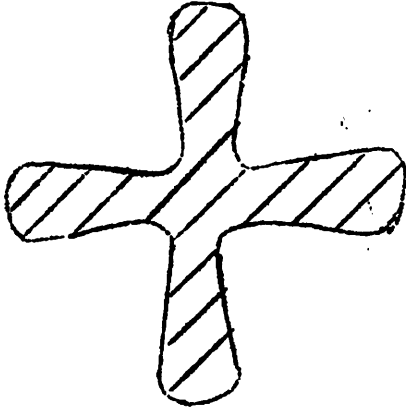

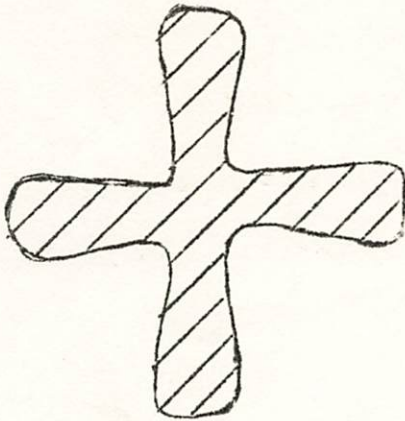

Internal: Ecclesiola and House Church manifest new intensity of spirit as we are in the giant West Australian Fishbowl.

## SOUTH SEA

External: KL Regional Catalytic Cadre decides at meeting to pick up 100% Asian self-support for ITI: Seoul and raise quota; Seremban Signal Local Church completed first round of its "RSI" curriculum in the Church School by creating montages; Bishop Yap Kim Hao was taken to dinner and hosted at the House upon his return from the USA; Yap, in his sermon at Trinity Church PJ, told congregation that one of the 3 key events of his trip and signs of a renewing Church was his visit to Kansas City Religious House and his talk with the Prior, John Cock. Yap returns to us a deeper colleague.

Internal: Rona Earle, "visiting home" following 4 weeks of Academy joins Bunkers for daily collegiums during June before returning to Chicago for Summer '72.

Religious House: Caracas June 9-15  
External: Metro cadre creates 4 year goals for continent, areas, and Caracas region.  
Internal: Received "warm welcome" from head of Commission on Ecumenism of Caracas diocese opening way to recruitment enablement for courses in Fall.  
Contradiction: Appropriating the "fact" that the Lord continually "creates out of nothing."

Religious House: Caracas June 16-22  
External: Summer '72 recruitment now stands at 9 registrations-6 for full month.

**Internal:** Week 2 festival is highlighted by play on life of (saint of the week) John Wesley who is realistically portrayed by Bill Senton as he masterfully guided a shetland pony across the stage while the Sunday Olympics featured Ecclesiolas against each other in thrilling tournament competition of capture the flag.

**Contradiction:** Breaking up of old Ecclesiolas in order to spread out 150 new campers who arrived on July 2nd.
