UNITED STATES

NORTH Religious House: Chicago North.

EXTERNAL: Hartford, Wisconsin RS-1 held with good representation from galaxy congregation.

INTERNAL: New decor on the theme of the Solitaries was both immediate and lasting address.

CONTRADICTION: How to guide PLC grads into sustaining structures.

Religious House Chicago South.

EXTERNAL: Learning again that missional care occurs during development calls.

INTERNAL: All House members assigned galactic responsibilities.

CONTRADICTION: Mood of discontinuity during teaching quarter because of diversity and multiplicity of assignments.

SIGN: RSI, PLC, and development calls which were projected as contradiction became sign.

Religious House: Rockford.

EXTERNAL: Our recently intensified PLC recruitment is bringing forth a diversity of local church possibilities - among the 36 registered for the 7th week PLC, denominations represented are: Anglo-Catholic, Episcopalian, Southern Baptist, American Baptist, Society of Friends, Presbyterian, Lutheran, U.C.C., Roman Catholic, Pentecostal, Methodist and Jewish.

INTERNAL: Our new sojourner family - Mel, Alice, Ellen, and David Painter - has arrived, bringing with them their rich heritage in the Jewish faith and anticipation of a forthcoming corporate living experience in Israel.

CONTRADICTION: While intensifying our recruitment for the Odyssey, we find ourselves between the No-Longer and the Not-Yet; Most of those we have seen have either been to the Odyssey or are not yet ready to go.

SIGN: Our job hunting style is earning the respect of the non-church community to such an extent that one of the agencies with which we came in contact referred someone to us for employment.

Religious House: Cleveland.

EXTERNAL: Breakopen course in Richmond sector (Indiana), 6 week cadre training started in two galaxy churches, cadres organized in Cleveland metro, Odyssey recruitment enabled by regional Wk II assignment structure! Development team here - did significant spirit push as well as raise money.

CONTRADICTION: Grounding the momentum of formulation thrust in specific churches through frequent consults.

EXTERNAL: 3 RSI's this weekend - first course in the deserts of Bakersfield. Participants of Wilshire RSI decide to meet in two weeks.

INTERNAL: Celebrated 3 weeks of RSI, PLC and CSI recruiting. Welcomed Monk for Month Ken Thomas, Program Director for Manitoba Association for World Development.

CONTRADICTION: How to maintain objectivity toward key churches as their clergy say "no" to Spring PLC.

EXTERNAL: Series of intentional meetings (mainly over meals) during the week with colleagues from the London and Bristol regions pointing toward the summer and beyond. An evening with local Methodists (at the invitation of their pastor) produced leaven for the recruitment lump.

All adults and youth in Sydney attended Sydney RSI. Rob Duffey was sent to Samoa for two week trip. Ray Richmond and regional colleague Deaconess Colleen Grieve headed north on six-day trip to Townsville.

INTERNAL: Manual of Internal life and assignments for quarter produced. Invitations out and decor beginning for open house on 9th May.

CONTRADICTION: With few troops 'in' we allow anxieties to cloud our love for the nitty-gritty.

SUB ASIA

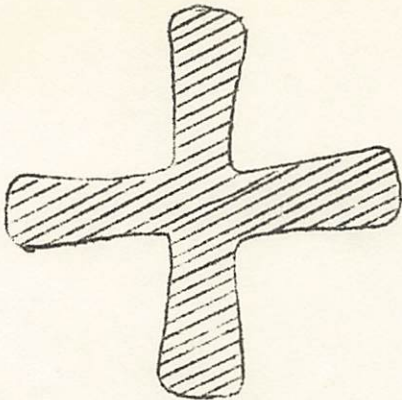
INDIA Religious Outpost: Bombay.

INTERNAL: Outpost celebration featured "NRM Chart charades" and "Pop the Illusion". Attended speech and reception for M.M. Thomas; hosted George Sisler of Protestant Businessman's Foundation of Chicago. Hosting Joe Pierce and the New Women's Teaching team. Sent out Jesse Clements to attend the Research Assembly in Chicago.

CONTRADICTION: How to get the promised money as cash in hand.

JAPAN

Religious Outpost: Osaka

EXTERNAL: Tokyo Cadre held and participated in a Local Congregation Course. A small RSI held in Sendai. New Women's Forum in Tokyo with 20 participants.

INTERNAL: Hammering out a monetary model that honors the universal in the midst of numerous particulars. Outpost and colleagues together working on the C.R.R.P. Response to National Council assignments hearteningly affirmative with all major roles being filled.

CONTRADICTION: Embracing the mission at hand in the midst of intolerable up-pacing' of pre-summer demands.

Religious Outpost: Fukushima

EXTERNAL: Last minute schedule conflicts of clergy postpone the date for RSI. Weekend consultation held with Sendai colleagues and National Council assignments worked through. Permeation have begun work on long range faculty relations model.

INTERNAL: Locating all grads on map of the Tohoku (North Japan). Have begun work on the Japanese NRM NSV study.

CONTRADICTION: Launching work on Development.

TAIWAN Religious Outpost: Tainan

EXTERNAL: Visit by New Women's Forum Team. Basil and Joseph to a retreat of ministers from Tainan and Kaohsiung Presbyteries on Church Renewal - to listen. Meeting on Church Experimentation project with Phok-Ai Church - situation not favourable. ITI Development . N.W.F. team met husband of Kobe course participant while in Kaohsiung Airport. \$100 for ITI from local Chinese.

INTERNAL: College resumed. Started studying Boulding - "Meaning of the 20th Century.

CONTRADICTION: ITI Development is difficult in face of lack of concern, interest, hope and vision.

SAMOA Religious Outpost: Samoa

EXTERNAL: Second RSI follow-up meeting was used to build a broblemat for the world Samoa, and Apia area.

INTERNAL: Began 3 week break from school. We sent Joel out to Fiji with Rob Duffy to find a second Fijian ITI delegate and to explore high schools to get some invitations for movement school teachers.

CONTRADICTION: ITI development is our main thrust during our three weeks off but the first week is not very useful because we need to work with our colleagues in the congregational church and they are at conference. The last week is not very useful because of independence day holidays.

MARSHALL ISLANDS

Religious Outpost: Majuro

EXTERNAL: Spent a day refining youth center plans from the Mini ITI to be presented to the Bi-Annual Conference of the church.

INTERNAL: Working on a comprehensive list of "recommendations for next year" in response to an assignment from the faculty meeting.

CONTRADICTION: Many ITI decisions regarding funding and practics await Judis arrival and a Board of Directors Meeting in early June.

PHILIPPINES

Religious Outpost: Manila

EXTERNAL: Both conferences of Methodists addressed by Fishel and McCleskey. Manila RSI and PLC set for June 11-16; ITI grads recruiting. David heads to Visayas & Mindanao for courses and visits, expecially five R.C. Bishops. New Women arrive Wednesday, 27 affirmative for ITI: Manila Whew!

INTERNAL: Harry Wainwright's visit to do tactical systems in INDIA: ITI brings in global context as well as San Francisco Region. Judy's work accelerates to 60 hours a week and U.S. \$600 a month. Donna half way through teachers training.

CONTRADICTION: ITI funds!

SUB

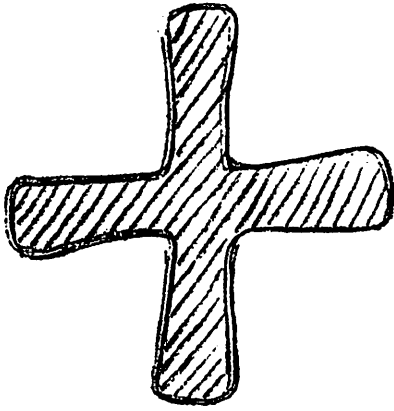
ASIA-INDIA

GLOBAL WEST

UNITED STATES

NORTH Religious House: Chicago North

EXTERNAL: Milwaukee metro impacted as we began intensive recruitment for Summer '71 and for the Regional Council meeting. At the same time we worked with Zervigon and Haman from Base on ITI funding from Milwaukee colleagues.

INTERNAL: A great dinner at Diana's Greek Restaurant with some of our Regional colleagues celebrated our White Ur Heritage as well as the rendering up to history of the past eight weeks of our being.

CONTRADICTION: Sustaining the push on the CRPP while maintaining Major recruitment and development efforts in Milwaukee.

Religious House: Chicago South

EXTERNAL: Preparing to house over 100 for Regional Council at House. Collegium spent in creating flaming invitations and implorations for regional colleagues to attend Research Assembly.

INTERNAL: Preparing for second wedding in the history of the House, Week I being climaxed by ecclesiola banquet Thursday evening.

CONTRADICTION: Co-ordinating external and internal activities while brooding on necessary summer plans.

Religious House: Rockford

EXTERNAL: Our recruitment of an RSI (32 participants) and an RSIIIa (23 participants) for this coming Week II showed us that we really can ward off the "We-Can-Always-Send-them-To-Base" syndrome.

INTERNAL: The twelve of us who attended the CSIIIa course at base last Week II were so addressed by the imperatives left with us that since then the house has been in open rather than latent family struggle, which has led to significant breakthroughs. We ourselves seem to be the sign of the deep battle fatigue which shows up when life has been expended...and around the house one can hear a quiet "Glory, Hallelujah!" uttered out of raw decision for the future.

CONTRADICTION: With all eyes turned toward Summer '71 and the New Social Vehicle, we find ourselves having no 3-month summer timeline to simultaneously glance at.

Religious House: Cleveland

EXTERNAL: Galaxy participated in Continental Consult - major breakthrough with new cadre members - imagining themselves as the experiment in a new way; every metro visited on Wk II for Metro Council work, Summer '71 recruitment, cadre formulation, ongoing structures established in Ft. Wayne and Columbus metros for the first time.

INTERNAL: Memorial Day discontinuity focussed on family planning: 40 - 4 year timelines, constitutions; NSV screening continues, assignments made for House participation in Summer '71.

CONTRADICTION: Maintaining single thrust in the complexity of the transition into summer quarter, particularly in creating adequate images for Regional Council.

Religious House: Kansas City

This giant step in Regional Development ended with everyone at a spirit picnic (Regional Council) with new Fall brochures. Meditative friends from Bonhoeffer to Seuss came to dinner one night; Benedict's rule, another.

INTERNAL: 1. Received another sojourner - Becky Reece. 2. Discontinuity month beginning with Week II (Friday night and Saturday) family discontinuity and beginnings shift in weekly/daily time design (eschatologically rocks us) and three new jobs for "vacationing" school teachers which were procured in less than one day's hunting. 3. Paul Ertel, at first 10pm Collegium, shared his family's nine-year involvement with this outfit, including Fred Buss' vision that the property at 3444 W. Congress. could house (if squeezed) about 150 - 200 persons. House youth decide to use family night for 3-hour RSI pedagogy session, after spending that day and previous day on it also.

CONTRADICTION: One down - twenty-four to go (Summer '71 recruitment).

Religious House: Detroit

EXTERNAL: Metro Power Units in 3 metros continue regular meetings with ecclesiola structure. 52 colleagues across 5 metros are involved in the MPU's and receive assignment out of the context of "all time is assigned time"/

INTERNAL: Week II quarter evaluations and planning broke loose fantastic models for the summer. Planned formulation week in each metro. Mark Johnson received as sojourner.

CONTRADICTION: In the face of intensified demands, how to overcome the image that the summer is a time for slowing down movement activity in the region.

EAST

Religious House: Boston

EXTERNAL: Summer '71 recruitment model created with teams calling in 6 metros on Saturday. Conversations held with leadership of congregations in every metro, regarding Galaxy possibilities for next year. Galaxy churches completing Spring Quarter tactics and focussing on Summer '71 Recruitment.

INTERNAL: Completing Schreiber while re-ordering weekly design to support planning and recruitment for Summer.

CONTRADICTION. Breaking loose spirit to recruit Summer '71 as well as an adequate image of the missional context of the Summer in the Region.

Religious House: New York

EXTERNAL: Two RSI's for 35 adults and 40 children, plus final meeting of all 6 Metro Ecclesiolas set stage for high celebrational Pentecost Council.

INTERNAL: Week 8 Odyssey of 73 (18 from Philadelphia Region) imparts quantum jump of spirit energy to House and Region. Welcomed JWM, John Clark, John & Ann Cole, Jim & Gayle Stewart, and Phil Townley to wedding breakfast for Michael Cowan and Jane Wheeler

CONTRADICTION: Creating summer plans that are discontinuous without losing momentum.

Religious House: Rochester

EXTERNAL: Regional Praesidium to plan for council held with 16 colleagues in attendance. marks new birth in Rochester region.

INTERNAL: A busy week II with praesidium quarterly celebration plus the ordination of William David Schlesinger into the Presbyterian Church. We rejoice at endings and beginnings.

CONTRADICTION: Daring to plan summer with only one person assigned in - also Summer '71 recruitment.

Religious House: Washington, D.C.

EXTERNAL: A weekend pedagogy guild held in Richmond with region-wide participation enabled regional consciousness as well as depth pushing at Tillich.

INTERNAL: An exiting Ecclesiola during which St. Teresa was "levitated" to high place in the meditative council of all participants.

CONTRADICTION: Keeping to the demands of the CRRP in the midst of almost overwhelming formulational demands in the region and Summer 71 recruitment.

WEST Religious house: San Francisco

EXTERNAL: Specially scheduled San Jose RS-1 largest of quarter with exiting participation of 5 regional youth. Spirit-filled Galactic Pentacost celebration with 52 present to exploding possibility of recovering this celebration in the life of the Church.

INTERNAL: Regional colleagues share excitement of CRRP in week II-Part I and Summer 71 recruitment workshop in part II.

CONTRADICTION: To transform gift of many tongues to the clear articulation of the one word.

Religious House: SeattleReligious House: Los AngelesReligious House: DenverSOUTH Religious House; Houston

EXTERNAL: Local Church Experiment consult held in Baptist Church in China; with remainder of House deploy in regional formulation trek.

INTERNAL: House received 2 new intentr families; Randy, Barbara, Chris and Sharon Williams; and Stan, Gail, Chris, Nina and Karen Crow. Both families come from the Baumont sector of the Houston Metro. Celebrated Bruce Clithero's graduation from the Reagan High School.

CONTRADICTION: Cretion of models for crash recruitment of Summer 71; full regional penetration and formulation and Local Church Experiment tertiary activation with a minimum of troops.

Religious House: New Orleans

EXTERNAL: The development team met with Regional and Galaxy leaders, and impacted them with the Global Movement especially with Bien's presence

INTERNAL: An economic report reveals a little light in the darkness, we aren't in as much debt as we thought.

CONTRADICTION: How keep all the plates in the Region spinning, in the midst of utilizing the summer as a time for planning and visioning.

Religious House: Atlanta

EXTERNAL: Fourteen from Atlanta and Miami Regions joined with the house in a Week II PSU on the New Social Vehicle aimed at Summer '71 recruitment, and wisdom gathering.

INTERNAL: Atlanta Metro were guests at College in which we sent out the Dennis and Marti Lord family to intern at base, had a spirit conversation on bugs, and had the first singing of a New Social Vehicle song composed by a Metro colleague.

CONTRADICTION: Three quarters of Atlanta Region Summer '71 participants not yet recruited.

Religious House; Oklahoma City

EXTERNAL: Plans created by Regional panjayat for great council celebration of 2 days. Active recruitment in every metro has been bearing fruit.

INTERNAL: Total house engaged in enablement for Regional Council celebration with creation of great gigantic banners and baking of many cakes. Shift to discontinuous time schedule for month of June.

CONTRADICTION: Necessity to create great enabling camp structures to free regional colleagues to participate in S '71 (Lord have Mercy) in the midst of heightened activity in the region symbolizing no time off in the revolution.

CANADA EAST

Religious House: Montreal

EXTERNAL: 13 man Odyssey with representation from France, England, Canada, and U.S. particularly impacted by corporate style of guru team representing three houses: Boston, NYC, and Montreal. Visit by English Roman Catholic Bishop of Montreal to the House a deep address as we encounter a churchman who is sensitive to the radicality of the times, thinks in terms of depth renewal, and takes very seriously his symbolic role within mother church.

INTERNAL: Evaluation of spring qtr. and "year I (Sept.-June) recreates our story and propels us into the summer with intensified fascination and dread.

CONTRADICTION: Inadequate battle plan to rationally order multitudinous demands of an expanded arena of struggle in relation to present and potential troop strength.

CANADA WEST

Religious House: Winnipeg

EXTERNAL: Fourteen sisters of the Sisters' Senate, representing five orders, attend consultation at Winnipeg Religious House - style impact of the new religious in relation to the local church spoke to the need for missional vision in all religious orders.

INTERNAL: Pentecost House Church celebration welcomes new interne, Ken Thomas, and highlights week 2 structure which saw all members in four modules dealing with finance, Winnipeg Ecumenical Institute annual meeting preparation, Summer '71 reading and recruitment, and cadre development.

CONTRADICTION: Needing to adjust a four week house timeline to a two week house timeline as Don and Jane, Prior Couple, assigned to Chicago for Summer '71 leadership.

EUROPE Religious Outpost: England

EXTERNAL: Extended spirit and Social Vehicle Conversation with Tim Harrup in Macclesfield. Clergy and Cadre Consultations in Sheffield.

INTERNAL: The arrival of the Zollars meant great times of sharing developments at base and developments in England. A real spirit feast.

CONTRADICTION: Housing - both short term and long term. Recruitment for Summer '71

GLOBAL EAST

SEAPAC

AUSTRALIA

Religious House: Sydney

EXTERNAL: Four courses taught - RSI Brisbane and Broken Hill, PLC - Balmoral (Vic). Pedagogy Sydney. Sign was freedom lecture given by farmer pedagogue to group of rural clergy and farmers. Sunday seminary six week series launched in Paddington local church. Another weekend of preschool improvements included floor sanding and polishing.

INTERNAL: Three youth arrived from Adelaide and Perth for week of work on youth culture course during Uni Vac. Other guests included Keith Braithwaite from Perth, Betty Willis from Toowoomba, and three young Sydney colleagues.

CONTRADICTION: Spirits frustrated and nerves a bit frayed by multitude of possibilities we can't pick up; even those we do are limited accomplishment only. Examples: serious block in preschool renovation plan checks \$60,000 hopes temporarily and causes flurry of nitty-gritty; Two formulation dinners held with pleasant atmosphere (balm for house!) but no guests.

Religious House: Perth

EXTERNAL: Successful consultation held with ministers from the south west in Bunbury. 23 registered for New Women's Forum. Julie Braithwaite sent out to Youth Council in Sydney. MMA Airlines granted us one free Derby-Perth return fare for the staff of Aboriginal Heritage course.

INTERNAL: House inundated by the return of our youth from school holidays. We welcome new arrival Edna Mungaloo from Mowanjum. Entire house worked to create montages for NWF including several region grads.

CONTRADICTION: Post-holiday blues. One more person than beds.

Religious House: Derby

EXTERNAL: Aboriginal Heritage was held in Derby for Broalali people (35 attended) and Mowanjum Vikings journey to Broome for 3 days in their new uniforms (black T-shirts). Final preparations are made for the arrival of sheep and goats, as one more student is sent to Perth Religious House.

INTERNAL: Structures hold up Quarter plan with most of house members assigned out.
CONTRADICTION - Enabling the celebration of day to dayness in the midst of quarter plan coming off.

Religious House: Brisbane

EXTERNAL: Two day penetration, formulation visit to Toowoomba. Ten RSI grads at RSI.

INTERNAL: Ray Richmond returned from 4 day visit to Sydney. Finalized planning consultation for Qld. Christian Television Association.

CONTRADICTION: Concentration of doing at the expense of being.

MALAYSIA Religious House: Kuala LumpurSINGAPOREReligious House: Singapore

EXTERNAL: A great Week II: New Women's Seminar on Saturday; followed, on Sunday, by the first experiment in liturgical reformulation at Foochow; and a college type lunch at noon for 12 at the Outpost, the highlight of which was the send-out for Singapore's first International Intern, Mr. Phung Khye Sun.

INTERNAL: Visit by the "Chicago Three" for the New Women's Seminar included three great collegial meals of fine Singapore food, Malay, Russian, and Chinese. Singapore's evening newspaper, "The New Nation", carried a lengthy editorial page article in its June 1st edition on "The Great Virtues" of Poverty as detachment, Chastity as single-mindedness, and Obedience as engagement, written by colleague Garry de Cruz, one of the editors, after an informal conversation about our NRM charts.

CONTRADICTION: One key lay colleague, invited to attend ITI, has not yet been able to make arrangements for leave from his job.

INDONESIA Religious Outpost: DjakartaHONG KONGReligious Outpost: Hong Kong

EXTERNAL: An exciting PLC for 22 total persons - mostly seminarians. It was a first in that part was in English and part in Cantonese - a fascinating dynamic; A follow up program for the New Women's Forum course was held.

INTERNAL: Celebration of the 78th Anniversary of Shum Oi Church; new decor created for the church

CONTRADICTION/SIGN: Although immediate cash is less than hoped for, there are a number of clear avenues for long range ITI funding opening up.

JAPAN Religious Outpost: Osaka

EXTERNAL: Morrill met with Tokyo Cadre at celebrational dinner - responsibilities for National Council enthusiastically picked up by cadre; dinner followed by attending film - "the Swimmer" with nine couples from NWF; film conversation most exciting and enticing to husbands of group; heavy recruitment push for English-speaking Japanese course by Osaka cadre; Iida given final permission to be on staff at ITI Manila. Enthusiastic and open response on part of Japanese laymen being recruited for RSI shows great possibilities and an expectant "waiting" for this sort of thing.

INTERNAL: Hard push on finalizing theoretical and practical models for Japan Summer Training for 17 days in August at Osaka House for intensifying iron-man training. Completion of Japan Social Vehicle study with written gestalts and summaries of 13 week study bring increased clarity to our cultural context of work.

CONTRADICTION: Break-down of adequate ecclesiola structure necessary for objectivity on internal life; adequate and constant nurture of colleagues across the nation while seeing demand for new area of penetration; cancellation of Kofu RSI.

Religious Outpost: Fukushima

EXTERNAL: Crowded week in Fukushima with CSI battleplan constructed by cadre, sector mailing accomplished, exciting Kazanzakis study, and pastoral visitation continued. Implementation of faculty relations model has Ken on faculty Volley Ball team - some advantage emerges in being 30 centimeters above the nearest competition.

INTERNAL: Solitary Office boxes equipped with new types of incense and burners. The Mystery shows a new face.

CONTRADICTION: Maintaining momentum on recruitment for national council.

PHILIPPINES

Religious Outpost; Manila

EXTERNAL: The constitution Convention begins with a strong smell of awe. We in the house are torn between the depths of cynicism and deep frustration that we do not yet have the "homework" done on the NSV to the point yet where we can contribute significantly to the process of building a national polity construct adequate to the complexities of the 20th Century. (Right on Summer '71, Lord have mercy!)

INTERNAL: David in the South on a pre ITI trip.

SIGN: R.C. Sister sent by the LORD to attend the ITI. Breaks open unexpectedly a new area.

TAIWAN Religious Outpost: Tainan

SAMOA Religious Outpost: Samoa

EXTERNAL: Joel and Rob Duffy went to Fiji to finalise ITI participants, and Joel visited several schools. We now have invitations to several schools and the opportunity for an outpost no later than Jan. 72, and the Movement has its feet on firm ground. Created Pentecost Card in a 24 hour period, which is now printed and ready to mail.

INTERNAL: Created a new house design and brought intentionality into the function of each room and the use of the house as a missional tool. Have begun our quarter evaluation.

CONTRADICTION: Need time for reflection and evaluation, yet are consumed by ITI, cadre, New Women's Forum, and Development!

MARSHALL ISLANDS

Religious Outpost: Majuro

EXTERNAL: Created imaginal orientation brochure and application form for school. Polishing up course manuals and organizational recommendations for next year.

INTERNAL: Celebrated the end of classes with a feast: fish, roast and Ferragaki pig, and the trimmings, plus a drama of an old Marshallese legend.

CONTRADICTION: No books for NSV research.

SUB ASIA

Religious Outpost: Bombay.

ORDER BASE

EXTERNAL: 193 courses taught across the continent this quarter. 90% of the checks were turned in by the pedagogues. The other 10% are on the way.

INTERNAL: Ellison-Freiberger, Dismeyer-Avery wedding accompanied by dramatic effects from the Lord. The hurricane pitched us into the blackness and the waters from the depths of the earth rose into our basement. Ellison commented that he thought "It was a good day to be married".

CONTRADICTION: Facilities for Summer '71
