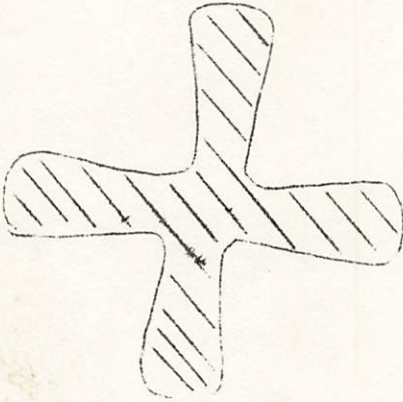


Chicago

GLOBAL WEST Religious House: Chicago
 External: Corporate power manifest in signal Week II recruitment as old hands, new hands pitch in to assure first RS-1 of the quarter.

NORTH AMERICA Internal: Experienced the dynamic of Summer '71 intensified as we initiated New time design, Gogarten, St. John of the Cross, and Latin America--the Canonical hours and received increasing numbers of guests in one week.

NORTH Contradiction: Bringing into being global research while engaging in 100% penetration effort.

Religious House: Madison

External: Permeation of Young World Developers here led to lengthy conversation with Fanny Lou Hamer.

Internal: Lease signed on house, occupancy by October 18th--2218 Center Ave.

Contradiction: What is the model for cadres not in Experiment and what is their mission to their local church.

Religious House: Milwaukee

Religious House: Rockford

Religious House: Peoria

External: Four strange angels arrived from Chicago to enable exciting break-open blitz.

Internal: Launching of the quarter with new, intensive time design. Struggle to squeeze in Order study and research but excited to plug into Global Research Net.

Contradiction: Advanced courses stand as a looming giant on the other side of intensive RS-1 recruitment push.

Religious House: Champaign/Urbana

External: PLC calling in Watseka, Danville, and Champaign/Urbana; brochures mailed out to metro grads; speaking engagement with governing Board of UCC church in Champaign was well received.

Religious House: Champaign/Urbana cont'd.

Internal: Covenanting of marriage between Marolyn Sue Fortin and Joseph Kirsch house interns on October 1, with colleagues from 3 metros participating in service. Service and reception had deep and significant impact on all present --a sign of possibility for intentional celebration within local congregation.

Contradiction: How to release metro colleagues to decide the cruciality of dying their deaths on the tactic of RS-1 recruitment.

Religious House: Minneapolis

External: Request from Green Bay metro for a galaxy in Fall '72, with three churches now ready with strong clergy families and cadres.

Internal: Long Range Planning (to Summer '76) objectified missional demands and possibilities. One more job acquired (one to go) and a house possibility emerged.

Contradiction: External Mission engagement slowed by beginning fall quarter with uncompleted plans, house hunting, and lack of internal mission tools (books, breviaries, etc.)

Religious House: Detroit

External: The galactic auxiliary timeline for the quarter was built out of comprehensive strategies and tactics which included completion of the galactic configuration and missional family models. Implemented missional model as catalytic agent in Presidium planning and metro course recruitment.

Internal: A new team structure and time design emerged out of the completion of both internal enablement and external mission planning, signaling the beginning of the Fall quarter's work.

Contradiction: Dealing seriously with an interim measure to actualize PLC recruitment without a broad base of movement clergy.

Religious House: ClevelandReligious House: IndianapolisReligious House: Cincinnati

External: Six teams from house and metro recruit 26 for Fall Quarter RS-1's. 83 participants in United Methodist School of Religion met for the first of four Tuesday night sessions on Imaginal Education team taught by two house members and a prospective galaxy pastor.

Internal: Another job secured. Two people now permeating the Federal Government. Ecclesiola with 22 guests. House members numbered five.

Contradiction: Community Organization with reduced futuristic vision temporarily blocks securing the structure that God ordained 80 years ago to be the Cincinnati Religious House.

Religious House: Kansas City

External: Lincoln/Omaha Week II foray nets 50-plus clergy calls in one day and doubling of prospect list. Kansas City PLC trains five prospective LCE families. Two new pre-primal cadres (K.C. and Lincoln). Males in Lincoln decide to make Movement a family affair. Intern prospect list swells.

Internal: Received Karen and Herschel Ele as interns at House Church. Quarterly enablement assignments seem "effective", ease burden of hour/hour "chart watching". Began Gogarten study-eager to receive books.

Contradiction: Formulation possibilities demanding less people on permeation jobs Messiah; one huge income.

EAST

Religious House: Boston

External: Regional Presidium signaled an emerging body of corporate leadership within the Spirit Movement and intensified fall penetration.

Internal: The occasion of making fall quarter assignments created missional order and a comprehensive context for responding to the demands of global civilization.

Contradiction: To construct an adequate financial base to allow for broadening a response to emerging demands.

Religious House: Manchester

External: Signal Regional Presidium with 54 colleagues points toward year of common thrust of total region; located in Metro with intensive calling and L.C. galaxy expansion groundwork.

Internal: Planning for year's thrust in the continuation of module experiment in metro and region.

Contradiction: Structuring of time/troops to enable all thrusts of mission to go on simultaneously and be intensified.

Sign: Cliff working two shifts a day to enable financial push, job upgrading also in process.

Religious House: Portland

External: Participated in the grassroots consensus to renew the Local Church by sending two colleagues from Portland metro to Fall Academy and by participating with 11 colleagues in Fall Regional Presidium.

Internal: Building the quarter calendar that honors both the Local demands and the common global order demands as we actualize the research dynamic.

Contradiction: Catalyzing and giving structural form to the module dynamic that relates the house dynamic to the other regional dynamics.

Religious House: Pittsburg

External: PLC and RSI recruitment blitz throughout region with 57 clergy contacted and preaching during layman Sunday and Worldwide Communion Sunday, future galaxy nurture by visitation to present cadre, job hunting intensified; Pittsburg Pirates leap into World Series enabling at least one mendicant mercenary to work at ticket office.

Internal: Became a sign of impingement to present tenants of Religious House by moving 5 youth, 3 children, and 4 adults into basement.

Contradiction: Allowing regional and metro structures to pick up responsibilities while engaged in recruitment which must be done immediately.

Religious House: Philadelphia

External: Eight regional colleagues attended House Church after a well attended metro meeting: PLC recruitment visitation intensified by House/Regional colleague teams; House attended world-wide communion at galaxy church.

Internal: Sister Marie Raphael, assistant to Mother General, Order of Gray Nuns, spoke to House about her order; Week II House PSU got out regional battleplan; Crookers arrived.

Contradiction: Quickly enabling Region to do its job.

Religious House: New York (September 24-30)

External: The first of six visitation trips into the metros signaled an intensified push on PLC recruitment. Visits with clergy in the Poughkeepsie Metro opened up new possibilities for the coming PLC as well as recruits for RSI.

Internal: Guest night excitement sparked by the study of Pachomius and the presence of 10 nuns studying Religious Education at Fordham University.

Contradiction: Catalyzing the development of Metro tactical models for penetration.

Religious House: New York (October 1-7)

External: Massive Penetration in Poughkeepsie Metro demonstrated the corporate power of the Regional Movement and the possibility of releasing new decisions in total stragglers.

Internal: The beginning of Fall Quarter was symbolized with a shift in the time design to include Daily Office and corporate conversations at the evening meal as well as a shift in the space design creating a missional office and a Young Churchmen's training room.

Contradiction: Holding comprehensive thrust for Region while becoming engaged in particular tactics for each Metro.

Religious House: Rochester

Religious House: Washington

NORTH-
EAST

Religious House: Montreal (September 24-30)

External: 1st Galaxy council of the quarter met last weekend to begin tertiary actualization.

Internal: House youth hosted Galaxy emerging generation during weekend of galaxy council with admirable curriculum and pedagogical skill.

Contradiction: Lack of coordinated models to carry on mission makes lack of troops seem more acute than it is.

Religious House: Montreal (October 1-7)

External: Intensified recruitment turns up participants for 3 courses to be held in the next 2 week period.

Internal: The summer methodology dealing with contradictions has pushed and given greater clarity to the House's station. strategic objectives.

Contradiction: Missionally focusing priorities in the midst of diverse demands.

Religious House: Toronto

External: Full day of recruiting by entire house and regional colleagues insures fall courses.

Internal: House celebrates two new jobs in two days, and begins fall quarter with zest.

Contradiction: Running to catch up with the present so we can run into the future.

NORTH-
WEST

Religious House Winnipeg (September 24-30)

External: Week-long foray to Saskatchewan to nurture grads, set up and recruit courses. Wee II 1400 mile foray for recruiting PLC and RSI with whole house participating.

Internal: Exceptionally fine House Church with four key regional people in the house.

Contradiction: The plan we created for recruitment is not consistent with the immediate situation resulting in either a mad rush or paralysis.

Religious House: Winnipeg (October 1-7)

External: Steady force of PLC, RSI recruitment temas in Winnipeg area breaks open new prospects. Clergy's old images of "EI thing" being recontextualized effectively but slowly.

Internal: 5 P.S.U.'s on Formulation and Penetration past Wk II; study of "Christ of History" paper the key event of the week.

Contradiction: How hold tension of creating ground-swell for whole year's courses and the need for immediate registrations for fall courses.

WEST

Religious House: Seattle (September 24 - October 7)

External: Sent another team back up to Vancouver, B.C. on weekend foray; recruitment in Seattle Metro with Regional colleagues empties out house; held weekend RSI Pedagogy with 14 colleagues; prior made two day formulation trip through Pasco Metro.

Internal: Celebrated endings of summer and beginning of Fall with Alaskan celebration which was empowered by presence of our Alaskan colleagues Marsha Bach and Dorothy Green; sent the Phillips off to Academy; welcomed new intern Denise Roys; emerging generation weekend camping trip in mountains great success.

Contradiction: Lack of enough intern couples to stabilize our external thrust and internal life in midst of penetration demands and income mission demands.

Religious House: Denver

Religious House: Billings

External: Exciting work and findings Billings and researching data on denominational structure, and research data on Billings Region's 1,100,000.

Internal: Job hunting continues, one more obtained.

Contradiction: PLC registrations split -- 2 courses jeopardizing both.

Religious House: Rapid City

External: RSI blitz in Rapid City sector yields several recruits and many probables.

Internal: Beginning of Daily Office is like new blood as Fall Quarter begins.

Contradiction: PLC recruitment in Rapid City sector not keeping pace with outlying sectors; danger is that good clergy recruits may "die at third."

Religious House: San Francisco

External: Faculty guild with 33 receiving teaching and enablement assignments for quarter.

Internal: Visits from Joel and Betsy Radford returning from Samoa, the Aso's on their way to Japan, Rev. Kang on his way to Korea, John Burbidge traveling from Perth to academy spirited house to globality of the movement. Sent Ruth Landmann and Charlotte Quimby to academy.

Contradiction: Enthusiasm requires longer range vision to enable more practical model building.

Sign: Arrival of Carl and Claudia Dolh for sojourn assignment from galaxy.

Religious House: Los Angeles

External: Implementation of Fall Quarter time design begins enabling time design for major pushes in 6 metros all at once.

Internal: Exciting Gogarten study begins fall quarter as it puts the demands and vision of the summer in perspective relative to the fall mission.

Contradiction: Getting the depth formulation task done in the midst of immediate fall calendar demands.

SOUTH

Religious House: Oklahoma City

External: Recruit, recruit, recruit: whole house out every Week II and evenings as well as full time people in the metros from Tues. through Thurs.

Internal: 3 house meeting on Sunday to set quarter goals. Great reunion.

Ecclesiola construct off to flying start: all troops return from front lines for it.

Contradiction: Re-evaluate PLC recruitment plan with metro colleagues in the light of collapse of first PLC.

Religious House: Amarillo

External: As sign of regional resource exchange OKC 1st Christian pastor colleague attends RSI recruitment talk and visits key potential galaxy 1st Christian clergy in Amarillo Sun. and Monday. Very helpful.

Internal: Rented temporary outpost house: 1919 S. Crockett, Amarillo, Texas 79109, with special room for guests, sojourners or an intern family. Job hunts opens OEO adult education job possibility.

Contradiction: Wee 4 RSI strategy that elicits deep "yes" from 35 spirits in Amarillo metro.

Religious House: Tulsa

External: Intensification penetration work for RSI's and PLC. Cultivating helpful relationships with the establishment through vehicle of house search. Catalytic cadre formulation enabled in Bartlesville. Galaxy in good shape.

Internal: Celebrated House Church in OKC with colleagues from other outpost and central House, recontexting ourselves with finalizing of quarter battle plans. Project churches and intern families on the timeline for this fall.

Contradiction: Bringing order to our internal design while intensifying activity in multiplying missional arenas.

Religious House: New Orleans

Internal: New Worship Room indicative of the fall quarter internal structures.

External: Blitz strategy employed in Lake Charles Metro: 38 calls made in recruiting two courses.

Contradiction: Turning blitz enthusiasm into course registrations.

Religious House: Atlanta

External: Mass Penetration (20 people) in Savannah during Week II netted 16 registrations and many possibilities; PLC this week promises strong colleagues; Oct. 15-17 RSI at 30 and rising.

Internal: Fall divisions in full swing with work on symbolic life and quarter planning; House children scale Stone Mt. on Week II trek.

Contradiction: How to meet all the demands in the midst of House working out (or seeking) and strong metro colleagues away at Academy (Praise God!).

Religious House: Houston

Religious House: Miami

EUROPE

Religious House: London

External: Had conversation with Archbishop at York about our work and new location.

Internal: Moved into our house and began trying to furnish it--- people whose 2 suitcases are full of course materials are not much help in furnishing an empty house. Received Clare Spencers and Bill Bonnell as interns -- with great joy.

Contradiction: Starting a new quarter with incomplete course calendar -- scheduled.

SEAPAC
AUSTRALIAReligious House: Sydney

External: Made report to Australian Presbyterian Church Committee relative to the Mowanjum Project.

Internal: Missional planning for quarter.

Contradiction: Minor illnesses of adults and children.

Religious House : PerthReligious House: DerbyReligious Outpost: Melbourne

External: The Melbourne metropolitan calling net has begun with its first full day of calling with teams comprised of outpost colleagues and regional colleagues. At present there are seven for the RS-111A and four for the RS-1 expecting to rise strongly in the next two weeks. The gridding of all clergy prospects in the Melbourne Mega is nearly completed, and a beginning has been made in compiling a good Roman Catholic contact list. Outpost sent one member to be present for Adelaide Regional Council. The hope of a serious Local - Church Project is the fondest longing of many laymen and clergy alike. There are five congregations with eager grads and in various states of readiness in the South End of Melbourne alone.

Internal: After evaluation session, the Melbourne colleagues decided that the outpost should continue to function in Melbourne, that the colleagues would continue financial enablement, and the Morton family should move to a bungalow-flat owned by Anglican clergyman, the Rev. Leo Ball.

Contradiction: The lack of adequate intermediate programmes and procedures between the given situation and an adequate local church project.

PACIFICA

Religious Outpost: Majuro

External: Complete school schedule ready to go this week. Teachers specializing in discipline for the first time.

Internal: House flooded with potential pre-schoolers who help take care of Nathan.

Contradiction: Enabling movemental dynamics to gain momentum.

Religious Outpost: Apia

External: Our quarter time design shifted to emphasize school; house assigned to school five afternoons per week. Exciting things happening in Experimental model classes. (Team meeting-decor explosions).

Internal: Week 11 meeting on Missional Trust produced a very exciting visionary plan for indigenization. Phase 1 will begin the quarter with the High Point being a special two week training program in the month of December.

Contradiction: No structure for getting lunches to school.

JAPAN

Religious Outpost: Osaka

External: National Planning meeting held in Tokyo to pull together a full year's calendar; highlighted by report from Toshifumi and Michiko Aso returning from International Intern Program.

Internal: Beginning of Fall Quarter with new time design-- excited by the Global Research Net materials arriving from Base and seeing how meshed with our insights of what needed to happen; Cole family sojourning for a week.

Contradiction: Less man-power and more work. How to create methods that enable comprehensive futuric planning.

TAIWAN

Religious Outpost: Tainan

External: Group in Kashiung doing research on Chinese Culture Course, -- Bulletin and Quarter format for Local Church. McDonald's decored military base chapel with the Urs for world-wide communion.

Internal: Quarter time-line laid out. Budget made. PLC preliminary course construct laid out looking toward PLC pedagogy. New corporate day schedule in operation.

Contradiction: More to do than can get done in the one day a month for planning as total group.

HONG KONG

Religious Outpost: Hong Kong

External: The Hong Kong Regional Council decided to corporately plan for a regional faculty by begining weekly pedagogical Guild for this Fall Quarter

Internal: October 1st marked the beginning of a totally corporate economic base for the house. The Yin-Yang was dramatized when an autumn Chinese-- Festival Lantern caught on fire during House Church setting the context for Life and Death.

Contradiction: No adequate structures for comprehensive regional training for all age groups.

MALAYSIA

Religious Outpost: Kuala Lumpur

September 22

External: Began gathering forces for catalytic cadre (with visions of galaxies in our heads): Three dinners with total of 6 ITI grads in the KL metro. Gave experimental NRM sermon to Port Swettenham Methodist Church. Reported on Manila ITI to Roman Catholic Bishop of KI diocese with favorable response.

Internal: Traveled to Singapore for second session of joint House strategizing and attended meeting of Singapore cadre. Completed preliminary -- yearly and quarterly battleplan with clear emphasis on Local Church Project preparation.

Contradiction: House financial crisis has reached the critical phase of payment or disconnection.

Religious Outpost: Kuala Lumpur

October 6

External: The KL metro colleagues (9) held their second meeting at the Religious House and built a Year's Battleplan, mapped out a potential galaxy, discussed the Local Church Project with James Solamadan (ITI Hong Kong, - Research Assembly in Manila), scheduled next meeting in six days and ended with House Church led by John Kovilpillai (ITI Manila). House attended World Wide Communion Sunday service led by Methodist Bishop Yap. Also celebrated wedding of James Teal and Susie Putechary, movement colleagues.

Internal: Celebrated illustrious Mooncake Festival, created Quarter's time design and internal structures for House, (study of the Second Malaysia Plan' pulled through the NSV triangles and SK's Training in Christianity scheduled for quarter).

Contradiction; Merging the new burst of self-initiative and momentum of the Movement with the past three years of courses and former cadres and colleagues.

SINGAPORE

Religious Outpost: Singapore

External: Initiated systematic cultivation of STAR Plan churches with visitations and guest nights.

Internal: Began regular quarterly schedule with 5 a.m. Collegium and Daily Office.

Contradiction; The tendency of the colleagues to concentrate on their own problems blocks their ability to assume missional leadership for renewing the whole church.

Religious Outpost: Manila

External: Prepared for report on separation on Church/State for CON-CON Committee.

Internal: Shaking down the structures and preparing the time design that fits the external demands and the Philippino style.

Contradiction: Lifting the burden of decision relative to objectifying the necessary in terms of structures.

SUBASIA Religious Outpost: Bombay Urban Ashram September 19

External: Break open possibilities for recruitment, development and permeation for Quarter II as advanced teams visited south, east and west; gathered support of three Bombay Bishops and begun development with the American Business Community.

Internal: Frequent and lengthy visits by many colleagues was climaxed with worship and breakfast celebration at the return of Bishop R.D. Joshi during which he presented the Urban Ashram the Order Banner from the Panchayat and delighted the House with tales of Religious Houses Drama around the globe.

Contradiction: Picking up on the possibilities broken open this week with over half the house out on extended teaching tracks.

Religious Outpost: Bombay Urban Ashram September 26

External: Bombay Cadre gets out mass mailing to clergy in the metros of Bombay region announcing 1st of 8 PLCs to be held in the Sub-Continent this quarter. Bishop James K. Mathews visited the House and gave a discourse on dynamics of "Ashram" pulled through the 144's. Imaginal Education Course in Delhi with 55 public school teachers in attendance, half of whom are non-churchmen.

Internal: House involves itself in morass of tasks that hails ending of quarter I and launches Sub-Continent into new quarter.

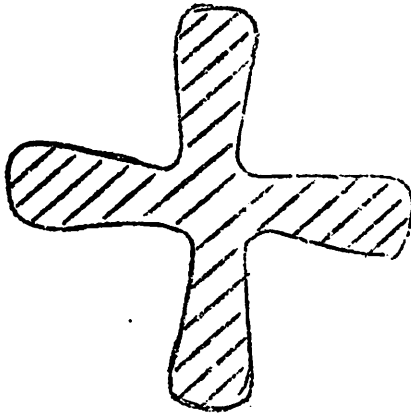
Contradiction: Completing Ecclesiola format for quarter as quarter II begins.

ORDER BASE

External: The teaching quarter began with 610 participants in 5 PLC's, 15 RS-1's, and 8 Advance Courses on the North American Continent. Urban Academy enrollment increases to 50 as participants continue to arrive. International Interns and visitors have arrived from England, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Australia and India.

Internal: Joel and Betsy Radford returned after two year assignment to Samoa, deeply impacted by spirit and spirit of the movement on this continent. Development received a gift of 3 adding machines and 10,000 gallons of paint ... unlabeled.

Contradiction: Co-ordination of complex teaching assignments with Local.- Church Councils and other demands.

GLOBAL Religious House: Chicago

WEST External: Availability for PLC holding values of adequate space, close proximity to Chicago, reasonable cost, and beds rather than cots.

NORTH Internal: Permission of St. John of the Cross to decide to be in the dark night.

AMERICA Contradiction: Intensity of recruitment and formulation leaves tangles in the enablement structures.

NORTH

Religious House: Madison

External: Metro leadership shifts gears from accomplishment of 27 week I RS-1 to contradiction of only 6 registered for week IV P-1.

Internal: House deeply addressed by question of care for key clergy family whose church burned down.

Contradiction: Moving day, regional priors meeting, clergy guild, recruitment. Must go on simultaneously, but how?

Religious House: Milwaukee (October 1-7)

External: RS-1 and PLC recruitment in all 6 sectors this week (41 registered for 1st RS-1), including dinner with present staff of Father Groppi's church, witnessing their despair over loss of vision. 40 from Metro build eight week's worth of children's curriculum in one night!

Internal: Healing came during a youth colloquium which included conversation relative to roles of youth and adults in a Religious House. First week of daily office revealed new depths in our own sense after corporate worship.

Contradiction: Knowing we have 1000 years doesn't really help you decide which pebble on the beach you need to pick up first, although one very large pebble is labeled "door".

Religious House: Milwaukee (October 8-14)

External: RS-1 recruitment intensifies with three penetration nights in three sectors this week, covering all 6 sectors. Recruiting nights approached with dread but also deep excitement.

Internal: Presence of St. Leo's Parish Cadre at Ecclesiola heightened our sense of the Ecclesiola dynamic and the intentionality necessary to release the spirit deeps.

Contradiction: Releasing stored-up energy and power in metro, relative to decision to intern; and the house, relative to constantly embodying the vision.

Religious House: Rockford (October 1-7)

External: Old Metro leadership deciding to meet together for eight weeks of training and recruiting. Ten metro colleagues operating under Fall Quarter wk II Assignment structure.

Internal: First ecclesiola in four months without regional guests enabled us to reflect on House's corporateness and see ourselves as the unique entity of the Religious House.

Contradiction: 17 prepaids already have canceled out of 36 registered for this first weekend course.

Religious House: Rockford (October 8-14)

External: First time the first course of the year has come off in Rockford in four years.

Internal: High mood of celebration and much humor with a Bug Conversation in Ecclesiola. House Church celebrated with colleagues who represented 10 Religious Houses again pushed the globality of the movement.

Contradiction: How to keep to a minimum the prepaid "No Shows".

Religious House: Peoria

Religious House: Champaign/Urbana

External: 7 day intensive recruitment of 140 visits: concretion of the slogan "We give our lives for 35".

Internal: House procurement continues unabated.

Contradiction: Recruitment pitch.

Religious House: Minneapolis

External: Development in the Minneapolis Metro netted \$2500+ in two days.

Internal: Spent Week II finalizing Fall Quarter external mission planning, with tactics and timelines.

Contradiction: PLC two weeks off with nine registrations tied down.

Religious House: Detroit

External: Detroit RS-1, selection of a Historical Order for research and lunch with urban affairs leader of the Methodist Church explode montage of external mission.

Internal: Gogarten lecture at first 5 a.m. collegium initiated the theological undergirding of the NSV work for the Fall Quarter.

Contradiction: The role of the House as catalytic agent in the region.

Religious House: Cleveland

External: House penetration tactic--"webbing"--reaches quaternary mindset with new recruitment stories required. Continued work on intensive penetration battle plan by PSU weekend and week I gridding to micro level with telephone books arriving for micro cities symbolizes the task.

Internal: The celebration of the death of Roger Emig of the Cincinnati House--rejoice for all the saints who from their labors rest. NSV study and Gogarten open exciting new vistas to hold the comprehensive context in the midst of the very particular.

Contradiction: Adjusting to the absence of those necessarily assigned out of regular House meals and events.

Religious House: Indianapolis

Religious House: Cincinnati

External: Louisville massive penetration, Hamilton RS-1, and Louisville PLC are signal events of the new quarter pointing to infinite possibilities to plug in finite number of fresh grads.

Internal: Death of intern Roger Emig due to long bout with cancer on Sunday, October 10. Ninety-four colleagues and family members gathered at a feast Monday to celebrate Roger's life thru the sharing of stories and expressions of thanksgiving for his life. The celebration of his death thru the wake Monday night and funeral Tuesday allowed all involved to experience Roger's death as the completion of his life, and as a single thrust into history, pronounced good and whole.

Contradiction: Under new working image of modules, how is it 12 sectors begin spinning with 9 house members to do the task? Demand: be in all sectors every weekend.

Religious House: Kansas City

External: Cock is on faculty at St. Paul's School of Theology (Field Service Supervisor of two in-house seminarians). Omaha PLC 3 weeks away already showing signs of new birth--gas pumping ex-clergyman and wife named "Bones" are signed up. Visited Servants of Mary in Omaha--received open invitation to stay "anytime" in their guestroom. Met priest there who was so excited by our story that he wants to pay our way to come and talk with all his central Nebraska priests at their next meeting.

Internal: House levitates as we became latin America during our week II research featuring beef chow mein. Hour-long singing and pedagogical "being" drama of "The Cryin'" allows us to be centered. District Superintendent visits and says, "I am struck by the reverence, cleanliness, and joy of this house... its not at all like the commune I visited! I'd like to come back with my family."

Contradiction: Have not yet begun looking for a larger house, knowing what we know.

EAST

Religious House: Rochester

External: Seven house members to Albany for RS-1 and PLC recruitment over the weekend.

Internal: Regional sojourners in the House for a week and Catholic Seminarian and Faculty member attended Ecclesiola.

Contradiction: Still looking for the six intern families necessary for House mission.

External: House moving in all metros to raise up new leadership in 36 sectors. Training will begin in the fifth week with the establishment of six Pedagogy Guilds. Interested clergy are being visited relative to Galaxy expansion. Penetration is breaking loose in all sectors.

Contradiction: The need for patience and restrained forcefulness to enable the journeys of the covenant group--over against a limited timeline.

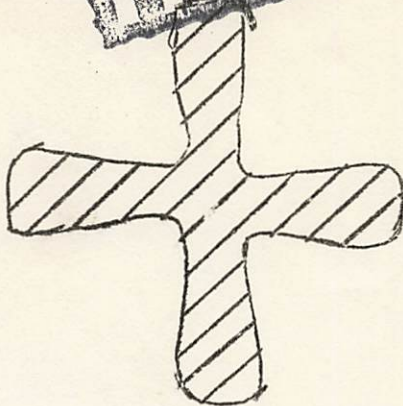

AMERICA External: Signal PLC revealed crucial role of Metro enablement and a local pastor on the teaching team.

NORTH Internal: Conversation pulling anticipated RS-1 participants through characters in Little Big Man, became meditative friend to those assigned in as well as those assigned out to teach.

Contradiction: Massive dispersion for penetration and formulation and wall to wall internal assignments call for new structures of communication to keep on top of the total picture.

Religious House: Madison

External: Recruitment continues for second RS-1 amidst a significant local church consult in which we decided to repeat the first quarter tactics.

Internal: The Outpost moved from the residence of the Metro co-ordinator to a home on the east side of Madison.

Contradiction: Enabling participation of clergy in weekly guild.

Religious House: Milwaukee

External: Recruited in all six sectors again, taught or participated in three courses and enabled the creation of two congregational cadres.

External: First RS-1 of quarter with nods from participants on metro council participation. Preparation for signal metro council. Consult with Bloomington cadre.

Internal: PSU on NSV. All permeators now employed.

Contradiction: Finding ways to create external structures which will enable old grads and colleagues to operate out of strengthened internal resources.

Contradiction: Lack of follow through model for pushing PLC decision by key ministers; house and metro being hit by aridity of doing.

Internal: Another job secured and begun--for a total of 4. Two still looking

Contradiction: Had a car for every family but only one was in condition to go more than a distance of 20 miles.

Religious House: Kansas City

External: Formulation meetings in Lincoln, Wichita, Kansas City and Salina; penetration in Topeka, Lawrence and Kansas City--all in one night without dropping one permeation "plate." Pastors from last PLC recruiting their laymen before we show up to suggest it! Praise the Free Man. Penetration in Wichita registers 14 from one Mennonite House. 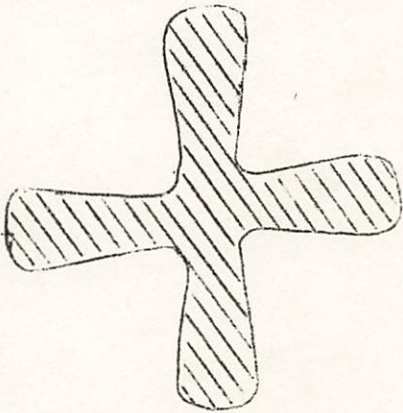

Consult this WkII' with 6 clergy ready to hear the invitation to participate in the experiment.

Internal: Excitement over Gogarten study beginning to mount. House teams preparing reports on NSV triangles relative to Russia -- this week heard reports on Russian Cyclical Roles.

Contradiction: How to hold tension of building a regional recruitment machine for which regional colleagues sense themselves responsible while not losing valuable course time and cancelling courses while that machine is being built.

Religious House: New Orleans

Religious House: Atlanta

External: Recruitment for January PLC begun with letters and winter brochures mailed to 204 'eager' clergymen.

Internal: Week II push on internal ordering signalled by battle with German roaches and completion of work on regional printout by young churchmen.

Contradiction: Meeting demand for employment (2 to go) while maintaining effective regional thrust.

Religious House: Miami (October 15-21)

Internal: 3rd week of quarter was our 1st (and probably last) week of business as usual. Gogarten study begun with high excitement and the week was signaled by house church with all present.

External: Third Week Regional Circuit was completed and Week II recruitment teams blitzed Gainesville and Jacksonville. Veterans Day blitz of Miami focused on PLC recruitment. Sending out course registration confirmation letters signals that it's 'all systems go'.

Contradiction: High priority of the Miami Metro along with the requirement of insuring an RSI 400 miles away from the House dramatizes the imperative to catalyze metro cadres.

Religious House: Miami: (October 22-28)

External: All attention focused on prospecting, recruiting, confirming, re-confirming, enabling and teaching penetration courses. A call from David McCleskey at the airport on his way to Caracas dramatizes the relationship of Miami to Latin America. Minor miracle to report: as PLC facility cancelled on us 24 hours before course was to start, another facility was reserved.

Internal: Guest night gave us the opportunity to host the president of the Miami Fellowship of Churches and his wife. Week II Pedagogy session geared us all with what recruitment is all about. Affirming the very strategic location of the House is the establishment of the Fred Harris For President Headquarters next door -- so watch for the white house next door on TV news clips of Harris events in Miami.

Contradiction: Circuit models and metro recruitment models are not producing enough live bodies relative to the demands for trained regional colleagues and metro structures in the winter quarter.

EUROPE

UNITED
KINGDOM

Religious House: London

External: Two people left for a two week trip through three regions of the British Isles. Initial reports indicate some good new contacts as well as helpful renewal of old acquaintances.

Internal: With aid of plumber (leaking pipe brings down piece of ceiling) and electrician (mysterious short blacks out ground floor) and our own scrub-lift power, moved 1st two people into Annex and prepared to receive another family.

Contradiction: Meshing the time to create a Global Order.

ORDER
BASE

External: Symbolic presence of the Order in Global South was doubled by sending Marcia to join Bruce Bunker in their local congregation in Caracas. Penetration reports 23 RS-1 and PLC courses completed during last week. In 5th City 200 children and 77 adults became a giant Halloween celebration as brought off by Iron Man know-how in the heart of West Side Chicago.

Internal: The secular "Convoy Course"--including all three "ships", men, women, and youth--was held in its complete form for the second time and, with some minor overhauling, was censured upon as ready for another test in a local congregational setting. The traditional children's Halloween "trick-or-treat" was observed with a splendid array of costumes and candies.

Contradiction: The internal appropriation of the external task.

SEAPAC

Religious House: Sydney

AUSTRALIA

External: Recruitment for RS-1, advanced courses, and Summer '72 goes on as Rob Duffy and Nelson Stover are sent out to teach courses in other regions.

Internal: Pushing the spirit deeps with Gogarten and St. John of the Cross.

Contradiction: Deciding on priorities in the midst of innumerable possibilities.

Sign: Importance of Aboriginal thrust impressed upon us as Joseph Mathews holds two hour collegium with Duffy and Stover at airport on his way to a meeting about Mowanjum at Darwin.

Religious House: Perth

External: Full scale visitation with three teams out each evening uncovering significant contacts among Baptists and Presbyterians. Interview with Cyril Manuel, Mission Secretary of Anglican church, results in donation and acceptance of invitation to House. First of three pedagogy weekends for region held at House and enablement of Scarborough Anglican church continues.

Internal: Children's week II hits new high with dozens of pictures of 2001: Space Odyssey from local cinema providing the decor of their dining room. Trips to the Astronomical observatory and an Air Force base included. Youth of the House presented their banner and symbol to House Church. Guests and House watched the ABC TV documentary on the Institute.

Contradiction: How to maintain the pace and accelerate the quarter.

Religious House: Derby

External: During the fourth week of Bungungal Quarter the key external event was the assignment of Mowaijariai and Albert Barunga to Darwin to meet Joe Mathews and to talk with the Tribal Elders and course graduates from arnhem land. The Kitchen, Laundry and slaughterhouse guild moved this week to begin the new slaughter house which will provide the facilities to slaughter sheep, cattle and pigs for the community needs. The other two key events were the selling of more salt, and the mooring of the Muliundooma in deep water after being in dry dock for so long.

Internal: We received this week John Telford a sojourner from South Australia. George Holcombe and Jonathan Barker were assigned to Darwin with the two community Elders to meet Joe Mathews and to plan and begin the penetration in the total model of Aboriginal development. Completed the writing, reading and typing of the total proposal model for the government.

Contradiction: Not having built the procedural step model and to release the forces to produce the sign of missional thrust that is needed for Mowanjum community.

Religious Outpost: Melbourne

External: Brian Pullen and D. Morton held a local church consultation with the Noble Park Presbyterian Church, including 16 church leaders, on the purposes and methods of Bible conversations and studies. Regarded as a fine success all around. Began visiting on the North Side (North of the Yarra River, that is), as the beginning point for a second metro collegium to collect and reinvest some long term old grads in the work of renewing the local church.

Internal: Outpost colleagues began a re-study of Document II, and Morton family began Gogarten. First informal guest night held with Andrew Vigas and Ann Williams.

Contradiction: Earning income to make post self-sustaining, as mission intensifies.

PACIFICA

Religious Outpost: Apia

External: Visit with conference president of the Methodist Church in Samoa reveals new interest as he requests two week training program for teachers in Methodist schools. He also asked two outpost members to help set up a Sunday school program in his church.

Internal: Outpost reorganizes time design to allow for effective participation in Global Research Net. Outpost size doubles with housing of a high school student and arrival of Ensinger family.

Contradiction: Orienting new outpost staff while needing to increase spin of all areas as summer approaches.

Sign: Visits to Lalomilo in Honolulu and Rev. Kamu in American Samoa find them still seeking church renewal and seeing Institute methodology what is needed in that.

Religious Outpost: Majuro

JAPAN

Religious Outpost: SendaiReligious Outpost: Osaka (October 15-21)

External: Mark Reames and Justin Morrill begin series of permeation calls on Seiko Kai (Episcopal) Clergy in Kobe-Osaka area by visiting with eight clergy. Visits also made on YWCA leadership and visits made on Korean clergy in Japan by Kang.

Internal: Great sense of global collegiality with visit of Byoung Hoon Kang and two Korean pastors who participated in House Church and Monday collegium on the Local Church Project.

Contradiction: Osaka RS-1 six days away with four registrations requires new recruitment strategies and tactics.

Religious Outpost: Osaka (October 22-28)

External: First course of Quarter was PLC held in Kitakyushu with 18 participants. Joseph Iida as first teacher was fantastic showing great promise for training Japanese pedagogues. International sign by the teaching of Kand in the course. Visit with head of Ecumenical Affairs for Episcopal Church in Osaka gives greater promise of PLC soon.

Internal: Great renewed address for all in Ecclesiola in the study of McClesky's "Spirit Life" paper; week II moved us down the road in the NSV study of the Political Dimension of India with corporate and individual study marked by the employment of the Canonical Hours.

Contradiction: Continual Global and movement contextualizing to keep vision and "problems" focussed on the large and the long picture to enable adequate expenditure of human energy.

TAIWAN

Religious Outpost: Tainan (October 8-14)

External: Trip to Kaohsiung to grid the city, survey possibilities for Local Church involvement and to get leads on possible Spirit men. Joe led worship at the Seminary.

Internal: Celebration of Double Ten (tenth month, tenth day) which is National Day (birthday) for the Republic of China.

Contradiction: No grid of key men.

Religious House: Tainan (October 15-21)

External: Investigation of possible key men for Tainan and Kaohsiung. Visit with two local church pastors. Basil introduced solitary practices to a small group at the Seminary.

Internal: A PSU to lay out the structure of a PLC for Taiwan. Preparations for first regional meeting of ITI grads. Crispin Clements (parents interning in Hong Kong; she is a student at Tunghai University) visited for the weekend and brought a fresh, exciting spirit to our midst.

Contradiction: Permeation jobs taking too much time.

Religious House: Tainan (October 22-28)

External: Full day Regional meeting with ITI grads. Church union meeting attended by Basil and George for cultivation purposes.

Internal: Heads together in a PSU on the movement budget. Two Seminary students as college guests.

Contradiction: How to keep the vision while dealing with details.

HONG KONG

Religious Outpost: Hong Kong

External: Several significant contacts with Roman Catholic clergy and lay people this week helps to lay firm groundwork for future course recruitment.

Internal: The House was impacted by the Rev. and Mrs. Hosea Williams, SCLC Program Director, who just spent a month in China promoting contact between the Chinese and Black people. One observation they made was that the country of 600 million people live the style of all the jobs are for all the people and all the food is for all the people.

Contradiction: How to train Chinese pedagogues fast enough to meet the demand of Chinese courses that the Region needs.

MALAYSIA

Religious House: Kuala Lumpur

External: First RS-1 course in Mandarin taught by ITI grads in Sibu, Sarawak. Attended Church Union Negotiating Committee as a member (Peggy Heng). Analyzed signal Methodist Church in KL and discovered it was already in Phase 2 of Local Church Experiment.

Internal: Printed Kuala Lumpur-Singapore House planning booklet. Substitute teaching still increasing.

Contradiction: Prayer. Every 10 minute conversation with colleagues or potential colleagues requires at least an hour of model building.

SINGAPORE

Religious Outpost: Singapore

External: Began serious systematic PLC recruiting, netting three promises including a young evangelical minister and his wife.

Internal: Had three guests for dinner, all educators: a Belgian who teaches in an Australian progressive school, and a student from New Zealand, both returning from a journey to India; and a student from Singapore's Teacher Training College.

Contradiction: Corporateness requires structures, and structures require time, and time requires consensus, and consensus requires corporateness.

INDONESIA Religious Outpost: Djakarta

PHILIPPINES Religious Outpost: Manila

External: Preached chapel service at Philippines Christian College. Permeation network there increases. U. N. Day observed with 12 hour YWCA bakesale.

Internal: Blandina's tickets arrive. Will she get confirmed space to Rong-Rong? Tune in next week for next exciting chapter in "The Spirit Movement vs. Pan-Am".

SUBASIA Religious Outpost: Bombay Urban Ashram (October 15-21)

External: Bombay PLC and IRS-1 produce first strong inroads into Catholic Church.

Internal: Return of faculty from first teaching trek in Delhi with great reports from lucrative Imaginal Education Course followed by IRS-1 boosts mood of House.

Contradiction: Booking faculty railroad transportation during Diwali holiday transportation crush.

Sign: Completed 34 page Teaching Manual for continental faculty.

Sign: A choir celebration/rehearsal at which 17 nationalities were represented.
