**External:** Summer'72 send out Celebration impacts house members as well as over 40 guests and participants. Guests were greeted and ushered through the suffering world and then welcomed to the New World, "Planet Sinai." The evening was climaxed as 25 adults and children ascended the porch to be sent out by Galaxy member, Bill Scribner. As promises were claimed and the Spirit Song sung, the spirit poured forth (in form of Niagra Falls fireworks).

**Internal:** House received Rick and Linda Jones as interns (Priase God!) as Rick returns from Academy and 2 week stint at boot camp and Linda completes her 3 month sojourn. Holiday spent transforming Religious House into a monastery for the Summer Friary. Each room was given the name of a saint and an altar was created within it. **Contradiction:** How to meet missional and job responsibilities with troops working 3 different shifts.....communication restricted to phone and bulletin board.

**External:** S'72 trip to Savannah Metro produces 5 registrations, including 3 from Palen UMC (black) as pastor assumes responsibility for church by calling leaders together, workshopping 3 registrations, all only 2 weeks prior to moving to a new church.

**Internal:** House addressed by new look at financial situation. Visit of M/M Clif Toal, parents of Patsy Westall, turns out to be a time of pleasing collegiality. Contradiction: Discerning how to walk tightrope of pushing much and doing too little to recruit 36 participants for Summer '72: British Isles.

External: RSI injected into the middle of a 4-year parish education plan in a Welsh Village-ecumenical house groups already established.

Course received with Welsh enthusiasm, adding some great grads to the roster and hopefully to Summer '72: British Isles.

Internal: A 5-phase celebration marks the end of the first twenty years with appropriate events, songs, and symbols to signify each 4-year period, and promises for the future to symbolized the whole.

Contradiction: Tying down every last possibility for S'72.

ASIAReligious House: Sendai June 29, 1972

**External:** Local church pastor and cadreman offers prayer at Sunday service for I.T.I. and faculty, particularly Anne and Ken Filipski (who attend a different church) as they depart for Seoul.

**Internal:** Obtain new vehicle, our fourth, for use by sojourners. We are the proud owners of 3 bicycles and one (now driverless) motorcycle. Two new tutoring jobs lined up.

**Contradiction:** Creating helpful summer training constructs for those unable to go to I.T.I.

Religious House: Osaka June 28, 1972

**External:** In a spirit of emerging area consciousness, movement colleagues from the six regions of Japan and Korea participated in the first Northeast Asia Area Council June 16 and 17 in Tokyo with Pyong Yang Region symbolically represented by a colleague born in North Korea. At the Presidium following the Council key regional colleagues took giant steps in their spirit journeys as they struggled with decisions and time-lines for house internships. Pedagogy held in Fukuoka Metro increases power of potential iron men and greatly needed course teachers.

**Internal:** Eric Gowers, Australian colleague, swelled house troops as he added great wisdom to Area Council pre-planning. Anita Morrill, house youth, experienced rites of passage as she was sent out from the Osaka Region to the USA. Tomoko Nakashima, house sojourner decides to attend I.T.I.

**Contradiction:** How to image the summer quarter as business as more than usual while Area colleagues prepare in large numbers to participate in the I.T.I. in Seoul.

July 4, 1972

**External:** The Korean drum, gift from movement colleagues across the sea, serves as a great symbolic reminder of Area collegueship. It also reminds us that I.T.I. funding doesn't end with the first session of the Institute but continues all summer long.

**Internal:** The entire house celebrated the end of the quarter with a trip to the 600-year-old Moss Temple in Kyoto and a visit to the Arashiyama district with many more temples and shrines... A trip into the living past that pushes us into the future.

**Contradiction:** Imaging the summer as economic intensification while recruiting for courses.

Religious House: Seoul June 25, 1972

**External:** Consciousness of the Seoul Region heightened by: successful RS-1 (plus 1 session on I.T.I.) for 40 clergy at Suwon Christian Academy taught by staff and translated by 3 I.T.I. grads who brought great passion and commitment to the course dynamic; return of Kang Vance from Area meeting in Japan where reports from Seoul (plus 1 Korean Drum to the Osaka House) were received.

**Internal:** House prepares for I.T.I. Faculty meeting making arrangements for 8 more colleagues.

**Contradiction:** Regearing images for new assignments and tasks of the summer quarter.

Religious House: Seoul July 3, 1972

**External:** The twenty goals of the external missional thrust of the house for the summer are translated into Korean and consensed upon. I.T.I. faculty arrive and begin their preparations.

**Internal:** House celebrates the end of the first twenty years of the Order and beginning of the next twenty years with Order members on I.T.I. faculty.

**Contradiction:** How to meet the demand for intern recruitment before I.T.I. is over.

Religious Outpost: Majuro

**External:** Welcomed the return of John Oyler from formulation trip to Guam. Sent out Montgomery's to Ebeye and the Oylers to Majuro to begin intensive English summer programs for incoming 8th grade students.

**Internal:** Moved to two new locations in Majuro and Ebeye. Both involve team work and corporate meal structuring with colleagues on the Rongrong faculty.

**Contradiction:** Getting Micronesian participants to the global council.

PACIFICIA Religious House: Apia

EAST ASIA Religious House: Taipei

Religious House: Tainan June 26, 1972

**External:** Lecture at Church celebration on "Challenge to Church in 20th Century reaped unexpected honorarium. Plans set for South Gate Church Youth Retreat using spirit methods. Preaching assignment in Kaoshiung-Chian Kuo Baptist Church. Very successful I.T.I. Orientation afternoon beginning with House Church.

**Internal:** Continuing to look for employment for fall. Assignment of Rod Rippel to I.T.I.

**Contradiction:** Inadequate model as to how to stay on top of Governmental red tape.

July 5, 1972

**External:** Final quota reached for I.T.I. by securing further discount on tickets purchased in Taipei. Secured exit permits for 3 of 7 participants. Departure date looks possible. Booklet printed for South Gate Youth Retreat led by Joe Hse.

**Internal:** Sending out of Rod Rippel to Seoul to Seoul for I.T.I. faculty. Redoing of House Structures Enablement and Time Design due to send out and intensified summer employment.

**Contradiction:** Holding vision and corporateness in midst of minimal corporate time.

Religious House: Hong Kong

**External:** Regional Council with 16 present: sent out 4 to Seoul I.T.I., 3 to Summer '72.

Religious House: Hong Kong con't:

Internal: Again rearranged the House, in order to create a common room (now housing 3 E.G. in the monk's cell). Notification of Pierce's immediate assignment to Seoul I.T.I. faculty brought with it the experience of awe at the workings of the mystery, and the demand to re-do just completed model for summer plans for the house.

Contradiction: Regional work and consensus on 6 month teaching schedule plus quarter's evaluation suddenly reveals the gap that has happened in formulation.

PHILLIPINES Religious House: Manila

External: Davao Course scheduled for Week 13 (this is, we think, the last course of the first 20 years). Ten denominational representatives attend I.T.I. scholarship dinner at Senator Eva Kalaw's home; 38,000 pesos pledged. One hundred proposals typed and delivered as I.T.I. development moves into 'last-round-up'. New EI Movement brochure arrives with new EI stationery.

Internal: Summer session ends with House teachers participating in curriculum building and teacher training workshops; school year opening with total salaries practically doubled. Kim Kwan Lyun, Korean NCC, Director of Ecumenical Action Division, is Ecclesiola guest as Bonhoeffer's Community impacts House. Strategizing and feet-on-table spinning on next 20 years comes as 'the calm' in the midst of the season's first typhoon.

Contradiction: How to utilize the momentum and acceleration Development has produced with no clear way to relate the area context to that which is practically possible in these three regions.

Religious House: Sydney Node

External: Forged the missional timelines of all 6 stations for quarter 3.

Internal: Week of intensive planning and celebrating--completed Internal House Plans Manual and held end of quarter/end of 20 year celebration after performance of "Jesus Christ Super Star." Sent 3 to Summer '72 Research Assembly and received a sojourner (from Canada).

Contradiction: Welding new corporateness out of framework of emerging new style in order to pick up demands of quarter 3.

Religious House: Derby

Religious House: Brisbane

Religious House: Sydney June 23 - 30

External: Week II RS-I blitz to Tamworth Metro, 12 House and regional colleagues participated. Registered 6, coming 1, seriously considering 18--and 60 prospects still to contact.

Internal: Welcomed Doug, Julie, Georgina and Josephine MacCaulem from Derby as 2nd prior family, and Jim and Mary Myers as 3rd priors. At guest night, visited by 3 little sister of Jesus--our next door neighbours. We received intriguing insights into their order and they in turn were intrigued by NRM charts and our historical order research.

Religious House: Sydney con't.

**Contradiction:** Tension between the need for preparation for long range courses, and immediate demands of RS-I just around the corner.

June 30 - July 7th

**External:** Fortnightly Breakfast Clergy Guild met for 1st time small beginning with 5 present and a potential of 10 next meeting.

**Internal:** The studies of the 'Global Strategies' and the 'next 20 years' has brought a mood of seriousness into the House as we get more accurate glimpses of the future -- evidenced in 20/20 celebration last Friday night. Week II discontinuity.

**Contradiction:** We sense ourselves behind and the demand to catch up-- in the midst of untrained regional troops and need to create tactical signs of possibility.

Religious House: Melbourne

**External:** We call colleagues to recruit for Odyssey and to re-vision about Quarter III. Make plans with Mooraggin clergy colleague about RS-I for St. David's congregation.

**Internal:** A great Odyssey with a new spirit breakloose for all concerned. House completely redecored for Odyssey, and in preparation for Open House during Week One. New Quarter Manual made ready for Quarter commencement.

**Contradiction:** Building sufficiently comprehensive models to enable a small house to move a large mountain.

Religious House: Adelaide

**External:** Valuable contact with newly turned on Presbyterian Local Church Pastor gives 13 new prospects for RS-I. External Planning highlighted by decision to hold to 30 as number to week 5 P.L.C.

**Internal:** Collegium study of HRN's "Toward . . ." and research in preparation for PSU on Order Style, pre-galaxy models and Area publications. Hosted key movement family for dinner at

Religious House. A week of many guests dropping in. Printed Area Plan Book for Quarter 1 of '72-73. Sent Margy out to Summer '72 assignment.

Contradiction: With 1 week before I.T.I.: Seoul, have no model (and perhaps unstrategic) to hurry-up hierarchy decisions to choose 3 participants/faculty in area.

Religious Outpost: Singapore June 28, 1972

External: Held the "Second Annual III Dinner" to send out the delegates and to celebrate the success of the development effort; 30 attended; Bishop Yap was the principle speaker.

Internal: Held a fantastic House Church with our three Iron Men present; celebrated 1 birthday and 3 anniversaries; received the first intern family (Mr. and Mrs. Huang Hsing Peng) and then sent them out to I.T.I.: Seoul and EI: Chicago. Also begun serious house hunting with little immediate success.

Contradiction: The unexpected task of arranging travel to Seoul for 20 people from 7 cities in 3 nations each requiring two visas is consuming time otherwise earmarked for development to pay for the travel.

July 4, 1972

External: The KL-Singapore Religious House, in consultation with local colleagues, decided to go the whole distance on I.T.I. development, meeting the assigned quota for Area SSEA of \$10,000 by July 9th, with a colleague making a personal loan for the balance outstanding to be raised during the quarter.

Internal: Two members joined the KL House for a Week II PSU on Order style and the Local Church Task, also celebrating the turn to "the 20 and 20", while four members stayed in Singapore to host Ng Yaw Fong from Sandakan on his way to I.T.I. and to house hunt.

Contradiction: Knowing what it will mean to be an Area Node House from here on in, and having the wisdom to plan accordingly.

Religious House: Delhi Urban AshramReligious House: Bombay Urban Ashram June 19 -25

External: 24 Congregations were visited during the weekend to launch Bombay RS-I recruitment push; P. D. Sham Rao and John Hutchinson were sent to Jabalpur for the first development trip of the quarter.

Internal: The House was addressed by Bishop Joshi's witness to the Movement's critical role in discovering new forms for the Church in Sub-Asia; Mary Kurian was sent out to Base as Sub-Asia's first International Intern.

Contradiction: Creating the firm that will provide one focus in the midst of diverse functions and vast geographical spread.

External: Jabalpur and Delhi Development Trips; Bombay Cadre meeting kick off the first quarter of the year and the next 20 years.

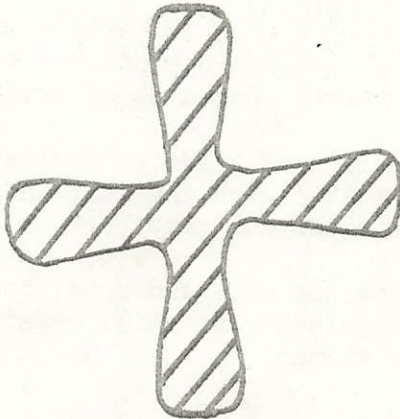

Internal: New insights into the power of decor revealed as decor blitz intensifies the transformation of the Kemper building from an office building to 8 floors of the other world. Key insight was that we were not decorating for a month's program --but that we were decorating for the next 20 years. This week 21,000 meals or snacks plus 800 gallons of coffee were served, and 11 million sheets of paper printed a new dimension of corporateness was begun as Westside Coordinators experimented with enabling a program via the printed and telephone across 13 miles of city traffic

Contradiction: How to chastely engage Summer '72 as the focus of the entire Spirit Movement while standing present to the ongoing needs and activities of 58 Religious Houses and an I.T.I.

NORTH AMERICA Religious House: Chicago

NORTH

External: The galaxy was impacted by the Training Institute dynamic in having 10 key metro leaders join as guests for sodality in July.

Internal: A new 6'x 4' metro map, with the parish grid delineated, leads the way for many new visual tools necessary to define the missional imperative for next fall.

Contradiction: Getting clarity on last year's experience regarding recruitment tactics and style, thus enabling a significantly larger number of clergy families to actively participate in the movement, and particularly attend the fall Academy.

Religious House: Madison

External: Formulation has resulted from demands for housing change as metro colleagues pitch in to help make transition. Report on first week of Summer '72 exciting.

Internal: New time design initiated and division assignments concensed on. Trip to Rockford to participate in three-metro House Church.

Contradiction: Collapse of structures reveals necessity of house to pick up invention of structures when economic demands radicalize time design.

Religious House: Milwaukee

External: Visited by Regional Director of Franciscan Sisters of Little Falls one-half hour after house-cleaning blitz, which was drastically needed following Ecclesiola of 30 adults and 25 children the night before.

Internal: Gifts of Summer '72 brought back by returning house member enable collegium attendance to soar as 2 sector cadres come to hear tape of opening plenary address: Sr. Judy left home at 4:15 to make Daily Office at 5:00-by bike.

Contradiction: When you have your feet propped up on the table, how do you make sure you don't fall out of the chair you need to be sitting in?

Religious House: Rockford June 30-July 6

External: New kind of enthusiasm has pervaded the metro presidium with the vision that Fall quarter can and will come off with the help of a newly organized task force dynamic.

Internal: Work Week II at Kemper gave those of us not attending the Summer Assembly a new sense of participation in it while also giving us a glimpse of the kind of corporateness going on there.

Contradiction: How we electrically grid the metro as the three dynamics it is so that all three blink at the same time.

Religious House: Rockford July 7-13

External: Metro Presidium met with new and old colleagues present to see "Lisa and David"...thus the "Happening" tactic showed up as a viable part of the metro's quarter plan.

Internal: The house was nearly overwhelmed with non-grads at Ecclesiola Thursday night...thus again we were confronted with the fear and fascination of the demand to see that all under our care be enabled to courses this fall quarter.

Contradiction: In the midst of needing to scatter more and more, how is it we hold the pole of "I'm all that's required" and still remain clear that "I'm" a part of the corporate thrust.

Religious House: Peoria

External: Began back up systems for fall RSI penetration; Summer '72 recruits itself as evidenced by new decisions to participate.

Internal: Guest celebrant for House Church picks up on spirit of S'72 by leading house in new songs and prayer for the renewal of his church in the world.

Contradiction: Finding adequate operating image for the summer.

Religious House: Champaign-Urbana June 30-July 6

External: Summer '72 send out celebration signals shift into summer missional work.

Internal: 7 session House Council to plan the signal spirit event of the summer turns into a spirit event itself when the House sings the "I am the One" march to rid the House of possible prowlers.

Contradiction: Doing 13 weeks of Summer work in the next 7.

Religious House: Champaign-Urbana July 7-13

External: Sent out our first summer brochure-calendar. Metro and house both present to discern spirit location of man. Key strategies for summer thought to be (1) story-telling, (2) popular preaching, and (3) waltzing.

Internal: The presence of a galaxy pastor and family at House Church more than doubles the size of the community. Study of Gealy paper occasions spirit reflection by guests.

Contradiction: Now that we've decided to be in present facility for another year, creating two more rooms.

Religious House: Minneapolis

External: First RSI call in six weeks on laywoman who wants something "which will demand 100% of my life" and in midst of call begins to recruit two of her friends present.

Internal: Having made corporate decision to add \$848 to summer quarter income, we amaze ourselves by uncovering first \$400 toward that goal in one week.

Contradiction: Creating the symbols to hold before house our own participation in S'72 and the global mission as over against imaging what

we're doing as busy work.

Religious House: Detroit

**External:** Three regional colleagues participate in mailing party that gets letters out of 220 previously contacted clergy families concerning the Fall PLC's.

**Internal:** Contingency of life is grounded in the collapse of three cars in one day on permeation assignments--the possibility of life is grounded in the presence of everyone at their permeation post the next day, using alternate transportation model.

**Contradiction:** Rehearsing one story about the way life is in the cool of the morning and living out of some other story in the heat of the day and evening.

Religious House: Cleveland June 30-July 6

**External:** House receives guests journeying to Chicago and then welcomes bachelorized husbands to Ecclesiola. How to expand one week Summer '72 plans into longer stay? Don't include eastward transportation in your transport model for at least two weeks.

**Internal:** New two night Ecclesiola construct slows down the pace for the summer while deepening and spiritizing priorship training. Fourth of July conversation on the American Revolution recalls a significant part of the American story.

**Contradiction:** House nearly vacated due to Chicago and evening sector demands slow down corporate planning for sector formulation and penetration badly needed.

Religious House: Cleveland July 7-13

**External:** Coordinated Religious House/Training Institute efforts are actively engaged in imaging and creating a central file system to facilitate smoother operations and handling of a greater mass of data.

**Internal:** Week II PLC PSU sees the creation of manuals and symbolic life packets for use during the Pre-Prep Period before the eight week countdown before courses begin. Aim: To make lots of friends, get lots of names, and familiarize them with EI before we hit them with the demand. Sodality session is the first of several planning sessions for a Labor Day Weekend Methods Lab: Twenty Year Weekend.

**Contradiction:** Odd schedules and low troops slacken corporate power badly needed for the external mission.

Religious House: Indianapolis

**External:** Held 24 hr. Bi-Metro Penetration PSU with 11 present. Metro discovered clarity on what it means to build models on behalf of others. The galaxy reached spirit high with singing of a song written by one of its members, Alice Reider, who returned to the galaxy after one week of Summer '72.

**Internal:** The gears of summer time-design have meshed and are picking up speed. With a warf of Summer '72 held by the return of colleagues and a visit from David Butler bringing us news and songs and the woof preparing for full speed ahead in the fall with pedagogy training and model building.

**Contradiction:** The PSU weekend to develop models for recruitment raised new questions, creating the need for additional models.

Religious House: Cincinnati

**External:** Bi-metro pauses momentarily in discontinuity before plunging headlong into July. With 36 spirit people sent to the Research

Assembly in Chicago, remaining manpower begins shouldering a triple load of responsibility. Spirit muscle development is already evident.

**Internal:** The Cincinnati Religious House rejoices to receive on behalf of the Globe: Harriet Endriss and the Appenfelder family as interns; and the Ed Reed family as sojourners for the month of July. Neighbors are once again impacted by the strange goings on at 501 Garrard as a big yellow bus with "IRON MAN SPIRIT TREK" painted on the side, rolls up to the front door and disgorges 27 children, 5 disheveled adults, pots, pans, food, bedrolls, etc., all of which is destined for Washington: Children's Summer Camp.

**Contradiction:** Although we manage to show up in three different sectors on one evening, we do not manage to show up at the grocery store, the laundry room, or our own rooms in three weeks.

Religious House; Kansas City June 30-July 6

**External:** Sent our 23 of the 47 to Summer '72 Saturday evening. Galaxy Churches are meeting holiday and weekends to begin quarter on schedule--their own suggestion! Rev. Don and Alice Hood are guests at House Church as they drive in from Iola, Kansas so he could be our celebrant.

**Internal:** Children's Academy and Youth Academy keep house on its toes pedagogically as we nail down 4 weeks of curriculum for them. Massive garage sale prep all day 4th of July; resettlement creates 3 curriculum rooms for Academies; worldly goods of families not here for month moved to garage and attic (preparation for next year's attic sale!)

**Contradiction:** House shifted to intensive permeation plan schedule--last minute shift in summer '72 decisions taking place--how enable the decisions of colleagues when most effective method of driving out and sitting down with them is not possible.

Religious House: Kansas City July 7-13

**External:** Sojourner Fran Moore sent out to Memphis permeation assignment to "prepare the way." A lawyer (grad), a seminarian and a Benedictine nun (non-grads) throw themselves into a guest night "obedience game" and the charts, the house and the guests all come alive.

**Internal:** Galaxy layman sojourns (while his youth are in our Academy and his wife is at S'72); leads Meaning of the 20th C. study; gets house a part-time receptionist job in his office (3.50/hr!); and begins recruiting other galaxy colleagues to sojourn. Seriousness with which the Youth Academy engages in study is a depth address to our cynicism relative to that Phase of life. Permeation PSU builds strategies and tactics for the next 8 weeks' war on the the unbalanced budget--confident prediction: we will win.

**Contradiction:** Deciding that "all is well" as images of "this world" pastures and air conditioning "well up in our hearts and melancholy sets in" as we walk back down the hill to the boulder of "solveny by August 31st."

EAST

Religious House: Rochester

**External:** Trip to Buffalo Metro results in Summer '72 registration bringing to six, or all metros will now be represented at the Summer Research Assembly.

**Internal:** Arrival of Stan Fry from Albany as 2 week sojourner and new intern Margaret Mallory brings house occupants to seven.

**Contradiction:** Cutting over against regional colleagues propensity to want summer off.

Religious House: Boston June 30-July 6

**External:** Experienced great celebrational week with galaxy celebration on Monday night (42 galactic people), Training Institute celebration on Wednesday night (31 regional people), and Summer '72 sendout held in four locations with use of conference call (68 regional People).

**Internal:** After a comprehensive transportation model was created, 50 adults and 24 children were sent forth to Chicago and Wisconsin. The house celebrated the 4th of July by ordering the subterranean chaos (cleaned the basement) and embracing the suburban life style (cleaned the back yard) and then enjoyed the fruits of our labor with a picnic in the back yard.

**Contradiction:**

**External:** Created models to enable house to visit region and region to visit house during summer quarter.

**Internal:** Arrival of two sojourners for month of July: Evelyn Ferguson, 69-year-old wise woman, and James Badgett. Grateful to report that we are 93% gainfully employed--including positions as cocktail waitress, house painter, bellhop, ecology technician, and Jane Johnson driving a cab.

**Contradiction:** Creating models without a tactical system ensuring their actualization.

Religious House: Pittsburgh July 7-13

**External:** Formulated summer module visitation to all six metros with regional coordinator.

**Internal:** Summer blows many visitors through Pittsburgh! Bruce and Kitty Brunkhorst, colleagues from the Chicago Region, en route to their new church in Queens, New York, sojourned for Week II and gave us insights on what it means to formulate on a sector level. Also, Rev. Archie Doig, Presbyterian exchange minister from Scotland, celebrated House Church and was a powerful witness of the movemental church at work there.

**Contradiction:** How to communicate to a region with the mindset: "Nothing ever happens in the summer," the excitement and dreadful fascination of beginning the next twenty years.

Religious House: Philadelphia June 30-July 6

**External:** In the midst of enabling fifteen regional colleagues and four Order youth to fit into four cars headed for Chicago, the House engages in an all-out permeation offensive to impact the city with what it means to be a decisional man.

**Internal:** House's decision to pick up on financial demand gets actualised by six of seven members employed and four out of that six with double

Jobs and is celebrated at a Fourth of July barbeque from which three members were sent early for permeation assignments.

Contradiction: Trying to get on top of work schedules in order to enable the corporate symbolic life and finding it crucial to get a hold of what it means for the remnant to rehearse the symbolic on behalf of all.

Religious House: Philadelphia July 7-13

External: Contact with movement colleague from Syracuse now in Harrisburg reveals solitary giant and augurs well for Metro's future; one third of fall course sites firmed up as secretarial blitz prepares way for face to face contact with fall quarter prospects.

Internal: House study curriculum provides insights which enable colleagues to round the clock permeation.

Contradiction: Deciding that formulation and penetration will come off in midst of permeation push.

Religious House: New York

External: The first weekend of month-long pedagogy reminds us again of the power of RSI and the constant need to practice our art.

Internal: The musical Bucht on Brecht packed a double punch: in the relevance of pre-WWII prophecies to our time; and in the imaginal impact of the action and staging.

Contradiction: How to spiritize the region through the July slump when budget cuts seal off communication lines.

Religious House: Washington

External: The Lord let us win again! Local Church Galaxy enables deeper understanding of marriage vows by gift of CSIIIA scholarship to former seminarian assistant and now newly married Percy Brown and wife Cecille-presented by Father Taylor at the Ordination Service for Father Brown, Sunday, in Miami, Fla.

Internal: Short term bachelors sojourning at R.H., while wives are at S'72, are Phil Agee and Clesson McDonald, with sons Paul and Alan, "who get to go to Pre School every day."

Contradiction: Man proposes and God desposes! Great plans made for Sat. metro visits and Thursday night Ecclesiola turns out as the signal event.

NORTHEAST Religious House: Montreal

External: New Regional Presidium met in Week II to plan for Fall quarter.

Internal: Major shift made in actualization of financial miracle by new upgraded job.

Contradiction: Image of financial miracle as internal support rather than external mission.

Religious House: Toronto June 30-July 6

External: Summer '72 in the Toronto Region began with a baseball game of House and framing nexus of troops to launch our send out celebration and the setting up of a cross metro Ecclesiola construct.

Internal: Sodality supper with an art form conversation and pedagogy guild role playing began a whole new sense after what it means to be Secular Religious men constantly confronting the mystery and thus contributed to our study of popular preaching.

Religious House: Toronto (cont.)

**Contradiction:** Partial paralysis sets in as we allow ourselves to rehearse the story that "its all happening in Chicago" coupled with acute summeritis.

Religious House: Toronto July 7-13

**External:** Journey of 2 regular metro Ecclesiolas given new life with birth of Ecclesiola manual.

**Internal:** Grasped after what the shift from the church to the world looks like through encounter with the Other World in popular preaching sessions in Niebuhm's "Toward a New Other Worldliness" paper and by participating in the movie, "The Gospel According to St. Matthew."

**Contradiction:** Being satisfied with using some of the tactical methods available to us.

**Imperative:** Do weekly tactical modification and quarterly tactical focusing.

NORTHWEST Religious House: WinnipegWEST Religious House: SeattleReligious House: Billings June 30-July 6

**External:** Hosted Metro guests in 1st summer schedule Ecclesiola. Master list of grads reviewed, noting next step necessary for each on their journey. Clergy in outlying areas gridded for priority visits.

**Internal:** Opened special account for yearend close-out funds coming in from across the Region to help cover the House deficit. Religious Houses Questionnaire has proven to be a phenomenal tool for reflecting on the year.

**Contradiction:** Seccond and third jobs slow in coming.

Religious House: Billings July 7-13

**External:** Cadre consult in the form of a potluck led to contact with and nurture of colleagues from Butte, Missoula and Great Falls Metros. Roy Chamberlin took the Pulpit, the first in a series, as Billings most popular supply preacher. Laid strategies for Week II clergy calling. The response to our invitations to Ecclesiola and House Church leads us to believe we will be feeding the 5,000.

**Internal:** The Lord has blessed us with; another raise--total of 5 for 3 people in the last two months, 12 hours of overtime at time and a half, and a \$20 bill lying in the middle of the sidewalk!

**Contradiction:** Creating interior time and space that will counterbalance our "busy-bee" activity.

Religious House: Rapid CityReligious House: San Francisco June 30-July 6

**External:** Two metros participated at the House in the first of two Metro Sodality weekends which included visioning for the next 20 years of both metros, attending "Fiddler on the Roof" and the creation of a Metro tactical system complete with the statement of the contradictions and strategic objectives on four levels of the system. **External:** Fall PLC begins to get off the ground with Lutheran, Presbyterian and VCC endorsement letters on the way to press.

**Internal:** House's horizon broadened in terms of R.C. participation in LCX as we host pastor from Boston, Harold Lawson, and family engaged in West coast exploration. Kwang Park stops in from Japan enroute to school in Toronto.

**Contradiction:** Ordering demands in a priority system.

Religious House: Los Angeles July 7-13

**External:** Send out of Summer '72 participants; some in car pool to pick up colleagues in Phoenix and Amarillo.

**Internal:** Received Mueller family as Interns at House Church, Theo, Shirley, Tim, Toni, Tricia, Trudi, Todd, Tadd.

**Contradiction:** Maintaining intentional time design in midst of interns moving and members packing for Summer '72.

## SOUTH

Religious House: Oklahoma City

**External:** Held a Fantastic pedagogy Week II with 5 regional colleagues. to keep things honest. Address same as a recent RSI grad continued to witness how RSI changed her life, which radically held us before the seriousness of deciding to be a pedagogue.

**Internal:** Ten guests for Guest Night added to the week's joy, begun with the new songs from S'72 that Mary Meyer brought back with her from base.

**Contradiction:** Completing the necessary maintenance work on property in time and money allotted.

Religious House: AmarilloReligious House: Tulsa

**External:** The recruitment of the Family Friary done by the house this last week brought out the realization that any recruitment is never easy.

**Internal:** An in-house pedagogy weekend pushed the stance and style of all those participating, to it is "I who must teach," with everyone seeing that RSI is indeed the Word of life. Ecclesiola was a celebration on behalf of India with the meal being eaten sitting on the floor and decor depicting the suffering of the world.

**Contradiction:** Maintaining the level of intensity about the Family Friary in the midst of disappointing calls.

Religious House: Houston

**External:** House participated in a week PSU to prepare for a Regional Week II trip. The focus was to launch formulation and penetration efforts

for the fall.

**Internal:** The impact of the Summer breakfast collegiums is being experienced by the whole house. It includes such realities as contextual lectures, station meetings, social method and symbolic edge work. Religious House: Atlanta

**External:** Galaxy auxiliary meeting begins to bubble with excitement over need and possibility of bringing Word into all educational structures of the church.

**Internal:** House begins to put form to local congregation formulation lab "happen" in August and is excited by possibility of creating a local congregation for the weekend. Potential galaxy pastor celebrates House Church on 8 hours notice.

**Contradiction:** How do we detach ourselves from the overpowering death-wish in the midst of the fact that we're out to be the Religious House experiment in history, and dance and sing over that as the gift of the summer?

Religious House: Miami June 30-July 6

**External:** Fourth of July celebrated on the beach. The whole house joined with key families from Boulevard Christian Church to cook breakfast on the beach on July 4. It was a great celebration which allowed church families a long awaited time to ask all their questions about life in the Religious House.

**Internal:** Everyone at work 90% of the time (parker now driving a cab) but the other 10% spent in totally reworking the house to get it ready for consultation next Week II with 3 churches from Ft. Lauderdale.

**Contradiction:** Models for coordination of house effort when most of us are gone most of the time, and a meeting with everyone present is getting next to impossible to have.

Religious House: Miami July 7-13

**External:** Held Week II consultation with 17 laymen and the clergy from two Disciples congregations in Ft. Lauderdale. They have decided to work toward being Galaxy churches, and have begun that by working out strategies for recruiting a one-hundred participant RSI course for the fall. By the end of the weekend they had prospect lists, financial model, specific tactics, timeline, assignments and twenty registrations. A very exciting weekend for them and for the house!

**Internal:** House welcomed Church Taylor, Summer '72 participant, who was in Miami for the ordination of a colleague. His report to Monday morning

**Contradiction:** Dynamiting the varied blocks to Summer '72 participation.

ASIAReligious House: Sendai June 30-July 6

**External:** Journied to Sendai to attend the ITI sendout for 3 participants.

Held a family conversation class for one of our physician batees impacting them with the Institute story (in Japanese, as only three months of English lessons made an English explanation difficult.

**Internal:** Decor night produces exiting entrance-way to the house.

Welcomed Anne's brother as a sojourner and hosted 2 Ecclesiolas for 2 overnight sojourners as they prepare for ITI. Hosted Ryuichi Hoshi for several days to provide a context for a decision to sojourn for the summer.

**Contradiction:** Unwrapping red tape to get visas for ITI participants in time for a timely departure.

Religious House: Sendai July 7-13

**External:** Attended send-out dinner for Reverend Ron Wallace Missionary and cadre member returning to Montreal to study at McGill

University, chaparoned the annual dance party at Sakura No Seibo Junior College-the very first dance for many-while making the final push to get Etsuko Okazuke on the plane for ITI-finally accomplished with many phone calls and post office tracings of the late arriving ticket. Eignal event of the week is the confirmation of cadre-member at Sei Ko Kai Anglican Church where we met the Bishop of Tohoku (Northern Honshu) Diocese. He impacted us by switching to the English "The Body of Chrust" while administering communion to Sue.

**Internal:** Our two sojourners (one speaking no Japanese and the other little English) create together a L.C. Saints triangle. Hosted cadre penetration team for initial evening of research of documents as they pian the study life of the cadre. Sent our American sojourner back to Ohio.

**Contradiction:** Embracing all the possibilities opening locally for a local summer '72.

Religious House: Osaka June 30-July 6

**External:** Another \$1000 sent off to ITI: Seoul, as the North East Asia Area continues to take responsibility for funding an entirely Asia financed ITI. RSI Papers in their final stage of correction are being printed for the first time in Japanese.

**Internal:** As troops diminish for summer assignments, an interning family of four decides that they are the ones needed and that it is the symbolic life that makes a Religious House.

**Contradiction:** Enabling Regional course grads to take responsibility for the recruitment push needed for the summer PLC in the Osaka Region.

Religious House: Seoul June 12

**External:** "The vitality and strength of the Korean Church is discovered with the claim of promise that Korean churchmen be those who renew the church in Asia and the world"--this was received with surprise and a sense of burden upon the Hankuk Theological School students in important speech given by staff. Responsibility picked up more with increased calling by Korean colleagues in business and church community.

**Internal:** House financial report gives clarity on the demand to earn more money through the summer. Journey into the spirit dimension symbolized by the Canonical Hours brings sustenance during hectic

times.

**Contradiction:** The tension of doing tactics and creating tactics with colleagues at the same time, when time seems so limited.

Religious House: Seoul June 19

**External:** Hang Byong Hoon and Vance sent to Area Council in Tokyo. Foray into the Korean church when Jane preaches at key Sung Nam Presbyterian Church service. The final practices for ITI are in order as elaborate funding, participant, recruitment, and administration timelines are implemented.

**Internal:** Contract offered by Seoul Foreign School to Jane to teach Typing and Business Math next fall. Dr. Park (a parish woman physician) decides to signify her regular participation in House English Training by offering to cook this coming Tuesday. The ITI materials counted, organized into the office--again leaving our empty extra room awaiting an intern family.

**Contradiction:** Transforming regular House participants into full-fledged House interns.

Religious House: Seoul June 30-July 6

**External:** Final week of ITI preparation includes banner making with house and extended members, receiving several heartily welcomed contributions and sending off 30 Korean participants from 4 metros. Around the edges held an initial meeting with representatives of Mazyknolls and Columbian Fathers and recruited a woman seminary professor for funding calling.

**Internal:** House yard "landscaped" by house member, Kim Ko Kwang and House English Training meal led by member for first time.

**Contradiction:** How to recruit families made up of three-generations when this is the normal style of family life.

**PACIFICA** Religious House: Majuro June 30-July 66

**External:** Five RSI's scheduled for Ponape, Truk, and Guam for fall quarter. Three participants and one Asian faculty sent out to ITI: Seoul from Agana region. Seventy-five students in English program in Ebeye and fifty in Majuro.

**Internal:** Mealtimes prove to be excellent permeation tools. All meals in Ebeye are with parents of the students. All meals in Majuro corporately structured with another faculty couple.

**Contradiction:** Separation of personnel plus closeness and constantness of permeation relations make house internal structures extremely awkward to carry out.

Religious House: Apia June 30-July 6.

**External:** The signal event of the week occurred when it was necessary for us to deliver the unpleasant task that one of the Samoan delegates preparing for the ITI would not be able to attend this year because of limited finances. We were very surprised when in reply to this news the delegate announced with a grad from last year "We have decided that we have a plan." We are still in a state of wonder about the tactic used to raise over 750 U.S. dollars in one week, mostly through the delegates creative and daring insights and finally through his committing his family savings and getting a loan. **Contradiction:** How to prepare for marching back into the desert after 10 oasis days of getting the ITI grads off and assisting in the above miracle.

**External:** With the intervention of the Mystery, the sending out of all 7 ITI participants was accomplished. Last seconds release of passports and visas amidst delays in communication explodes into miracle send off complete with family, friends, and movement colleagues. Local Church Youth Retreat began with 60 youth.

**Internal:** Corporate Day and Seminar Model completed for the summer. Doubled transportation facilities with purchase of a bicycle, needed to enable travel to English Class summer schedule. Sending out of Hsu and George to Taipei for enablement and send out of participants.

**Contradiction:** Concretizing the mission of the house and not allowing the ideal to eat you up.

Religious House: Hong KongPHILLIPINES Religious House: Manila

**External:** Davao Region holds first local church consult in preparation for RSI with leadership of key UCCP church. Development get the final push as 5 paid up delegates depart for Seoul ITI. Quarter I battleplan created in closing minutes of last 20 years. flushed out this week.

**Internal:** The initial stages of a protracted move-in by Quimby's of Tokyo begun as they continue/begin their internship in R.H. Manila. School begins for Tamora first grade at Paco Chinese, Traci in 7th at Phil Christian College.

**Contradiction:** Is the emergency over? How do you move to the "regular" structures?

AUSTRALIAReligious House: Sydney Node June 30-July 6

**External:** Recruitment mailing completed for South East Asia Training Academy to SE Asia, Pacifica and Australia. 3 participants (2 black, 1 white) sent to ITI Seoul. Began evening worship and study for Village Church.

**Internal:** House Manual published for Quarter 3. Education Station to include youth timelines within missional time design of total house.

**Contradiction:** Deciding that our models are adequate to cope with the overwhelming demands.

Religious House: DerbyReligious House: Brisbane June 30- July 6

**External:** We held the first course follow-up for grads in the region. This meeting set the context for the course grads to decide to participate further in the region in terms of going to advanced courses, attending the cadre meeting, or help in recruit for courses. The recruiting in

the region for the next RSI has begun to bubble as an anglican and Catholic PLC grads decide to send laymen from their parishes to the course.

**Contradiction:** Four paid registrations for RSI and only three weeks to the course.

**External:** Clergy guild continued to touch vital depths. Ken and Priscilla Broadbent returned from Academy to Local Parish, the Bishop is happy, Region regains iron.

**Internal:** Whole House celebrates, shifts rooms, redistributes furniture, and begins anew.

**Contradiction:** Organizing and coordinating Regional commitment.

Religious House: Perth June 3-9

**External:** Sent Sam Umbagai and David Mowaljarlai to ITI Seoul, after radically accelerating social structures to produce passports and visas in 72 hours. Whole house worked to complete mailing to all

Clergy in region. The recruiters meeting held, coordinator selected, times covenanted.

Internal: Began new Quarter with new internal structures including Bureaus and stations and time designs with evening meals eaten by teams (Tues. night) or Bureaus (Wed. night) or whole house for Ecclesiola and House Church.

Contradiction: Communicating Regional leadership's decisions to entire region.

SOUTH SEA Religious House: Kuala Lumpur July 5

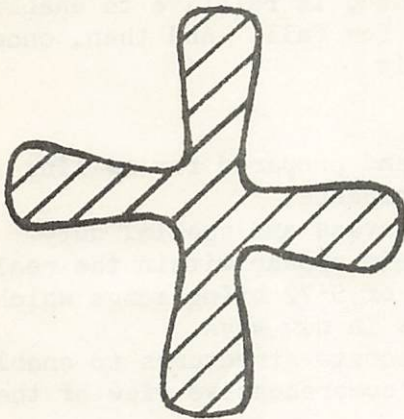

Contradiction: Knowing what the necessary deed is relative to enabling mission during the summer and preparing for Fall. And then, once we know it, finding the troops "In" to do it.

External: PLC letter and brochure printed and prepared for mailing is first step towards Fall PLC of 40 participants.

Internal: Two second jobs (as restaurant hostess and special duty orderly) secured and financial goals again appear within the realm of possibility. Returnees from 2 weeks of S'72 bring songs which excited house and sustain internal deeps in new ways.

Internal: The return of two House members from the first half of the Research Assembly, the securing of one more job, and the singing of songs in morning collegium combine in a mood of gratitude for all our trials.

Contradiction: Allowing a reduced budget to block us from encountering colleagues when needed.

Religious House: ClevelandReligious House: IndianapolisReligious House: Cincinnati

External: Amazing spirit strength of Bi-Metro colleagues comes forth in response to triple demands during month of July. Radical decisions to expend selves as mission blossom forth, old grads are resurrected colleagues demand new tools and training, old inadequate structures are overthrown and replaced. Other-Worldliness prevails everywhere and is emphasized by the waltzes, marches, etc. filtering out of Chicago and by our own metro song creating.

"Yes" responses to our letters seeking endorsements for PLC brochure flood in within 2 days of mailing from bishops, district superintendents and conference leaders.

Workshopped images to use in talking about S'72, the next 20 years, and the Long March. Also worked on ways of spiritizing flood conversations.

Contradiction: Missional demands prevent pushing workshops to needed depth or bringing them to a satisfactory conclusion.

Religious House: Rapid City July 14-20

External: A trip to Sheridan Metro for visit with RSI grads finds them excited about recruiting a course in Sheridan for Fall. Nurture calls on all grads in Sector cities begun. Sent out 2 more to S'72.

As soon as the fruit was made available, the Lord opened up other opportunities for Doris to demonstrate her faith.

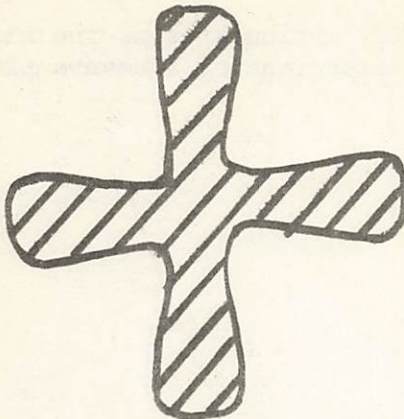
How do you travel around to the various growers to pick up 4 tons of fruit? How do you get it to Chicago before it gets too ripe? How and who loads and unloads it? How do you package it for shipment? And--the greatest opportunity of all--how do you do it all for nothing as an "in-kind" donation?

The fruit was picked up by truck--donated. Santa Fe Railroad supplied a 21 ton refrigerated freight car--donated. They then flew a refrigeration dispersment expert to Fresno to supervise placement--at no charge. The metro got off work and loaded the car from the truck. National Tea unloaded into another donated truck in Chicago. National also donated an additional 4,000 pounds of oranges! A local food store supplied an orange juicer at no charge--and it all arrived just in time for the Fast. (Someone slipped in 4 gallons of California wine!)

No longer can anyone say, "I'm just a housewife." Now we all know how you move mountains on nothing---but faith.

Internal: 1000 people struggled corporately up the Mountain of Care this week symbolizing the awareness of contingency with a 3 day fast, and symbolized the equally burdensome awareness of sheer possibility with a huge feast.

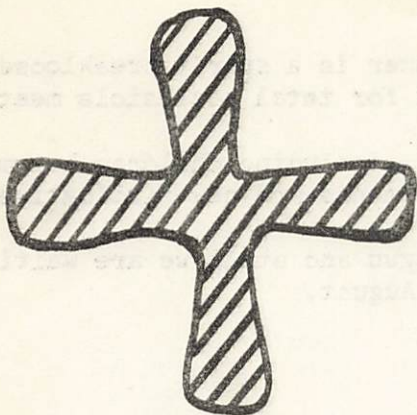

Guest brings fireworks and we engage in traditional summer evening amusement and then locate it on the NSV triangles. Took a major step in decorating the front yard in the midst of planning for weekend gathering of houses in Tokyo.

Contradiction: More grads and prospects to visit and care for than ways to finance travel through Korea.

External: Visited President of Buddhist College and found a man ready to discuss in depth the trinity in Buddhist writings. Same day had exciting call on Dean of Graduate School of Foreign Trade at Confucian College.

Internal: Rogal Asiatic Society Meeting talk by Anglican Bishop Richard Rutt (met on May trip to Tacju Metro) leads house to make a pilgrimage to ancient shrines outside of Seoul (to two 1000-year-old statues of Buddhist monks). Contradiction: How to coordinate corporate thrust with everyone working out.

Religious House: SydneyReligious House: Melbourne

External: Diverse and segregated colleagues united in new form of collegiality on other side of powerful RSIIB course, act out new found power in dramatically alive metro meeting in deciding the destiny of region in remaining weeks of quarter (took two hours to achieve consensus). Week II spent in formulation visits on old grads in Tasmania and Melbourne Metro.
