LONDON

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: LONDON

External: Two RSI's in House at same time culminating week of visits to four Metros, setting up RSI in one virtually untouched Metro.

Internal: House internal life reaches peak after painting, experiencing fasting, feasting dynamic, while struggle with Kierkegaard's 'Love Hopes All Things' was key event. Experience globality again with visit by Rees from Melbourne House enroute to Chicago.

Contradiction: Raising question of the next step after completing year's timeline in less than three quarters. (Wk. 8)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: GLASGOW

External: Whole House gathers in London to celebrate Easter and to forge the future, indicative battleplanning and subsequent miracles reveal 'the great war' before us; regional colleague who attended the weekend announces his intention to go to S'75; also one whole day spent with Edinburgh colleagues building religious education curriculum for Edinburgh school.

Internal: Fearing up for our tribe to resettle in new location by April 15.

Contradiction: Tactics that enable the movement to move on the Primal Community Experiment more directly. (WK. 13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BRISTOL

External: Follow-up visit to Quarter III PLC grad reveals that he is already working on the 'social model' we presented in the seminar. City centre passion mime catalyses Lent reflection for whole city.

Internal: Return of prior with miracle stories from Primal Community Training School fires imaginations for coming Council and Quarter IV. Bonhoeffer continues to impact our lives around the meals.

Contradiction: Anticipating a signal Quarter culminating a year's momentum with the necessity of every one working two jobs. (Wk. 12)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: MANCHESTER

External: House battleplans the 54 miracles that will break loose Region and Parish next Quarter.

Internal: Receive with great joy long awaited visit of Mollie Clements en route to Bombay; she spins House with the new Faith, Hope and Love triangles.

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: MANCHESTER (cont.)

Contradiction: How to beat system relative to visas, work permits and jobs. (Wk. 13)

PARIS

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: PARIS

External: RSI follow-up luncheon nets decision of grads to meet again for day-long planning session.

Internal: Week II of battleplanning reveals need of practical community and Church engagement and renewed urgency to catalyze miracles which will focus this engagement.

Contradiction: How to come down from fourth floor perch and effectively communicate models of community renewal through practical engagement (WK. 12)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: ROME

External: Holy Week of prayer without ceasing over the Religious Order culminates in document on strategic intent and new focus in housing search.

Internal: A watch, involving study of 'Purity of Heart', a corporate montage on hope and document on question of our relationship to Religious Orders, marked observance of Holy Week. Hess's stopover en route to Bombay ITI and Rev Chan Ho. Kim's visit contribute to 'Global simultaneity' and give occasion for exploration of Rome and Pompei.

Contradiction: The assault of Quarter 1V reveals necessity to telescope timeline for forthcoming programs. (WK. 12)

BRUSSELS

GLOBAL CENTRUM: BRUSSELS

External: Keying off of the excitement of Priors. Council, the Nexus spent very productive week of planning for Quarter IV.

Internal: Prior's Council completed on Monday with great send out celebration, marking full occupancy of Nexus and taking advantage of St. Patrick's Day for theme. Hosted Mollie Clements on her way through to Bombay.

Contradiction: Integration of sub-systems not spinning yet into major systems that are off the ground and running. (WK. 12)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BRUSSELS

External: First regional PLC, third course of Quarter.

Internal: Enablement marathan of PLC-RSI including children's RSI. Ecclesiola guest Bishop recently returned from ITI Frankfurt suggests that he follow-up on PLC by telephoning participants.

Contradiction: Standing before perpetually new horizons, how follow up rapidly enough on new potential to pull together all troops into formation for Spring Quarter thrust. (Wk. 8)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: AMSTERDAM

External: Penetration trip to South brings total of 14 out of 18 Metros visited this year; one considering ITP after visit from colleague. ITI patron wants to distribute Bishop Wickham's opening speech to his Consistory. Article on EI, written by us, appears in newspaper of local Catholic seminary.

Internal: House full with colleagues. Recent PCTS grad drops in to hold accountability. Palm Sunday celebrated by attendance at impressive thousand person agape meal in important parish church.

Contradiction: How to prioritize and organize time/task in order for six people to do everything including pulling off the miracles. (WK. 12)

FRANKFURT

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: FRANKFURT

External: More Parish 'yesses' as large Roman Catholic church O.K.'s hosting Pentecost Human Resurgance Mission and one Protestant church requests regular consultation for planning of youth work.

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: FRANKFURT (cont.)

Internal: Quarter Ecclesiola work culminates in wrap-up of Hope study. Week II of discontinuity over Easter.

Contradiction: Credibility gap with city, church establishment slows timeline for moving into new facility, with time running out on present one. (WK. 13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BERLIN

External: Two local church colleagues say a 'yes' to Summer 75, Chicago. Black Chaplain, RSI grad, requests consultations on contemporary social problems for army.

Internal: Preparation for Easter begins with a complete celebration of the Passover Meal done by local American Lutheran clergy on Maundy Thursday.

Contradiction: Doing planning that allows all miracles to be dealt with when every one appears to be first priority. (WK. 13)

NAIROBI

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: NAIROBI

External: Registrations continue to come in for PLC as grads in Nairobi and Nyeri Metros recruit second course in three weeks.

Internal: School holiday begins, Carol Stocking sent to Chicago. House re-arrange for new arrivals, and celebrate Easter.

Contradiction: Changing support to deeper commitment to enable participation in pedagogue training. (WK.13)

BOMBAY

GLOBAL CENTRUM: BOMBAY

External: The securing of permission for the Moore's to stay on till 4, July.

Internal: Arrival of Fred Hess and Clements family.

Contradiction: Preparing for GRA with troops scattered across the continent. (WK. 13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BOMBAY

External: With GRA a few weeks off intensify circuit ride recruitment by sending House members to Poona, Nagpur, Ahmedabad, and Goa and reports that more 20th Century Xaviours needed for Goa. Narendra Paul at Nagpur sends report of two registrations and six firm Yes's for ITI.

Internal: Host continental Priors as they reach Bombay for Week 10 meeting. Intensive workshop and planning for internal structure building to enable House to function fully as pressure of GRA and ITI consumes time and energy. Ecclesiola Kazantzakis study rocks us with authenticity of the spirit struggle.

Contradiction: How to ground mission in the Megalopolis with the mobility and pace of Bombay life. (WK. 12)

DELHI

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: DELHI

External: LENS Seminar of 25 ends with great excitement about PCE, follow-up meeting at House.

Internal: Week of LENS as the Jenkins do collegium, LENS conversation pedagogy, and five from House PO LENS.

Contradiction: How to do necessary circuit rides for GRA/ITI recruitment when all troops need to be full time on Self-Support and Development. (Wk. 10)

MADRAS

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: HYDERABAD

External: Area Council builds ten year timeline which gives visionary meaning to the Guild, LENS followup and ITI/GRA recruitment. Madras RSI comes off with 23 participants.

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: HYDERABAD (cont.)

Internal: House Church becomes great event as colleagues who have spent much of their week working at the House rehearse a natural collegiality.

Contradiction: Seizing opportune moments to plan, rather than waiting. (Wk. 11)

CALCUTTA

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: CALCUTTA

External: Second Area circuit ride completed bringing back Yes to Calcutta: ITI from Orissa State C.N.I. Area Superintendant==old regional colleague Kalyan Biswas is first paid registration for GRA. Rediscover the Lord decides, not us, who is the Movement, as unexpected colleagues turn up for fantastic Area Council. ITI recruitment well under way in one region as 6 paid registrations and request for 10 more application forms arrive in one day. Internal: House pools together ITI/GRA stories and images, recruitment models to put GRA/ITI recruitment in high gear. Day of Fasting makes us aware of cruciality of intentional spirit life. Landlord motivated to fulfill promises when he finds out we control purse strings.

Contradiction: How actualize GRA/ITI recruitment with two weeks to go and only one registration and one Yes for Bombay: GRA out of quota of nine. (Wk.11)

SINGAPORE

GLOBAL CENTRUM: SINGAPORE

External: A full Lenten mailing goes out to the zone as the nexus begins reassessing the external mission in terms of our strategic presence in Singapore which reveals the usual need for troops and that Australia is not so far away as it was.

Internal: Centrum reports have led the nexus into a week of difficult planning contexted by ample celebrations, two movies, and evening interlude following prayers and an afternoon touring Sentosa Island and saying prayers over the Straits of Malacca.

Contradiction: The turn to the world has called upon us to have a crack battalion while we seem instead to have a small, tired inner corps thereby challenging us to devise the tactics for the adequate empowerment of the weaknesses in the movement. (Wk. 13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SINGAPORE

External: Strategizing continued following Area Council for upcoming RSI, CSI, CSIIIA, LENS courses as well as ITI and GRA, CSI, CSIIIA brochures designed.

Internal: Area Council held at Singapore House with all Kuala Lumpur and Jakarta House members present plus Singapore Regional colleague James Chia. Centrum: Singapore Nexus joins Council for House Church bringing all Order members in Area: Singapore together in one celebration. Symond Kock sent to ITP program.

Contradiction: Breaking open issues of practice (staff, facility, faculty, materials) for the ITI to allow focus on recruitment, along with ICA office, E.G. structures and parish work. (WK. 12)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: KUALA LUMPUR

External: Begin to push on Odyssey recruitment along with Quarter IV courses, I.E., CSI, LENS, and a move toward GRA/ITI.

Internal: Whole House treks to Singapore to participate in Area Council and make plans for Quarter IV after having Fast Day in preparation for it.

Contradiction: How to hold the long range without getting sucked up in immediacies. (WK. 12)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: JAKARTA

External: House travels to Singapore for Area Council and is impacted by corporate strength of Area; awed by distance we've traveled in Quarter III; and excited as pieces of demonstration fall into place.

Internal: First International Training Program intern, Connie Widyatma, returns to South East Asia to liven up Area council and sojourn in Jakarta House.

Contradiction: Need the powerful tactic that unlocks depth passion of Christian Churchmen in Indonesia. (Wk.11)

HONG KONG

GLOBAL CENTRUM: HONG KONG

External: Jessie Clements introduces us to old friends for development which resulted in the Lutheran World Service of Hong Kong donating 1,000H.K. Further negotiations take place with Swire group for the Majuro Ship.

Internal: Bishop Joshi visits unexpectedly when his plane was laid over. His speaking at dinner lays out his concerns for the direction of the movement in India. Indicative Battleplanning weekend at Cheung Chau Island.

Contradiction: The challenge is the creation of structures that enable the undergirding of the four individual centrums by the whole nexus in order to maximise data exchange and comprehensiveness.

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: HONG KONG

External: Jesse Clements tells story of Majuro and Town Meeting to colleagues and opens door to signal gifts from key businesses.

Internal House does battleplanning on Week II while holding ourselves conscious to 'Good Friday' by readings and meditations on 'Imitation of Christ.'

Contradiction: Gearing on recruitment to major events while creating the regional structures necessary for post course engagement. (Wk. 13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: KAOHSIUNG

External: Holy Week Trek comes off and reveals new possibilities of spirit care in Taiwan. Development continues to win with 8400NT for the week in hand and contacts broadening daily.

Internal: Easter celebration a great event highlighted by attendance at Church where Annie Hsu directs choir, and being enraptured by the music. One family added to tutoring load adds \$125/mo. to House income.

Contradiction: Long range goals are exciting, but where are the next three steps.

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: MANILA

External: Great Community sign as House participates with 400 residents of P.C. in Holy Week cleanup. Six hour demonstration training workshop with 60 E.G. and Youth of PCE. Delegates to National meeting in Cebu embark on 22-hour boat trip.

Internal: Metro colleagues help with 'Splendiferous' celebration for Addingtons' send out; complete with barbeque chicken, traditional Filipino dances,(we all tried the Tinikling),waltzing and much singing. House takes advantage of Holy Days Time-Off to do indicative b/p.

Contradiction: Arranging 15 top priority items into a missional design that frees us to move into coming Quarter. (WK. 13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: TAIPEI

External: Women's Global Language explodes as attendance jumps from seven to 23 churchwomen with three denominations represented. Enthusiastic response from Taipei American School faculty participating in workshop led by House member.

Internal: House experiences new demands and possibilities in Quarter III and Quarter IV battleplan modification. Don Quimby calls on the House between business appointments.

Contradiction: Discerning real ambiguity we need to live with and our own dullness we need to push through. (WK. 12)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: CEBU

External: Invitation to teach Imaginal Education to 5000 Elementary School Teachers.

Internal: Battleplanned for ITI/GRA recruitment.

Contradiction: Location of sites for upcoming courses (WK. 11)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: DAVAO

External: First fully paid registration for Week III PLC.

Internal: Celebrate return of prior family from Area Priors' Council with movie 'My Name is Nobody' in midst of Fasting and Feasting.

Contradiction: How to harness the tidal wave toward PCE!

TOKYO**RELIGIOUS HOUSE: TOKYO**

External: Incredible week of collegial hosting as Paul and Gerry Evans host Dr. and Mrs. Preston Bradley at famous Japanese restaurant; ITI sponsor Victor Ordonez delivers Manila ITI brochures and regional colleagues engage in radical tactics to prepare new Religious House.

Internal: Concretion of tactical thinking dramatized in 'Great Box Hunt' which finds House learning special Japanese to get Inkind boxes and colleague Okochi delivers 50.

Contradiction: How to focus and maximize energies in relation to discontinuous Permeation schedules. (Wk.II)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SEOUL

External: Regional Council opened by Bishop McNaughton with 77 present heralds new day in Korea as participation by laymen and woman play crucial role: of 20 reports given, 10 by laity and five by women. Region impacted by visit of Dr. Victor Ordonez, Dean of La Salle Graduate School in Manila who is host at ICA dinner party for 17. Celebrate Rev. Oh Kwang Sup's installation as Holiness pastor. Daegu PLC provides research for creating 21 point program and polis priority chart.

Internal: Week II of intense work on spiral curriculum pushes us far down road. Emerging Generation Global Language Training begins again and House sees 'Jesus Christ Superstar' as journey through Lent intensifies.

Contradiction: How to work present operating image of the 'Evangelistic Church' for global service to the secular society. (WK. 12)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: FUKUOKA

External: Image of our regional capital shifts from that of secluded city to one of national import as new bullet train line links it directly to Tokyo. The six-week training model for Primal Community has its first session, with nine Fukuoka clergy in attendance and regional colleague teaching. House attendance at ordination ceremonies at Roman Catholic Seminary rehearses our presence to the historic grandeur of the church, and gives us an opportunity to honor the Bishop.

Internal: Successfully completed negotiations on new house and packed the entire office as our symbol. Income shoots up with a \$200 month raise given in strategic YMCA position. Exciting talk by permeation colleague on her trip to Indonesia and Bali.

Contradiction: Difficulty in getting recruitment material and facility in Japanese blocks our LENS thrust. (WK. 12)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: OSAKA

External: Mr. Iwai of P.H.P. (offshoot of Matsushita Co.) agrees to speak at LENS club meeting.

Internal: Indicative battleplanning session focuses on next Quarter with heavy emphasis on Demonstration.

Contradiction: It's time to move- and we're waiting to raise the key money. (WK. 13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SENDAI

External: Ten-day Global Language Lab(GLS) held in House with 20 participating, with visitation of key regional and community leaders giving authorization to House's work in Region.

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SENDAI (cont.)

Internal: House journeys through Holy Week in Secular Mode, highlighted by Good Friday GLS-'Self awareness' talk.

Contradiction: How to follow up a course when implications demand a new start for Movement formation and social demonstration (Wk 13)

SYDNEY**RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SYDNEY**

External: Intensified Metro and prioritized polis visiting reveals how RSI has literally affected the nation as old grads are uncovered in key social and govt. agencies living out of a vision borne in RSI. (Hurstville polis-visits opened up one consult with a congregation (Tony Baker who entered the ministry because of Kjell Knutsen and conversation with community worker-RSI vintage '68)

Internal: Fr. Tom Tehan from Tokyo shares the movement story and task of building the global local movement with House. Odyssey broke loose in song writing in Chastity Muse.

Contradiction: Sustaining the visitation to uncover the power points in every metro and key polis, and wiring them into a network. (WK. 13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: PERTH

External: Increase our engagement in the mission through Treks to two outer Metros, and a intensification of LENS marketing in Perth.

Internal: Quarter IV external mission plan finished. Whole House attends Celebration 75 inauguration in Edgely Centre along with 7,500 Anglicans. Mowanjum sfor English through using Movement wisdom.

Contradiction: Being corporate and holding a common vision midst the scatteredness that mission is requiring. (WK. 11)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: DARWIN

External: Sophisticated ICA/EI booklet and 40 Page social reconstruction proposal prepared over extended Week 11 to launch authorization blitz. PCE residents group announces plans for city wide trade fair, a local building co-op and launches two day care centres. Tourist association holds first meeting since cyclone and reaffirms long range vision of Darwin.

Internal: PSU preparing crucial missional documents extends Week 11 design in to Wednesday of the next week. Guild colleague Carol Borovic drops in after evacuation, points out pre-cyclone indicative battleplan was right and asks 'where do I start'.

Contradiction: How to relate internal models and external mission so as not to experience continuing drop-ins by people at all hours of the day and night as 'catching us in the act.' (Wk 9)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: OOMBULGURRI

External: In spite of cyclone and flood, 15 bright orange and blue newly in-kind tents pop up and task force on horseback bring back special beef in time for the beginning of a ten-day Djaruk during which five young men will be initiated into the law and manhood. Mowanjum colleagues join in awesome singing and dancing.

Internal: Insurance assessor arrives for two-hour inspection of deceased boat and stays for two days, deeply impacted. Whole House works on common local wisdom and memory amid floods and trips to repair water pump. Saturday night songfest a fine event.

Contradiction: Holding the tension between the long-range vision and today's necessity: How can the community glue itself together during the long struggle to recover the law (Wk. 12)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: ADELAIDE

External: Site secured for Adelaide LENS while LENS in Clare concludes heralding intensification of turn to the world.

Internal: All House files reorganized into 20 Programme system; House Easter retreat provides opportunity for all House members to give spins on NRM, Week 12 provides time for exterior and interior ordering.

Contradiction: Naming and timing key areans to push in for maximum effectiveness. (WK. 13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: MELBOURNE

External: Win authorization to paint sign on Prahran 5 wall and receive inkind gift of paint RSI and PLC registrations arrive in mail after speaking at local church. Talk with Catholic lay woman uncovers radical movement in Catholic Church in Victoria.

Internal: Immediate answer to prayer in arrival of Tim and Sue Wegner. Begin Easter celebration by attending Maundy Thursday service at Keith Braithwaites church.

Contradiction: Only three paid RSI/PLC registrations in hand. with nearing deadline. (Wk. 13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: CANBERRA

External: House PSU completes warboard design and grid of Canberra North 5, while team deployed to Adelaide LENS reports victory in high places and locates key colleague in Wagga Metro on return trip through.

Internal: Holy Week highlighted by Str. Janet Hughs' report to House on her work in Darwin with Darwin House in cyclone reconstruction under assignment by her order, the Sisters of Mercy. Maundy Thursday Common Meal commemorates Last Supper.

Contradiction: Completing detailed battleplanning while securing adequate employment. (WK. 13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BRISBANE

External: Key Regional colleagues and elements of Black community leadership explore application of Indicative Battleplanning method to struggle of the Urban Aboriginal. First paid Community LENS registration comes as by-product of PLC recruitment.

Internal: Jim Newkirk arrives as House moves into intensified symbolic time of Easter Watch; Richardson's airline delay actualizes global Wayside Inn dynamic as they travel through to Oombulgurri.

Contradiction: Un-symbolized Movement priorities sabotage corporate Regional thrust. (Wk. 12)

SUVA

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: MAJURO

External: Joined in 35-man painting team at MCAA to transform two buildings. Huge TASC order arrives in Kwajalien and is transhipped to Majuro-with whole House stevedoring effort to unload.

Internal: Roberta Sperstad begins working with Majuro pre-school just in time to participate in Easter 'party' complete with TV-new this week in Majuro- games, eggs, and a feast. House completes Lenten ramen for breakfast fast with a liquid fast on Good Friday. Sent out Orvis Agee with KITCO reception.

Contradiction: Initiating new programs before equipment, staff and funding that is needed, is available. (Wk. 12)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: APIA

External: Prior is sent out on authorization and nurture trip to Fiji.

Internal: During Week 11, meal conversations using Samoan proverbs help us to grasp the gifts of this UR.

Contradiction: Deciding to see past the contradictions to the gifts of this culture to enable others to build the necessary models. (Wk. 12)

SAN FRANCISCO RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SAN FRANCISCO

External: Found all cylinders firing, sending out three to ITI faculty, holding regional T.M. planning session, meeting with Pierce and Phillips on advocacy, workshop on a demonstration business, and hold Methods Consult for Executives.

Internal: Celebrated Maundy Thursday at Galaxy churches and Easter weekend as discontinuity. Sent out Allan Nagel, Bob Stewart, and Symond Kock back to Cincinnati, Chicago, and Academy.

Contradiction: How to sustain servanthood role in Galaxy and Town Meeting '76, seeing that each must be servant of the other. (Wk. 13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SAN JOSE

External: Key Galaxy church picking up major responsibility as tactics for next Quarter nearing completion, including tactics related to Galaxy expansion of churches in Center City 5. Results of Church School Training Institute include letters of appreciation and requests for RSI.

Internal: House heads for Santa Cruz Mountains Methodist Camp site for day of planning for next Quarter; find methodology of T.M. very exciting as 'on target' proposals created. Celebration in great Mexican restaurant concludes day. Bicentennial decor and office reordering, including red, white and blue filing system, remind us of the shift. Bi-Metro House Church with reports from Chicago Prior's meeting and T.M. excite all.

Contradiction: Finding way to hold corporate thrust of Bi-Metro through fragmented time schemes. (WK. 12)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SACRAMENTO

External: Bi-Metro sends three to Academy.

Internal: Discontinuous Easter Week II: from the winerys, to the gold fields, to the oceans white with foam. God bless California, my home sweet home.'

Contradiction: Understanding that all is made new (including the present.) (Wk. 13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SEATTLE

External: A great week of breaking open Town Meeting Advocacy in Idaho, working with the Salt Lake City House. New ITI prospects emerge in Portland, while PCE quarter battleplanning exposes the dual role required to do both the parish and the region.

Internal: Sharon Pilliot, Robert Knutson, and Doris Lee Dimick are guests. House Ecclesiola finds us leaping from high places, racing furiously, and plunging to the deeps as we go swimming at nearby pool. E.G. attempt (unsuccessful) walk on water in local marsh.

Contradiction: How to put a workable, enabling form on the operating designs for the PCE/Regional Centrum for Quarter IV. (WK. 12)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: PHOENIX

External: Task Team decision and enablement of two people to Town Meeting Council in Chicago.

Internal: Sense of strength in midst of small numbers around Ecclesiola table.

Contradiction: No clear plan from here to Town Meeting, May 17. (WK. 11)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SALT LAKE CITY

External: 5000 Brochures and 200 posters plus all food successfully obtained through inkind for the Local Community Consultation.

Internal: Three Guild members join House members for breakfast and collegium every morning of Holy Week. Tribal resettlement creates new space design that enables us to set aside Prayer Room, ICA office.

Contradiction: When it's clear that onrushing missional demands make no allowance for gaps, find ourselves ontologically in the gap. (WK. 13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: DENVER

External: Metro Cadre re-constitutes itself with new time design, four task forces, corporately written covenant, and common study model.

Internal: Regional Council with SLC House here; great discontinuous happening of reflection and celebration.

Contradiction: After Boulder T.M., what's the real Spring Quarter demonstration. (WK. 13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: RAPID CITY

External: Trip to North Dakota pretty much assures funds for T.M. and results in invitation to participate in eight Town Treks with North Dakota Bicentennial Committee to set up Bicentennial activities.

Internal: Blizzard halts all traffic including penetration and permeation trips planned by House and puts damper on Easter Discontinuity plans.

Contradiction: Return from Easter Discontinuity to discover Quarter IV has arrived sooner than we thought. (WK. 13)

Internal: Spirit of House is high as youth leads Ecclesiola study which drives us to the deeps and we travel out into parish on night trek for sodality. Friday evening supper club brings Gold Rush Rush days to life; E. G. celebrate with pizza outing, Chinese kite clinic.

Contradiction: Provide TM76 context as tactic for parish renewal and operating image of all. (Wk.II)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SASKATOON.

External: Regional colleagues engage in House life during a Spring trek which includes painting, Cabaret and Odyssey.

Internal: 26 engage in children's and adult Ecclesiola celebration as we look to Braithwaite for the past and Heilbronner for the future. Emerging Generation's spirit creations of food, music and decor provide unique thread for the week.

Contradiction: Enabling the rhythm of work and celebration as an ongoing dynamic in the region.(WK. 13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: WINNIPEG

Contradiction: How to will one thing in midst of diverse facets of the task. (Wk.13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BOSTON

External: Town Meeting break through for Demonstration meeting in May as sponsorship begins to take shape.

Internal: Internal life structured so as remind us every moment that we were in Holy Week beginning with metal celebration by attending ,Passion play, Seder Meal. Fast from 'Maundy Thursday to Sunday, prayer vigil Saturday night and time of silence beginning at 10:00p.m. each evening during Holy Week.

Contradiction: How to transform inner spirit burst to outward effectiveness. (WK. 13)

MONTREAL**RELIGIOUS HOUSE: MONTREAL**

External: P.C. group, after having completed seven weeks SMS makes the decision to become a core and to continue to care for that community. Area prior makes visit to Halifax region for CFC planning and consultation with Community Council.

Systems and plans reap dollars as Chicago reports its best Quarter in movement history by raising \$353,000. Experimentation with increasing circuit trips to a total 70 last quarter raising \$1,300 per circuit. Hong Kong rejoices as it receives \$1,000 U.S. from contacts in Taipei and Jesse Clements makes introductions to his 15-year associations in Hong Kong. Bombay writes 20 proposals for submission to companies and Singapore's back-up system starts operating with thank you's, pledge letters and proposal production. Brussels lays out its Quarter IV trek schedule and experiences break-throughs with clarity on the fact that funds will come from sources other than the movement. Chicago's break-through is the establishment of a Public Image post. The contradiction is seeing that grassroots, donors, major funding go on simultaneously while moving into new orbits.

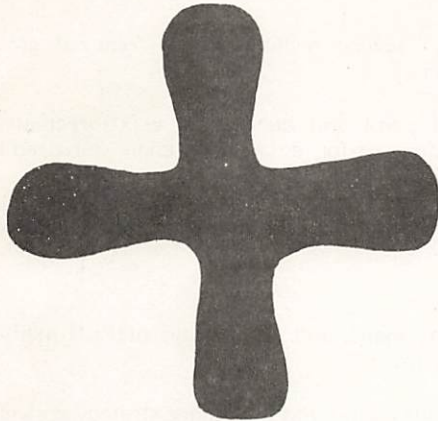
Global Management Centurms re-appropriate practics and paper work as enabling to missional endeavors. Bombay wrestles with space design as it anticipates arrival of GRA staff. Brussels rediscovers finance forms and procedures as helpful tools in global mission rather than burdensome responsibility. Hong Kong moves toward bookkeeping system that will embody minimum effective accountability. Singapore initiates LENS marketing with 100 individually-typed letters and the printing of a new LENS brochure. Chicago creates new 'Major Services' (old In-Kind) post as new possibilities in innovative in-kind building materials open up for 6th floor walls and Majuro needs. The contradiction has to do with creating the concrete events that become catalytic happenings rather than nitty-gritty routine.

GRA/ITI recruitment in Bombay is gathering momentum as Hess arrives, Jenkins reports on possibilities from Sri Lanka and P.T. James is assigned to GRA recruitment. In Hong Kong all the printing and mailing of the GRA/ITI procedures, brochures and guidelines to the Houses and Centurms is completed. Singapore receives list of sponsors and host committee for Kuala Lumpur ITI. Brussels mailed Quarter IV programme schedule two weeks before first course. Chicago rearranges space to include Summer 75 post, while finishing battleplanning and teaching assignments. Preaching Mission for 500 in Seoul. Prior's Councils in Bombay and Brussels Nexus. The challenge is in creating an operational calendar that holds the 20 programs in perspective in 26 weeks without neglecting the immediacy of the ITI/GRA.

PCE as global demonstration continues to hold spotlight as Brussels mails first European quarterly PCE manual. Guilds report to Bombay a regularizing of weekly attendance. Hong Kong initiates writing post and begins editing of Area Priors Council: HK spins; centrum battleplanning with SMS indicative procedures reveals refinements necessary for use of the procedures with city district officers. Singapore tallies teachers survey: 51 teachers plus N.A.--36 women, 15 men. 94 parish grids now in hand. Pentecost HRM schedule is beginning to fill out. Quarter IV Ecclesiola and PCE manuals sent out. The contradiction is maintaining internal discipline and creating spirit happenings as global demonstration increasing fragments immediate attention outward to practical tasks in the world.

LONDON

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: LONDON

External: Week of miracle of launching S'75 recruitment in which selected calling on 50 results in 26 'red hot' prospects (back-up systems start rolling) and blitz of penetration shows all Spring courses look good.

Internal: In-kind victories on Guinness, pencils, fresh vegetables, ashtrays and biscuits (cookies), in time for beginning of new Wayside Inn programme initiated by Sister from Holy Child Jesus Order in Birmingham.

Contradiction: Releasing cultural mindset of 'there is plenty time...to participate... later.. in a few years time.' (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: GLASGOW

External: Week of working closely with regional colleagues and cadres as Trinity Theological College Cadre begins work on decor for College Commons Room, while the Bishopton Cadre and House build model for Imaginal Education consult for church faculty Week 3, and Jordanhill College colleague and House build model for 5-session 'Community Reformulation Workshop' to be held at College.

Internal: Week that signaled the future: sent Fiona Willock, Scotland's first intern, out to Global Centrum:Chicago to International Training Program, while region colleagues participate in search for new facility, and Sylvia Benert, Edinburgh colleague, joins us to celebrate last House Church at 2 Victoria Crescent Road.

Contradiction: Creating careful assignment rationale and time design that allows us to do whole job. (Wk.I)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BRISTOL

External: Visit to Wales signals two new cadre possibilities. Locations secured by Cadre for Southampton RSI and four registrations thus far for Swamsea PLC. Regional Council planning with Metro Cadre and contact of City Social Services yields interest in GRA.

Internal: Preparation for and participation in Area Order Council explodes our images once again to the whole task. The concept of 'miracle' becomes a viable means of releasing our total expenditure in the midst of the Dark Night and Long March.

Contradiction: As more and more of the twenty programmes become possibilities in our mission how not to treat them as a check list of you oughts and be crippled by guilt. (Wk. 12)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: MANCHESTER

External: Intensive week of battleplanning miracles, first with Area at London Area Council, and then at House.

Internal: Unamuno paper stimulates House's discussion and brooding over Hope.

Contradiction: Trusting our intuitions rather than tried-and-true strategies. (Wk. 1)

PARIS

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: PARIS

External: Key visit with Parisian churchmen-laymen reveals willingness of 'renewal groups' to participate in fresh new vision of the future of the Church.

Internal: Complete redecoration of space (gallons of paint and buckets of wax!) recreates every room--we now have revolutionary Collegium room, gracious parlor, enlarged kitchen, spiritized hallway and even a sophisticated bathroom.

Contradiction: Decision to follow intuitions, while in midst of fog, comes as painful, but necessary. (Wk.1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: ROME

External: Visit with Jesuit leader of Christian Life Movement, and completion of PLC mailing, add congregation to dream of metamorphosis in church in Rome.

Internal: Week 11 of intensive indicative battleplanning with Psalms and long-range strategy conversations slews us into chute for Spring, Summer and Fall.

Contradiction: How to find tactic that will enable diverse set of miracles to empower each other rather than defuse each other. (WK. 1)

BRUSSELS

GLOBAL CENTRUM: BRUSSELS

External: Shift into new Centrum space reveals warboard possibilities as wall space is carefully measured for holding new designs. The wheels are beginning to turn relative to the summers programs as reports are received of GRA registrations.

Internal: New worship room is set up as the first paint is applied to transform a former 'cave' into great symbolic space, and Easter week 11 becomes a time of creation of symbols to hold the new life.

Contradiction: Creating symbols that hold us over against the comprehensive task and the quarters priorities. (Wk. 13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BRUSSELS

External: Bishop Jan Van Cauwelaert, 1975 Frankfurt ITI grad, becomes 1976 ITI sponsor. As House attends Easter Mass in parish church, the priest, passing the peace, breaks from the aisle, walks down our row to embrace the Prior and kiss him on both cheeks!

Internal: Transparency breaks loose during Steve Hamje's school report. Urged to remember he is a parish tactic, Steve replied, 'No I'm not a tactic I'm a community miracle.'

Contradiction: Remembering tactics conquer time limitation, and we have plenty of both. (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: AMSTERDAM

External: In midst of wedding practics House hosts three Sisters for supper and two members do speaking engagement at meeting of Ecumenical peace action group.

Internal: Crane-Baublitz wedding brings Centrum and Area House to Amsterdam for elegant congregational dinner in House and occasions combination of Daily Office and the Mass in liturgy in Redemptorist Church in the Parish.

Contradiction: Keeping priority of the long-range(ITI) and the immediate (RSI,PLC,HRM,LCC) in tension with the necessary strategies and tactics for both.(Wk.1)

FRANKFURT

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: FRANKFURT

External: More Parish 'yeses' as large Roman Catholic church O.K.'s hosting Pentecost Human Resurgence Mission and one Protestant church requests regular consultation for planning of youth work.

Internal: Quarter Ecclesiola work culminates in wrap-up of Hope study. Week II of discontinuity over Easter.

Contradiction: Credibility gap with city, church establishment slows timeline for moving into new facility, with time running out on present one. (WK. 13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BERLIN

External: Explosion of new impact for the movement with 2 all day consultations established plus a for broke decision by educators for a Week 3 LENS.

Internal: Received Frankfurt House for Area battleplanning weekend that thrust us with practical miracles into our busiest Quarter yet.

Contradiction: Finding the bureaucratic key to new facility as deadline of our house approaches fast. (Wk. 13)

NAIROBI

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: NAIROBI

External: Last minute registrations for Qtr.IV Week I PLC push numbers beyond number facility can take as we expect 30 people around table, all recruited by colleagues. Registrar of University of Nairobi says Yes to LENS for University staff.

Internal: Internal planning for Quarter IV done. Cliff Stocking's parents arrive for visit.

Contradiction: Finding key that will release people to participate in further training whenever they think that recruiting courses we teach is enough. (Wk.I)

BOMBAY

GLOBAL CENTRUM: BOMBAY

External: Planners Association of Srilanka invites proposals for minimum of six LENS courses for all tea plantation owners. I.E. in Patna for Roman Catholic teachers.

Contradiction: Maintaining ITI recruitment at full force, while holding GRA critical leadership presence relative to staffing. (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BOMBAY

External: With GRA a few weeks off intensify circuit ride recruitment by sending House members to Poona, Nagpur, Ahmedabad, and Goa and reports that more 20th Century Xaviours needed for Goa. Narendra Paul at Nagpur sends report of two registrations and six firm Yes's for ITI.

Internal: Host continental Priors as they reach Bombay for Week 10 meeting. Intensive workshop and planning for internal structure building to enable House to function fully as pressure of GRA and ITI consumes time and energy. Ecclesiola Kazantzakis study rocks us with authenticity of the spirit struggle.

Contradiction: How to ground mission in the Megalapolis with the mobility and pace of Bombay life. (WK. 12)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: DELHI

External: ITI recruitment blitz to all regions allows House to personally visit 209 people, ending week with 71 'considering', but only one paid pre-registration fee.

Internal: Week II re-reading of 'By the Skin of our Teeth', corporate work on HRM 'New Church' witness, and participation in Holy Week services call us to struggle with the resurrected life.

Contradiction: In a time of despair and hopelessness in the Church and Nation, breaking open new ITI prospects, creating new recruitment stories, and building a new vision that inoculates against infection. (WK. 1)

MADRAS

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: HYDERABAD

External: In-kind development begins to break open in Hyderabad for ITI, particularly with Jaycees offering to gather many of required items.

Internal: New intern family, Harry and Theresa Anthic and their four children, moves into House with garlanding ceremony at House Church. Week of intensive Mission and celebration.

Contradiction: Utilizing our limited (but ever-expanding) troops to gain. Maximum effect as last round-up for Global Research Assembly begins. (WK. 1)

CALCUTTA

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: CALCUTTA

External: Second Area circuit ride completed bringing back Yes to Calcutta: ITI from Orissa State C.N.I. Area Superintendant old regional colleague Kalyan Biswas is first paid registration for GRA. Rediscover the Lord decides, not us, who is the Movement, as unexpected colleagues turn up for fantastic Area Council. ITI recruitment well under way in one region as 6 paid registrations and request for 10 more application forms arrive in one day.

Internal: House pools together ITI/GRA stories and images, recruitment models to put GRA/ITI recruitment in high gear. Day of Fasting makes us aware of cruciality of intentional spirit life. Landlord motivated to fulfill promises when he finds out we control purse strings.

Contradiction: How to actualize GRA/ITI recruitment with two weeks to go and only one registration and one yes for Bombay: GRA out of quota of nine. (WK.11)

SINGAPORE

GLOBAL CENTRUM: SINGAPORE

External: During Week I of Week I an Imaginal Education course is taught with 50 teachers in Malaysia through the Malaysian Teachers for Social Action; held at Cameron Highlands and through the sponsorship of Roman Catholics.

Internal: Shinns in transit to Bombay: Global Research Assembly give an enlightening report of the future of demonstration among Aborigines in Australia.

Contradiction: In the volley ball game of the 20 programs the challenge is to provide such a backup system that the ball never touches the floor: six LENS courses, two taught simultaneously on two different weekends--guess where the miracle is. (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SINGAPORE

External: Four of New Town teachers (parish guild) announce commitment to attend Global Research Assembly in Manila. Regional colleague announces he is available for assignment to GRA or as ITI faculty member.

Internal: Ed and Mime Shinn enroute to Global Research Assembly: Bombay, spent one night at House and report at Collegium on journey of Oombulgurri. Huang family takes up job at Heng Teck Center (Presbyterian Community Center) near New Town parish.

Contradiction: Looking beyond immediate isolated goals to discern the critical task as well as Movement of the spirit across the globe. (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: KUALA LUMPUR

External: Four day CS-IIIB course for Lutheran and Anglican Church Worker Trainees and staff reveals cry for adequate training; new agricultural project funding possibilities arise out of development call to Asia Foundation. Internal: Centrum guests and House dispersed for CS-IIIB, Local Community Consult, development, and jobs; coming together in time for complete space transformation and preparation for Odyssey.

Contradiction: So busy with immediate demands, don't have adequate long-range individual journey plans for colleagues. (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: JAKARTA

External: LENS marketing spurred on by Dick (Soybeans) West from Kuala Lumpur while five-day circuit ride to Central and East Java enables present and future Metro meetings and recruits for GRA and ITI.

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: JAKARTA (cont.)

Internal: House impacted by Quarter of its members visit to 4th century Buddhist Temple Barobadour in Central Java as week-long visit by K.L. house member makes area seem closer.

Contradiction: With Central and East Java opening up, how do we meet all the challenges and still to Manado Region and LENS. (Wk. 12)

HONG KONG

GLOBAL CENTRUM: HONG KONG

External: Entree to shipping magnate in Hong Kong. Created Bi-Centrums / (Man/Oper/Deve/Res) to focus troop power for the GRA/ITI and completed the practical planning for each Centrum. Initiated the publishing of the Ecclesiola book for Houses within the Centrum zone.

Internal: First Centrum guest-night with Canossian Sisters of Charity and old movement colleague, Sean Burke (Maryknoll Order). Centrum pedagogy on Primal Community Experiment conversations. Hosted Addington family on their way to Chicago.

Contradiction: Being chaste in the battleplan method and trusting that the tactics will catalyze the needed miracles. (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: HONG KONG

External: Jesse Clements tells story of Majuro and Town Meeting to colleagues and opens door to signal gifts from key businesses.

Internal House does battleplanning on Week II while holding ourselves conscious to 'Good Friday' by readings and meditations on 'Imitation of Christ.'

Contradiction: Gearing on recruitment to major events while creating the regional structures necessary for post course engagement. (Wk. 13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: KAOHSIUNG

External: City impacted by round of secular celebrations centered in our Parish as Mayor proclaims this 'Life-Line Week'.

Internal: Planning for internal undergirding of the missional demands of Quarter IV. House discontinuity.

Contradiction: Dealing with 'end of Quarter syndrome.' (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: MANILA

External: Great Community sign as House participates with 400 residents of P.C. in Holy Week cleanup. Six hour demonstration training workshop with 60 E.G. and Youth of PCE. Delegates to National meeting in Cebu embark on 22-hour boat trip.

Internal: Metro colleagues help with 'Splendiferous' celebration for Addingtons' send out; complete with barbeque chicken, traditional Filipino dances, (we all tried the Tinikling), waltzing and much singing. House takes advantage of Holy Days Time-Off to do indicative b/p.

Contradiction: Arranging 15 top priority items into a missional design that frees us to move into coming Quarter. (WK. 13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: TAIPEI

External: Representing LENS at management association dinner, results in possibility of LENS being used as management training too! Region celebrates by journeying up mountain to Lovers' Temple for picnic and activities. Local pastor to be sent to GRA by congregation.

Internal: House completes internal planning to launch Quarter IV. School Spring vacation enables extended discontinuity allowing families to experience breadth and depth of Taiwan.

Contradiction: Pulling threads of Quarter together to get focus on Primal Community Experiment. (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: CEBU

External: Swirl of external events both recontext and reground the House and Region for the next two Quarters' work. Minischool closing exercises with about 100 LENS (community) site and brochure completed, national strategy session with Davao and Manila regions; held in Cebu House and LENS grad celebration at Dolphin Island Resort of Dr. Mancao, recent grad for grads and families, 100 plus people.

Internal: Miracle in-kind donation of paint, brushes, etc. worth about \$1500, enables massive transformation of House-outside and inside. Sent out Adelbert Batista to Cebu polis upon completion of his extended internship year.

Contradiction: Evaluation and pulling together models of House battleplans, Regional Council battleplans and NSS battleplans to focus total thrust of Quarter (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: DAVAO

External: Sent out House and regional colleagues to National Meeting in Cebu.

Internal: House participates in various Holy Week services in several key churches, and sees movie 'Shoes of the Fisherman' on Good Friday.

Contradiction: Need to mesh all indicatives into one common thrust. (Wk.I)

TOKYO**RELIGIOUS HOUSE: TOKYO**

External: Incredible week of collegial hosting as Paul and Gerry Evans host Dr. and Mrs. Preston Bradley at famous Japanese restaurant; ITI sponsor Victor Ordonez delivers Manila ITI brochures and regional colleagues engage in radical tactics to prepare new Religious House.

Internal: Concretion of tactical thinking dramatized in 'Great Box Hunt' which finds House learning special Japanese to get Inkind boxes and colleague Okochi delivers 50.

Contradiction: How to focus and maximize energies in relation to discontinuous Permeation schedules. (Wk.II)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SEOUL

External: Luncheon is held for Mr. Hyun Suk Ho, Chairman, Institute of Catholic Catechism, to send him on his global trip to Rome, Europe and North America. Met with Mr. Choi Kye Yong, Executive Director of Korea Capital Corporation. Wk 11 indicative battleplan plans for global education network in Korea.

Internal: The House celebrates Christopher Edward Work's 100th day. A full House dinner with Dr. Park Young Nae symbolizes the receiving of a gift of a new program center.

Contradiction: As we move into Quarter IV with battle planning and tactics complete, still have job of creating Regional operations schedule. (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: FUKUOKA

External: With in-kind use of two vans and assistance of six English language students, House picks up and moves in three hours flat to 16 room furnished Taisho Era (1912-25) mansion, three minutes walk from downtown Fukuoka and located dead center in parish.

Internal: House celebrates adoption of Natasha Therese Filipki, two year-9 month old daughter of Ken and Anne. Witnesses her baptism at Hikarigaoka Catholic Church Easter Vigil Service culminating Lent and Order Fast Day.

Contradiction: The need to speed up translation work on LENS manual in order to meet course dead-line. (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: OSAKA

External: Global Language staff visit with, Mr. Kuroishi, Director of Japan Management Services. exploring possibilities for future relationships. Galaxy participants write proposals.

Internal: Complete and publish battle-planning. Receive authorization for 3,000,000 yen (\$10,000) loans from Maryknoll and Scheut Orders in Japan.

Contradiction: ICA brochure needs to be translated. (Wk. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SENDAI

External: Regional coordinator, Rev. Miyazaki travels to Sapporo Metro with Area prior Ellison for three days of pedagogy.

Internal: Experiment with secular sophistication where secular and religious gather for birthday party.

Contradiction: Seeing tools and visions for dealing with local situation, but finding our strategies are on different path. (WK. 1)

SYDNEY**RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SYDNEY**

External: PCE crowds lounge of Woolhara manse with all congregations present and dramatizes missional demand on its life for Qtr.IV, and symbolizes replication.

Internal: Final guest night for quarter was largest and included pastor from local congregation and a guildsman from Wyndham.

Contradiction: Trusting the Quarter's battleplan as the operating system. (Wk.I)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: PERTH

External: Major thrusts through LENS recruiting and Human Research Mission set-up to break loose local leadership and authorization for Primal Community Experiment.

Internal: A guest night done in sophisticated style. Quarter manuals presented at House Church. English tutorial for Aboriginal students commences. David Mowarlarli visits us.

Contradiction: Catalytic actions that will bring forth a nod from local authorization and release troops for training. (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: DARWIN

External: ICA/EI booklet and 40 Page social reconstruction proposal prepared over extended Week II to launch authorization blitz. PCE residents group announces plans for city wide trade fair, a local building coop and launches two day care centers. Tourist association holds first meeting since cyclone and reaffirms long range vision for Darwin.

Internal: PSU preparing crucial missional documents extends Week II design in to Wednesday of the next week. Guild colleague Carol Borovic drops in after return from evacuation, points out pre cyclone indicative battleplan was right and asks 'Where do I start.'

Contradiction: How to relate internal models and external mission so as not to experience continuing dropins by people at all hours of the day night as 'catching us in the act'. (WK. 9)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: OOMBULGURRI

External: Elders assume new power and role in community as circumcision of five young boys symbolizes their initiation into manhood at end of 10-day djaruk. Met with lawyer for new housing association to plan application for major grant for construction.

Internal: Shinns sent to GRA in Subcontinent. Whole House re-created in Good Friday work day. Presence of auxiliary men at initiation impacts us with depth and power of local heritage.

Contradiction: As entire community moves back into daily Guild structures, discerning event which will catalyze corporate momentum and concretize new beginning the djaruk has been. (Wk.I)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: ADELAIDE

External: Secured invitation for second Human Resurgence Mission during Pentecost season and printed the Region timeline and manual for Quarter IV.

Internal: Held House 'end-of-quarter' celebration at Benjamin's Restaurant on River Torrens, followed two days later by observing appointed day of fasting; we become aware of abounding and abasing.

Contradiction: Getting clear enough images of what is required; priorities, events and tactics, in order to enable others to participate, allowing us to be the catalysts. (Wk. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: MELBOURNE

External: Trek to Sale metro results in four speaking engagements and uncovers clergy network. Key tactic actualized with interchurch council in Prahran parish with speaking engagement.

Internal: Another teaching position secured, the second House position in a school of the same Catholic Order. House breaks Fast with Quarter celebration in a restaurant. Week II sees completion of House battleplan.

Contradiction: In midst of engagement in Parish, possibility in outer metros outrunning our practical vision and revealing need for rational plan. (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: CANBERRA

External: The tide begins to turn: First Assistant Secretary of Department of Social Security and executive of Australian Assistance Plan, Tom o'Brien invites ICA to lunch. On parting he requests a seat at LENS.

Internal: Old hands Drude and Aline McMaster move into House.

Contradiction: Having patience to work through Battleplanning method to the tactics rather than short cutting our planning. (Wk. 1.)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BRISBANE

External: Broad-based sponsoring for community LENS secured, from Federal member to local little old lady; Cloncurry colleague flies in to share state of Metro, in anticipation of actualizing Metro care.

Internal: Radical corporateness celebrated and symbolized through Easter Watch, with Regional colleagues participating.

Contradiction: Focusing individual positive responses through Movemental dynamic into 'laser beam' of missional thrust. (Wk.1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: MAJURO

External: Joined in 35-man painting team at MCAA to transform two buildings. Huge TASC order arrives in Kwajajelen and is transhipped to Majuro-with whole House stevedoring effort to unload.

Internal: Roberta Sperstad begins working with Majuro pre-school just in time to participate in Easter 'party' complete with TV-new this week in Majuro- games, eggs, and a feast. Contradiction: Initiating new programs before equipment, staff and funding that is needed, is available. (Wk. 12)

SUVA**RELIGIOUS HOUSE: APIA**

External: Report on prior's trip to Fiji illuminates colleagues journeys there and state of our authorization base. Old grad drops by unexpectedly for conversation and stays for dinner.

Internal: Learning from Global Report we are now in area Apia. Creating Internal Life models for Quarter IV and deciding which of three 'new' Ecclesiola constructs to use. House yard delineated by new hibiscus hedge.

Contradiction: Moving in Samoa so that local and overseas people can see need to work together and meet challenges present in this country. (WK. 1)

SAN FRANCISCO RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SAN FRANCISCO

External: Sent out four colleagues from Primal Community Experiment in Seattle to TI. Quarter's Primal Community Experiment battleplanning completed.

Internal: Sent out Jose DeFruyt to denominational assignment in Osaka. House sees movie 'Shampoo' and wrestles with its significance for world.

Contradiction: Needing consensus on task force rationale so can move into new Quarter's task. (Wk. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SAN JOSE

External: House attends City sponsored Bi-Centennial kick-off meeting in form of 'Town Meeting', full regalia, including Town Crier. 2,000 people from City of San Jose attend. Briefings following meeting give House good idea of where San Jose is in terms of Bi-Centennial planning.

Internal: External battleplans, proposals and tactics, and internal life models all completed and ready to go for Quarter IV as workday concludes with celebrational meal and House Manual at every place. Unbelievable Inkind visits continue to pay off--20 cases of fruits, vegetables, canned goods, jams, peanut butter, etc.--some on way to ITI.

Contradiction: How enable singleminded vision in midst of various and sundry tasks. (Wk.I)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SACRAMENTO

External: Five sent to Global Training, three to Academy, and two to ITI.

Internal: Tribal resettlement frees up space for new lounge and expanded gathering areas.

Contradiction: With maxing clarity about what the Doing of Qtr.IV needs to be, how to timeline and orchestrate whole show into one reality. (Wk.I)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SEATTLE

External: A great week of breaking open Town Meeting Advocacy in Idaho, working with the Salt Lake City House. New ITI prospects emerge in Portland, while PCE quarter battleplanning exposes the dual role required to do both the parish and the region.

Internal: Sharon Pilliot, Robert Knutson, and Doris Lee Dimick are guests. House Ecclesiola finds us leaping from high places, racing furiously, and plunging to the deeps as we go swimming at nearby pool. E.G. attempt (unsuccessful) walk on water in local marsh.

Contradiction: How to put a workable, enabling form on the operating designs for the PCE/Regional Centrum for Quarter IV. (WK. 12)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: LOS ANGELES

External: ITI prepared and launched without completely abandoning other things. T'M '76 progresses, Primal Community Experiment meets, ect.

Internal; Frequent trips to Upland for decor completion. All of House adults at opening feast of ITI.

Contradiction: Need to be prepared with working models to keep house and Region in gear while flexible enough to meet all ITI demands. (Wk. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: PHOENIX

External: Three Albuquerque families, the Moores, the Thompsons, and the Eberhardts, journey to Phoenix for Week II sojourn.

Internal: Sent out first prior to Los Angeles ITI for five weeks.

Contradiction: Being able to hold spirit intentionality in midst of operation chaos. (Wk.I)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SALT LAKE CITY

External: Discovery of new colleagues and future iron men of Central City during LCC calling.

Internal: War Room at the House functions as exciting co-ordinating centre to receive information on breakthroughs during LCC callings.

Contradiction: Deciding to take time to catalyze Metro colleagues to participate in demands of LCC versus House members themselves responding to the immediate. (Wk. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BILLINGS

External: Newly elected Alderman joins Guild for PCE battleplanning, as well as representatives of Latino Club, to plan Guild and community-wide participation in Cinco de Mayo celebration.

Internal: House celebrates Easter with great feast, sends out Jim Kilgore and Scott McGuire, consensus on internal life manual. Women's dorm now has three Japanese 'Futon'-style beds.

Contradiction: In midst of our great Guild battleplan, critical state of House finances and decision to do 24 Town Meetings, how to hold comprehensiveness. (Wk.I)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: DENVER

External: Eight leave from Tri-Metro for ITI in Los Angeles. Pre-guilders reverse House's shaky decision to meet as they come armed with their assigned research and model building tasks completed.

Internal: Reflection and planning for internal House roles bring exciting changes in persons filling the roles and fresh new consciousness in Wayside Inn dynamic.

Contradiction: Insisting for hunt of golden grail already in our possession manifested in outcry for nurture and precise models. (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: RAPID CITY

External: Trip to North Dakota pretty much assures funds for T.M. and results in invitation to participate in eight Town Treks with North Dakota Bicentennial Committee to set up Bicentennial activities.

Internal: McGregors of Ontario come for Daily Office and breakfast Collegium. Delight in beginning Ecclesiola study Week one: Mecca! and in brilliant organization of Teams and Stations Waltzed before Battle with 24 hours discontinuity.

Contradiction: Caught in midst of creating screen to handle ambiguities and demands while ten do work of twenty. (Wk. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: ANCHORAGE

External: Local churches impacted as we recruit RSI and participate in Holy Week service as House. TM 76 advocacy off and running with good visits to ex-state senator and campaign manager.

Internal: Holy Week celebration highlighted by three-day fast ending with magnificent candlelight feast preceded by battleplanning, creating montages for 15 Stations of the Cross, receiving sojourner, Ken Otto, and clearing driveway of winter snow and ice.

Contradiction: Parish Cadre realizes urgency of TM 76 but has not concretely dealt with building the structure to forge necessary battleplans. (WK.13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SASKATOON

'Bouregard Patriots', parish tenants alliance, drop in on House along with unexpected onslaught of nine guests ending in meeting of high intensity excitement and possibility.

Internal: Wayside Inn dynamic predominant in House hosting six guests for week on top of many guests dropping through, including nine on Thursday night. Among the assortment were Marge Knutsen and relatives, on her way to Malaysia.

Contradiction: Daring to approach the limits by daring to just use the contacts we have. (WK 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: TULSA

External: a Miracle of week: on Iron Man raised from the dead! Appointments with two cities for T.M. '76 prospects.

Internal: Celebrated first Ecclesiola. Decision of whole house to double jobs.

Contradiction: Time design for Quarter not yet concretized. (Wk. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: NEW ORLEANS

External: Three Primal Community Experiment churches gather thirty laymen for six week training, led by clergy totally. Total of 850 T.M. invitations sent to sponsorship number of office opportunity to look where we haven't looked before.

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: NEW ORLEANS (cont.)

Internal: Ecclesiola Sodality provides a jolting way to look at globe. Guests at House Church provide us with a fresh look at what we are doing.

Contradiction: Contexting urgency of T.M. sponsorship to get a 'yes' over all other important things. (WK. 1)

Plant city local pastor requests Pentecostal Human Resurgence Mission and three regional colleagues attend Guardians meeting in Chicago.

Internal: Rossmans move out on way to Charlotte, Gaiges move in from Chicago catalyzing tribal resettlement with three new Emerging Generation in House. Steve Harrington's (Ottawa House) parents come for a visit, bringing wintering Minneapolis friend and Ecclesiola dinner.

Contradiction: Tomorrow looks like yesterday. (WK. 1)

External: Eighth Guardian Consult is witness to emergence of TWC (Those Who Care) as a network across the continent and globe, highlighted by exciting report on Majuro social demonstration, and spiritizing spins on global responsibility of the businessman.

Internal: Colleagues visiting Centrum this past week were Bishop R.D. Joshi, Methodist Bishop of the Bombay Area, his niece, Sandra HOshi, and Suyra Kaut, Methodist pastor studying at McCormick. With us for Academy and Seminary study is the Very Reverend Lika Likownt Nessibu Tafesse, of Ethiopia, Dean of the Royal Church of St. Mary's at the Grand Palace, and past secretary of the Patriarchy. Rev. Andrew Chaung, Presbyterian pastor, arrives from Taiwan for the International Training Program. RELIGIOUS HOUSE: KANSAS CITY

Internal: Absolution on old Quarter releases us to enter new; new station structure and full employment in the midst of recession hold key to unlock Mission.

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: MINNEAPOLIS

External: Town Meeting authorized as official Bicentennial program of South Dakota. Galaxy creation of six-miracle battleplan for Quarter focus on entering Parish with T.M. as tactic.

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: MINNEAPOLIS (cont.)

Internal: Week of Celebration, Lenny, the M.C. artformed in Ecclesiola and Weekend of engagement with Supper Club Celebration and first birthday party for Peter Ballard.

Contradiction: Maintaining the Missional Momentum in midst of intensified permeation. (WK. 9)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: WASHINGTON

External: 70 year old LENS grad to make LENS call as seven from New 'U' Community phone in to register for LENS. Obtain five TM sponsors for first TM in Virginia (Fairfax), including Civitan, Optimist, J.C.s, D.C. Federal Civic Ass'n General Assembly says 'Yes' to prime participation as sponsorship in 45 Town Meetings.

Internal: Welcome Deborah Ownes as sojourner, and guests from New Jersey, 46 from Wisconsin, and Joe Crocker from New York. Also welcome Bob Dexter as 'new printer', and inkind of 11 lbs. of poultry. New TM decor and pictures from New 'U' TM go up. Two new Day I task force members for TM work.

Contradiction: Being called up to field army, and struggling to get one squad to the battle front. (Wk.1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BALTIMORE

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: PHILADELPHIA

External: After T.M., Advocacy picks up tremendous speed with follow-up visits to executives of United Way and the Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission and appointments with Prudential and Soroptomists.

Internal: House kicks off Spring Quarter planning week with Easter steak banquet with highlight of week being the creating a symbol, song, and slogan for the Quarter.

Contradiction: Being a small snake who has feasted on an elephant (T.M.'76). How do we move quickly ahead to Primal Community Experiment. (WK. 13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: NEWARK

External: The miraculous in midst of the mundane as community and city services engage with Movement colleagues in transforming junky four lots surrounding Newark House into first Parish miracle, while Phase 4 Italian immigrant couple serve zapoles to total community during workday.

Internal: In midst of fantastic Open House, where old Movement colleagues have reunion with new colleagues from Parish workday, blow our secular image when Episcopal colleague in full vestment blesses entire House, room by room, with holy water and incense, as children and community delight in transformation of dilapidated old mansion and grounds into community symbol of possibility in midst of ethnic diversity.

Contradiction: Finding key to unlock Week I time design to hold us and Metro colleagues constantly before our decision, and to accomplish the mission. (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: HARTFORD

External: Hartford House hosts Regional Odyssey; 130 PLC letters and new brochure sent (have had previous visits), three from Bi-metro to Academy; Quarter IV modification; program and miracle timeline laid out in detail. Congregational planning retreat firmed up for week III.

Internal: Doug Wilson sent out to intern at Chicago Centrum. Episcopal priest from Centers parish in New Haven visits Sunday afternoon 'for a rest' and stays and celebrates House Church. Odyssey preparation and participation cares for us all.

Contradiction: Creating the symbolic decor to allow us to stand before the task of the Quarter and hold us accountable to our program and miracle timeline. (WK. 1)

Internal: Spring blooming through blanket of snow.

Contradiction: Shifting gears into new quarter. (Wk.I)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BOSTON

External: Town Meeting breakthrough for Demonstration meeting in May as sponsorship begins to take shape.

Internal: Internal life structured so as to remind us every moment that we were in Holy Week beginning with celebration by attending Passion play, Seder Meal. Fast from 'Maundy Thursday to Sunday. Prayer vigil Saturday night and time of silence beginning at 10:00 each evening during Holy Week.

Contradiction: How to transform inner spirit burst to outward effectiveness. (Wk.I3)

External: Journey of new colleagues is intensified as: parish core takes in new parish colleagues; colleague conducts two-day workshop with Mental Retardation Association using indicative battleplanning methodology, Metro Cadre member, Carolyn Chung sent out to Academy.

Internal: Week III (3:00 a.m.-9:00 a.m.-Sunday) rediscovered which provides longest period of uninterrupted corporate brooding and planning time ever experienced during the whole year thus far.

Contradiction: Long-range plan obscures quarterly rhythm and tends to produce week-by-week planning. (WK. 1)

Internal: Journey on, journey on, was refrain of 'Odyssey' when area literally stormed Toronto, soaked up Kleinburg Art Centre where Group of Seven's art is exhibited, penetrated 'The Pilgrim' and sent Alan Herbert to hospital for a successful operation. Highlight of Odyssey was colleague's House Church witness-a depth charge.

Contradiction: After anticipated chaos is ordered, we can move strategically and cover all bases. (WK. 13)

CARACAS

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: CARACAS

External: LENS course 'go' with three representatives from Governor's office being sent, and one company President who says Yes after 6-minute pitch. First Parish Leadership Seminar (in Spanish) held in local church at Prados del Este, enthusiastically received by congregational representatives. Cadre breaks loose new plan and commitment for RSI recruitment.

Internal: George and Rafael sent out to Caribbean for week-long retreat with Carmelites followed by PLC in St. Martins for Methodist clergy in Caribbean.

Contradiction: Enabling movements engagement in mission.(WK. 1)

Chicago's circuit battleplanning creates fresh mode of operation for Quarter IV. Hosting Guardians' Consult reaffirms corporateness, and Guardian involvement in Town Meeting seen as practical breakloose. Newly created Public Image Post sets up. Four months of at least \$100,000 each are received as new trend, and Quarter III income was \$75,000 more than Quarter III of last year. Singapore made eight development calls in one day in Kuala Lumpur, uncovering promising donation from millionaire. Hong Kong's visit to American businessman gives promise of \$5000 H.K. and an introduction to a Chinese shipping magnate. Intensification of phone calls for appointments (51 calls in three days on list of 85 companies) allows Movement to break into American business community, works with commonizing development system in regions and motivating regional responsibility. Contradiction is how is practical, secular evangelism manifested?

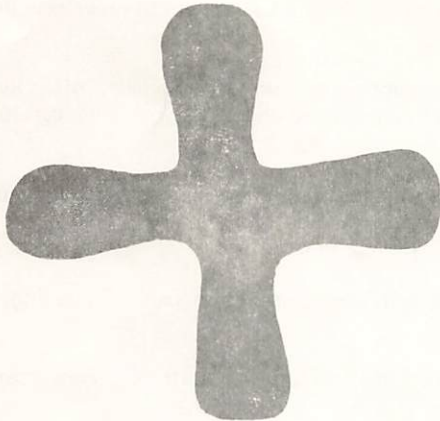
Centrum publishing activity increases as Singapore sends out 220 LENS recruitment letters, Brussels prints all night to publish Crane wedding documents, Hong Kong publishes Ecclesiola manual for entire Centrum responsibility, and Chicago handles massive Guardian publishing with non-challance. Reports and financial statements arrive at Bombay from Houses as partial implementation of financial model begins, and Brussels deals with issue of the economic 'ordering' now rather than waiting until Summer. Intensification of GRA initiation enables new push into practics as spirit motivity. Massive government rationing in India effects immediate need for food staples required for GRA. Hong Kong intentionalizes space and location as sophisticated office/training center completes renovation of one more room. Chicago Management participates in development as two of the priors are sent out on circuits. New level of sophistication exhibited with Guardians Consult enablement. The increased experience in ability to anticipate, is allowing better use of troop strength. Contradiction is inventing the systems and story which will allow us to stand before global expansion.

Bombay reports context for final planning set with concrete data on GRA/ITI recruitment arriving from Houses, moves into one thrust of coordination towards opening of GRA. Hong Kong meets with Management for tactical planning on GRA/ITI. Centrum priorities, tactics, and timeline worked through in relation to coordination of 20 Programs, along with Centrum 'March of Miracles.' Singapore, too, moves into more practical preparation for ITI, with all time spent in materials and communications. Brussels experiences breakthrough as committment by Houses to Quarter IV program schedule reveals power of common operating images and assignments across continent. Battleplanning for new Quarter in Chicago reveals focus on edges of the work and the honing rather than new directions and tactics, and holds Centrum open to designs that allow total enablement of Town Meeting '76. First LENS for clergy held in New York, other LENS courses in Caracas and Washington D.C., and CSIIB in Kuala Lumpur, Odysseys and Bi-Metro and Area Councils held throughout Movement. Contradiction is moving in the East from ITI/GRA centeredness to sustaining continued thrust of all 20 programs and maintaining global commonality.

In Chicago the Guardians' Consult emphasizes Guardian rble in bringing off 5,000 Town Meetings in North America. PCE consult model built and launched with first of 52 consults in Continent, focusing on building four-year replication model in each Bi-Metro. Brussels has its Global Primal Community consult manual ready for printing, and excitement mounts as HRM and LCC role in the PCE in Europe becomes clearer. In Bombay the PCE gets practical focus during the GRA through concrete impenetaries. Byculla 5 Guild becomes more conscious of its task in the neighborhood as it moves to meet for first time in Guildsman's home. Singapore reports that Eka Dharmaputra Jakarta pastor and ITI grad, has become chairmen of a jojo Protestant denomination, the G.K.I. Community and Polis course in Kuala Lumpur with Lutheran and Anglican parish workers opens up new penetration strategy for local churches, and possibility of becoming permanent consultants to their training centre. In Hong Kong, preparation for catalyzing PCE this Quarter occurs through experimentation with vocation conversations. Research catalyzed in regions and Houses as Centrum plans mesh with plans from global band to prepare Movement for social demonstration. Contradiction is lining out exact program constructs to be used for local situations in midst of global models, and timing program resoures availability.

Internal: In-kind victories on Guinness, pencils, fresh vegetables, ashtrays and biscuits (cookies), in time for beginning of new Wayside Inn programme initiated by Sister from Holy Child Jesus Order in Birmingham.

Contradiction: Releasing cultural mindset of 'there is plenty time...to participate... later.. in a few years time.' (WK. 3)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: GLASGOW

External: Two regional colleagues come through with house to live in (24 hours before we were on the street) and a lorry to move our two suitcases. Set corporate date for PCE field visit.

Internal: Secure new temporary location only two hours before signing of lease for house we didn't want. Location is a flat in Govan, Old Parish Church (Church of Scotland), George MacLeod's last congregation, birthplace of Iona Community, and site of continuous Christian worship for last 1,100 years. Packing and miraculous moving mixed with work on finances, comprehensiveness screens and brooding on S'75, and ITI'76.

Contradiction: Now that we're moved, a creative station rationale that gets whole job done. (Wk.2)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BRISTOL

External: New Summer '75 contact and marketing arenas explode with social services and regional meeting produces old and new unexpected people.

Internal: House transformed by SDP/GRA decor in time for regional gathering and summer promotion. Deeply impacted and addressed by indicative of social demonstration in Area London by first Ecclesiola Sodality.

Contradiction: With overwhelming success of first foray into secular structures, discerning tactical network of authorization, so we care for long term task and not immediate social need. (WK 2)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: MANCHESTER

External: Intensive week of battleplanning miracles, first with Area at London Area Council, and then at House.

Internal: Unamuno paper stimulates House's discussion and brooding over Hope.

Contradiction: Trusting our intuitions rather than tried-and-true strategies. (Wk. 1)

PARIS**RELIGIOUS HOUSE: PARIS**

External: Week of visits to The Rue Roquepine congregation, uncover an eagerness to move practically and immediately on their vision for the Church.

Internal: Found new Ecclesiola model refreshing and very enabling--couldn't cut Sodality off! Quarter E.G. curriculum completed and already altering our image of care for the children, when they can report to us the news and scripture of the day.

Contradiction: Shattering of illusion that once you get facility in shape and quarter's internal life models completed, the external mission will automatically fall into place. (Wk.2)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: ROME

External: Visit with Jesuit leader of Christian Life Movement, and completion of PLC mailing, add concretion to dream of metamorphosis in church of Rome.

Internal: Week II of intensive indicative battleplanning with Psalms and long-range strategy conversations slews us into chute for Spring, Summer and Fall.

Contradiction: How to find tactic that will enable diverse set of miracles to empower each other rather than defuse each other. (WK. 1)

BRUSSELS**GLOBAL CENTRUM: BRUSSELS**

External: Development teams out in Brussels and Frankfurt, as quarter development thrust is launched. Speaking engagement in Brussels with key couple hosting church mission committee.

Internal: Daily Office takes on new dimensions as begin worshipping in newly painted and decored worship/prayer room.

Contradiction: Concretely organizing ourselves to carry the whole load. (Wk.2)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BRUSSELS

External: ITI sponsors for 1976: Lord George MacLeod, Bishop Ted Wickam, Bishop Jan van Cauwelaert, Canon Joseph Dessain (Ecumenical Affairs for Cardinal Suenens) and German head of practical theology at University of Heidelberg. Further church authorisation through world as ITT v/p and wife host dinner party for us to pitch the Papal Nuncio, Archbishop Cardinale.

Internal: Income sources blossom to prayer tactics with part time and full time sec'y position, week's thesis typing, two basements painted, two gardens of weeds to go at \$17 hour for crew of five. Good use for old Ecclesiola study books as Paul Schrijnen's parents ask us to mail gift of used Segundo to his uncle, the new Dutch ambassador to Vatican.

Contradiction: Remembering that rain every day, leaky bathroom pipe, lack of focus, and postponed RS-I are not contradictions. (WK 2)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: AMSTERDAM

External: Speaking engagement/mini-consult with Anglican Church in Utrecht opens door to ecumenical work there, and adds to our economic enablement with gift of \$50 U.S.

Internal: House ready to expand as long-awaited walls built and formulation brochure created.

Contradiction: Discerning pressure point that allows others to risk selves and say 'yes' without waiting for approval of hierarchies (which we have been told Dutch churchmen disdain.) (Wk.2)

FRANKFURT

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: FRANKFURT

External: New grounds broken as whole House impacted with trip through the DDR to Berlin, and upstairs neighbors (travel agent with Yugoslavian Airlines and local artist) spend evening with House.

Internal: Order in Area Frankfurt meets for three days of Indicative Battleplanning in Berlin. Week II a great demonstration of corporateness and produces system of procedures that all sensed they could pour their lives into.

Contradiction: Drawing on same Metro colleagues for all events coming up in our fullest quarter to date. (Wk.2)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BERLIN

External: Two local church colleagues say a 'yes' to Summer 75, Chicago. Black Chaplain, RSI grad, requests consultations on contemporary social problems for army.

Internal: Preparation for Easter begins with a complete celebration of the Passover Meal done by local American Lutheran clergy on Maundy Thursday.

Contradiction: Doing planning that allows all miracles to be dealt with when every one appears to be first priority. (WK. 13)

NAIROBI

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: NAIROBI

External: Last minute registrations for Qtr.IV Week I PLC push numbers beyond number facility can take as we expect 30 people around table, all recruited by colleagues. Registrar of University of Nairobi says Yes to LENS for University staff.

Internal: Internal planning for Quarter IV done. Cliff Stocking's parents arrive for visit.

Contradiction: Finding key that will release people to participate in further training whenever they think that recruiting courses WE teach is enough. (Wk.I)

BOMBAY

GLOBAL CENTRUM: BOMBAY

External: Planners Association of Srilanka invites proposals for minimum of six LENS courses for all tea plantation owners. I.E. in Patna for Roman Catholic teachers.

Internal: Shinns arrive to complete Global Staff Assignments for GRA/ITI.

Contradiction: Maintaining ITI recruitment at full force, while holding GRA critical leadership presence relative to staffing. (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BOMBAY

External: Intensive researching for new GRA site and ITI site has brought us into close contact with many Orders and Schools.

Internal: Week of arrivals: GRA faculty arrives in Bombay: Hess from Chicago, Shinns from Oombulgurri, Tickners from Delhi, Dharmalingam from Hyderabad. Joyous welcome to Clements family in time for Easter celebrations.

Contradiction: Changing 40 yeses to 16 paid for ITI in order to keep to our timeline while radically intensifying Area Development tactics. (Wk.2)

MADRAS

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: HYDERABAD

External: In-kind development begins to break open in Hyderabad for ITI, particularly with Jaycees offering to gather many of required items.

Internal: New intern family, Harry and Theresa Anthic and their four children, moves into House with garlanding ceremony at House Church. Week of intensive Mission and celebration.

Contradiction: Utilizing our limited (but ever-expanding) troops to gain. Maximum effect as last round-up for Global Research Assembly begins. (WK. 1)

CALCUTTA

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: CALCUTTA

External: ITI Calcutta miracles occur as CNI Bishop nods, we obtain Bishop's Theological College (CNI) for ITI and three teams of circuit riders disperse to two areas of the continent.

Internal: J.P. Narayan speaks in university hall on bottom floor of Urban Ashram and House witnesses riots from the roof.

Contradiction: How to change our story to result in tactical visits to result in Calcutta city registrations for ITI in face of fact that most registrations are from outside city. (Wk.2)

SINGAPORE

GLOBAL CENTRUM: SINGAPORE

External: During Week I of Week I an Imaginal Education course is taught with 50 teachers in Malaysia through the Malaysian Teachers for Social Action; held at Cameron Highlands and through the sponsorship of Roman Catholics.

Internal: TheShinns in transit to Bombay: Global Research Assembly give an enlightening report of the future of demonstration among Aborigines in Australia.

Contradiction: In the volley ball game of the 20 programs the challenge is to provide such a backup system that the ball never touches the floor: six LENS courses, two taught simultaneously on two different weekends--guess where the miracle is. (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SINGAPORE

External: Colleagues address New Town Guild and lead a workshop on planning for the school. Chen I An (Taiwanese) attends memorial service for Chiang Kai Shek.

Internal: Mailings for LENS, CSI and quarter calendar get out inspite of all hands gone for school holidays (E.G.), I.E. courses, and soybean planting.

Contradiction: Building cultivation model for 80 new grads in last two weeks. (Wk.2)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: JAKARTA

External: LENS calling continues with four authorization meetings, including dinner at House with Seoul grad; Quarter IV planning focuses our thrust on LENS, GRA, ITI, Metro meetings, RSI, and Manado House preparation--all miracles due this quarter.

External: Sent Rafos on Centrum trek to Seoul to cover Area Tokyo APC. Began Hong Kong development calling with regional colleague Wong Pak-Yeung-first in series of calls using colleagues. First centrum miracle (20 program coordination) happened with Week II PSU/ Task Force completing House/ Centrum working charts and GRA/ITI accountability.

Internal: Shifted, altered, created new space that freed up two more offices for our Bi-centrum working areas. Five song conversations on Week II prepared us for spirit life in PCE as well as training us for trek consults. Two House Church guests: Rev. Lalsawma (United Theological College, Bangalore, India), Peter Stayn (South African now working in H.K.).

Contradiction: How in midst of implementing tactics do we both increase momentum and continue catalyzing corporate power. (WK 2)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: HONG KONG

External: Jesse Clements tells story of Majuro and Town Meeting to colleagues and opens door to signal gifts from key businesses.

Internal House does battleplanning on Week II while holding ourselves conscious to 'Good Friday' by readings and meditations on 'Imitation of Christ.'

Contradiction: Gearing on recruitment to major events while creating the regional structures necessary for post course engagement. (Wk. 13)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: KAOHSIUNG

External: City impacted by round of secular celebrations centered in our Parish as Mayor proclaims this 'Life-Line Week'.

Internal: Planning for internal undergirding of the missional demands of Quarter IV. House discontinuity.

Contradiction: Dealing with 'end of Quarter syndrome.' (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: MANILA

External: One day trip to Baguio Metro by youngest member of House nets two ITI and one GRA recruit and salvages RSI for end of quarter. Five major organizations in Manila send out LENS mailings. Some businessmen receive four different ones.

Internal: Quarter IV battleplanning goes far on Fall of Bataan Day. Paul Worthington visits for House Church, from Washington, D.C., while here on USAID assignment for the week. Four House members attend birthday party for Msgr. Justino Ortiz. Contradiction: With heavy program schedule focusing us on certain particulars, necessity of adequate battleplanning to risk the comprehensive. (Wk.2)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: TAIPEI

External: Representing LENS at management association dinner, results in possibility of LENS being used as management training too! Region celebrates by journeying up mountain to Lovers' Temple for picnic and activities. Local pastor to be sent to GRA by congregation.

Internal: House completes internal planning to launch Quarter IV. School Spring vacation enables extended discontinuity allowing families to experience breadth and depth of Taiwan.

Contradiction: Pulling threads of Quarter together to get focus on Primal Community Experiment. (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: CEBU

External: Swirl of external events both recontext and reground the House and Region for the next two Quarters' work. Minischool closing exercises with about 100 LENS (community) site and brochure completed, national strategy session with Davao and Manila regions; held in Cebu House and LENS grad celebration at Dolphin Island Resort of Dr. Mancao, recent grad for grads and families, 100 plus people.

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: CEBU (cont.)

Contradiction: Need to mesh all indicatives into one common thrust. (Wk.I)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: TOKYO

External: Incredible week of collegial hosting as Paul and Gerry Evans host Dr. and Mrs. Preston Bradley at famous Japanese restaurant; ITI sponsor Victor Ordonez delivers Manila ITI brochures and regional colleagues engage in radical tactics to prepare new Religious House.

Internal: Concretion of tactical thinking dramatized in 'Great Box Hunt' which finds House learning special Japanese to get Inkind boxes and colleague Okochi delivers 50.

Contradiction: How to focus and maximize energies in relation to discontinuous Permeation schedules. (Wk.II)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: SEOUL

External: Luncheon is held for Mr. Hyun Suk Ho, chairman, Institute of Catholic Catechism, to send him on his global trip to Rome, Europe and North America. Met with Mr. Choi Kye Yong, executive director of Korea Capital Corporation. Week II Indicative Battleplanning plans for global eduction network in Korea.

Internal: The House celebrates Christopher Edward Work's 100th day. A full House dinner with Dr. Park Young Nae symbolizes the receiving of a gift of a new program center.

Contradiction: As we move into Quarter IV with battle planning and tactics complete, still have job of creating Regional operations schedule. (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: FUKUOKA

External: With in-kind use of two vans and assistance of six English language students, House picks up and moves in three hours flat to 16 room furnished Taisho Era (1912-25) mansion, three minutes walk from downtown Fukuoka and located dead center in parish.

External: House and Region join Galaxy pastor for dinner-dance at PCE setting. Detroit Bicentennial gives nod to TM 76 and Kiwanis group on West side of State considers sponsoring TM.

Internal: House embarks on quarter which we have entitled a 'quarter of 'wild experimentation.' With kitchen painted revolutionary green and worship area shifted, mood of anticipation rises: what next?

Contradiction: How to discern depths while dealing with immediacies. (Wk.2)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: CLEVELAND

External: Breakthru into local foundation funding for ICA and TM 76 catalyzed by Chicago development team. Running into limits of sporadic recruiting for LENS grounds necessity to move toward sponsorship of LENS by already present city network of agencies and foundations.

Internal: Visit to House by Malachi Martin occasions meaningful dialogue on spirit of church around the globe. His reflection: 'I didn't know a group like this (Order) existed.' Our reflection: 'How can spirit wisdom of church be used to launch next stage of revolution.'

Contradiction: How to say 'yes' to a time design that 'takes away all excuses for a life to be lived as dead'. (WK. 2)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: NEW YORK

External: In the swirl of excitement of RM training in Philadelphia, two Roman Catholic colleagues from Japan assist in recruiting LENS soliciting new authorization in the Roman Catholic church.

Internal: New passion for Academy recruitment is occasion in House Collegium.

Contradiction: How to avoid allowing measurable success in 20 programs to blur the vision of what kind of ongoing care is equally required by this local situation. (WK. 12)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: PITTSBURGH

External: Regional leadership gathers for Praesidium, and we find task forces formed at Regional Council still working. Decision made for first time in Region's history to pick up on financial support of regional program.

Internal: House invitation to attend memorabilia program honoring Mary Cardwell Dawson, founder of National Negro Opera Company, and sister of Guildsman Harold Cardwell. Four-hour program impacts us with black talent and potential authorization. Wall decor comes down as we decide to symbolize to ourselves our concrete decision to help sell house and move to Parish.

Contradiction: Enabling colleagues to see that Symbolic Order decision is not loss of freedom. (Wk.2)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: ROCHESTER

External: Albany Town Meeting Demonstration firmly sponsored by five service clubs thus far, with more considering. Flag Day, June 15th. will be The Day. Albany Metro Cadre flying high as they get endorsement from Inter-Faith group for Schenectady TM 76 in the Fall.

Internal: New quarter begun with ICA office space created, new RSI and LENS brochures created, sojourners' rooms readied, books purchased.

Contradiction: How deal generally with overall regional model of each Bi-Metros' Battleplan to pull off all penetration and demonstration events without jeopardizing common tactics. (WK. 2)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: RICHMOND

External: May 31 Town Meeting at State Farm of Virginia, gains momentum as staff steering committee expands from 5 to 10, and as a group of 25 inmates, who are sensitive and responsive, unanimously accepts sponsorship.

Internal: Global Prayer Room finally completed and already a new spirit is sensed by all troops. Bob and Pat Hawley from Minneapolis, colleagues and parents of Bob Hawley from Richmond House arrive for House Church and one-week visit.

Contradiction: Discerning key initiative step into our Parish. (WK 2)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: WASHINGTON

External: Civic Assoc'ns with the 8 political wards of the city represented met at training center and consented to sponsor 8 TMs. in late May and early June, at first Metro-wide steering committee meeting. New U Community clean-up day draws 50 community workers and three pieces of heavy equipment from city and director of Environment Services. LENS grad calls on Councilman and Executive Director of Trade. Images himself as consultant to ICA. Community LENS with 35.

Internal: Sent key inter-city workers and leaders to L.A. ITI, and intern to Academy. Hope arriveth with mother Elicabeth Ann Sheldon and sister Jill as sojourns. Messrs Green and Dexter miracelizing meeting space of House. Brussels seminar room turned into T/M war room. Enjoy great Indian Feast.

Contradiction: Creating new castle while locked in 'kamode' of the old. (WK. 2)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BALTIMORE

External: Meeting with Bishop Mathews brings out possibility for more local church participation in T.M. with 12 organizations, three churches, 1 Sisters of St. Joseph at Locust Point brings \$10 and five people commitment from each.

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BALTIMORE (cont.)

Internal: Ecclesiola begins with five guests. Jo Riley gets charge of kitchen and immediately transforms it and renders deed to history.

Contradiction: Parish alive with so many possibilities (a church wants to know if their Bicentennial committee can work with Human Resurgence Mission committee) that we don't know which basket has eggs we need. (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: PHILADELPHIA

External: Week of making preliminary advocacy calls for TM 76 shows possibility of building public momentum as everyone says yes.

Internal: 'Planning on your feet' dynamic refocused with Week II. House planning session re-locates feet and direction they are headed.

Contradiction: How do you do follow up on 'The Masses' who will go through events this quarter. (WK. 2)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: NEWARK

External: The miraculous in midst of the mundane as community and city services engage with Movement colleagues in transforming junky four lots surrounding Newark House into first Parish miracle, while Phase 4 Italian immigrant couple serve zapoles to total community during workday.

Internal: In midst of fantastic Open House, where old Movement colleagues have reunion with new colleagues from Parish workday, blow our secular image when Episcopal colleague in full vestment blesses entire House, room by room, with holy water and incense, as children and community delight in transformation of dilapidated old mansion and grounds into community symbol of possibility in midst of ethnic diversity.

Contradiction: After weekend of miracles, community and Movement colleagues asking, 'What do we do next?', while we are saying, 'Wait till we finish our battleplanning.' (Wk.1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BROOKLYN

External: Metro Council engages in PSU to create 13-week miracle chart for Quarter IV. Work solidifies decisions of key colleagues to be under assignment for Quarter.

Internal: First Ecclesiola of Quarter draws colleagues from all across the Bi-Metro to celebrate decision to intensify engagement. The New Castle lives up to all expectations and pushes social implications of the Other World.

Contradiction: Finding key to unlock Week I time design to hold us and Metro colleagues constantly before our decision, and to accomplish the mission. (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: HARTFORD

External: Recruiting for RSI, PLC, LENS, TM 76; first meeting with potential sponsoring group: Enfield, Lions. For TM 76; three black churchmen to New York City LENS; two to guardians, authorization by priest and parish council meet to discuss RSI.

Internal: Ecclesiola 'new Castle study' key event of week. Urban House fleet (cars) readied by repair and cleaning. South 40 cleaned backyard; most of the House suffered from flu for at least 24 hours, Metro colleagues come through.

Contradiction: Developing metro core strength to enable overwhelming task before us to come off. (WK 2)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: MANCHESTER

External: Week of advocacy as Town Meeting 76 is presented to Optimists Club, and Manchester Clergy Association says, yes to an all Manchester Pentecost Human Resurgence Mission. After looking over 20 programs, new guilders says, 'I've learned more in one night than in a whole year of Sociology classes!'

Internal: Five guests from one Galaxy Church come to House Church; Week II spent in indicative battleplanning and culminating with all new quarter assignments for teams and House internal structuring.

Contradiction: Thinking you can make life secure by creating 'perfect' structures and models.

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BOSTON

External: Primal Community Consult grounds vision of Tri-Metro as well as focuses and concretizes our doing for next 4 years. Lawrence Clergy Luncheon receives Rt. Rev. Michael Hakim, Superior General Visilian Salvatorian Order, Lebanon, and hears witness from host pastor who says, 'We're doing so well because of my training with the Ecumenical Institute.'

Internal: Chinese Ur celebrated at Ecclesiola as House and guests are impacted with the on target fortune cookies. In-kind received 12 dozen eggs.

Contradiction: Find we are strong on obedience, but struggle with poverty and chastity. (WK. 2)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: MONTREAL

External: Journey on new colleagues is intensified as parish core takes in new parish colleagues; colleague conducts two-day workshop with Mental Retardation Association using indicative battleplanning methodology, Metro Cadre member, Carolyn Chung sent out to Academy.

Internal: Week III (3:00a.m.-9:00a.m.-Sunday) rediscovered which provides longest period of uninterrupted corporate brooding and planning time ever experienced during the whole year thus far.

Contradiction: Long-range plan obscures quarterly rhythm and tends to produce week-by-week planning. (WK. 1)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: TORONTO

External: Focus on Guild formation calls into being Parish Cadre. Guardians journey to Chicago, Guardians Meeting and appointments made with key advocacy prospects in preparation for Gideon Blitz.

Internal: Journey on, journey on, was refrain of 'Odyssey' when area literally stormed Toronto, soaked up Kleinburg Art Centre where Group of Seven's art is exhibited, penetrated 'The Pilgrim' and sent Alan Herbert to hospital for a successful operation. Highlight of Odyssey was colleague's House Church witness, a depth charge.

Contradiction: After anticipated chaos is ordered, we can move strategically and cover all bases. (WK 2)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: CARACAS

External: Caribbean retreat (PLC with evening Ecclesiola and closing with Odyssey) held with 60 Carmelite Sisters around the table. ITI grad who is the Mother Superior enables in the kitchen so that superior of the local convent can attend. LENS with 27 around the table including three from governors office and several corporation presidents; a resounding success.

Internal: Finished Internal Life Manual; pedagogy on God lecture deep address to the cadre. First prior flies in for LENS course from Trinidad and is sent back out for St. Martin PLC.

Contradiction: Not letting high priority items (like House relocation) fall through the cracks as we deal with other high priority items. (WK. 2)

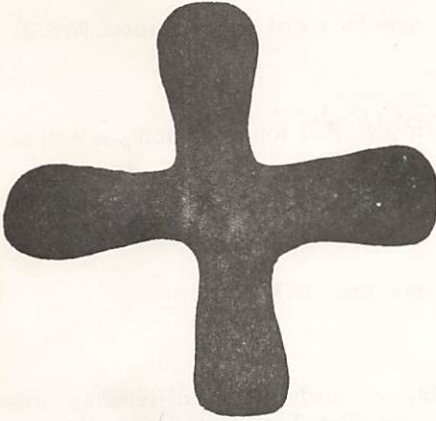

External: Five-session Community Reformulation Workshop begins with bang for 30 Joydanhill College students gridding and problemmatting, House works through 26-week timeline, shares meals with five different regional families and celebrates two regional colleagues decisions to teach outside Scotland.

Contradiction: Next step in responsibility for Movement regional colleagues beyond course recruitment. (WK. 3)

BOMBAY

GLOBAL CENTRUM: BOMBAY

External: GRA begun in Hyderabad and participants impacted by SMS as first week ends.

Internal: GRA participates in send-out of Jenkins family to Hong Kong. Numbers reduced to 3 at Centrum location. Experience motivation as Shinn reports on Oombulgurri.

Contradiction: Establishing a firm legal base. (Wk. 3)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BOMBAY

External: A Centrum trek in Manila, in Kaohsiung, and in Seoul where Tokyo Area held its APC and decided on ITI in Seoul for Quarter I. Sixteen ITI:HK applications arrive. Centrum holds collegium with H.K. House to create model for HRM.

Contradiction: Transforming LENS, ITI, GRA interest into paid registrations. (WK 3)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: CEBU

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: GREEN BAY

External: RSI with 36 around table.

Internal: Visit by newly elected Mayor, Mike Monfils; secure his support for TM, set up ICA office, including new in-kind furniture.

Contradiction: : Trust the next month establishing thrust for TM that comes from years of being around Town. (WK. 3)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: MILWAUKEE

External: Primal Community consult hits us in 'jaw' of our new focus as we experience explosion of Local Church Consults, recruitment, and Summer registrations from different polises.

Internal: Ecclesiola with six guests from a Unitarian study group and four Guardians proves the method can work on anyone and can be done by anyone.

Contradiction: The Story that allows colleagues to be free to thrust the corporate structures and methods. (WK. 3)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: INDIANAPOLIS

External: Lord winks at us as neighborhood association agrees to sponsor TM in parish school of former Galaxy church in PCE.

Internal: Circus celebration reminds us of our passingawayness and contingency, individually and as group; as Orth family is sent out after sojourning and Jack Bayer sojourns for five weeks.

Contradiction: Shifting internal troops and images of promises in present economic up-against-ness. (WK. 3)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: CINCINNATI

External: Three parish PLC grads say 'Yes' to LENS.

Internal: Proposal written to enable two additional jobs in parish.

Contradiction: Holding missional decision as that which is enabling to individuals. (WK.3)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: DETROIT

External: Experience Primal Community Consult as wedding of gridding and battleplanning as next four years in Detroit Region begins to be art-formed.

Internal: Visitors from Michigan State University demonstrate to us gift we are as community by picking up enablement assignments after less than 24 hours of being House guests.

Contradiction: How to be 'in but not of' all the events demanding our time and expenditure. (WK. 3)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: CLEVELAND

External: Intensification of local expenditure through permeation assignments and parish work, mysteriously is linked to global. Cleveland Foundation visits 5th City in considering TM funding; two days after deciding to reschedule LENS, we break through contact with powerful social agency network; contact for Majuro housing opens door to selling former religious house.

Internal: Decision name House teams after five stakes of University Circle and assign them there frees up more time than we thought possible for parish. Bishop Joshi brings Global network home in new way as he shows up for Daily Office and tells us of need for indigenous priorship in India and everywhere.

Contradiction: Our lucidity concerning Parish enables us to see clearly that we 'don't know what we're doing.' What we see far less clearly is that only the doing itself will reveal that which we need to know. (WK. 3)

NEW YORK**RELIGIOUS HOUSE: NEW YORK**

External: Committee of 18 holds Town Meeting 76 PSU which focused on concrete task of local advocacy and sponsorship for the city of New York.

Internal: Town Meeting 76 manual, created by the PSU, lays out the specifics that allowed the whole House to get a hold of the excitement and single thrust of Town Meeting.

Contradiction: Getting ahold of short courses and spirit contexts that allow us to pace spirit breakloose and tie us together in one thrust. (Wk. 3)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: PITTSBURGH

External: Week of meetings impacts House from revival to PLC clergy luncheons, with key happening of Sunday School teacher's consult seen as possible group RSI recruitment tactic, as well as possibility of task force dynamic happening in the church.

Internal: House search in Parish while colleagues experience House embodying new intentionality.

Contradiction: Decision to live out of 'If's' rather than 'When,' in relation to course recruitment. (WK. 3)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: ROCHESTER

External: Albany TM sponsors decide to take full responsibility for TM in only three meeting sessions.

Internal: House grounded longrange vision over against immediate task.

Contradiction: In midst of pulling back from such structures as Metro Cadre, we experience necessity to create strategies to deal with untouched territories in region. (WK. 3)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: RICHMOND

External: Week of turn to TM 76 as House and Metro Cadre plan and restructure for 20 TMs and Galaxy agrees to make TM center of their Movemental activity.

Internal: Cabaret evening of internal battleplanning, punctuated by ice cream, launches us internally for quarter after external planning is done. Wayside Inn reward as Hawleys from Minneapolis share their witness and wisdom throughout week.

Contradiction: Using vacuum created by the re-assignment of House personnel to draw forth priorship from Metro colleagues. (WK. 3)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: WASHINGTON

External: Four steering committees on road making concrete plans, as Metro Cadre core resolves to do eight TMs, and in-kind machinery burps out 1200 dill pickles, 9,000 toothpicks from Tico Taco, 9,000 Red, White, and Blue napkins, and 9,000 match books!

Internal: Cramers, Sr., grace House with presence and incredible roast beef 'down home' feast! Portales, New Mexico colleague, Delores Penrod is sign of disciplined extended Order, and E'G' start victory garden!

Contradiction: How to dub eight indigenous gurus who will transform urban chaos into eight great TM happenings. (WK. 3)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BALTIMORE

External: Town Meeting article in Baltimore Sun; in local South Baltimore paper, the Enterprise Town Meeting took place of 'Birch Log' from John Birch Society.

Internal: Odyssey. Carlos Betonte promoted to higher class in school. Three clerics, one priest at House Church. (What a waste of celebrants).

Contradiction: How to resolve question of what to do after TM. (WK. 3)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: PHILADELPHIA

External: Vineland and Atlantic City, New Jersey's newspapers carry front story article titled: 'Town Meeting tto Launch Bicentennial Here.'

Internal: Re-gearing House for PLC produces PLC Cabaret during Ecclesiola interlude.

Contradiction: More meal-time hours need to be put into model-building time. (WK. 3)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: NEWARK

External: In the arena of TM '76: procuring and setting up a display in large department store window on Main Street of downtown East Orange; the date shift to two weeks later reflects decision of local committee to create a steering committee to get the work done rather than do it ourselves; received benefits of having had three to Guardians Consults;

Internal: Old colleagues and non-grads join in making Ecclesiola an exciting event. Week II, Saturday night celebration after only four adults worked on Indicative Battleplanning all day, turns up 12 from red Ur, lots of dancing, whooping Indians.

Contradiction: Recover sense of movement while going so fast it seems we're standing still, or how see and sense the visible signs and miracles rather than 'Ho-humming' them. (WK. 3)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BROOKLYN

External: TM '76 PSU creates battleplans, realizes immediate results: advocacy from New York state Assemblymen, and Southhold Township Bicentennial Committee endorses TM '76, agrees to help find local sponsors for first one.

Internal: At House Church, 17 Metro colleagues formally covenant themselves as Metro Cadre to be mission and to be responsible to God for world.

Contradiction: In midst of intensification of local engagement, we must find new ways of holding before ourselves global context, guarding against 'paralyzing parochialism.' (WK. 3)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: HARTFORD

External: Luncheon held Friday with 12 church and community leaders deciding to begin PCE training. Great reports by three men who attend Clergy LENS in NYC. Spanish leaders in New Haven excited by LENS pitch.

Internal: 23 guests at House Church. E.G. Development brings in \$8.00 on one candle after exciting pitch by five-year-old at House Church. David King, Director of Center City Churches is guest speaker at Friday morning collegium as old friend of Christian Faith and Life Community. Welcome one-week sojourner, Dr. James Stewart, Human Resources Planner for State Dept. of Finance and Control.

Contradiction: How to elicit decisions from clergy to say 'Yes' to PLC when many have given up on church and community. (WK. 3)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: MANCHESTER

External: Guild begins indicative battleplanning for Parish; visual image of Bi-Metro Grid and PCE impact over next four years rocks Metro Cadre at Week II Consult.

Internal: Internal reordering impacts House as new teams named after Saints (Zorba, St. Francis, Don Juan) for sophisticated style and demonstrate power of structural care. Guild member, Lorraine Pillotte, attends PCC and revitalizes whole consult with fresh images.

Contradiction: Maintaining comprehensive and getting everything done at same time. (WK. 3)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: BOSTON

External: Strategic group presentations break loose future of church and world as first South End TM '76 steering committee dares the future by picking May 31 for New England demonstration. Episcopal clergy of Rhode Island decide to pay for and sponsor PLC first week of June. Through Bishop Belden, meeting with Congress of 39 communities in Rhode Island creates ground work for 39 TM's in fall and Fall River Council of Churches strategize training through RSI, PLC.

Internal: Creation of New Boston ICA office in space that didn't exist, and designing invisible enablement allows us to put form to 'Castle' that is really for executive director as well as last fat lady.

Contradiction: Seeing that in order to be on target as catalyzers of course, we allow longer lead time to give local churchmen participation impetus following carefully planned time-lining for TM '76. (WK. 3)

MONTREAL

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: MONTREAL

External: Journey on new colleagues is intensified as parish core takes in new parish colleagues; colleague conducts two-day workshop with Mental Retardation Association using indicative battleplanning methodology, Metro Cadre member, Carolyn Chung sent out to the Academy.

Internal: Chinese Ur celebrated at Ecclesiola as House and guests are impacted with the on target fortune cookies. In-kind received 12 dozen eggs.

Contradiction: Find we are strong on obedience, but struggle with poverty and chastity. (Wk. 2)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: TORONTO

External: National Team visits key Political, Economic and Cultural figures for Toronto CFC Advocacy. Toronto CFC sponsored by high rise residents and Task Force Forms.

Internal: ICA office creation symbolized by giving of keys to Metro Cadre.

Contradiction: Empowering CFC ripple and local leadership to create an interrelated push. (Wk. 3)

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: OTTAWA

External: Visiting and visitors were highlights as Seaway Galaxy Youth tour Ottawa, experiencing local, national and international dimensions of this great city and colleague sees Dr. McLeod, director of training for government staff, and is assured of support and interest in French and English LENS.

Internal: Journey on, journey on, was reaffirmation of 'Odyssey' when area literally stormed Toronto, soaked up Kleinburg Art Centre where Group of Seven's art is exhibited, penetrated 'The Pilgrim' and sent Alan Herbert to hospital for a successful operation. Highlight of Odyssey was colleague's House Church witness a deep charge.

Contradiction: After anticipated chaos is ordered, we can move strategically and cover all bases. (Wk.2)

CARACAS

RELIGIOUS HOUSE: CARACAS

External: St. Martins PLC Battle-planning session with Biennial Anglican Council in Venezuela. Breakopen new territory in Caribbean and continent. RSI mailing results in two registrations two days after mailing.

Internal: Pedagogy edge of internal life as House builds 4-level charts and lesson plans for Bultman. Clancy and Maryanne Mann at House Church---bringing globe to table.

Contradiction: After several signal courses, how to make sure the formulation gets done. (WK. 3)

Hong Kong; Manila and Cebu trek submits first proposal to IBM. Hong Kong calls produce invitations to submit proposals. Visits yield data on companies' budget year and time to submit proposals for 1976. Singapore mailing of course pitch to teachers ready to go. First monies from pledge and seasonal mailings received and Donnelly sends word of first corporation money in Australia. Two proposals submitted and Quarter IV circuits begin in Area Sydney. Luncheon held in Parish with Guardian net, immediate dollars and commitments for more. Series of temporary assignments to Centrum signals intensified push, and Brussels finance report completed through corporate work session. Charts developed to hold us before 22 week development push and funding march breaks loose fresh strategy and objectifies progress. Immediate cash vacuum as GRA begins and excellent proposals are still pending. Chicago computer blitz gets program for 1973-74 gifts over \$1,000. Computer program completed in one day for auditors and development \$200,000 May push. Pre-Summer push with circuits traveling to Oklahoma, Fargo and Chicago. The contradiction is keeping the pressure on Corporations and Foundations in the midst of push for immediate funds.

Chicago celebrates the first 2,000 CFC participant manuals printed and collated. An improved printing facility is secured and installed at the Singapore Nexus. Bombay reports last minute arrival of GRA materials through customs and forwarded in one day. Brussels uses a corporate work session to complete the six month financial report. Bombay experiences trends in complexity of financial arena. Twenty-six LENS calls are made in Kuala Lumpur as time line for Singapore LENS functions well. Guardians visit with Mr. Choi and Mr. Cooledge in Seoul. Hong Kong also reports seeing the need and possible means for becoming a legal, reputable organization in Area Tokyo; two working visas are received one for 6 months and the other for one year. Chicago uses corporate mind and experiences breakthrough with decision to meet fire safety standards and building code on resident floors for whole NExus. Bombay housing involves meshing four agencies timelines in order to resolve questions for permanent facility procurement. Contradiction: To grasping vision of comprehensive, urgent role in the midst of continuing to handle particular tasks.

Miracles and Significant Events for the GRA/ITI show up around the Band. Hong Kong co-ordinated back-up system comes into operation enabling visa letters to be written and returned in 24 hours after receiving first 16 registrations. GRA on the sub-continent is relocated to Hyderabad. Breakthrough made in getting all 13 staff on the same train with one day ticketing from Bombay. Singapore reports ITI site confirmed at the Methodist camp: Port Dickson and sends recommendations for faculty assignments. Brussels decides to keep basic format for ITI brochure for the 3rd. year running demonstrating the building of a program rather than a one time event. First co-ordination of courses between nations this quarter with increased use of the Telex in Hong Kong highlights communication network effectivity. System of rapid distribution of materials in Singapore and updated teaching assignments mailed out. Chicago Week II task forces re-think Fall projections and a Summer brochure and prepares Warboard for Summer 75. PLC recruitment taught in Nairobi, Kisumu and St. Martins in Carribean. RSIs in Anchorage, Wausau, Cleveland, and a Clergy LENS in New York for 32. The contradiction is maintaining flexibility and being a cohesive thrust in the midst of practical engagement.

Bombay is discovering new troops in the community even as GRA commences. Brussels study plans done for Ecclesiola as part of Global net. Field visits and Consults begin to firm up for the Quarter. Hong Kong met with principal of International School of Sacred Heart and Principal of 4 Korean Schools in Seoul to plan Social Demonstration Project based on educational 'galaxy' concept. Held collegium with Hong Kong House on Human Resurgence Mission and plan to use the HRM as means of involving regional colleagues and catalyzing clergy collegiums. Singapore prepared timeline for Quarter IV during Week 11 while Week 1 include PSU schedule for the refining of Imaginal Education Course, Research Centrum Handbook, the Philosophy of education transparentization of religion, and Asian style lab. Revised daytime schedule for ITI is taking form with three sessions a day, tea and bath break and a late dinner. Singapore quarter report amiled and Imaginal Education follow-up mailed out for last two IE Consults; the Chinese stories are illuminating the Sino life style. Primal Community Consults were held in Anchorage, Winnipeg, Chicago and Brooklyn. The contradiction is keeping practices ahead of the events.
