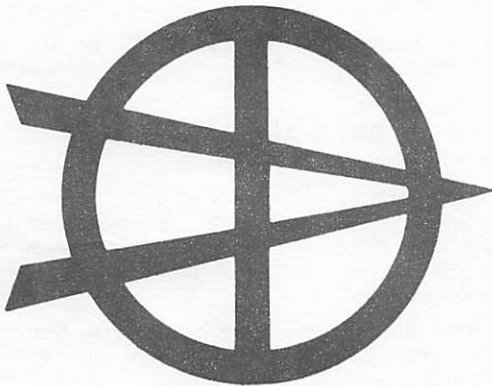

AREA MADRID

THE MADRID HOUSE

External: Fundacion Mexicana is very pleased with our collaboration with them in State of Queretaro and decides to set up a visit with their rural projects in Michoacan. Time-Life Co. is still excited over their two LENSES and begin to contact other companies about future LENS. House continues to visit airlines to obtain free or reduced ticketing for delegates to IERD (4). Two circuits in one week accomplish one Project Description Lab initiation and a visit to the Soria-Zarogosa human development cadres. The latter reveals a full scale cooperative sewing industry in Santa Maria de Huerta, and catalyzes new action on the youth organisation in Arcos de Jalon. Visit to ICA president Fr. Garcia interests him in funding Year of Order Council (2).

Internal: The House has week of honoring the life and death of Araceli Mathews with a 24 hour vigil and community mass. House spends Week II creating three month sojourn plan and Barbara is sent out to Caracas Council (4). Spanish classes begin and house decor receives needed attention as the 54 areas are lettered in Spanish for the collegium room (2).

Contradiction: Insuring ongoing care for the future of the Order in the midst of carrying out the immediate particular everpresent demands. Finding the most effective strategy to beckon Mexican Sojourners. (Weeks 2,4)*

LISBON—THE LAMEGO HOUSE

External: First week in new teams produces a series of victories in the cluster villages; strawberries are delivered to eight new families on the agro-business demonstration, Roundtable in Mezio, implementation meeting in Bigorne, a site visit from Purdue professors on assignment in Portugal, and a joyous reunion with Father Lemos, returned Academy grad. Maconde money (2,000USD) comes in.

Internal: Christine's parents arrive to await the family's first grandchild just as the bathroom is completed. House welcomes David Heslop, British volunteer, for three-month stay, who charms villages with slides of Brazil.

Contradiction: Finishing the endless construction to release troops to meet demands of the Montemuro cluster. (Week 3)*

AREA LONDON

THE LONDON HOUSE

External: Two final PDLs are completed as House holds open evening. NSC makes final delegate selection and are excited by presentation by three very talented graphics and design people who will prepare U.K. exhibits. Volunteers report on their attendance to rally in London sponsored by the committee for nuclear disarmament.

Internal: Two English volunteers express desire for interning, Sally Ann Bailey leaves for Jamaica as volunteer and sojourners brighten coming weeks' evenings with inkind theatre tickets.

Contradiction: Present and new clarity presses for additional and thoughtful strategy and implementation for rest of quarter. (Week 3)*

AREA PARIS

THE PARIS HOUSE

External: House's documentation and funding thrusts are fortified with capability of Robert Leurs to operate in French through setting and keeping appointments and in doing translations, e.g. contact made with Rotary and Lions Clubs, researching and visiting Natural Parks and Rural Centres and International Civil Service re possible projects. Students of North-South Association of Management Institute is committed to work as volunteers. Three or four possible delegations to IERD meet together to plan Exposition displays and expose possibility of IERD coverage by French TV channel.

Internal: Order Forms collegium is enlivened by Robert Leurs and Julie Nicholson's kibbutz experience. Julie performs miracles on apartment windows with creation of new curtains.

Contradiction: Getting to sources for private funding of IERD. (Weeks 2,3,)*

THE FRANKFURT HOUSE

THE AMSTERDAM HOUSE

External: NSC meets and selects 10 possible projects then breaks into teams of two and three for visits. Four projects are visited the first week revealing hitherto unknown funding possibilities. Regional Council is held with 18 colleagues representing all aspects of the ICA work, creating strategies for the Volunteer Program, courses Roundtables, and IERD.

Internal: Three team members visit Brussels for IE pedagogy and development push. New post box, telephone and office are procured for the region. Geroen Genats has Kate over for lots of singing and schedules first planning session to begin implementing strategies from the Regional Council.

Contradiction: Discerning the clear and eventful steps after project selection that will involve the team and NSC in getting a group off to Delhi. (Weeks 1-3)*

AREA ROME

THE ROME HOUSE

External: A proposal is submitted to Maritese for funding for five Italian IERD delegates. Introductory meeting is held with the new Rector of St. Peter's College. Visits to Honeywell and Time-Life in Milan produce potential supporters. Video-tape showing is scheduled with Milan business community for mid-November (3). Community development research and documentation treks take teams to Naples, Florence and Milan. Visit is made to the San Egidio Community, a significant group committed to helping the poor in Rome (2).

Internal: Jon Jenkins is welcomed back from Brussels and his report is heard on the special development meeting. Preparations for Panchayat visit include the creation of two new rooms in the attic (3). House hosts dinner for three third world priests who have attended S.E.M.s. The Okusas attain visa extension. All rooms are filled with paying hostelry guests (2).

Contradiction: Pushing through self-support to turn toward the larger mission. Being mystified about how to get things done in Rome. (Weeks 2,3)*

AREA BUDAPEST

THE VIENNA HOUSE

External: Executive Committee of National Steering Committee meets to discuss funding sources. Letter is written to be mailed to companies for funding seeking to break open private sector support. Two training sessions for workshop leaders for the Symposium are held with Hannerl Golda.

Internal: Christel Otko is sent out after sojourning for three weeks.

Contradiction: Finding ways to use NSC member strength to advantage when meeting at one time and in one place seems impossible. (Week 1)

AREA CAIRO

GIZA — THE EL BAYAD HOUSE

External: Second draw for desert is in the bank from Canadian Embassy. Beni Suliman water management committee and community at large decide to work together on relocating water tank. Second week of HDTI concludes with personal evaluation and exams for each student.

Internal: Mr. Ibrahim Youssef, 33 years with Department of Social Affairs, spends weekend in Bayad and House participates in Order Day collegiums.

Contradiction: Staying one step ahead of HDTI participants and cash flow needs in order to maintain momentum. (Week)*

AREA ABIDJAN

THE ABIDJAN HOUSE

External: Evening at the Institute including a showing of the global film with Phillips Petroleum employees leads to monthly contributions of \$500, quarterly project work days and bi-weekly Roundtables.

Internal: New self-support venture is uncovered through English teaching contract possibility with international courier service.

Contradiction: Money development openings, but little time to write new proposals, blocks regularity of development income. (Week 2)*

AREA LAGOS

THE LAGOS HOUSE

AREA KINSHASA

THE LUSAKA HOUSE

External: NORAD is visited to complete a survey of all non-government agencies they fund. Mutendes Investments representative promises K1,000 after declaring "I'm a village man."

Internal: Fine House celebration with disco-music concluded a week of initial 4-year planning. Elaine arrives via Johannesburg. Staff attends funeral of elderly lady in Kapini.

Contradiction: Releasing operational equipment to host the Panchayat, travel to colleague evening out, travel to an inkind Quarter Celebration, and take staff member for doctor visit. (Week 2)*

AREA NAIROBI

THE NAIROBI HOUSE

External: The team kicks off two major staff training programmes (Advanced Training School (ATS) and Health School (HATS) with 50 people involved in both. Swedish Co-operative Centre mission participates in demonstration LENS in preparation to write grant design. House celebrates the completed life of Mgee Kabiro who graciously supported the Kabiro Project during the past four years.

Internal: New Quarter is truly launched as we spend week on internal designs at same time as we receive back Charles Lingo from 3-week IERD trip to Zimbabwe and Malawi

Contradiction: Having opened the gate three times discovering some things are not yet ready to run. (Week 2)*

NAIROBI—THE KABIRO HOUSE

NAIROBI-THE KALWANI-SHAMALAGO HOUSE

External: Week of Consult set-up includes section circuits to two new sites as well as Mundobelwa and Kaganda Houses. Kalwani House circuits home sub-location at Senende and sets Health Training in Ivora. Team speaks to officials and all headmen of a whole location on authorisation trip, spins on resurgence research in Kenya and receives great affirmation of replication scheme.

Internal: Panchayat visit links us up to our globality giving opportunity to renew our sense of being an experiment on behalf of the two million villages as well as new challenge of modifying Quarter II timeline so the intensification we've planned can be a victory!

Contradiction: Doing a full quarter's work in 10 weeks with little flexibility in numbers of staff and assuring time to refresh. (Week 2)

AREA BOMBAY

BOMBAY-THE MALIWADA HOUSE

External: Letter is submitted to Pachora for health training to cluster villagers. Eye camp invitations are given to cluster and propaganda with a loud speaker with Ghati hospital's free matadore: is done by medical college students of Aurangabad and ICA Collegues. A site visit gives an opportunity to start small industry by DIC.(3). Education guild visits Preschool in cluster villages to get all information in hand. Handloom society meeting is held in Asegaon and industry guild meeting is held in Maliwada. Cluster loan defaulters list is in hand (2).

Internal: Ashram colleagues write a letter to all other cluster ashrams at letter writing collegium to be interchange. Cluster actuation model collegium helps to start spacious work in cluster and because of this all bicycles are repaired (3). Ashram celebrates "Shamal's" first birthday. Imaginal Education Training, global ICA collegium, and leadership style conversation pushes images to be ready before time (2).

Contradiction: Pushing to victory story of possibility to make strong village vision of irrigation/industry and preschool. Changing weak visions and creating strong guilds strategy. (Weeks 2,3)*

BOMBAY-THE CHIKHALE HOUSE

External: House and cluster experience a week of activities including home science demonstration (22 village women and 12 students and lecturer from SNTD women's university); bank loan meeting to discuss loans for villagers below poverty line (Canara Bank mgrs., Block Dec. officer, village leaders and villagers, 30 in all) photo tableau by RCF Fertilizer Co. (villagers, ICA staff, bank Mgrs. and RCF rep.) in demonstration rice plot and two of the House Priors, Hiriman Kakone and Nancy Lanphear attend Area Meeting and PDL in Jawale.

Internal: Joining the move from "greasy plastic" the House manifests intentionality with Hindalium plates and cups. Mattresses for all and an iron to keep us looking neat and trim; holds celebration in honour of Khajagari festival; and participates in an internal Shramdan (workday) to do drainage ditches and walls of bathroom.

Contradiction: Looking at our past experience and deciding how to move with new strength in the cluster and block. (Week 3)*

BOMBAY-THE VAVIHARSH HOUSE

External: Tree plantation programme is completed. Three hundred people participate in Health Camp. Work on tap water scheme for Vaviharsh village is going very well. Cluster preschool proposal is submitted to CEO and Social Welfare officer Zilla Parishad. Carpenter Skill Training proposal is submitted to Panchayat Samiti-Igatpun. We got 1,500rs first aid medicine from district health officer for Vaviharsh village and cluster village. Work is going on cluster mahila assembly through mahila leader - Ramabai Ambekar Nusik.

Internal: Vaviharsh staff participate in Chikhale CSI cultural study. Pinto Babote's birthday is celebrated, 150 people participate from cluster village. Annual Appeal plan and materials are received.

Contradiction: (no contradiction or week submitted Week ?)*

PUNE-THE JAWALE HOUSE

External: Area Priors, Nagpur and Bombay Regional Priors meeting is held in Jawale for the ICA project documentation laboratory in preparation for the IERD. Forty Jawale village leaders met for a six year project journey workshop. After cluster site visit a report was written and a celebration held.

Internal: While all are gathered, an area meeting deals with issues and the creating of a Maharashtra village development brochure. A Jawale House meeting enables the creation of a countdown IERD prep timeline.

Contradiction: Holding deployment tension between continental PDL demands and local self-support and IERD prep demands. (Week 3)*

PUNE-THE MAALE HOUSE

PUNE-THE BUDHODA HOUSE

NAGPUR-THE SEVAGRAM HOUSE

External: Collector of Wardha district comes to community centre to inaugurate "Wine Shop Week" and celebrate Gandhi's 114th birthday. District Superintendent of Police distributes Rangoli and Kabadi prizes. Prohibition Department showed "Keewan" movie. Cluster preschool teachers gather for next plan. Youth module does Grand Shramadham and a cluster circuit and fixes date for economic module with D.R.D.A.

Internal: Hingamghatwala Shophupr who has given money for Maliwada VLC as did Surekha Thakker, a Mahrati movie actor visits the House.

Contradiction: How to engage all the shops when we don't have coming Quarter plan. (Week 13)

NAGPUR-THE TEMBHURWAHI HOUSE

External: Denada Societies distribution loan for 21 people in the cluster. We celebrated Gandhi's birthday on 2nd Oct. and visited Manohav Sapre (district member M.S.E.B.) and submitted proposal for Cluster Village Electricity.

Internal: New volunteer from England arrived in ashram. Mr. Chate, Police Sub-Inspector visits Ashram.

Contradiction: Circuit cluster people are busy in the field. How to engage them with 4-sector work all together. (Week 2)

NAGPUR-THE DABHAD HOUSE

External: Preschool shed is built in Jambron and Medhda holds shramdan and meeting with Gram Sevak. Managing Director of Village Bank in Pradhpur adopts six cluster villages.

Internal: Wood is obtained for Ashram repairs, S. Sawarkhed arrives from Sevagram and Prasad family is sent out on discontinuity. Marathi classes start.

Contradiction: Setting up Global Women's Forums without any educated women on the staff. (Week 12)

AREA DELHI

THE DELHI HOUSE

External: Annual Appeal is completed tripling last year's bottomline and the number of donors in the Area. Manoeuvring for Phase II of the Quarter accelerates cluster activities with formation of 5-village leadership structure, the exploration of site for training centre/ICA residence construction and a move on visible development signs. Intensive circuit across Area sets up six PDL events and four RDS's are scheduled for next month. Block Development Officer (BDO) visits House and assures full support while government finishes 3-village survey for flood water outlet system.

Internal: Kris Kuchera arrives as volunteer for six months. Battacharya children are enrolled in school with hostel. Self-support is off to good start with rupees 5,000 in hand for Bata Supervisors Course. Dinner out in Faridabad makes for great celebration of week's work.

Contradiction: After deciding PDL as number 1 priority for the next four weeks, launching critical cluster manoeuvres while PDL schedule is still unclear. (Week 1)*

AREA MADRAS

THE BANGALORE HOUSE

External: Eighty youth from 50 organizations form across Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka participate in three consecutive HD-I courses, taught in English, Tamil, Telegu and Kannada, under the sponsorship of Christian Children's Fund, for a fee of 5,750 rupees. Seven House staff and Kathy Rees from Nagpur participate rotationally in teaching it. Site visit in the course includes going down a gold mine. (courses were held at Lilar Gold Fields, Karnataka). Annual Appeal brings in 24,950 rupees (most ever from one circuit in Area Madras). Three PDL teams set off to cover 12 projects in four weeks.

Internal: Keeping a common mind amidst the multiplicity of happenings. (Week 2)*

AREA CALCUTTA

THE CALCUTTA HOUSE

External: A week of Jamshedpur activities includes an Imaginal Education for 36 Tisco School heads and assistant heads which result in follow-up possibilities. Project Description Lab is completed with Tisco Rural Development Society. Week climaxes with reflection on strategic position re Tisco and joint faculty regional team celebration (4). PDL teams complete first Lab at the Bengal Chamber of Commerce cluster village project, and receives positive responses from three colleagues in neighbouring States of Bihar and Orissan to join PDL team. Rupees 1,000 comes in from Stone India Co. for programme report advertisement (2). Annual Appeal ends with 10,000 Indian rupees in hand, 6,000 committed and 50,000 cheque to be picked up in Bombay. Five Project Description Labs are set up with 12 people from various organisations committed to participating in the team. First LENS follow-up consultancy held with Tisco at W. Bokaro Collieries reveals excellent demonstration tactics implementation and builds manoeuvres for four more tactics. Jamshedpur trip confirms Imaginal Education Seminar with 50 heads and deputy heads of Tisco Schools for October (1).

Internal: One day discontinuity "Muhrram" (Muslim Festival) launched a dispersed week with teams leaving for PDL's, Imaginal Educational and Bombay LENS, leaving one adult and four children to hold the fort (4). The huge "Durga Puja" holiday allows House to create new decor, blackboard, office shelves and E.G. room set up (2). The new time design for the Quarter is launched and highlighted by an individual/corporate study night and one day family festivities (1).

Contradiction: Maintaining the balance between internal and external demands. Configuring ourselves to handle strategically an Imaginal Education Course, PDL and continental LENS assignment. Maintaining programme momentum in the midst of major puja festivities. (Weeks 1,2,4)*

AREA SINGAPORE

THE JAKARTA HOUSE

External: We send the whole set-up team to the first Rural Development Interchange Workshop (RDIW) in Medan, set for Oct. 10. New, streamlined RDIW facilitation and follow-up schedule is designed, and all of the materials are created to enable the meetings. One module on Clerical Management sold to a major multi-national, first of twelve targeted for the year.

Internal: First full week of new House structures is implemented successfully. House office is enlarged as we remodel and set up new decor and begin new computer training to enable teamwork and office efficiency. House and Michael Neat celebrate his 32nd birthday.

Contradiction: Motivating colleagues, the Indonesian Steering Committee, and sponsoring organizations to fully engage in order to bring off the upcoming Jakarta RDIW. (Week 1)

THE MEDAN HOUSE

External: Two great RDS's in the Region result in nine in this last week. Two from HDZ participate in eight and attend women's Conference of GBKP (protestant) A first for GBKP to have Muslim's in attendance. A door is opened also for regional self-support and HDZ expansion.

Internal: Team celebrates RDS with first Indonesian film showing for Medan Region, sends out RDS team to help cover rest of Indonesia, House is left with two plus Rind who have first workday assignment of SLV.

Contradiction: Making sure all the projects designated are visited while making sure the development and self-support marketing don't get behind. (Weeks 2,3)*

THE KUALA LUMPUR HOUSE

External: Final draft of 1982-1983 Annual Report cum newsletter is completed and model is built for producing it at a minimal cost.

Internal: S. Krishnan is sent out to Indonesia for several weeks for enabling the campaign of RDS.

Contradiction: Allowing a breakloose of creativity in transforming our space with images for the next year and getting it all finished within a week with the staff left in the House. (Week)

THE UJUNG PANDANG HOUSE

External: One hundred page document of Bontoa and Cluster Development is completed in Indonesian Language as a final report to the government of South Sulawesi. Mailing and delivering the invitation to 26 organizations for Lokakarya Pembina Swadaya Masyarakat (RDS) to be held in Ujung Pandang on 27 of October '83. Bontoa activities continue; renew the street name signs, cleaning the bontoa Mini Park and the Economic guild gets excited as they make first profit from their businesses.

Internal: The House celebrates three events at the same time: Burhan wedding-Roundtable - and Week II is feast attended by many Bontoa youth. Rochmat's friend Andrea Serich and Gaby Weist two doctors from West Germany spend four days in Bontoa, they wanted to know about Rural Development in Indonesia.

Contradiction: Fixing the Car and renewing the license in the midst of RDS preparation. (Week 2)*

AREA HONG KONG

THE MANILA HOUSE

External: Documentation Trek team highlights visit of the Leper Colony in Palawan. Fiance team is organized with Turn Over of books releasing Tricia Mueller and Claudia Cramer. Ben Potot and wife Cita completes visit and stay in the House for two weeks and had great event watching Ben Potot and Ben Kingsley in the Global Film. Human Development Engagement Module is completed with 19 participants from Taiwan, USA, Netherlands UK and the Philippine Islands. Seven agriculturist were received to sojourn and intern.

Internal: Collegium on the Order and review of the weekly packets bring memories of the way we were. House sends out Jean and Tricia for the Panchayat trek.

Contradiction: Coordinating five teams into one mission at the same time orienting 11 new staff. (Week 3)*

THE HONG KONG HOUSE

External: Proposal for year-long training program for Time Inc., Asia, is created and submitted.

Internal: House has party to celebrate Jack's 39th birthday.

Contradiction: Locating the gas to power our IERD Implementation Vehicle. (Week 4)

THE TAIPEI HOUSE

External: House member and two Steering Committee members pay visit to two government department chairmen (both on ROC IERD Advisory Board) who promise their financial support for IERD, which, after CAPD (Council of Agriculture Planning & Department) promise of two weeks ago, completes the public sector half of ROC IERD funding! We send out over 150,000NT-worth of development proposals (at least 100,000 committed). Philips Taiwan calls after months of brooding to request a Meeting Management Module for their Chung Li plant managers (2). Steering Committee member goes on visit that gains Ambassador Hotel's agreement to support the RDS. Nineteen Development calls net NT\$149,000 committed in one week. Local branch of Continental Bank announces computerization plans which give the House hope of receiving statements that don't spread five lines of data over two pages (1).

Internal: Panchayat arrives (John and Clare) with Don Cramer, welcomed by freshly cleaned, decorated, rearranged, new guest-roomed house. During the week individual House members spend discontinuous moments jostling crowds at the National "Double Ten" parade reveling at the Taiwan Electronic Show, and marveling at a Marcel Marceau performance (2). House celebrates Gordon's birthday (also Gandhi Day) by eating at the only Indian restaurant in Taipei, and Paul Mayama, ICA: Japan Board Director, joins the celebration at weekly ritual (1).

Contradiction: Thinking of ways to move (on the IERD), while experiencing suspended animation. Scheduling corporate time to generate consensus and momentum on new projects amid strong momentum of longer-term, equally urgent work. (Weeks 1,2)

MANILA-THE PUTSAN HOUSE

External: Putsan people celebrated the community fiesta last October 18-19, 1983, sports tournament was organized by the Youth Club, teacher staff, Bgy. Officials, and ICA. Every house serves special food for visitors as Filipino custom during fiesta. The week was highlighted by the free movie from NMPC and about 2,500 people judged the show.

Internal: General cleaning of the House includes collegium, putting new room decor, varnishing chairs and tables for Panchayat visit to the Putsan House. This was highlighted by the House bowling celebration.

Contradiction: Activating the guild workers to their respective departments. (Week 4)*

THE CEBU HOUSE

External: Mactan-24 ELNC teachers have whole day tour around the Mactan Island with a celebrative lunch at mid-day in the local beach (Tongo) with the staff. Mactan-24 pig raising experiment takes inventory. They plant the pastural grass from Australia which was given by John Dalton an Australian guy who was working ADAB before.

Internal: The House studied the Philippine Liturgy to understand well about what is the meaning of all the messages in the liturgy used during the Ritual. House has prep workday for the Panchayat trek. House and Panchayat tour the project and unexpectedly participate in a village fiesta which is one of the village projects (Bagong Dalan).

Contradiction: Enabling Mactan-24 on going activities while doing inking blitz for the preschools food and supplies. (Week 9)*

DAVAO-LANGUB

External: MSSD distribute the third batch of rice to drought victims. Monthly baby weighing is completed and reported this quarter. Mr Cesar Gante donates lumber for Langub preschool building. Highlight of the year is the 5th Anniversary Fair for LHDP and Mountain Cluster Project, attended by the Ministry of Health, POPCOM, MSSD, BPI, MEC and two international staff from Manila and 200 people from the cluster.

Internal: Cluster workers participate in house painting and repair and extending road to the highway.

Contradiction: Beginning the think-tank for next year's work and developing proposals for different agencies to support the program. (Week ?)

DAVAO-MAHAYAG

External: We visit Provincial Engineer Office. Men of P.E.O. arrive and fix broken pipe & repairs Delusom well. House discovers three sources of water at staff house site by modern adaptation of ancient practice of water divination using stainless steel well.

Internal: House decides on their own Roundtable study on historical interpretation of the forces that have influenced change in the Mindanao Island.

Contradiction: The boulders have thudded down the Mountain... we are now caught in our oggles in order to see the larger vision...(Week 2)*

AREA TOKYO

THE TOKYO HOUSE

Internal: Regional Council is a great sign of future engagement as 20 participate in all day planning and stay for evening celebration. Tokyo Guardians host Panchayat and Order members with a traditional Japanese feast. Regional Colleague reception provides an opportunity for introducing new staff and Panchayat, IERD film, new songs and great conversations.

Internal: Pam Eddy is welcomed to Tokyo House as a volunteer from Denver. House planning Week II focuses priorities and assigns everyone to missional taskforces.

Contradiction: Determining priorities among overwhelming possibilities and having the courage to bracket others. (Weeks 2,3)*

THE SEOUL HOUSE

External: Lee Kang Jin and Len Hockley travel to two southern provinces for two days in a car provided by guardian, Mr. Taugy to do IERD project research.

Internal: Regional discontinuous event with a two day trip to the mountains starts with rain but ends with sunshine for the twenty-five participants.

Contradiction: (no contradiction submitted (Week 13)*)

SEOUL-THE CHEONG WON HOUSE

THE FUKUOKA HOUSE

External: Local Village Symposium in Krume provides us an opportunity to show the Kingsley video, make a short speech about IERD, meet many fascinating people who are equally fascinated by ICA and sell home made cakes and cookies. After the presentation, translated by Mrs. Sato, and the song, people said, "The singing changed the meeting." Roundtable at the House is a fine evening with seven guests and a Canadian couple on a working holiday who got our address from Barry Oakley in Australia.

Internal: The neighbour in whose House "the Fire" started comes by with a welcome money gift to offer apologies. The new collegium rationale is worked out and ICA members meet to decide next steps to keep Fukuoka open.

Contradiction: Orchestrating Okinawa from a distance. (Week 3)*

THE OSAKA HOUSE

THE SAPPORO HOUSE

External: Staff and colleagues attending International Women's Club party encounter excitement over the Volunteer Symposium results. Governor of Hokkaido's wife invites us over to her house. Three people are committed for next year's Philippine Work Camp during initial phone recruitment (3). Forty-two participants including UNESCO, Japan Peace Corps, Rotary, and Buddhist youth groups attended the Volunteer Symposium on Hokkaido's development cooperation with the world. The 10 leading local banks and businesses support the Symposium IERD manoeuvres for a local delegation begin with visits to the governors office and funding advisors (1,2).

Internal: Experimental models proposed for future Sapporo Region finances when no Order staff are present. Order Life collegium on "impact" compares the religious institution impact of RS-1 years with community institution impact of the present years (3). Panchayat visit reviews our history back to Fukushima days and writes several pages in the "Book of the Order: Ecumenical." External: Circuit to Suva visits the director of Rural Development which results in request for formal invitation to the government to attend IERD. UNDP deputy director will visit ICA in Tonga. Geographical leaders in Vava'u meet and decide to document (form III) two projects for India. PTS faculty work on translation of materials and spend Saturday creating collegiums for Ha'apai

Internal: Sandy Ariel and Karyn Crow arrive and create a new dynamic in the House. Long-awaited multi-week GOR arrives and whole house catches up on the world. Kitchen is painted and decorated in a 24 hour miracle.

Contradiction: Strengthening the consensus re IERD and PTS. (Week 3)*

AREA SAN FRANCISCO

THE LOS ANGELES HOUSE

External: Brochure for Showcase Forums is assured by Sausalito printer provided on an inkind basis. Two Showcase Forums steering committees set meetings in Soledad and Calapatria, Frances Roper is sent to Las Creces, N.M. for first Area PDL - Sef Help Enterprises is visited, press conference is scheduled to announce their selection to IERD. Successful trip to Hawaii by Alice Wright and Peggy Johnson to present 'PAX' to the American Baptist Pacific Southwest Conference results in 46 specific follow-up possibilities and five hot "bytes" for sales and the LA Computer Guild enters its first weekly report through use of CDC Bulletin Board.

Internal: Our first RRP movie, "The Chosen" was held at Roundtable along with two birthday celebrations Samia Youseff and Sid Munshin (Sara Wacker's husband); Samia celebrates by participating in self-support through Computer Paragigm.

Contradiction: Keeping before all of us the "big picture such that all participate at "full-tilt" level - youth, sojourners, venture folks, on-the-roads etc. (Week 4)*

THE SEATTLE HOUSE

External: After the NSC selection meeting decision, a phone call to the Tilth Association, an organization concerned with bio-sustainable agriculture, puts them on the road to New Delhi. Writing articles on the Pacific Northwest and Alaska and their projects which demonstrate Approaches That Work, both provides copy for the U.S. Western States tabloid and reinforces the conviction that amazing things are happening in the local. The installation of Raymond as President of the Council of Internaitonal Organizations puts us in the midst of Seattle's international scene.

Contradiction: Maintaining missional momentum when region is in summer mode. (Week 1)

AREA HOUSTON

THE HOUSTON HOUSE

External: House writes maneuvers for each pole of the Year of Order Council triangle. Receives note of thanks and a check for \$10,000 following a visit with Bob Trull done in the midst of a Trull family tragedy (3). The announcement by NSC of six projects from area Houston to go to Delhi plenary is celebrating occasion for the first meeting of complete tri-regional Day I "army" in office; and launches House participation in continental prep for PDL, database and fund raising (2).

Internal: House completes internal work including a refreshing two week rhythm time design (3). Week-long House planning series is punctuated by live lunch hour classical music serenades; produces creative 2-week time design; and is capped by "Age of Aquarious" creativity celebration at an elegant Indian resutaurant (2).

Contradiction: Holding the big picture of Year of Order Council in the midst of moving into a mode of implementation in myriad arenas. Struggling to get a hold of a style of reconciliation in the midst of diverse values of how we be missional (Weeks 2,3)

THE DALLAS HOUSE

THE MEMPHIS HOUSE

External: Circuit to Mississippi includes RDS Steering Committee deciding to go with new March dates to give needed prep time and deal with political considerations and securing firm PDL dates from local representatives at MACE. Local residents at LeMoen Garden housing project consense on six proposals for community care in workshop ICA facilitates. House, emerging team, and Area Prior use Regional Council to give context of last year's accomplishments and charting the next 16 months of YOC (3). Meeting with LeMoen Garden residents to initiate "We Can Do It" group looks at history and current situation at large public housing project in Memphis. Permeation position task gets long awaited contacts inside Memphis Roman Catholic Diocese Office. Circuit to Arkansas with nine appointments uncovers solid support and referrals from Episcopal Bishop and exciting seriousness from Rural Public Health Program Head to create long term strategy for rural Arkansas (2).

Donna McCleskey arrives and takes off with two of our best (Don and Eric) to tell the story for funding in N. Carolina and we hear before she arrives that one proposal has already been granted (via Hong Kong). The regional newsletter is composed, printed and mailed and the NSC "highlights" is under the belt.

Contradiction: Thinking boldly for the quarter and year to encompass limitless possibility of the Metro and the Regions. (Week 1)

AREA CHICAGO

THE CHICAGO HOUSE

THE KANSAS CITY HOUSE External: The Lorimor team comes down for Annual Appeal wrap-up and Regional PSU. The House is now the proud owner of a Kay-Pro computer to be used for self-support and House. The Metro decides to hold evening House Churches twice a month (1). Kansas City House hosts two video events with Kansas City friends (13).

Internal: Life is highlighted by the celebration of Annual Appeal picnic in which both Houses participate along with two Chicago representatives. Marie Sharp leads a series of collegiums on Phase I while she is here (1). The youth are busy with an abundance of work, promising a good year with respect to self-support.

Contradiction: Spreading leadership of House to expand external mission. Maintaining ongoing corporate schedule to mesh with eventful time design. (Weeks 13,1qtr2)

LORIMOR HDP

External: The E. Waterloo community experiences the "Wonder of Winning" through a community clean up day, in the rain; it's first public effort, with the TV cameras recording the event. The Hunger Taskforce of the United Methodist Church, Iowa, designates \$5,000 to the work of the ICA this year. The Chicago Area enters it's first Approaches That Work Project into the Global Data Base through the modum at the Data Office in Lorimor (3). Circuits to Waterloo, Cedar Rapids, Ames, Lincoln, Ne. and Kansas City keep teams on the road. Presentations to Coon Rapids and Grundy Center churches uncovers people looking for significant engagement and very interested in our approach. LENS facilitators training weekend prepares 30 men and women from different parts of the region in the LENS process (2).

Internal: Gail West, Iris Boivin, Dallas Ziegenhorn, Mark Rebstock and Lori Haman represent the Order: Ecumenical at the burial service and celebration of the completed life of our colleague Wesley Salmon in Macksville, K.S. on October 22, 1983 (3). Gail West and Gene Boiven return from the NSC, Area-Regional Priors meeting and Areal/Global computer repository creation in Chicago. K.C. Houses gather for Fiscal Management Taskforce meeting with film festival and champagne breakfast (2).

Contradiction: Breaking through authentic engagement forms in relation to a two year strategy beyond programmatic follow up. Identifying arenas of corporate focus so that individuals are given permission to audaciously build releasing models. (Weeks 2,3)

THE MINNEAPOLIS HOUSE

External: LENS International spends the week working with the regional team on the Design Conference and targeting key corporations in the Twin Cities. The third session of the Roundtable was highlighted by an intense conversation on the "Peace Movement in our Time" and a reflection on talks sharing individual stories of life and mission. A team does site visits to IMPACT 7 in Wisconsin and Centrol in Northfield, Minnesota (1). Saturday Champagne Breakfast with House and regional team celebrates the \$18,000 Annual Appeal victory and launches the quarter with an "A" money development workshop, and sends out Justin Morrill to Nexus with \$10,000 from sideline "B" maneuvers. Contradiction: Configuring the best use of resources to get the missional task done. Designing the imaginal time and space that will release the teamwork needed to creatively conquer the complexity facing us. (Week 1,13)

THE DETROIT HOUSE

THE INDIANAPOLIS HOUSE

External: Warren, Indiana Showcase Forum has 43 participants, 11 co-sponsors including seven banks, and 11 projects displayed. Lafayette Cadre were key catalyst and facilitators. Hillsboro, Ohio Showcase Forum is set for December three. Uptown Neighborhood Festival is held at Bank parking lot with steady stream of young and old participants.

Internal: First steps are taken to modify V.O.W. construct for Missional Family Cluster training. Massive mailing is sent to potential donors and sponsors for Mid-North Home Helps. Contradiction: Managing major maneuvers in minutes rather than months. (Week 4)*

AREA NEW YORK

THE NEW YORK HOUSE

External: Loisaida Employment Taskforce meeting has 32 people in attendance with representation from the NY State Department of Commerce and NY City Department of Employment. Individual guilds decide to meet to accomplish their assignments before next taskforce meeting. New York Region Annual Report is completed and mailed to entire mailing list.

Internal: House is filled with boarders from Japan, Germany, Australia, Brooklyn, Chicago and Caracas. Longer term boarders volunteer to assist in building renovations

Contradiction: Breaking through gap in development income with only one third September program check earned. (Week 2)

Internal: Both Manuel Samayo and Bill Allerging celebrate birthdays in same week. House inkind 1976 four-door Renault. House gets facelift of rugs and curtains in corporate space (2). Order grieves at the sudden death of Araceli Mathews, age 28 on October 12th. Araceli's family, Jim Mathews, Frank Hilliard, Bill and Phyllis Slicker, Dr. Bob Springs and House celebrate her life together (3).

Contradiction: Addressing ourselves to global push on IERD, Order Council and finances reveals utter necessity to intensify local program. Getting commitment from projects to select their own representatives to go to India and participate in Phase III. (Week 2,3)*

THE GUATEMALA CITY HOUSE

External: National Steering Committee meets for the first time in El Salvador and decides to take responsibility for their representation at IERD without requiring the direct help of ICA signaling another non-resident country on the road to the IERD. Three film (Kingsley) showings, and five more committed to NSC-Guatemala moves prep into a new phase. The entire team receives computer training with each person specializing in one type of skill (word processing, basic, visacalc, Data based master etc.) creating the integrated team on the computer.

Internal: George and Donna Marie West are sent out of India with a grand "despedida" in Conacaste including the local marimba with their favorite tones and dancing after a typical dinner of "pollo jocon". The send-out by village leader was "We sow corn and beans, you sowed something else in conacaste and it will keep on growing."

Contradiction: Finding the ways to have local committees and entities captivated by the vision of the missional task and creating models with them to participate in it. (Week 2)*

AREA HAVANA

THE KINGSTON HOUSE

External: NSC holds two meetings and begins documentation site visits. ICA lectures at University of West Indies in a Community Development course. Woburn Lawn builders travel to Claverty Cottage to donate labour on community centre construction. Two Rotary-ICA committee meetings are held. Cluster circuits are held in Portland, St. Andrew, Yallah's Valley and the Blue Mountains. Thirty colleagues attend Regional Team Meeting to plan circuits and expansion strategy. Panchayat Reception is held at the Pegasus with Ben Kingsley video shown to 28 "frame" - colleagues.

Internal: Panchayat visit is the highlight; tragic car accident near Woburn Lawn injures several village leaders and kills Alice Wright's niece; House welcomes Jack Silk and two sons and celebrates anniversary and birthdays.

Contradiction: Keeping our nerve while negotiating the symplegadies of three major grants evaluations which are upon us. (Week 2)*

AREA LIMA

THE LIMA HOUSE

External: Week of planning scheduled a Foro Campaign to do 24 Foros in two provinces in the next two months at the same time a decision was made to send seven people to the Continental GRA Council and Priorship Training School in Caracas. Fourteen people from the cluster communities decided to be trained to lead the Foros to cover the staffing gap. Visited GAB member Mrs. Belaunde (first lady) with Panchayat and presented a proposal for IERD delegate funding which would have the ICA do programs in her urban "slum" projects. This is a new breakthrough in IERD funding - earning the money by doing programs.

Internal: Panchayat visit called forth a deeper understanding of the task of our Order in History and interns witnessed to their own significant role in this task.

Contradiction: Securing appropriate working office space in Lima to enable the expanding task. (Week 1)

AREA CARACAS

THE CARACAS HOUSE

External: Second to last NSC meeting of 22 people narrows down final project selection for IERD as preparations for November intensity with inkind blitz, facility check, continental travel, arrangements, money search, decor prep, and procedres (4). The House participates in an emphasis on the Phase I dynamic of Caño Negro by aiding the sendout of six junior high students to the Jesuits' Trade School in Merida and participating in a baptism (3). The House hosts a site visit from the Benevolence Committee of The United Christian Church, completes sections of the Spanish Human Development Methods Lab manual and completes the requirements for sending Caño Negro students to the Merida Jesuit School (1).

Internal: Week II Area planning in Caño Negro is held as we count down to the 5-week continental program (4). Six new sojourners are welcomed amidst a celebration for Juan Jose's 20th birthday. House receives a donation of pasta and flour. House self-support venture brings in its first profits (1).

Contradiction: How to gear the November 2-week research assembly, continental council, and three week priorship training school around movement formation in Latin America. Assuming a new style with a balance between priorities and details in proximity of the Continental Research Assembly. Enlarging the human resources of the ICA: Barlovento. (Weeks 1,3,4)*

AREA BUENOS AIRES

THE SANTIAGO HOUSE

External: Sol de Septiembre follows up Foro with a meeting with representation of two people from all activities arenas, active or inactive, teams are created to work in eight arenas and the president of the deirectiva not only uses the methods but also uses the ritual created at the Foro. NSC meeting pulls together Chile statement of criterias for successful Rural Development from RDS and names four of six people to represent Chile in India. Committee also takes on task of translating Kingsley tape for use with development.

Internal: Team has great birthday celebration following second successful marketing meeting. Pumpkin pie is served for Bill's 57 years and chocolate cake for Nancy's 27 years. Translations start flowing as Joaquina arrives from Peru to wait for LA Council visa.

Contradiction: Continuing to maintain and project our spirit of possibility and futuric vision in the midst of the daily vast unknown. (Week 4)*

AREA RIO DE JANEIRO

THE RIO DE JANEIRO HOUSE

External: Sixty-five children participate in second annual Children's Day Festival in Braçaña with games, food and slides on dental hygiene. Development team reaches a total of 100 targets on file to be contacted. House receives the Panchayat and is impacted by history and future strategies workshops.

Internal: House receives first Brazilian volunteer, Roberto Baptista da Silva.

Contradiction: Involving the municipal team in fund raising. (Week 2)

THE ROCHESTER HOUSE

External: Two co-sponsors are confirmed for "Approaches That Work" Conference and first flyer advertising the event is prepared for mailing. Regional Team Office Day clears up a backlog of letters and phone calls (4). HUD and New York State Association of Renewal and Housing Officers agree to co-sponsor a Conference, "Partnership in Economic Development--Approaches That Work". Training sessions for Regional Team brings in 20 from six metros to prepare for leading programs for local groups. The first round of brochures advertising programs goes into the mail (3).

Internal: House visits with RPI family to view pictures of Chang Sha province and discuss Chinese customs (4). Janice Ulangca stays three days at House while Bob Mayo and Ellen Howie commit themselves to one day in the House (3).

Contradiction: Confirming additional co-sponsors for the "Approaches That Work" Conference. Confirming additional co-sponsors for the Conference so that the first mailing can go out in 10 days. (Week 4)*

THE WASHINGTON HOUSE

External: One thousand four hundred and seventy dollars in Annual Appeal money comes in this week--\$800 of it is a contribution from a Baltimore artist who donated the proceeds from her recent art sale. Invitations to the first IERD benefit are mailed, and first returns come in after two days with 20 people saying "yes" and \$385 in-hand. Program PSU produces a unifying symbol on the next 16 months as well as a plan for Quarter II. Private agencies in International Development (P.A.I.D.) call to remind us that we've missed recent meetings and they've missed us!

Internal: Quarter II House life manual is completed and experimental time design is implemented. Hostelery program receives request from Philadelphia Lutheran Seminary for housing for 15 people Nov. 6-11 during 500th birthday celebration of Martin Luther.

Contradiction: Making Order assignments which create the interface that releases people to do the tasks before us this quarter. (Week 1)

THE BOSTON HOUSE

External: A \$100,000 week for Boston Training Inc. as Old Smith Church commits \$20,000. Bay State Skills Corporation \$72,000 and BP at John Hancock hosts sophisticated presentation for Boston businesses on the 60th floor of the Hancock. Gary Drown, VP at Indianapolis Life is a great guest speaker. Uniglobe Design Travel Consultants (Buna Macomber) opens its doors for business. October update and brochure for November courses goes out and four cars head North for 5th October workday in Starks.

Internal: Visits and celebrations mark the week with Gary and Pat Drown here from Indianapolis. Tina Slicker goes to Starks and Boston for mid-term break, Phyllis Allard's birthday is celebrated with a trip to the circus and Debra Griffin's birthday is celebrated with a birthday breakfast.

Contradiction: Looking at all we're doing through the screen of the Year of Order Council and creating designs for new actions. (Week 4)*

BOSTON-THE STARKS HOUSE

External: Fifteen from beyond Starks join SEC regulars and House for great workday with further pilot furnace room, and wood prep progress. N.H. project is confirmed for IERD Delhi Event. Wreath 10 are all set for production. Woodworks chair sample is done and marketing brochure is mocked up.

Internal: House celebrates with SEC the great workday by having a spaghetti food and going roller skating.

Contradiction: Breaking through the marketing contradiction of the region. (Week 2)

AREA MONTREAL

THE TORONTO HOUSE

External: First LENS of the year is successfully completed with Graham Fiberglass, Ltd. Representatives from every level of the company participated. The three selected Ontario projects for Delhi confirm their intent to participate. Development circuit uncovers promising "B" money leads (4). Open House showing of Kingsley and RDS videos to 17 people produces many good contacts and \$1200 in pledges plus a dentist who will do teeth under IDS policy. House experiences abounding of "A" money as the next two program checks are assured. A visit to Owen Sound produces the possibility of a LENS with the Concerned Farm Women plus a registration for the Facilitator Training Course. A site visit with the Panchayat to the Mississauga Condominium shows how a forum two years ago has resulted in continued active community care (3).

Internal: Week II on LENS marketing is capped off by House visit to the Kleinburg gallery to see an excellent collection of Canadian art. Panchayat visit gives us an affirmation of the directions we're going with our program and research to explore all possibilities in this Year of Order Council (3).

Sisters of Charity visit the House for a Lorne update and resolution of financial commitments (1).

Internal: Wind up of great Panchayat visit takes the form of Japanese style teriaki feast and a collegium on teamhood from Humphrey Bogart in Treasure of Sirra Madre video (3). Presence of Area Priors occasions two days of planning for Quarter II and beyond, accompanied by development workshop and re-arrangement of office space (1).

Contradiction: Reminding ourselves about engaging others. Keeping the revolutionary Global View and maintaining spiritual context in the midst of the day to day demands. (Week 1,3)

AREA MEXICO CITY

THE MEXICO CITY HOUSE

External: Trip to State of Queretaro is made by House and ICA Board President and NSC member. Network of 35 active village projects initiated by Mexican Foundation for Rural Development shows strong interest in methods of Human Development and local participation in IERD. Manuel works with Mahtews' in Los Reyes community. Youth are committed to bring off Youth Forum and ensure participation from San Camilo. House continues strategy of breakfast and IERD meetings (2). Circuit to State of Queretaro results in likely project for IERD. Local initiative is startling, including care for wider network of villages, mostly in agricultural improvement. Pre-selection committee of NSC meets and invites eight projects from RDS to participate. Letter and questionnaire is sent out. Open door is presented to work in all or any of Fundacion Mexicana's 45 economic projects around the whole nation (3).

External: IERD global strikeforce meets and strategizes to reap harvest of delegates from 50 nations. Development planning meeting creates plan for raising new money from Religious Orders. Service Ventures reports September self-support income is in hand or invoiced, October income contracted, November marketing calls begun.

Internal: Jane Sharp arrives and Denise Stanley celebrates 19th birthday. House hosts 17 people during IERD check signals and development Religious Orders planning meeting.

Contradiction: Getting clear quickly on current situation as total body without losing momentum. (Week 3)

THE BOMBAY NEXUS HOUSE

External: Continental LENS staff receives strong push as we receive Cadbury Consultancy and Mukund LENS. Nine more PDL's are held across India. NST facility in Pune is pinned down (3). Annual Appeal goes over the bottom-line of one and a half Lakhs, bringing this year's income to two and a half times that of last year at this time. First six project description labs are complete after one week on the road (2).

Internal: Chocolate treats abound as Cyprian returns from Brussels IERD meeting and Cadbury LENS staff brings back ink. Vaughn O'Halloran leads collegium on Calcutta House unique internal and external thrusts (3). First computer PSU on sub-continent produces 13-step tactics chart towards broadening our self-support options. Annual Appeal celebration features sitar and tabla drums from Air India as Academy Awards are presented to Appeal teams (2).

Contradiction: Ungrounded common images of Year of Order Council that will make sense out of the everyday frenzy. Assignment structure that is outmoded for the kind of year on our hands. (Week 2,3)*

THE HONG KONG NEXUS HOUSE

External: The Nexus moves into a three-guild configuration as planning is completed: Financial Services, Programme Support and Local Development Experiment. Hong Kong Region begins to whirl as R.J. Reynolds gives \$30,000 (US) for Hong Kong Programme work; Local Development Symposium is set up for Nov. 16 and brochure (all inked) goes to press. Hilliary Edwards member of London Steering Committee comes to stay for a few days and delights us with descriptions of Area London's project search (for IERD).

Internal: House begins to sparkle as collegium room is painted a-fresh, new decor created, office and guild space recreated and new Internal life two-week rhythm goes into action with two new series of collegiums weekly, one on resurgence in major world religions and the second on the nine continents towards a geo-social spirit analysis.

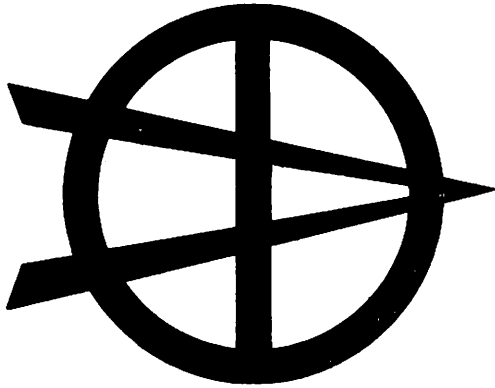

AREA MADRID

THE MADRID HOUSE

External: Fundacion Mexicana is very pleased with our collaboration with them in State of Queretaro and decides to set up a visit with their rural projects in Michoacan. Time-Life Co. is still excited over their two LENSES and begin to contact other companies about future LENS. House continues to visit airlines to obtain free or reduced ticketing for delegates to IERD (4). Two circuits in one week accomplish one Project Description Lab initiation and a visit to the Soria-Zarogosa human development cadres. The latter reveals a full scale cooperative sewing industry in Santa Maria de Huerta, and catalyzes new action on the youth organisation in Arcos de Jalon. Visit to ICA president Fr. Garcia interests him in funding Year of Order Council (2).

Internal: The House has week of honoring the life and death of Araceli Mathews with a 24 hour vigil and community mass. House spends Week II creating three month sojourn plan and Barbara is sent out to Caracas Council (4). Spanish classes begin and house decor receives needed attention as the 54 areas are lettered in Spanish for the collegium room (2).

Contradiction: Insuring ongoing care for the future of the Order in the midst of carrying out the immediate particular everpresent demands. Finding the most effective strategy to beckon Mexican Sojourners. (Weeks 2,4)

LISBON—THE LAMEGO HOUSE

External: Development trip to Lisbon results in 1,000 USD from Wassen, a visit with UNDP where ICA found out that UNFPA in New York wrote the Portuguese government saying it would consider a proposal for funding the Portuguese delegation to the IERD if the Portuguese government would request it. Four cluster villages hold quarterly planning meetings, combined with slides from Brazil. Ten families put demonstration strawberries in the ground before the first fall freeze while chestnut tree campaign begins in all cluster villages.

Volunteers report on their attendance to rally in London sponsored by the committee for nuclear disarmament.

Internal: Two English volunteers express desire for interning, Sally Ann Bailey leaves for Jamaica as volunteer and sojourners brighten coming weeks' evenings with inkind theatre tickets.

Contradiction: Present and new clarity presses for additional and thoughtful strategy and implementation for rest of quarter. (Week 3)

AREA PARIS

THE PARIS HOUSE

External: House's documentation and funding thrusts are fortified with capability of Robert Leurs to operate in French through setting and keeping appointments and in doing translations, e.g. contact made with Rotary and Lions Clubs, researching and visiting Natural Parks and Rural Centres and International Civil Service re possible projects. Students of North-South Association of Management Institute is committed to work as volunteers. Three or four possible delegations to IERD meet together to plan Exposition displays and expose possibility of IERD coverage by French TV channel.

Internal: Order Forms collegium is enlivened by Robert Leurs and Julie Nicholson's kibbutz experience. Julie performs miracles on apartment windows with creation of new curtains.

Contradiction: Getting to sources for private funding of IERD. (Weeks 2,3.)

Internal: Christel Otké is sent out after sojourning for three weeks.

Contradiction: Finding ways to use NSC member strength to advantage when meeting at one time and in one place seems impossible. (Week 1)

AREA CAIRO

GIZA — THE EL BAYAD HOUSE

External: Second draw for desert is in the bank from Canadian Embassy. Beni Suliman water management committee and community at large decide to work together on relocating water tank. Second week of HDTI concludes with personal evaluation and exams for each student.

Internal: Mr. Ibrahim Youssef, 33 years with Department of Social Affairs, spends weekend in Bayad and House participates in Order Day collegiums.

Contradiction: Staying one step ahead of HDTI participants and cash flow needs in order to maintain momentum. (Week)

AREA ABIDJAN

THE ABIDJAN HOUSE

External: Evening at the Institute including a showing of the global film with Phillips Petroleum employees leads to monthly cotributions of \$500, quarterly project work days and bi-weekly Roundtables.

Internal: New self-support venture is uncovered through English teaching contract possibility with international courier service.

Contradiction: Money development openings, but little time to write new proposals, blocks regularity of development income. (Week 2)

AREA LAGOS

THE LAGOS HOUSE

AREA KINSHASA

THE LUSAKA HOUSE

External: Colleague event held at NSC chairperson's home evolves into new contacts and sources for funding and authorization. One thousand dollar contribution is largest single money source in ten months.

Internal: Panchayat sessions realized Year of the Order Council as priority for '83-'84, and struggled with exploration of our future vision for the Order: Ecumenical. Year and Quarter planning adds to preparation for Panchayat sessions.

Contradiction: Utilizing Panchayat visit and public holidays to launch new yearly and quarterly operational modes. (Week 3)*

AREA NAIROBI

THE NAIROBI HOUSE

External: Superb evaluation from two week 4-person Swedish Cooperative team leads to proposal to train the Kenya Cooperative Movement in our methods. Eight projects are selected to represent Kenya to IERD with 12 delegates finances committed. Management collects James Wambua's passport for going to Zambia on the way to Section Meetings in A, B, and C.

Internal: David Montgomery, Julie Michalson and Robert Leurs arrive from Area London as volunteers, bringing to nine the number of volunteers assisting the New Village Movement while celebrating week with Tan Ur meal on the patio under the stars.

Contradiction: Using mid-quarter planning and National project directors meeting to evaluate and weave together our quarter's resolves. (Week 4)*

A site visit gives an opportunity to start small industry by DIC.(3). Education guild visits Preschool in cluster villages to get all information in hand. Handloom society meeting is held in Asegaon and industry guild meeting is held in Maliwada. Cluster loan defaulters list is in hand (2).

Internal: Ashram colleagues write a letter to all other cluster ashrams at letter writing collegium to be interchange. Cluster actuation model collegium helps to start spacious work in cluster and because of this all bicycles are repaired (3). Ashram celebrates "Shamal's" first birthday. Imaginal Education Training, global ICA collegium, and leadership style conversation pushes images to be ready before time (2).

Contradiction: Pushing to victory story of possibility to make strong village vision of irrigation/industry and preschool. Changing weak visions and creating strong guilds strategy. (Weeks 2,3)

External: House and cluster experience a week of activities including home science demonstration (22 village women and 12 students and lecturer from SNDT women's university); bank loan meeting to discuss loans for villagers below poverty line (Canara Bank mgrs., Block Dec. officer, village leaders and villagers, 30 in all) photo tableau by RCF Fertilizer Co. (villagers, ICA staff, bank Mgrs. and RCF rep.) in demonstration rice plot and two of the House Priors, Hiriman Kakone and Nancy Lanphear attend Area Meeting and PDL in Jawale.

District Superintendent of Police distributes Rangoli and Kabadi prizes. Prohibition Department showed "Keewan" movie. Cluster preschool teachers gather for next plan. Youth module does Grand Shramadham and a cluster circuit and fixes date for economic module with D.R.D.A.

Internal: Hingamghatwala Shophupr who has given money for Maliwada VLC as did Surekha Thakker, a Mahrati movie actor visits the House.

Contradiction: How to engage all the shops when we don't have coming Quarter plan. (Week 13)

NAGPUR—THE TEMBHURWAHI HOUSE

External: Denada Societies distribution loan for 21 people in the cluster. We celebrated Gandhi's birthday on 2nd Oct. and visited Manohav Sapre (district member M.S.E.B.) and submitted proposal for Cluster Village Electricity.

Internal: New volunteer from England arrived in ashram. Mr. Chate, Police Sub-Inspector visits Ashram.

Contradiction: Circuit cluster people are busy in the field. How to engage them with 4-sector work all together. (Week 2)

NAGPUR—THE DABHAD HOUSE

External: Preschool shed is built in Jambron and Medhda holds shramdan and meeting with Gram Sevak. Managing Director of Village Bank in Pradhpur adopts six cluster villages.

Internal: Wood is obtained for Ashram repairs, S. Sawarkhed arrives from Sevagram and Prasad family is sent out on discontinuity. Marathi classes start.

Contradiction: Setting up Global Women's Forums without any educated women on the staff. (Week 12)

AREA DELHI

THE DELHI HOUSE

External: Annual Appeal is completed tripling last year's bottomline and the number of donors in the Area. Manoeuvring for Phase II of the Quarter accelerates cluster activities with formation of 5-village leadership structure, the exploration of site for training centre/ICA residence construction and a move on visible development signs. Intensive circuit across Area sets up six PDL events and four RDS's are scheduled for next month. Block Development Officer (BDO) visits House and assures full support while government finishes 3-village survey for flood water outlet system.

Internal: Kris Kuchera arrives as volunteer for six months. Battacharya children are enrolled in school with hostel. Self-support is off to good start with rupees 5,000 in hand for Bata Supervisors Course. Dinner out in Faridabad makes for great celebration of week's work.

Contradiction: After deciding PDL as number 1 priority for the next four weeks, launching critical cluster manoeuvres while PDL schedule is still unclear. (Week 1)

AREA MADRAS

THE BANGALORE HOUSE

External: Six out of 14 Project Description Laboratories in the four states of Southern India are completed and the rest on track to be completed by November 6th. Area Development is close to surpassing the annual total of the last two years in week three of Quarter II, with two 10,000 rupee gifts from Madras, 200,000 rupees working and a realistic plan for 400,000 in the works. Health plan in cluster continues to develop with one man undergoing an eye operation and hospitalization arranged for two polio victims.

Project Description Lab is completed with Tisco Rural Development Society. Week climaxes with reflection on strategic position re Tisco and joint faculty regional team celebration (4). PDL teams complete first Lab at the Bengal Chamber of Commerce cluster village project, and receives positive responses from three colleagues in neighbouring States of Bihar and Orissan to join PDL team. Rupees 1,000 comes in from Stone India Co. for programme report advertisement (2). Annual Appeal ends with 10,000 Indian rupees in hand, 6,000 committed and 50,000 cheque to be picked up in Bombay. Five Project Description Labs are set up with 12 people from various organisations committed to participating in the team. First LENS follow-up consultancy held with Tisco at W. Bokaro Collieries reveals excellent demonstration tactics implementation and builds manoeuvres for four more tactics. Jamshedpur trip confirms Imaginal Education Seminar with 50 heads and deputy heads of Tisco Schools for October (1).

Internal: One day discontinuity "Muhrram" (Muslim Festival) launched a dispersed week with teams leaving for PDL's, Imaginal Educational and Bombay LENS, leaving one adult and four children to hold the fort (4). The huge "Durga Puja" holiday allows House to create new decor, blackboard, office shelves and E.G. room set up (2). The new time design for the Quarter is launched and highlighted by an individual/corporate study night and one day family festivities (1).

Contradiction: Maintaining the balance between internal and external demands. Configuring ourselves to handle strategically an Imaginal Education Course, PDL and continental LENS assignment. Maintaining programme momentum in the midst of major puja festivities. (Weeks 1,2,4)

AREA SINGAPORE

THE JAKARTA HOUSE

External: We send the whole set-up team to the first Rural Development Interchange Workshop (RDIW) in Medan, set for Oct. 10. New, streamlined RDIW facilitation and follow-up schedule is designed, and all of the materials are created to enable the meetings. One module on Clerical Management sold to a major multi-national, first of twelve targeted for the year.

Internal: First full week of new House structures is implemented successfully. House office is enlarged as we remodel and set up new decor and begin new computer training to enable teamwork and office efficiency. House and Michael Neat celebrate his 32nd birthday.

Contradiction: Motivating colleagues, the Indonesian Steering Committee, and sponsoring organizations to fully engage in order to bring off the upcoming Jakarta RDIW. (Week 1)

THE MEDAN HOUSE

External: Local steering committee holds brief meeting regarding the RDS reports on site visit teams, and visits Women's Executive Committee Project on possible self-support Site visit teams on the Methodist Project.

Internal: A Roundtable with few people gives us spirit in dealing with compassion. Romanus is back from his discontinuity while Julia had trip to Penang for visa.

Contradiction: Building a momentum of development and self-support and Year of Council Research and brooding while sensing a need of pause after RDS/site visit campaign. (Week 4)*

THE KUALA LUMPUR HOUSE

External: Final draft of 1982-1983 Annual Report cum newsletter is completed and model is built for producing it at a minimal cost.

Internal: S. Krishnan is sent out to Indonesia for several weeks for enabling the campaign of RDS.

Contradiction: Allowing a breakloose of creativity in transforming our space with images for the next year and getting it all finished within a week with the staff left in the House. (Week)

THE UJUNG PANDANG HOUSE

External: One hundred page document of Bontoa and Cluster Development is completed in Indonesian Language as a final report to the government of South Sulawesi. Bontoa activities continue; renew the street name signs, cleaning the bontoa Mini Park and the Economic guild gets excited as they make first profit from their businesses.

Internal: The House celebrates three events at the same time: Burhan wedding-Roundtable - and Week II is feast attended by many Bontoa youth. Rochmat's friend Andrea Serich and Gaby Weist two doctors from West Germany spend four days in Bontoa, they wanted to know about Rural Development in Indonesia.

Contradiction: Fixing the Car and renewing the license in the midst of RDS preparation. (Week 2)

AREA HONG KONG

THE MANILA HOUSE

External: Documentation Trek team highlights visit of the Leper Colony in Palawan. Finance team is organized with Turn Over of books releasing Tricia Mueller and Claudia Cramer. Ben Potot and wife Cita completes visit and stay in the House for two weeks and had great event watching Ben Potot and Ben Kingsley in the Global Film. Human Development Engagment Module is completed with 19 participants from Taiwan, USA, Netherlands UK and the Philippine Islands. Seven agriculturists were received to sojourn and intern.

Internal: Collegium on the Order and review of the weekly packets bring memories of the way we were. House sends out Jean and Tricia for the Panchayat trek.

Contradiction: Coordinating five teams into one mission at the same time orienting 11 new staff. (Week 3)

THE HONG KONG HOUSE

External: Proposal for year-long training program for Time Inc., Asia, is created and submitted.

Internal: House has party to celebrate Jack's 39th birthday.

Contradiction: Locating the gas to power our IERD Implementation Vehicle. (Week 4)

THE TAIPEI HOUSE

External: A trip to Kaohsiung Region results in former LENS client holding a one day PSU for Chinese management staff; a visit to Hai Ou to see completed seawall and newly painted community center with tile front and conversation with village leader reveals a new folk dance group has been organized and the health clinic is open two days/week & staffed by nurses; a one-day training program with the Fang Liao Farmers Association is set; and helpful conversation with Ms. Chiu of Ping Tung Department of Social Affairs. Agenda is set for 4-session ESC with Maritime Transportation Agency and 80% of development bottomline for October is banked.

Internal: New House monthly planning session results in newly organized missional taskforces; research continues on facility and costs for possible December Seapac Priory Meeting in Taipei; September self-support money is secured. A fine discontinuous evening is had by all at Douglas and Lilly Chen's home (Jim Yu's sister) as we are trected to delicious dinner, mountain climbing, and informal and beautiful violin recital by Douglas.

Contradiction: Rehearsing the context that identifies the opportunities and articulates the dramatically engaging story of the global society's present spirit journey. (Week 4)*

MANILA-THE PUTSAN HOUSE

External: Putsan people celebrated the community fiesta last October 18-19, 1983, sports tournament was organized by the Youth Club, teacher staff, Bgy. Officials, and ICA. Every house serves special food for visitors as Filipino custom during fiesta. The week was highlighted by the free movie from NMPC and about 2,500 people judged the show.

Internal: General cleaning of the House includes collegium, putting new room decor, varnishing chairs and tables for Panchayat visit to the Putsan House. This was highlighted by the House bowling celebration.

Contradiction: Activating the guild workers to their respective departments. (Week 4)

THE CEBU HOUSE

Mactan-24 pig raising experiment takes inventory. They plant the pastoral grass from Australia which was given by John Dalton an Australian guy who was working ADAB before.

Contradiction: The boulders have thudded down the Mountain... we are now caught in our oggles in order to see the larger vision...(Week 2)

AREA TOKYO

THE TOKYO HOUSE

Internal: Regional Council is a great sign of future engagement as 20 participate in all day planning and stay for evening celebration. Tokyo Guardians host Panchayat and Order members with a traditional Japanese feast. Regional Colleague reception provides an opportunity for introducing new staff and Panchayat, IERD film, new songs and great conversations.

Internal: Pam Eddy is welcomed to Tokyo House as a volunteer from Denver. House planning Week II focuses priorities and assigns everyone to missional taskforces.

Contradiction: Determining priorities among overwhelming possibilities and having the courage to bracket others. (Weeks 2,3)

THE SEOUL HOUSE

External: Lee Kang Jin and Len Hockley travel to two southern provinces for two days in a car provided by guardian, Mr. Taugy to do IERD project research.

Internal: Regional discontinuous event with a two day trip to the mountains starts with rain but ends with sunshine for the twenty-five participants.

Contradiction: (no contradiction submitted) (Week 13)

SEOUL-THE CHEONG WON HOUSE

External: Using an analysis interview, cluster village projects are reviewed and format excites project managers as a way of monthly reporting to the village the victories and next steps. Team begins to see the implementation of the Korean DOOP model and accelerates planning for Pioneer Corps.

Internal: Our first RRP movie, "The Chosen" was held at Roundtable along with two birthday celebrations Samia Youseff and Sid Munshin (Sara Wacker's husband); Samia celebrates by participating in self-support through Computer Paragim.

The announcement by NSC of six projects from area Houston to go to Delhi plenary is celebrating occasion for the first meeting of complete tri-regional Day 1 "army" in office; and launches House participation in continental prep for PDL, database and fund raising (2).

Internal: House is filled with boarders from Japan, Germany, Australia, Brooklyn, Chicago and Caracas. Longer term boarders volunteer to assist in building renovations

Contradiction: Breaking through gap in development income with only one third September program check earned. (Week 2)

THE ROCHESTER HOUSE

External: Two co-sponsors are confirmed for "Approaches That Work" Conference and first flyer advertising the event is prepared for mailing. Regional Team Office Day clears up a backlog of letters and phone calls (4). Gary Drown, VP at Indianapolis Life is a great guest speaker. Uniglobe Design Travel Consultants (Buna Macomber) opens its doors for business. October update and brochure for November courses goes out and four cars head North for 5th October workday in Starks.

Internal: Visits and celebrations mark the week with Gary and Pat Drown here from Indianapolis. Tina Slicker goes to Starks and Boston for mid-term break. Phyllis Allard's birthday is celebrated with a trip to the circus and Debra Griffin's birthday is celebrated with a birthday breakfast.

Contradiction: Looking at all we're doing through the screen of the Year of Order Council and creating designs for new actions. (Week 4)

BOSTON-THE STARKS HOUSE

External: Six October Saturday workdays (Nov. 5) in cornshop completes installation of ductwork! Boughs are delivered for Starks Wreath Company to start '83 work. Augusta Luncheon prepares for first Maine Project Documentation Lab. Two bench designs are submitted for key woodwork order possibility. Danforth High Seniors put on big money raising dinner and dance for hunters as season opens (5). The Starks Enterprises Corporation (S.E.C.) holds its final October workday moving towards final push on duct and furnace room with nearly all female crew. Marketer gets samples from woodworks and brochure goes to press. North country business survey planning group begins its work (4).

Contradiction: House space still symbolises last year, discerning the narrow focussed path to Phase III, in midst of innumerable possibilities. (Weeks 2,4)

THE OTTAWA HOUSE

THE MONTREAL HOUSE

External: Father Valiquette, Bishop Trembley and Claude Lalonde dialogue with the Panchayat at the House on the implications of the Church's care for urban society. New age movements, the latest being the Greens, show up on our doorstep in search of animation methods to give form to their vision (3). Habitations Jeanne-Mance organizes daytime bowling league based on stakes, Community rooms with the help of one of Montreal's top lawyers. Sisters of Charity visit the House for a Lorne update and resolution of financial commitments (1).

Internal: Wind up of great Panchayat visit takes the form of Japanese style teriaki feast and a collegium on teamhood from Humphrey Bogart in Treasure of Sirra Madre video (3). Presence of Area Priors occasions two days of planning for Quarter II and beyond, accompanied by development workshop and re-arrangement of office space (1).

Contradiction: Reminding ourselves about engaging others. Keeping the revolutionary Global View and maintaining spiritual context in the midst of the day to day demands. (Week 1,3)

AREA MEXICO CITY

THE MEXICO CITY HOUSE

External: Trip to State of Queretaro is made by House and ICA Board President and NSC member. Network of 35 active village projects initiated by Mexican Foundation for Rural Development shows strong interest in methods of Human Development and local participation in IERD. Manuel works with Mahtews' in Los Reyes community. Youth are committed to bring off Youth Forum and ensure participation from San Camilo. House continues strategy of breakfast and IERD meetings (2). Circuit to State of Queretaro results in likely project for IERD. Local initiative is startling, including care for wider network of villages, mostly in agricultural improvement. Pre-selection committee of NSC meets and invites eight projects from RDS to participate. Letter and questionnaire is sent out. Open door is presented to work in all or any of Fundacion Mexicana's 45 economic projects around the whole nation (3).

Internal: Both Manuel Samayoa and Bill Allerging celebrate birthdays in same week. House inkind 1976 four-door Renault. House gets facelift of rugs and curtains in corporate space (2). Order gives at the sudden death of Araceli Mathews, age 28 on October 12th. Araceli's family, Jim Mathews, Frank Hilliard, Bill and Phyllis Slicker, Dr. Bob Springs and House celebrate her life together (3).

Contradiction: Addressing ourselves to global push on IERD, Order Council and finances reveals utter necessity to intensify local program. Getting commitment from projects to select their own representatives to go to India and participate in Phase III. (Week 2,3)

THE GUATEMALA CITY HOUSE

External: The week is highlighted by the discovery of new colleagues who are deeply committed to the task of the mission in Guatemala, these include: Eng. Victor Ortiz of EMPAGUA who lends his special expertise to the co-op with a refreshing eagerness, the new governor Victor Falla who spends his holiday-time visiting Conacaste and Irma Estrada a preschool teacher from Monte Grande who joins the extension team and sets up the new preschool in a fourth extension village. Julio Aldana from Conacaste accepts a position on the NSC and agrees to go on circuit to El Salvador, visits to APROFAM and MGRR broaden the NSC base; a business trip to Honduras by Rocio and Juan Arce initiates Honduran IERD prep and sparks team to set circuits up for Honduras, Belice and Panama in November for IERD visits to four non-resident Central American countries. The entire team and members of the coop work on development bringing in four new tires, computer software, Q100 from new contact and four appointments for next week.

Internal: Eight collegiums (breakfast and lunch) set team spinning and enable the many-varied tasks, House receives letter from Wilfredo (who is receiving special agriculture training with Iowa Guardian in US), which includes newspaper article on his visit.

Contradiction: Presenting the new avenues that allow all organizations involved (IADB, Technica Hidrolica, Co-op, ICA and other agencies) to be critical creative parts of enabling the future instead of hammering away at each other with "Who's responsible for what". (Week 3)*

AREA HAVANA

THE KINGSTON HOUSE

External: NSC holds two meetings and begins documentation site visits. ICA lectures at University of West Indies in a Community Development course. Woburn Lawn builders travel to Claverty Cottage to donate labour on community centre construction. Two Rotary-ICA committee meetings are held. Cluster circuits are held in Portland, St. Andrew, Yallah's Valley and the Blue Mountains. Thirty colleagues attend Regional Team Meeting to plan circuits and expansion strategy. Panchayat Reception is held at the Pegasus with Ben Kingsley video shown, to 28 "frame" - colleagues.

Internal: Panchayat visit is the highlight; tragic car accident near Woburn Lawn injures several village leaders and kills Alice Wright's niece; House welcomes Jack Silk and two sons and celebrates anniversary and birthdays.

Contradiction: Keeping our nerve while negotiating the symplegidies of three major grants evaluations which are upon us. (Week 2)

AREA LIMA

THE LIMA HOUSE

External: Week of planning scheduled a Foro Campaign to do 24 Foros in two provinces in the next two months at the same time a decision was made to send seven people to the Continental GRA Council and Priorship Training School in Caracas. Fourteen people from the cluster communities decided to be trained to lead the Foros to cover the staffing gap. Visited GAB member Mrs. Belaunde (first lady) with Panchayat and presented a proposal for IERD delegate funding which would have the ICA do programs in her urban "slum" projects. This is a new breakthrough in IERD funding - earning the money by doing programs.

Internal: Panchayat visit called forth a deeper understanding of the task of our Order in History and interns witnessed to their own significant role in this task.

Contradiction: Securing appropriate working office space in Lima to enable the expanding task. (Week 1)

AREA CARACAS

THE CARACAS HOUSE

External: Second to last NSC meeting of 22 people narrows down final project selection for IERD as preparations for November intensity with inkind blitz, facility check, continental travel, arrangements, money search, decor prep, and procedures (4). The House participates in an emphasis on the Phase I dynamic of Caño Negro by aiding the sendout of six junior high students to the Jesuits' Trade School in Merida and participating in a baptism (3). The House hosts a site visit from the Benevolence Committee of The United Christian Church, completes sections of the Spanish Human Development Methods Lab manual and completes the requirements for sending Caño Negro students to the Merida Jesuit School (1).

Internal: Week II Area planning in Caño Negro is held as we count down to the 5-week continental program (4). The Panchayat visit focuses many mini-miracles on creating a demonstration House and inspires reflections on the symbols and history of the Order (3). Six new sojourners are welcomed amidst a celebration for Juan Jose's 20th birthday. House receives a donation of pasta and flour. House self-support venture brings in its first profits (1).

Contradiction: How to gear the November 2-week research assembly, continental council, and three week priorship training school around movement formation in Latin America. Assuming a new style with a balance between priorities and details in proximity of the Continental Research Assembly. Enlarging the human resources of the ICA: Barlovento. (Weeks 1,3,4)

AREA BUENOS AIRES

THE SANTIAGO HOUSE

External: Sol de Septiembre follows up Foro with a meeting with representation of two people from all activities arenas, active or inactive, teams are created to work in eight arenas and the president of the directiva not only uses the methods but also uses the ritual created at the Foro. NSC meeting pulls together Chile statement of criterias for successful Rural Development from RDS and names four of six people to represent Chile in India. Committee also takes on task of translating Kingsley tape for use with development.

Internal: Team has great birthday celebration following second successful marketing meeting. Pumpkin pie is served for Bill's 57 years and chocolate cake for Nancy's 27 years. Translations start flowing as Joaquina arrives from Peru to wait for LA Council visa.

Contradiction: Continuing to maintain and project our spirit of possibility and futuric vision in the midst of the daily vast unknown. (Week 4)

AREA RIO DE JANEIRO

THE RIO DE JANEIRO HOUSE

External: Sixty-five children participate in second annual Children's Day Festival in Braçaña with games, food and slides on dental hygiene. Development team reaches a total of 100 targets on file to be contacted. House receives the Panchayat and is impacted by history and future strategies workshops.

Internal: House receives first Brazilian volunteer, Roberto Baptista da Silva.

Contradiction: Involving the municipal team in fund raising. (Week 2)

GLOBAL NEXUS

THE BRUSSELS NEXUS

External: Week is characterized by victories for IERD, as two Belgian delegates announce their intention to attend, and \$30,000 check arrives from Ford Foundation to enable the countdown to Delhi. Miraculously short timeline enlivens Service Ventures as \$2550 worth of work is sold in Week 4, to be begun in Week 5.

Internal: House and Centurms buzz with activity as our numbers are increased by 18 guests from the globe, including the "Troupe of six" who plug into the IERD taskforce in the same week we plug in a new "RSII" computer with graphics capability. Anne Slicker surprises the House with the gift of a birthday celebration for her 59th year.

Contradiction: Pushing goals, strategies, and tactics into maneuvers that will win in our complex network of priorities. (Week 4)*

THE BOMBAY HOUSE

External: Five people are assigned to MAFATLAL LENS continental training dynamic and enables MAFATLAL to write their corporate story titled "100 Years of Ethical Entrepreneurship". Nine more PDL's are completed for a total of 22 across the continent. New skills Training team moves to Pune facility to rough it while setting up for next school.

Internal: Centrum spaces painted in IERD colors reach out and beckon our engagement in the task. Whole House including EG plays English games at Roundtable, manifesting new levels of skill among our staff.

Contradiction: How to swirl with the Diwali fireworks instead of stopping to look at them. (Week 4)*

HONG KONG NEXUS HOUSE

External: Citibank has opened a new all-glass 50 story building opposite the Nexus building's front door and offers ICA the use of their training rooms, when they get them set up after January. Ten thousand HK dollars comes in from S.C. Johnson. The Roundtable construct for Quarter III is in process following Week II PSU (5). "Integrated circuiters" were sent out to Australia, Korea and Thailand and Papua, New Guinea by programme support strategy guild. Financial services made much progress with computer comprehension. The local development experiment team made a number of calls on potential participants at the local development symposium on November 16 (4).

Internal: Augusta leads great collegium on Buddhism and then leaves for Chicago to take up her assignment after a 3-month wait for visa (5). The Nexus celebrated the life and death of Aracelli Mathews and the birthdays of Ann Duffy (50) and Marsha Stansbury (4).

Contradiction: Ensuring international structures and time designs that will deal with the many universes that seem to be overwhelming the Nexus. Responding to the need to remanoeuvre and intensify the doing under the pressure of deadlines. (Week 4,5)*

THE CHICAGO NEXUS HOUSE

External: United States congressmen and top aides from the states of Washinton, Iowa, Michigan, Maine, North Carolina, and Tennessee along with six news services covering nine states attend a press conference announcing the projects to represent the United States at the Delhi Plenary hosted by Marvin Goldman of the NSC, while similar state press conferences were held in Denver, Phoenix, Kansas City, and Dayton (6).

Internal A problem becomes a gift when the new photocopier breaks down, catalyzing imaginal methods for significant collegiums on finances and the emerging generation.

Contradiction: Implementing support system tactics to stop the existing sapping of momentum. (Week 6)*

GLOBAL OPERATIONS CENTRUM

Global Operations Centrum reports that YOC collegiums lay context for 16 months of continental participation; British Physical Labs offers Nexus one to two hours a day on their computer. NST goes to Pune in prep for next school, electricity is turned on, building cleaned, and five guardians visited. Centruns complete computer use survey in preparation for deciding on an appropriate system; first Wheel of Human Development report is compiled and sent to ashrams. The key contradiction lies in the arena of transforming interchange systems to convey relevance of global participation by all Houses. (Week 4)*

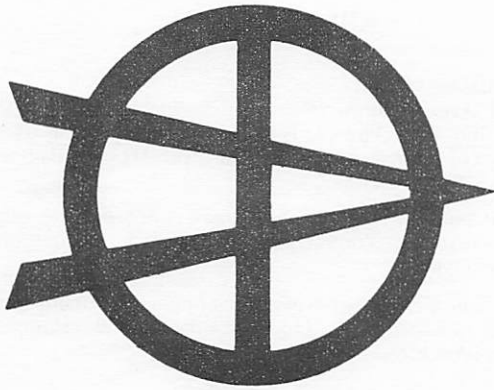
GLOBAL MANAGEMENT CENTRUM

AREA MADRID

THE MADRID HOUSE

External: Development call on Great American Insurance produces donation and confirmed job offer. Sophisticated, spacious ICA office is created. Lots of development appointments are set up for the month of November.

Internal: House experiences busy week as Joey Armas returns from Brussels having spent one month working in Service Ventures, and just in time to celebrate his 29th birthday. Steve Hamje travels through on his way to Portugal and gives exciting report on Ivory Coast; and House moves into occupying the whole third floor of our apartment building.

Contradiction: Weaving several key thrusts into singular strategic momentum. (Week 5)*

LISBON—THE LAMEGO HOUSE

External: Development trip to Lisbon results in 1,000 USD from Wassen, a visit with UNDP where ICA found out that UNFPA in New York wrote the Portuguese government saying it would consider a proposal for funding the Portuguese delegation to the IERD if the Portuguese government would request it. Four cluster villages hold quarterly planning meetings, combined with slides from Brazil. NSC makes final delegate selection and are excited by presentation by three very talented graphics and design people who will prepare U.K. exhibits. Volunteers report on their attendance to rally in London sponsored by the committee for nuclear disarmament.

Internal: Two English volunteers express desire for interning, Sally Ann Bailey leaves for Jamaica as volunteer and sojourners brighten coming weeks' evenings with inkind theatre tickets.

Contradiction: Present and new clarity presses for additional and thoughtful strategy and implementation for rest of quarter. (Week 3)

AREA PARIS

THE PARIS HOUSE

External: House's documentation and funding thrusts are fortified with capability of Robert Leurs to operate in French through setting and keeping appointments and in doing translations, e.g. contact made with Rotary and Lions Clubs, researching and visiting Natural Parks and Rural Centres and International Civil Service re possible projects. Students of North-South Association of Management Institute is committed to work as volunteers. Three or four possible delegations to IERD meet together to plan Exposition displays and expose possibility of IERD coverage by French TV channel.

Internal: Order Forms collegium is enlivened by Robert Leurs and Julie Nicholson's kibbutz experience. Julie performs miracles on apartment windows with creation of new curtains.

Contradiction: Getting to sources for private funding of IERD. (Weeks 2,3)

THE FRANKFURT HOUSE

THE AMSTERDAM HOUSE

External: NSC meets and selects 10 possible projects then breaks into teams of two and three for visits. Four projects are visited the first week revealing hitherto unknown funding possibilities. Regional Council is held with 18 colleagues representing all aspects of the ICA work, creating strategies for the Volunteer Program, courses Roundtables, and IERD.

Internal: Three team members visit Brussels for IE pedagogy and development push. New post box, telephone and office are procured for the region. Geroen Genats has Kate over for lots of singing and schedules first planning session to begin implementing strategies from the Regional Council.

Contradiction: Discerning the clear and eventful steps after project selection that will involve the team and NSC in getting a group off to Delhi. (Weeks 1-3)

Internal: House hosted Panchayat including a visit to the Catacombs of St. Sebastian.

Contradiction: Initiating the quarter plan has made it clear that mid-course correction is required. (Week 4)*

AREA BUDAPEST

THE VIENNA HOUSE

External: Austrian RDS is held in GRAZ with 27 around the table; with leadership provided by Hannerl Golda and NSC members; Mrs. Lugossy, Deputy Director of Institute of Agrarian Economics, Hungary and Lady Lindsay among RDS participants. A visit to Hungary's Ministry of Agriculture assures Hungary's participation in IERD and New Delhi event; two evenings of wine, cheese and Lady Lindsay bring together quite an assortment of Austrian and International personalities; follow-up mailing to RDS is completed and Roundtable uses revised "Bug Model" to introduce Year of Order Council.

Internal: House is enlarged on several occasions with presence of Lady Lindsay, Hannerl Golda, Manfred Golda and colleague, Panchayat, and Mary Kaye Soderlind.

Contradiction: Finding ways to select projects that have their own authorization apart from political and bureaucratic entanglement. (Weeks 4,5,6)*

AREA CAIRO

GIZA — THE EL BAYAD HOUSE

External: HDTI continues to be a powerful impact tool. Eight new participants arrive after the Department of Social Affairs approach ICA to receive National Service Volunteer. Heritage trip to Sakarra and Giza pyramids is highlight, imaginal Education Lab addresses all with process of image change and LE 2000 arrives from Australian Embassy to help maintain momentum of HDTI.

Internal: David Joech arrives from Kenya to give much needed boost to staff. Mahmoud Abdel Rasheed and wife, Laila, arrive to assist with profound humanness course. David Koech's African dance and David Coffman's country western dance give added touch to Egyptian dance celebration. Ragupati becomes favourite song after Ur collegiums

Contradiction: Building corporateness with diverse school group while cultivating and journeying leadership cores with limited guild structures and process. (Weeks 5,6)*

AREA ABIDJAN

THE ABIDJAN HOUSE

External: Evening at the Institute including a showing of the global film with Phillips Petroleum employees leads to monthly contributions of \$500, quarterly project work days and bi-weekly Roundtables.

Internal: New self-support venture is uncovered through English teaching contract possibility with international courier service.

Contradiction: Money development openings, but little time to write new proposals, blocks regularity of development income. (Week 2)

THE LAGOS HOUSE

AREA KINSHASA

THE LUSAKA HOUSE

External: Zambian copy of B. Kingsley video is made by new guardian, visit to Indian Association makes discovery of inexpensive charter flight to New Delhi and whole House participates in Zambia's independence, the 19th year celebration.

Internal: Office space is reconfigured symbolizing New Year launch and Zambian staff participate in fifth presidential election, re-electing K Kaunda for a fifth term.

Contradiction: Co-ordinating new configurations to ensure maximum effectiveness in quarter's operation. (Week 4)*

AREA NAIROBI

THE NAIROBI HOUSE

External: Tremendous Village Leaders' Conference with 51 leaders from Iveti South and North works on three week village leaders' training school, then commitment to begin circuiting as well as selecting representatives for IERD. NSC meeting with representatives from eight projects selected to represent Kenya gives orientation to IERD and invites them to join the NSC. Advanced training school graduates 24 and HDTI #14 opens with 55 students.

Internal: House celebrates Diwali in the midst of comings and goings as David Koesch boards plane for Egypt HDTI, Jim Wiegel leaves for Uganda on way to Bombay. Kenya HDTI participants arrive from Zambia and Mauritius, and two development teams leave for Mombasa.

Contradiction: Using area planning and national project directors' meetings to do careful, long-range planning in the midst of heavy fog still surrounding CRA, IERD, and GRA. (Week 5)*

NAIROBI—THE KABIRO HOUSE

NAIROBI-THE KALWANI-SHAMALAGO HOUSE

External: Week of Consult set-up includes section circuits to two new sites as well as Mundobelwa and Kaganda Houses. Kalwani House circuits home sub-location at Senende and sets Health Training in Ivora. Team speaks to officials and all headmen of a whole location on authorisation trip, spins on resurgence research in Kenya and receives great affirmation of replication scheme.

Internal: Panchayat visit links us up to our globality giving opportunity to renew our sense of being an experiment on behalf of the two million villages as well as new challenge of modifying Quarter II timeline so the intensification we've planned can be a victory!

Contradiction: Doing a full quarter's work in 10 weeks with little flexibility in numbers of staff and assuring time to refresh. (Week 2)

NAIROBI-THE MUGUMOINI HOUSE

External: All Kigumo division "B" villages are circuited as Kampi Ja Motto Authorization came out fine and Naaro Sub-Location Extension is compiled (5). Villages "A" 24 of them circuited and Muthithi Location Health Advanced Training is done with 77 participants (4).

Internal: House holds a big celebration without a disco and sends Anastacia Nsjeri to Kampi Ja Motto set up. Community Centre's window is fixed plus pillars (5). Mugumoini hosted new Stanley workday, 250 participated. House hosted Section "B" directors meetings. House receives Ibrahim Muriuki from Ngararia Village meeting and sends Daniel Ndoto and Marika Tee to Ngararia Impact and Bernard Misati to HDTI as a faculty (4).

Contradiction: Operating on the circuit schedule in the midst of leaders engagement to coffee picking and weeding maize and beans. Extending programmes in the midst of unclear context to the village leaders. (Weeks 4,5)*

MOMBASA-THE KAMWELANI HOUSE

External: The Kamweleni House last week had a fantastic time of covering villages in symbolic circuit within two weeks time with only 25 circuiters which were divided into 18 teams. Within two weeks they came out with 194 participants for VLC seminar which takes place on Monday 1-3-1983 to 3-3-1983 at KTS. Still the House sends two staff that is Larry Philbrook accompanied by John Kivi, section gun John Kivuva for the set of Mbiuni impact. The two staff also made visits to two D.O.'s to invite them for the closing of the VLC seminar.

Internal: Regarding this quarter the section C hosted the projects directors meeting. Kamweleni House with 14 directors, the main agendas were mainly the activities of the past and present quarters. Up to this present time the Kamweleni House erected a house which has a collegium room and other two rooms. Eight hundred KS have been secured for this new building. Besides the new building, the new beds have also been made for the couples which measure 3' 3" x 6' 4". Several work days were done but the main one was a 10 hour workday of laying a concrete disco. Because of programmes in Kamweleini training school, Kamweleni House has sent out Allan Bingham, Nzilani Mutua, Larry Philbrook to ATS. Also many wafula. EEverlyne Phillbrook being a full time ICA member, she arranged a celebration for all members in the House in respect to his birthday to which everyone was served with two bottles of sodas and a chocolate cake. The House is now operating dynamically to resume normal House structures.

Contradiction: The Kamweleni former staff story has affected most of the ongoing activities and how to eradicate the images which the community has been a hardship. (Week 4)*

AREA BOMBAY

BOMBAY-THE MALIWADA HOUSE

External: Eye camp is held in Maliwada Human Development Training Institute where 250 patients participate from cluster is checked and 35 eye operations are done by Dr. S.M. Shetye and his students of Ghati Medical College Aurangabad, and care for the patients for seven days with supplying free medicine. Health film is shown by this college too.

Internal: House cleaning creates the identity system at Diwali festival. Collegiums on seven revolutions; charting paper of image and artform method and conversation reminds us how to lead a group. Asharam hosted the guests, Mr. and Mrs. Vijaysingh Barase, the retired major of army from Aurangabad.

Contradiction: Linking of people from Diwali discontinuity to Week 6 effective action. (Week 4)*

BOMBAY-THE CHIKHALE HOUSE

External: House and cluster experience a week of activities including home science demonstration (22 village women and 12 students and lecturer from SNTD women's university); bank loan meeting to discuss loans for villagers below poverty line (Canara Bank mgrs., Block Dec. officer, village leaders and villagers, 30 in all) photo tableau by RCF Fertilizer Co. (villagers, ICA staff, bank Mgrs. and RCF rep.) in demonstration rice plot and two of the House Priors, Hiriman Kakone and Nancy Lanphear attend Area Meeting and PDL in Jawale.

Internal: Joining the move from "greasy plastic" the House manifests intentionality with Hindalium plates and cups. Mattresses for all and an iron to keep us looking neat and trim; holds celebration in honour of Khajagari festival; and participates in an internal Shramdan (workday) to do drainage ditches and walls of bathroom.

Contradiction: Looking at our past experience and deciding how to move with new strength in the cluster and block. (Week 3)

BOMBAY-THE VAVIHARSH HOUSE

External: Tree plantation programme is completed. Three hundred people participate in Health Camp. Work on tap water scheme for Vaviharsh village is going very well. Internal: Vaviharsh staff participate in Chikhale CSI cultural study. Pinto Babote's birthday is celebrated, 150 people participate from cluster village. Annual Appeal plan and materials are received.

Contradiction: (no contradiction or week submitted Week ?)

PUNE-THE JAWALE HOUSE

Contradiction: How to engage all the shops when we don't have coming Quarter plan. (Week 13)

NAGPUR—THE TEMBHURWAHI HOUSE

External: Denada Sociaties distribution loan for 21 people in the cluster. We celebrated Gandhi's birthday on 2nd Oct. and visited Manohav Sapre (district member M.S.E.B.) and submitted proposal for Cluster Village Electricity.

Internal: New volunteer from England arrived in ashram. Mr. Chate, Police Sub-Inspector visits Ashram.

Contradiction: Circuit cluster people are busy in the field. How to engage them with 4-sector work all together. (Week 2)

NAGPUR—THE DABHAD HOUSE

AREA DELHI

THE DELHI HOUSE

External: Annual Appeal is completed tripling last year's bottomline and the number of donors in the Area. Manoeuvring for Phase II of the Quarter accelerates cluster activities with formation of 5-village leadership structure, the exploration of site for training centre/ICA residence construction and a move on visible development signs. Intensive circuit across Area sets up six PDL events and four RDS's are scheduled for next month. Block Development Officer (BDO) visits House and assures full support while government finishes 3-village survey for flood water outlet system.

Internal: Kris Kuchera arrives as volunteer for six months. Battacharya children are enrolled in school with hostel. Self-support is off to good start with rupees 5,000 in hand for Bata Supervisors Course. Dinner out in Faridabad makes for great celebration of week's work.

Contradiction: After deciding PDL as number 1 priority for the next four weeks, launching critical cluster manoeuvres while PDL schedule is still unclear. (Week 1)

AREA MADRAS

THE BANGALORE HOUSE

External: Six out of 14 Project Description Laboratories in the four states of Southern India are completed and the rest on track to be completed by November 6th. Area Development is close to surpassing the annual total of the last two years in week three of Quarter II, with two 10,000 rupee gifts from Madras, 200,000 rupees working and a realistic plan for 400,000 in the works. Jamshedpur trip confirms Imaginal Education Seminar with 50 heads and deputy heads of Tisco Schools for October (1).

Internal: One day discontinuity "Muhrram" (Muslim Festival) launched a dispersed week with teams leaving for PDL's, Imaginal Educational and Bombay LENS, leaving one adult and four children to hold the fort (4). The huge "Durga Puja" holiday allows House to create new decor, blackboard, office shelves and E.G. room set up (2). The new time design for the Quarter is launched and highlighted by an individual/corporate study night and one day family festivities (1).

Contradiction: Maintaining the balance between internal and external demands. Configuring ourselves to handle strategically an Imaginal Education Course, PDL and continental LENS assignment. Maintaining programme momentum in the midst of major puja festivities. (Weeks 1,2,4)

AREA SINGAPORE

THE JAKARTA HOUSE

External: We send the whole set-up team to the first Rural Development Interchange Workshop (RDIW) in Medan, set for Oct. 10. New, streamlined RDIW facilitation and follow-up schedule is designed, and all of the materials are created to enable the meetings. One module on Clerical Management sold to a major multi-national, first of twelve targeted for the year.

Contradiction: Coordinating five teams into one mission at the same time orienting 11 new staff. (Week 3)

Internal: House has party to celebrate Jack's 39th birthday.

Contradiction: Locating the gas to power our IERD Implementation Vehicle. (Week 4)

THE TAIPEI HOUSE

External: A trip to Kaohsiung Region results in former LENS client holding a one day PSU for Chinese management staff; a visit to Hai Ou to see completed seawall and newly painted community center with tile front and conversation with village leader reveals a new folk dance group has been organized and the health clinic is open two days/week & staffed by nurses; a one-day training program with the Fang Liao Farmers Association is set; and helpful conversation with Ms. Chiu of Ping Tung Department of Social Affairs. Internal: The Lorimor team comes down to participate in an Order Day, which ends with a celebration of David's birthday. YES gets a design conference from Marge Tomlinson.

Contradiction: Creating story of our mission as youth in Order and community. (Week 6)*

LORIMOR HDP

External: Lee Early and Marge Tomlinson on LENS International trek to KC., Des Moines, Omaha and Lincoln give us ways to go to corporations we only dreamed of going to before.. Discover spirit giants and develop high level relationships invaluable for long range strategy. West Bend UMC presentation and Emmetsburg Pre-design Conference requests which suggest first really possible county-wide consultation and demonstration in Region.

Internal: Order Day in KC intensifies process for us of responsible strategic analysis and action re YOC. Order youth participation injects new creativity.

Contradiction: Rendering up all priorities people are living out of for the sake of one regional strategic picture. (Week 6)*

THE MINNEAPOLIS HOUSE

External: One Annual Appeal call nets \$400 check and the concern to introduce ICA to their church and friends before they move away. Another Annual Appeal letter nets \$1,000 check all the way from the Kirchs' in Kirachi. New maneuver to talk with Chambers of Commerces set up one program in Austin and the possibility of more. Regional colleague proposes a vision for broad-based economic planning and development throughout the state of Minnesota.

Internal: House celebrates Order fast with context and reflection using the NRM charts with a little bit of Tillich thrown in for good measure.

Contradiction: Getting through the organizational jam to implementation without getting stuck in the peanut butter. (Week 5)*

THE DETROIT HOUSE

External: The community of Bangor is overwhelmed at it's events after holding it's first project description lab. A letter from the Mt. Carmel Hospital Executive praises LENS as key tool in their work this year (5). Governor Blanchard proclaims November first as Rural Success Day. Bill Holland visits, looking for useful screens to use for the community development project and appointments are made with Ford, the Health Care Association and the Mt. Carmel Hospital (4). Virginia Stranahan gives \$1500 and a verification visit is made to Bangor confirming last steps in representing Bangor in IERD (in India) (3). A design conference, a marketing workshop and a LENS International meeting are held throughout the week. A regional colleague, Ken Smith, runs 26 miles in a marathon (2).

Internal: A new typewriter and two large pizzas are inkinded. The video "Sophie's Choice" and pizzas help celebrate Jean Blackledges 52nd birthday (5). Halloween party is a success with the youth as coordinators. Roundtable is looked at as a great event with the use of a rationale screen. Roundtables become eventful happenings with movies, outside or special evenings and guests preparing conversations (4). The Panchayat visit turns into a great event with a guided tour of every room in the House with hors d'oeuvres and stories. Andy Lanphear comes in first and second in a school swim meet (3). A women's night is held looking at historical women's journeys following a reflection on Judy Chicago's dinner party (2).

Contradiction: Finding the focus that can engage regional colleagues in the multiple aspects of the Year of Order Council. Coordinating various planning schedules and details into one common image that will release the regional team. An unfocused maneuver for regional team blocks catalytic team effort. No contradiction week 2 (Weeks 2,3,4,5)*

THE INDIANAPOLIS HOUSE

External: Missional Family Cluster "orientation" weekend pilot-structure has been tested and a slightly revised rerun is scheduled for December 9 and 10. Dyson's take Elder Power model to Dallas for consideration of the East Side Parish and present paper on "community health" to American Public Health Association convention. Director of The Day Before project does collegium over breakfast, House sees private screening of "The Day After" and leads several community leaders in art form conversation.

Internal: Training Inc. staff go to Chicago for In-Service day of training and also does a team miracle in producing a major proposal for next cycle funding before deadline.

Contradiction: Discovering the mythology for Phase III that releases a mass movement. (Week 6)*

AREA NEW YORK

THE NEW YORK HOUSE

External: Loisaida Employment Taskforce meeting has 32 people in attendance with representation from the NY State Department of Commerce and NY City Department of Employment. Individual guilds decide to meet to accomplish their assignments before next taskforce meeting. New York Region Annual Report is completed and mailed to entire mailing list.

Internal: House is filled with boarders from Japan, Germany, Australia, Brooklyn, Chicago and Caracas. Longer term boarders volunteer to assist in building renovations

Contradiction: Breaking through gap in development income with only one third September program check earned. (Week 2)

THE ROCHESTER HOUSE

External: Co-sponsors of "Approaches That Work Conference" give nominations for presenters. Invitations to that conference are mailed. A two hour workshop "Eating Better for Less" is led by Regional Team as a part of the Institute of Man and Science's "Help Yourself to Health in the Hilltowns" program.

Internal: The House celebrates the end of a busy week by going to see "The Right Stuff" and nine metro colleagues are present at House Church celebrating Alice Rose's entry into phase II.

Contradiction: Setting up site visits in the midst of busy schedules and vacation days. (Week 5)*

THE WASHINGTON HOUSE

External: One thousand four hundred and seventy dollars in Annual Appeal money comes in this week—\$800 of it is a contribution from a Baltimore artist who donated the proceeds from her recent art sale. Invitations to the first IERD benefit are mailed, and first returns come in after two days with 20 people saying "yes" and \$385 in-hand. Program PSU produces a unifying symbol on the next 16 months as well as a plan for Quarter II. Private agencies in International Development (P.A.I.D.) call to remind us that we've missed recent meetings and they've missed us!

Internal: Quarter II House life manual is completed and experimental time design is implemented. Hostelry program receives request from Philadelphia Lutheran Seminary for housing for 15 people Nov. 6-11 during 500th birthday celebration of Martin Luther.

Contradiction: Making Order assignments which create the interface that releases people to do the tasks before us this quarter. (Week 1)

THE BOSTON HOUSE

External: A \$100,000 week for Boston Training Inc. as Old Smith Church commits \$20,000, Bay State Skills Corporation \$72,000 and BP at John Hancock hosts sophisticated presentation for Boston businesses on the 60th floor of the Hancock. Gary Drown, VP at Indianapolis Life is a great guest speaker. Uniglobe Design Travel Consultants (Buna Macomber) opens its doors for business. October update and brochure for November courses goes out and four cars head North for 5th October workday in Starks.

Internal: Visits and celebrations mark the week with Gary and Pat Drown here from Indianapolis. Tina Slicker goes to Starks and Boston for mid-term break, Phyllis Allard's birthday is celebrated with a trip to the circus and Debra Griffin's birthday is celebrated with a birthday breakfast.

Contradiction: Looking at all we're doing through the screen of the Year of Order Council and creating designs for new actions. (Week 4)

BOSTON-THE STARKS HOUSE

External: Six October Saturday workdays (Nov. 5) in cornshop completes installation of ductwork! Boughs are delivered for Starks Wreath Company to start '83 work. Augusta Luncheon prepares for first Maine Project Documentation Lab. Two bench designs are submitted for key woodwork order possibility. Danforth High Seniors put on big money raising dinner and dance for hunters as season opens (5). The Starks Enterprises Corporation (S.E.C.) holds its final October workday moving towards final push on duct and furnace room with nearly all female crew. Marketer gets samples from woodworks and brochure goes to press. North country business survey planning group begins its work (4).

Internal: Tim gets \$1500 scholarship for school; Judy takes Rob to Little Peeps School - 1st time; workday participants are ICA intern possibilities; House celebrates week by seeing movie "The Grey Fox" (5). Halloween costumes country dance with prizes and a live band is great closing to a fine workday and even a money marker for S.E.C.(4).

Contradiction: Giving form to conversations on Order Future so they have a possibility of making a difference. Keeping several steps ahead of winter winds. (Week 4,5)

AREA MONTREAL

THE TORONTO HOUSE

External: First LENS of the year is successfully completed with Graham Fiberglass, Ltd. Representatives from every level of the company participated. The three selected Ontario projects for Delhi confirm their intent to participate. Development circuit uncovers promising "B" money leads (4). Open House showing of Kingsley and RDS videos to 17 people produces many good contacts and \$1200 in pledges plus a dentist who will do teeth under IDS policy. House experiences abounding of "A" money as the next two program checks are assured. A visit to Owen Sound produces the possibility of a LENS with the Concerned Farm Women plus a registration for the Facilitator Training Course. A site visit with the Panchayat to the Mississauga Condominium shows how a forum two years ago has resulted in continued active community care (3).

Internal: Week II on LENS marketing is capped off by House visit to the Kleinburg gallery to see an excellent collection of Canadian art. THE MONTREAL HOUSE

External: One Maritime trek is completed with seven case studies in hand while another begins with a whirlwind week of project description labs. Twenty people attend a Planetary Initiative planning session inaugurating our use of the "store front" study hall next door. Four of the Habitations Jeanne-Mance gardeners represent their project with a display at the Salon d'Agriculture at the Olympic Stadium.

Internal: Week of celebrations is highlighted by a big pumpkin supper on Hallowe'en night, duck à l'orange for Doug Allan's 51st birthday, and the gathering of about 15 people from the neighbourhood and the Planetary Initiatives meeting for a party at the House. First snow arrives.

Contradiction: Creating one mission out of an amazing diversity of recent and established colleagues. (Week 5)*

AREA MEXICO CITY

THE MEXICO CITY HOUSE

External: Trip to State of Queretaro is made by House and ICA Board President and NSC member. Network of 35 active village projects initiated by Mexican Foundation for Rural Development shows strong interest in methods of Human Development and local participation in IERD. Manuel works with Mathews' in Los Reyes community. Youth are committed to bring off Youth Forum and ensure participation from San Camilo. House continues strategy of breakfast and IERD meetings (2). Circuit to State of Queretaro results in likely project for IERD. Local initiative is startling, including care for wider network of villages, mostly in agricultural improvement. Pre-selection committee of NSC meets and invites eight projects from RDS to participate. Letter and questionnaire is sent out. Open door is presented to work in all or any of Fundacion Mexicana's 45 economic projects around the whole nation (3).

Internal: Both Manuel Samayoa and Bill Allerging celebrate birthdays in same week. House inkind 1976 four-door Renault. House gets facelift of rugs and curtains in corporate space (2). Order grives at the sudden death of Araceli Mathews, age 28 on October 12th. Araceli's family, Jim Mathews, Frank Hilliard, Bill and Phyllis Slicker, Dr. Bob Springs and House celebrate her life together (3).

Contradiction: Addressing ourselves to global push on IERD, Order Council and finances reveals utter necessity to intensify local program. Getting commitment from projects to select their own representatives to go to India and participate in Phase III. (Week 2,3)

THE GUATEMALA CITY HOUSE

External: The week is highlighted by the discovery of new colleagues who are deeply committed to the task of the mission in Guatemala, these include: Eng. Victor Ortiz of EMPAGUA who lends his special expertise to the co-op with a refreshing eagerness, the new governor Victor Falla who spends his holiday-time visiting Conacaste and Irma Estrada a preschool teacher from Monte Grande who joins the extension team and sets up the new preschool in a fourth extension village. Julio Aldana from Conacaste accepts a position on the NSC and agrees to go on circuit to El Salvador, visits to APROFAM and MGRR broaden the NSC base; a business trip to Honduras by Rocio and Juan Arce initiates Honduran IERD prep and sparks team to set circuits up for Honduras, Belice and Panama in November for IERD visits to four non-resident Central American countries. The entire team and members of the coop work on development bringing in four new tires, computer software, Q100 from new contact and four appointments for next week.

Internal: Eight collegiums (breakfast and lunch) set team spinning and enable the many-varied tasks, House receives letter from Wilfredo (who is receiving special agriculture training with Iowa Guardian in US), which includes newspaper article on his visit.

Contradiction: Presenting the new avenues that allow all organizations involved (IADB, Technica Hidrolica, Co-op, ICA and other agencies) to be critical creative parts of enabling the future instead of hammering away at each other with "Who's responsible for what". (Week 3)

AREA HAVANA

THE KINGSTON HOUSE

External: NSC holds two meetings and begins documentation site visits. ICA lectures at University of West Indies in a Community Development course. Woburn Lawn builders travel to Claverty Cottage to donate labour on community centre construction. Two Rotary-ICA committee meetings are held. Cluster circuits are held in Portland, St. Andrew, Yallah's Valley and the Blue Mountains. Thirty colleagues attend Regional Team Meeting to plan circuits and expansion strategy. Panchayat Reception is held at the Pegasus with Ben Kingsley video shown to 28 "frame" - colleagues.

Internal: Panchayat visit is the highlight; tragic car accident near Woburn Lawn injures several village leaders and kills Alice Wright's niece; House welcomes Jack Silk and two sons and celebrates anniversary and birthdays.

Contradiction: Keeping our nerve while negotiating the symplegidies of three major grants evaluations which are upon us. (Week 2)

AREA LIMA

THE LIMA HOUSE

External: Week of planning scheduled a Foro Campaign to do 24 Foros in two provinces in the next two months at the same time a decision was made to send seven people to the Continental GRA Council and Priorship Training School in Caracas. Fourteen people from the cluster communities decided to be trained to lead the Foros to cover the staffing gap. Visited GAB member Mrs. Belaunde (first lady) with Panchayat and presented a proposal for IERD delegate funding which would have the ICA do programs in her urban "slum" projects. This is a new breakthrough in IERD funding - earning the money by doing programs.

Internal: Panchayat visit called forth a deeper understanding of the task of our Order in History and interns witnessed to their own significant role in this task.

Contradiction: Securing appropriate working office space in Lima to enable the expanding task. (Week 1)

AREA CARACAS

THE CARACAS HOUSE

External: Second to last NSC meeting of 22 people narrows down final project selection for IERD as preparations for November intensity with inkind blitz, facility check, continental travel, arrangements, money search, decor prep, and procedures (4). The House participates in an emphasis on the Phase I dynamic of Caño Negro by aiding the sendout of six junior high students to the Jesuits' Trade School in Merida and participating in a baptism (3). The House hosts a site visit from the Benevolence Committee of The United Christian Church, completes sections of the Spanish Human Development Methods Lab manual and completes the requirements for sending Caño Negro students to the Merida Jesuit School (1).

Internal: Week II Area planning in Caño Negro is held as we count down to the 5-week continental program (4). The Panchayat visit focuses many mini-miracles on creating a demonstration House and inspires reflections on the symbols and history of the Order (3). Six new sojourners are welcomed amidst a celebration for Juan Jose's 20th birthday. House receives a donation of pasta and flour. House self-support venture brings in its first profits (1).

Contradiction: How to gear the November 2-week research assembly, continental council, and three week priorship training school around movement formation in Latin America. Assuming a new style with a balance between priorities and details in proximity of the Continental Research Assembly. Enlarging the human resources of the ICA: Barlovento. (Weeks 1,3,4)

AREA BUENOS AIRES

THE SANTIAGO HOUSE

External: All day presentation including workshops and spins initiates great interest at our first presentation at the NGO meeting. Youth Foro is held in Lampa and date is set for another Community Foro for next Saturday. Key is all are being done by local people. Catholic University calls and says yes we will translate the Kingsley video into Spanish and probably will show it on Channel 13 (6). Team sends out three persons to participate in the GRA, Continental Council and International School of Prior training in Caracas, Venezuela. Conversation with educational consultant of Center of Investigation and Development of Education helps keep the exchange of ideas flowing (4).

Internal: Directiva in Sol requests an emphasis on some kind of symbolic life for them and with three of our five in Caracas and most of the time one of the team in Sol and one in Santiago we understand what they are saying (6)! Viewing the film "Excalibur" and participating in a reflective conversation helps set the context for active participation in the research assembly of myths in Venezuela (4).

Contradiction: Holding the tension of fine programs and still using the programs to be indepth training for our extension team. Remembering our global context in the midst of the daily local thrusts. (Week 6)*

AREA RIO DE JANEIRO

THE RIO DE JANEIRO HOUSE

External: Long hours of development strategizing begin to reap results as GAB member writes introductory letter to 20 companies, and very promising call with R.J. Reynolds offers hope for private sector participation in IERD travel. Rio Bonito municipal team meets and devises plan for the economic undergirding of the rural help program.

Internal: House celebrates Mark Welch's birthday with luscious chocolate pie. His chief birthday present: an intensive course in Portuguese! Diann Porter is sent out to Caracas for Continental Council and GRA. Bill Slicker is here for development.

Contradiction: Prioritizing time in such a way that momentum is maintained on critical missional fronts. (Weeks 3,4)*

GLOBAL NEXUS

THE BRUSSELS NEXUS

External: IERD taskforce completes comprehensive delegate tracking system while the magnificent seven design an ICA brochure to inform European Religious Orders of our service and style.

Internal: For the Year of Order Council we study Order Ritual Life, past, present, and future, getting insights into the history of our guests, the global mobilization healers, through their collegium.

Contradiction: Intuition without action on functional systems to allow the whole mission to move into a new position by January, or, how to have three teams share lunch while climbing separate mountains. (Week 5)*

THE BOMBAY HOUSE

External: Five people are assigned to MAFATLAL LENS continental training dynamic and enables MAFATLAL to write their corporate story titled "100 Years of Ethical Entrepreneurship". Nine more PDL's are completed for a total of 22 across the continent. New skills Training team moves to Pune facility to rough it while setting up for next school.

Internal: Centrum spaces painted in IERD colors reach out and beckon our engagement in the task. Whole House including EG plays English games at Roundtable, manifesting new levels of skill among our staff.

Contradiction: How to swirl with the Diwali fireworks instead of stopping to look at them. (Week 4)

HONG KONG NEXUS HOUSE

External: Citibank has opened a new all-glass 50 story building opposite the Nexus building's front door and offers ICA the use of their training rooms, when they get them set up after January. Ten thousand HK dollars comes in from S.C. Johnson. The Roundtable construct for Quarter III is in process following Week II PSU (5). "Integrated circuiters" were sent out to Australia, Korea and Thailand and Papua, New Guinea by programme support strategy guild. Financial services made much progress with computer comprehension. The local development experiment team made a number of calls on potential participants at the local development symposium on November 16 (4).

Internal: Augusta leads great collegium on Buddhism and then leaves for Chicago to take up her assignment after a 3-month wait for visa (5). The Nexus celebrated the life and death of Aracelli Mathews and the birthdays of Ann Duffy (50) and Marsha Stansbury (4).

Contradiction: Ensuring international structures and time designs that will deal with the many universes that seem to be overwhelming the Nexus. Responding to the need to remanoeuvre and intensify the doing under the pressure of deadlines. (Week 4,5)

THE CHICAGO NEXUS HOUSE

External: Affirmative public responses and participation is evidenced in confirmed contract with LENS International, emerging continental inkind guild, and detailed tracking of IERD participants, facilitators, delegates and income.

Internal: House receives a surge of new vitality as the guild experiment stabilizes, as experienced through the event of the total Nexus winterization and renovation project, YOC collegium and evening guild studies.

Contradiction: Locating and rapidly cultivating from among new contacts the funding sources to assure November cash flow. (Week 7)*

NST goes to Pune in prep for next school, electricity is turned on, building cleaned, and five guardians visited. Centruns complete computer use survey in preparation for deciding on an appropriate system; first Wheel of Human Development report is compiled and sent to ashrams. The key contradiction lies in the arena of transforming interchange systems to convey relevance of global participation by all Houses. (Week 4)*

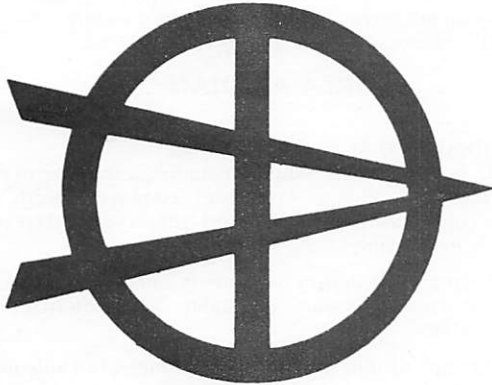
GLOBAL MANAGEMENT CENTRUM

AREA MADRID

THE MADRID HOUSE

External: A visit to GAB member (F. Elzaburo) results in getting our first delegate to the IERD in India. The ICA registration documents, a yearly extension process arrived this week from the Ministry of Interior. The first 10,000 ptas. development cheque was received (6). Circuit to Salamanca with PDL in El Cabaco completes five of the eight scheduled. Submission of first request for financial subvention \$13,000 is completed with all legal forms and bureaucratic forms in paper order (4).

Internal: The House received the Panchyat w/c resulted to House reflection, documenting, and creating the story of the region. The reception was attended by 10 colleagues plus House staff and saw Ben Kingsley movie for the first time. This was made possible by using colleague's color t.v. and video machine. The House hosted the Panchayat with a great Spanish dinner in the famous "Plaza Mayor" and went to see the "Flamenco dance", ending with the team singing "OLE!!! at 3:30 a.m.(6). House sends out 50 Panchayat reception invitations. Self-support income for October ensures Oct. and Nov. House checks and stipends. Acquisition of new apartment enables new creation of House space. Mary Kay is sent out for three and a half week permeation trek (4).

Contradiction: Getting the next thrust of IERD consolidated to release energy in other arenas. Breaking loose self-support and development victories. (Weeks 4,6)*

LISBON—THE LAMEGO HOUSE

External: Twelve Portuguese are trained and go on the road with ICA to do five cluster implementation meetings, add one new village to the cluster and attend international conference on rural agriculture in Coimbra. Agriculture University site visit chooses community greenhouse land to give concretion to Dutch Embassy grant. Cluster newspaper is printed and acquires local journalists in every village (6). Two PDL's are set up, in one village of Branja do Tedo and one with the agricultural university in Vila Real, launching the Montemuro IERD documentation. Mezio Roundtable continues to attract more villagers to study and plan bi-weekly (5).

Internal: House proudly announces the birth of Stefan Alexander, four and a half kilos, 53 cms. on November 10. Steve Hamje arrives and Andrea, German volunteer, joins staff (6). Harvest season brings village donations to giant squash, potatoes, beans and a huge rabbit, as training centre construction continues in the rain (5).

Contradiction: Changing focus from radical external cluster expenditure to deal with internal life and the upcoming Panchayat visit. Finding the right government channel to get the money in time to go to the IERD. (Weeks 5,6)*

AREA LONDON

THE LONDON HOUSE

External: Two final PDLs are completed as House holds open evening. NSC makes final delegate selection and are excited by presentation by three very talented graphics and design people who will prepare U.K. exhibits. Volunteers report on their attendance to rally in London sponsored by the committee for nuclear disarmament.

Internal: Two English volunteers express desire for interning. Sally Ann Bailey leaves for Jamaica as volunteer and sojourners brighten coming weeks' evenings with inkind theatre tickets.

Contradiction: Present and new clarity presses for additional and thoughtful strategy and implementation for rest of quarter. (Week 3)

AREA PARIS

THE PARIS HOUSE

External: Encouraging noises from Minister of Co-op keep spirits and momentum high in IERD preparations.

Internal: The great debate on How Our Thinking Has Changed in the last ten years (it is 10 years since the Paris House opened) is launched with resounding discoveries on all sides.

Contradiction: Over-dependence on public sector for IERD funding. (Week 4)*

THE FRANKFURT HOUSE

THE AMSTERDAM HOUSE

External: NSC meets and selects 10 possible projects then breaks into teams of two and three for visits. Four projects are visited the first week revealing hither to unknown funding possibilities. Regional Council is held with 18 colleagues representing all aspects of the ICA work, creating strategies for the Volunteer Program, courses Roundtables, and IERD.

THE ROME HOUSE

External: A development blitz with 13 appointments with general council members results in Lit. 100,000 in hand, \$3,000 committed and \$22,000 working (6). The highlight of the week is appointed with former New Jersey congresswoman, Millicent Fenwick who is the new U.S. representative to FAO. Also important were meetings with the superiors of the missionaries of the Precious Blood and the Sister of the Holy Family of Wazanela (5).

Internal: The arrival of three British volunteers bring new life to the House as they become familiar with the strange new culture of the ICA (6). Mid-quarter planning begins amidst preparations for the arrival of development team and volunteers (5).

Contradiction: Keeping development blitz moving while forging out Italian face of the mission. Using current troop and vantage to shift from maintenance and financial issues to missional thrust. (Week 5,6)*

AREA BUDAPEST

THE VIENNA HOUSE

External: Austrian RDS is held in GRAZ with 27 around the table; with leadership provided by Hannerl Golda and NSC members: Mrs. Lugossy, Deputy Director of Institute of Agrarian Economics, Hungary and Lady Lindsay among RDS participants. A visit to Hungary's Ministry of Agriculture assures Hungary's participation in IERD and New Delhi event; two evenings of wine, cheese and Lady Lindsay bring together quite an assortment of Austrian and International personalities; follow-up mailing to RDS is completed and Roundtable uses revised "Bug Model" to introduce Year of Order Council.

Internal: House is enlarged on several occasions with presence of Lady Lindsay, Hannerl Golda, Manfred Golda and colleague, Panchayat, and Mary Kaye Soderlind.

Contradiction: Finding ways to select projects that have their own authorization apart from political and bureaucratic entanglement. (Weeks 4,5,6)

AREA CAIRO

GIZA — THE EL BAYAD HOUSE

External: HDTI profound humanness course enables depth reflection on Life's Journey. Mahmoud Abdel Rasheed's teaching, translation, and reflection on the course is very enabling to faculty and participants. The half-way point of the Ten-week school is marked by celebration in Beni Suef.

Internal: Order Day collegium on impact and demonstration systems pushes House to reflect on over all missional thrust.

Contradiction: Determining the "turn of the dial" that is necessary in the HDTI to elicit depth decisions in second five weeks when intensive teaching load on four faculty seems to allow little "brooding" time. (Week 7)*

AREA ABIDJAN

THE ABIDJAN HOUSE

External: Evening at the Institute including a showing of the global film with Phillips Petroleum employees leads to monthly contributions of \$500, quarterly project work days and bi-weekly Roundtables.

Internal: New self-support venture is uncovered through English teaching contract possibility with international courier service.

Contradiction: Money development openings, but little time to write new proposals, blocks regularity of development income. (Week 2)

AREA LAGOS

THE LAGOS HOUSE

AREA KINSHASA

THE LUSAKA HOUSE

External: A week of "action on all fronts" began with a two day circuit to Kabwe by expansion task force for Village Expansion Authorization. This resulted in an introductory letter to villages and an invitation by the District Governor to work in clusters of his 1500 villages. Development's victories included Kwacha 1100 in hand for week, working with three NSC meetings relating to funding and selection. The first document action was held at Mazabuka while the first Assembly at Rapini for 18 months with sections and new action guild formed.

Internal: discussion and decisions related to local volunteer training programmes names five volunteers from Kitwe and Lusaka to a six month training programme.

Contradiction: Developing working relationships with the Diamond and newly elected board (CDA) and Douros Neet put us in a new position of advantage. (Week 6)*

AREA NAIROBI

THE NAIROBI HOUSE

External: Week of intensive work at Kamweleni training centre with National Project Directors meeting. Highlighted with a day of DOOP review and HDTI No. 14 completing its first week with 57 people representing nine Kenya Districts and four nations. IERD team to Uganda makes first visit to that region beyond anyone's memory as first step on trip to Uganda, Botswana, and Lesotho. Major strides are taken in securing a four year grant from the government as bi-lateral interest is shown by the Canadians, Swedish and Dutch.

Internal: Jim Wiegel is sent out to Delhi for IERD with visits to African contries with Shirley Heckman in most of Shanker and Dhondiram Wiegel's sixth birthday.

Contradiction: In most of truck theft, undergirding programme activities with adequate transport and cash flow. (Week 7)*

NAIROBI—THE KABIRO HOUSE

NAIROBI-THE KALWANI-SHAMALAGO HOUSE

External: Health training in Banja Sub-location graduated 20 health care takers. VLI is scheduled in Kisa and the staff circuited eight Sub-locations in Hanrisi Division.

Internal: House sent seven staff to the National Directors meeting including Area Planning. The House also sent Robert and Julie to another project and lastly the circuiters returned to the House

Contradiction: Having government schedules coming into contact with the planned programmes. (Week 6)*

NAIROBI—THE MUGUMOINI HOUSE

External: All Kigumo division "B" villages are circuited as Kampi Ja Motto Authorization came out fine and Naaro Sub-Location Extension is compiled (5). Villages "A" 24 of them circuited and Muthithi Location Health Advanced Training is done with 77 participants (4).

Internal: House holds a big celebration without a disco and sends Annastacia Nsjeri to Kampi Ja Motto set up. Community Centre's window is fixed plus pillars (5). Mugumoini hosted new Stanley workday, 250 participated. House hosted Section "B" directors meetings. House receives Ibrahim Muriuki from Ngararia Village meeting and sends Daniel Ndoto and Marika Tee to Ngararia Impact and Bernard Misati to HDTI as a faculty (4).

Contradiction: Operating on the circuit schedule in the midst of leaders engagement to coffee picking and weeding maize and beans. Extending programmes in the midst of unclear context to the village leaders. (Weeks 4,5)

MOMBASA—THE KAMWELENI HOUSE

External: The Kamweleni House last week had a fantastic time of covering villages in symbolic circuit within two weeks time with only 25 circuiters which were divided into 18 teams. Within two weeks they came out with 194 participants for VLC seminar which takes place on Monday 1-3-1983 to 3-3-1983 at KTS. Still the House sends two staff that is Larry Philbrook accompanied by John Kivi, section gun John Kivuva for the set of Mbiuni impact. The two staff also made visits to two D.O.'s to invite them for the closing of the VLC seminar.

Contradiction: The Kamweleni former staff story has affected most of the ongoing activities and how to eradicate the images which the community has been a hardship. (Week 4)

AREA BOMBAY

BOMBAY—THE MALIWADA HOUSE

External: Eye camp is held in Maliwada Human Development Training Institute where 250 patients participate from cluster is checked and 35 eye operations are done by Dr. S.M. Shetye and his students of Ghati Medical College Aurangabad, and care for the patients for seven days with supplying free medicine. Health film is shown by this college too.

Internal: House cleaning creates the identity system at Diwali festival. Collegiums on seven revolutions; charting paper of image and artform method and conversation reminds us how to lead a group. Asharam hosted the guests, Mr. and Mrs. Vijaysingh Barase, the retired major of army from Aurangabad.

Contradiction: Linking of people from Diwali discontinuity to Week 6 effective action. (Week 4)

BOMBAY—THE CHIKHALE HOUSE

External: Global Panchayat reception is held in Ashram with village leaders from Chikhale and other sectors manifesting reality of HDA in Panvel Block. Lively conversation included stories of villagers around the world, Chikhale Training Centre construction, Chikhale Cluster activities and IERD participation. Primary Health Care seminar is held in Jamkhed, sponsored by CASA and attended by Aka Gawde and Nancy Lanphear who were impacted by the powerful change agent role the female health caretakers are playing in the villages. Air India provides Diwali sweets to the cluster preschool children.

Internal: Following house members return from Diwali festival a week's preparation was finalized with Panchayat visit; Carol Pierce and Larry Ward lead sessions and released great new images of the role of the Order for the next 16 years. Barry Oakley spent brief visit at the ashram between his visit to Pakistan, Kokane, and Sudarkar Chandakar is sent out to NST and preparation for hosting IERD.

Contradiction: Experiencing a mountain of demands in the midst of new possibilities. (Week 6)*

BOMBAY—THE VAVIHARSH HOUSE

External: Tree plantation programme is completed. Three hundred people participate in Health Camp. Work on tap water scheme for Vaviharsh village is going very well. Cluster preschool proposal is submitted to CEO and Social Welfare officer Zilla Parishad. Carpenter Skill Training proposal is submitted to Panchayat Samiti-Igatpun. We got 1,500rs first aid medicine from district health officer for Vaviharsh village and cluster village. Work is going on cluster mahila assembly through mahila leader - Ramabai Ambekor Nusik.

Internal: Vaviharsh staff participate in Chikhale CSI cultural study. Pinto Babote's birthday is celebrated, 150 people participate from cluster village. Annual Appeal plan and materials are received.

Contradiction: (no contradiction or week submitted Week ?)

External: Area Priors, Nagpur and Bombay Regional Priors meeting is held in Jawale for the ICA project documentation laboratory in preparation for the IERD. Forty Jawale village leaders met for a six year project journey workshop. After cluster site visit a report was written and a celebration held.

Internal: While all are gathered, an area meeting deals with issues and the creating of a Maharashtra village development brochure. A Jawale House meeting enables the creation of a countdown IERD prep timeline.

Contradiction: Holding deployment tension between continental PDL demands and local self-support and IERD prep demands. (Week 3)

PUNE—THE MAALE HOUSE

PUNE—THE BUDHODA HOUSE

NAGPUR—THE SEVAGRAM HOUSE

External: House participates in international women's conference in Paunar and hosts 24 medical visitors from Belgium. Preparation continues for Village Economic Conference, for eight villages of Dhanova Cluster, scheduled for November 24 and 25.

Internal: House continues to fill up again following Diwali discontinuity.

Contradiction: Finding ways to arrange funding as part of every programme. (Week 6)*

NAGPUR—THE TEMBHURWAHI HOUSE

External: Denada Societies distribution loan for 21 people in the cluster. We celebrated Gandhi's birthday on 2nd Oct. and visited Manohav Sapre (district member M.S.E.B.) and submitted proposal for Cluster Village Electricity.

Internal: New volunteer from England arrived in ashram. Mr. Chate, Police Sub-Inspector visits Ashram.

Contradiction: Circuit cluster people are busy in the field. How to engage them with 4-sector work all together. (Week 2)

NAGPUR—THE DABHAD HOUSE

AREA DELHI

THE DELHI HOUSE

External: Annual Appeal is completed tripling last year's bottomline and the number of donors in the Area. Manoeuvring for Phase II of the Quarter accelerates cluster activities with formation of 5-village leadership structure, the exploration of site for training centre/ICA residence construction and a move on visible development signs. Intensive circuit across Area sets up six PDL events and four RDS's are scheduled for next month. Block Development Officer (BDO) visits House and assures full support while government finishes 3-village survey for flood water outlet system.

Internal: Kris Kuchera arrives as volunteer for six months. Battacharya children are enrolled in school with hostel. Self-support is off to good start with rupees 5,000 in hand for Bata Supervisors Course. Dinner out in Faridabad makes for great celebration of week's work.

Contradiction: After deciding PDL as number 1 priority for the next four weeks, launching critical cluster manoeuvres while PDL schedule is still unclear. (Week 1)

AREA MADRAS

THE BANGALORE HOUSE

External: Six out of 14 Project Description Laboratories in the four states of Southern India are completed and the rest on track to be completed by November 6th. Area Development is close to surpassing the annual total of the last two years in week three of Quarter II, with two 10,000 rupee gifts from Madras, 200,000 rupees working and a realistic plan for 400,000 in the works. Health plan in cluster continues to develop with one man undergoing an eye operation and hospitalization arranged for two polio victims.

Internal: Major House planning deals with space contradiction as House claims one new guest room and one new family room.

Contradiction: Allowing the feverish swirl of immediate activities to let us forget to plan for what happens after February 1984. (Week 3)

Jamshedpur trip confirms Imaginal Education Seminar with 50 heads and deputy heads of Tisco Schools for October (1).

Internal: One day discontinuity "Muhrram" (Muslim Festival) launched a dispersed week with teams leaving for PDL's, Imaginal Educational and Bombay LENS, leaving one adult and four children to hold the fort (4). The huge "Durga Puja" holiday allows House to create new decor, blackboard, office shelves and E.G. room set up (2). The new time design for the Quarter is launched and highlighted by an individual/corporate study night and one day family festivities (1).

Contradiction: Maintaining the balance between internal and external demands. Configuring ourselves to handle strategically an Imaginal Education Course, PDL and continental LENS assignment. Maintaining programme momentum in the midst of major puja festivities. (Weeks 1,2,4)

AREA SINGAPORE

THE JAKARTA HOUSE

External: The Jakarta House prepares a 52-page report on Rural Development Interchange Workshops held in six places across Indonesia for the Indonesian Steering Committee in anticipation of quick action needed relative to delegate selection and fund-raising. Eighty-eight letters are mailed out to contributors and potential contributions to attend a film showing at an inkinded room in the beautiful Mandarin Hotel.

Internal: Even the preparation for the Panchayat Trek occasioned a deeper reflection of Order Life as new decor, cleaning, painting, inkind, and several evening meetings helped us "get ready"--both mentally and physically. External: Final draft of 1982-1983 Annual Report cum newsletter is completed and model is built for producing it at a minimal cost.

Internal: S. Krishnan is sent out to Indonesia for several weeks for enabling the campaign of RDS.

Contradiction: Allowing a breakloose of creativity in transforming our space with images for the next year and getting it all finished within a week with the staff left in the House. (Week)

THE UJUNG PANDANG HOUSE

External: Youth group of Bontoa go to other village for soccer competition after having workday renew some electric post and clean the Bontoa Mini Park. Seventy people attend the opening ceremony and 56 people participate at the Likakarya Organisasi Pembina Swadaya Masyarakat (RDIW) as representatives from 26 village projects in South Sulawesi, five projects are selected to be successful village development, four projects are visited by a team from University and RDS team, Hasanuddin University provide a vehicle for the visitation. Preschool teachers economic group learn more new skills and add two members on the small business group. Visit to Mr. Parawansa a Governor Secretary and PNP 28 give some clues on what we will do next.

Internal: Arrival of the RDS team and Area Prior make all rooms in the House occupied. It's really fun to watch "Maju Kena Mundur Kena" an Indonesian comedy film for celebration after finish RDIW, and second anniversary of Bintang family.

Contradiction: Getting community to create and participate for their own development when time is running out. (Weeks 4,5)*

Contradiction: Being extremely conscious about the future and ready to take a leap but without a parachute. (Week 5)*

THE HONG KONG HOUSE

External: Proposal for year-long training program for Time Inc., Asia, is created and submitted.

Internal: House has party to celebrate Jack's 39th birthday.

Contradiction: Locating the gas to power our IERD Implementation Vehicle. (Week 4)

THE TAIPEI HOUSE

External: The House conducts four separate programs in one week--Philips Taiwan Meeting Management Module, first session of Effective Supervision Course for Maritime Transportation Agencies, Ltd. (1981 LENS veteran company), Communications Module for International American Schools' Conference, and, with the help of four colleagues (two from Taipei, Two from Kaohsiung), a great problem solving training session with the Fang Liao Farmers Association in Chinese. External: Putsan people celebrated the community fiesta last October 18-19, 1983, sports tournament was organized by the Youth Club, teacher staff, Bgy. Officials, and ICA. Every house serves special food for visitors as Filipino custom during fiesta. The week was highlighted by the free movie from NMPC and about 2,500 people judged the show.

Internal: General cleaning of the House includes collegium, putting new room decor, varnishing chairs and tables for Panchayat visit to the Putsan House. This was highlighted by the House bowling celebration.

Contradiction: Activating the guild workers to their respective departments. (Week 4)

THE CEBU HOUSE

External: The house did inkinding blitz for the preschool snacks with some of the ELNC teachers of the Mactan-24/ Bagong Dalan Free-clinic with 42 patients. House welcomes the two Panchayat and staff from Manila. The highlighted event was three month/Langub new P/S building accomplished in two weeks.

Internal: House sends out volunteer staff, Anna Booth to Manila. Eunice celebrate 26th birthday last November 1, 1983.

Contradiction: Looking forward for economic program this year to make a good self-support on Mountain Cluster Program. (Week ?)*

DAVAO-MAHAYAG

External: A framing visit to the local ministry of Social Services representative results in obtaining snack food for a month for two preschools. Six visits to Line Agency Offices in Pagadian City bring about a two hour whirlwind getting photos, licenses, notary seals, residents certificates and legal papers galore to make the sewing industry a legal entity and Flor Ramirez its authorized manager.

Internal: Collegium of visioning the next two years prepares the House for Panchayat visit. Fiesta in Barangay Delusom unites the staff and the community in the enjoyment of basketball, cockfights, and feasting.

Contradiction: The wind is at our backs. We have left the plateau and started up the mountain again climbing the muddy slope behind two lumbering carabo, training and sewing industry. These fat slow beasts are slipping dangerously. Our choice is to push them up or be smashed by their fall. (Week 3)

AREA TOKYO

THE TOKYO HOUSE

External: National staff meeting reconfirms reconfiguration rationale and Year of Order Council. Inkinded RDS brochures arrive and are instataneously mailed out.

Internal: After lively Roundtable, wine tasting party impacts the wine salesman. The new decor and new face of the training center impacts visiting staff and guests. National staff celebrate the Butchers 22nd anniversary and Takako Rawanura's birthday.

Contradiction: Organizing the practical tasks that create space for all and that all can share in the tasks. (Week 6)*

THE SEOUL HOUSE

Contradiction: Preparing a corporate dance, not a solitary dance. Remembering the key action to do in the midst of carrying out additional details. (Weeks 5,6)*

THE FUKUOKA HOUSE

External: Two good Town Meetings were held in Okinawa; one with a representative from the largest bank in Naha, the other with youth leaders. S. Sato, Joyce Reese and Bob Rafos did the meetings, met with colleagues and discussed possible future relations with a training company there. The Kingsley video tape was translated into Japanese at a local TV station and given to us free. Six guests study the summer theme of compassion and respond profoundly to its meanings.

Internal: Rafos' visit on the way to the Okinawa TMs gives opportunities for talks with Bishop Iida about reconfiguration and the future for the Order; with two potential IERD participants and staff. David does TM presentation.

Contradiction: Continuing the struggle with hard issues related to reconfiguration in only four months. (Week 5)

THE OSAKA HOUSE

THE SAPPORO HOUSE

External: Local leader from Hokkaido volunteers himself for IERD and for 70% of total fees and travel, and one of the five prefectural agricultural cooperative groups will decide by the end of the month about sending and funding three participants for IERD. On the publications side, the expanded version of the Volunteer Symposium document goes to the printer, and the RDS brochure with remarkable framing participation is sent to key groups.

Internal: The first Japanese self-support venture is worked through to practical possibility.

Contradiction: Engaging new people who'll be left behind for team leadership. (Week 6,7)*

AREA SYDNEY

THE SYDNEY HOUSE

Internal: Wayne Nelson visits for one day and does workshop with House to enable documentation of last six years at Murrin Bridge. Instense facility research continues. House empowered and delighted by celebrations as Jenny Robins' final exams finish, the Howards announce second child expected next June, Lyn shows and tells about her wedding photos, and Eileen Howard receives \$100/month raise. Mike Bellamy is sent out to the U.S.

Contradiction: Getting power into our funding and framing strategies while being consumed with resettlement issues. (Week 5)

SYDNEY-THE MURRIN BRIDGE HOUSE

THE MELBOURNE HOUSE

AREA SUVA

APIA - THE NUKU'ALOFA HOUSE

External: Project selection taskforce creates plan for visits and PDLs in 10 villages. Roundtable sends out Temaketi Tu'ilape to Melbourne. Vava'u fundraising nets \$110 for PTS (7). Vava'u/Ha'apai circuit team finally arrived with a confirmed date report and the list of participants for the Ha'apai PTS. The National Steering Committee meeting was convened by Dr. Amanaki Havea and gave a realistic decision about the IERD. Funding possibilities of Tonga's delegation were being discussed. The second faculty training was done focusing on the methods lab (6).

Internal: Workday polishes the house apples and plants kumala. Youth collegium on journey of the year excites whole house. House welcomes Ma'asi Tongotongo as sojourner and Tongan language lessons begin (7). Collegium on perspective gave new insights of our work and the House turns back into 18 as the Carlings, a family volunteer from Holland visited the house, after their six months work in 'Eva, one of the islands of Tonga. People were divided into three different teams for a day's workday which is planting of kumala, painting the bathroom and mowing the yard (6).

Contradiction: Prioritizing our time in midst of Panchayat visit, PTS prep and project selection. Living out of faith without tactics. (Week 6,7)*

AREA SAN FRANCISCO

THE LOS ANGELES HOUSE

External: House completes a one-day PSU with LA Social Services Agency attended by 60 people. Week is "big wins" with Computer Paradigm 6-month contract with LA musicians union, \$1200 PSU finalized with Fresno State and \$1,000 Town Meeting with PG & E sponsorship. Press conference for Self-help Enterprises is covered by three T.V. stations and governor's letter.

Internal: Panchayat visits Bi-Region San Francisco - Los Angeles through three events (San Francisco, Tulare, and L.A.) involving 84 people.

Contradiction: Keeping all in touch with comprehensive mission when each arena is all consuming. (Week 6)*

THE SEATTLE HOUSE

External: Panchayat Trek catalyzes great conversations and brooding with colleagues from Alaska and Regional Team brings in boxes of "momentos" to document the local history. Second Seattle Region Project is notified of selection for IERD Plenary and two Alaskan projects are selected by Advisory Committee. Meetings in Thurston and Snohomish Counties uncover excitement and possibility for three Showcase Forums in one week.

Internal: Three House packets and one packet from Brussels arrive three days in a row, inundating us with paper, data and models.

Contradiction: Structuring adequate corporate time that allows for full participation of all members. Imaging the win for the whole year regarding corporate finances. (Week 6,7)*

THE DENVER HOUSE

External: Cup overflows with new people participating in the IERD through events over last two weeks. A funding event brings in \$1300; selected project (Lamar) holds description lab week with 50 attending party for money; and sixth rural development showcase forum in region is held at Lone Star School where 21 organizations travel an average of three hours each to participate.

Internal: New sojourner, Laura Forbes arrives while 13 month sojourner Dona Herrick moves to her new home for next phase in her journey. Indonesian colleagues visit and House watches "Day After".

Contradiction: Turning the wisdom of a strategy workshop into scheduled power. (Weeks 6,7)*

AREA EDMONTON

THE EDMONTON HOUSE

External: The Prince Albert hosting committee for the Local Exchange Conference share vision for results of "Sharing Approaches" and assign themselves roles for upcoming event. The Project Description Lab team for the Ft. Vermilion project in the far north includes Fr. Sterzer and Jim Carberry of Syncrude who also supplies his company's airplane for the northern part of the trip.

Internal: Wayne and Jane Kines of the World Media Institute spend the weekend at the House helping plan the story board for video-taping the Prince Albert Local Exchange Conference.

Contradiction: Creating the climate which allows the Prince Albert Hosting Committee to fully experience being on the team as participants in the victory. (Week 6)*

THE ANCHORAGE HOUSE

External: Luke Titus, of Minto, says yes to being included on the Alaska Advisory Committee. Will Mayo attends the National Steering Committee meeting in Chicago as Alaska's representative. Over 100 invitations to Alaska Advisory IERD Committee meeting are sent.

Internal: Alan Stocking arrives for the summer and he takes on a phone answering job for the Daily News. Warren Crain, guardian from Seattle, stops by.

Contradiction: Maintaining mission momentum when region is in summer mode. (Week 1)

THE VANCOUVER HOUSE

AREA HOUSTON

THE HOUSTON HOUSE

External: House writes maneuvers for each pole of the Year of Order Council triangle. Receives note of thanks and a check for \$10,000 following a visit with Bob Trull done in the midst of a Trull family tragedy (3). The announcement by NSC of six projects from area Houston to go to Delhi plenary is celebrating occasion for the first meeting of complete tri-regional Day I "army" in office; and launches House participation in continental prep for PDL, database and fund raising (2).

Internal: House completes internal work including a refreshing two week rhythm time design (3). Week-long House planning series is punctuated by live lunch hour classical music serenades; produces creative 2-week time design; and is capped by "Age of Aquarius" creativity celebration at an elegant Indian restaurant (2).

Contradiction: Holding the big picture of Year of Order Council in the midst of moving into a mode of implementation in myriad arenas. Struggling to get a hold of a style of reconciliation in the midst of diverse values of how we be missional (Weeks 2,3)

THE DALLAS HOUSE

THE MEMPHIS HOUSE

THE ATLANTA HOUSE

External: "Sharing Alabama Style" symposium for Northern Alabama is fine, one-day event with 75 participants in Cullman, Alabama. Governor's proclamation honoring Baconton, GA, for its IERD selection is read at annual Baconton Pecan Festival, November 19. Regional team "outposts" in Raleigh, N.C. and Tallahassee, Fla. are commissioned by Panchayat.

Internal: Site visit to Atlanta's Grant Park area and viewing of "The Day After" at colleague Joe Thomas' home are part of Panchayat trek.

Contradiction: Getting beyond flying by the seat of our pants...(Week 7)*

AREA CHICAGO

THE CHICAGO HOUSE

External: The first two WLI's (Westside Leadership Labs), staffed by 5th Citians, Regional colleagues and House members, of 15 scheduled this month with community groups on the Westside of Chicago are two of 13 programs held this week with 250 people involved. Fifth City is mentioned at least five times by different commissioners at the Mayor's forum with Mayor Washington and his cabinet at an open meeting held at John Marshall High School for the Westside of Chicago. Fifth City Business Careers (FCBC) finally has signed contract and mayor's office comes out for the first time to do intact for the 14th session to begin soon.

Internal: A forty minute collegium gets whole house on tape of the North/South dialogue paper in an amazing manner.

Contradiction: Catapulting slowing missional activities to leap the holiday effect. (Week 7)*

THE KANSAS CITY HOUSE **External:** Marge Tomlinson and Dick West come to work on LENS marketing. LENS calls were made to United Telephone, ASTD, and Hallmark relative to LENS set up. Students from Westport High participate in Student Transition workshop.

Internal: The Lorimor team comes down to participate in an Order Day, which ends with a celebration of David's birthday. YES gets a design conference from Marge Tomlinson.

Contradiction: Creating story of our mission as youth in Order and community. (Week 6)

LORIMOR HDP

External: The Lt. Governor of Ia. invites ICA participation on an advisory council of key people in the state and discusses the role of ICA in planning a state demonstration. Bill and Nan Grow join House team in resurgent research forays with church colleagues and nearby Christian colleges, which provides a deeper dimension to the regional task. THE NEW YORK HOUSE

Individual guilds decide to meet to accomplish their assignments before next taskforce meeting. New York Region Annual Report is completed and mailed to entire mailing list.

Internal: House is filled with boarders from Japan, Germany, Australia, Brooklyn, Chicago and Caracas. Longer term boarders volunteer to assist in building renovations

Contradiction: Breaking through gap in development income with only one third September program check earned. (Week 2)

THE ROCHESTER HOUSE

External: Co-sponsors of "Approaches That Work Conference" give nominations for presenters. Invitations to that conference are mailed. A two hour workshop "Eating Better for Less" is led by Regional Team as a part of the Institute of Man and Science's "Help Yourself to Health in the Hilltowns" program.

Internal: The House celebrates the end of a busy week by going to see "The Right Stuff" and nine metro colleagues are present at House Church celebrating Alice Rose's entry into phase II.

Contradiction: Setting up site visits in the midst of busy schedules and vacation days. (Week 5)

THE WASHINGTON HOUSE

External: One thousand four hundred and seventy dollars in Annual Appeal money comes in this week—\$800 of it is a contribution from a Baltimore artist who donated the proceeds from her recent art sale. Invitations to the first IERD benefit are mailed, and first returns come in after two days with 20 people saying "yes" and \$385 in-hand. Program PSU produces a unifying symbol on the next 16 months as well as a plan for Quarter II. Private agencies in International Development (P.A.I.D.) call to remind us that we've missed recent meetings and they've missed us!

Internal: Quarter II House life manual is completed and experimental time design is implemented. Hostelry program receives request from Philadelphia Lutheran Seminary for housing for 15 people Nov. 6-11 during 500th birthday celebration of Martin Luther.

Contradiction: Making Order assignments which create the interface that releases people to do the tasks before us this quarter. (Week 1)

THE BOSTON HOUSE

External: A \$100,000 week for Boston Training Inc. as Old Smith Church commits \$20,000, Bay State Skills Corporation \$72,000 and BP at John Hancock hosts sophisticated presentation for Boston businesses on the 60th floor of the Hancock. Gary Drown, VP at Indianapolis Life is a great guest speaker. Uniglobe Design Travel Consultants (Buna Macomber) opens its doors for business. October update and brochure for November courses goes out and four cars head North for 5th October workday in Starks.

Internal: Visits and celebrations mark the week with Gary and Pat Drown here from Indianapolis. Tina Slicker goes to Starks and Boston for mid-term break, Phyllis Allard's birthday is celebrated with a trip to the circus and Debra Griffin's birthday is celebrated with a birthday breakfast.

Contradiction: Looking at all we're doing through the screen of the Year of Order Council and creating designs for new actions. (Week 4)

BOSTON-THE STARKS HOUSE

External: Seventh October Saturday (Nov. 12) completes cut, splitting and stacking wood for heating cornshop. First project documentation lab in New England is completed with Coastal Enterprises, Inc. of Maine. Wreath Company completes 104 wreaths in first week of production and receives new order from nearby Farmington.

Internal: All winter wood is cut, split, stacked; House used for production of honey from local bee hives; "excellence" study is excellent.

Contradiction: Overcoming being harried with details so we can focus on the real needs. (Week 6)*

AREA MONTREAL

THE TORONTO HOUSE

External: Working with the Montreal House, we completed the three PDL's for the projects in the Maritimes. We also have a good possibility for a representative from the Quebec Ministry of Agriculture. Facilitating a one-evening Focus Research Group session for a new energy conservation company brings \$1,000 and a very satisfied client (7). IERD media campaign gets a boost as TAKE 30 director agrees to put some of the Canadian projects on regional and possibly national television. The Canadian Council for International Cooperation provides lists of its 95 members nationwide for a mailing about the IERD and possible representation at New Delhi (6).

Manuel works with Mathews' in Los Reyes community. Youth are committed to bring off Youth Forum and ensure participation from San Camilo. House continues strategy of breakfast and IERD meetings (2). Circuit to State of Queretaro results in likely project for IERD. Local initiative is startling, including care for wider network of villages, mostly in agricultural improvement. Pre-selection committee of NSC meets and invites eight projects from RDS to participate. Letter and questionnaire is sent out. Open door is presented to work in all or any of Fundacion Mexicana's 45 economic projects around the whole nation (3).

Internal: Both Manuel Samayoa and Bill Allerging celebrate birthdays in same week. House inkind 1976 four-door Renault. House gets facelift of rugs and curtains in corporate space (2). Order grieves at the sudden death of Araceli Mathews, age 28 on October 12th. Araceli's family, Jim Mathews, Frank Hilliard, Bill and Phyllis Slicker, Dr. Bob Springs and House celebrate her life together (3).

Contradiction: Addressing ourselves to global push on IERD, Order Council and finances reveals utter necessity to intensify local program. Getting commitment from projects to select their own representatives to go to India and participate in Phase III. (Week 2,3)

THE GUATEMALA CITY HOUSE

External: The week is highlighted by the discovery of new colleagues who are deeply committed to the task of the mission in Guatemala, these include: Eng. Victor Ortiz of EMPAGUA who lends his special expertise to the co-op with a refreshing eagerness, the new governor Victor Falla who spends his holiday-time visiting Conacaste and Irma Estrada a preschool teacher from Monte Grande who joins the extension team and sets up the new preschool in a fourth extension village. AREA HAVANA

THE KINGSTON HOUSE

External: NSC holds two meetings and begins documentation site visits. ICA lectures at University of West Indies in a Community Development course. Woburn Lawn builders travel to Claverty Cottage to donate labour on community centre construction. Two Rotary-ICA committee meetings are held. Cluster circuits are held in Portland, St. Andrew, Yallah's Valley and the Blue Mountains. Thirty colleagues attend Regional Team Meeting to plan circuits and expansion strategy. Panchayat Reception is held at the Pegasus with Ben Kingsley video shown to 28 "frame" - colleagues.

Internal: Panchayat visit is the highlight; tragic car accident near Woburn Lawn injures several village leaders and kills Alice Wright's niece; House welcomes Jack Silk and two sons and celebrates anniversary and birthdays.

Contradiction: Keeping our nerve while negotiating the symplegidies of three major grants evaluations which are upon us. (Week 2)

AREA LIMA

THE LIMA HOUSE

External: New one-year plan is completed for Asia Valley intensification serving 30 communities while team journeys in cattle truck to contact communities at 2800 meters at cluster community at base of valley sets plans to build 6 x 20 water industry building with assistance of DePauw University next January. Two site visits produce excellent newspaper article and release \$24,000 CRS grant to New York approval.

Internal: Titus ride on a burro ends up with bruises and wisdom about burros which have never been ridden before. House planning creates new operating designs during absence of six key members for CRA and Priors School in Caracas.

Contradiction: Willing to do the necessary construction focus in the midst of many beckoning new tasks. (Week 5)*

AREA CARACAS

THE CARACAS HOUSE

External: Second to last NSC meeting of 22 people narrows down final project selection for IERD as preparations for November intensity with inkind blitz, facility check, continental travel, arrangements, money search, decor prep, and procedures (4). The House participates in an emphasis on the Phase I dynamic of Caño Negro by aiding the sendout of six junior high students to the Jesuits' Trade School in Merida and participating in a baptism (3). The House hosts a site visit from the Benevolence Committee of The United Christian Church, completes sections of the Spanish Human Development Methods Lab manual and completes the requirements for sending Caño Negro students to the Merida Jesuit School (1).

Internal: Week II Area planning in Caño Negro is held as we count down to the 5-week continental program (4). The Panchayat visit focuses many mini-miracles on creating a demonstration House and inspires reflections on the symbols and history of the Order (3). Six new sojourners are welcomed amidst a celebration for Juan Jose's 20th birthday. House receives a donation of pasta and flour. House self-support venture brings in its first profits (1).

Contradiction: How to gear the November 2-week research assembly, continental council, and three week priorship training school around movement formation in Latin America. Assuming a new style with a balance between priorities and details in proximity of the Continental Research Assembly. Enlarging the human resources of the ICA: Barlovento. (Weeks 1,3,4)

AREA BUENOS AIRES

THE SANTIAGO HOUSE

External: All day presentation including workshops and spins initiates great interest at our first presentation at the NGO meeting. Youth Foro is held in Lampa and date is set for another Community Foro for next Saturday. Key is all are being done by local people. Catholic University calls and says yes we will translate the Kingsley video into Spanish and probably will show it on Channel 13 (6). Team sends out three persons to participate in the GRA, Continental Council and International School of Prior training in Caracas, Venezuela. Conversation with educational consultant of Center of Investigation and Development of Education helps keep the exchange of ideas flowing (4).

Internal: Directiva in Sol requests an emphasis on some kind of symbolic life for them and with three of our five in Caracas and most of the time one of the team in Sol and one in Santiago we understand what they are saying (6)! Viewing the film "Excalibur" and participating in a reflective conversation helps set the context for active participation in the research assembly of myths in Venezuela (4).

Contradiction: Holding the tension of fine programs and still using the programs to be indepth training for our extension team. Remembering our global context in the midst of the daily local thrusts. (Week 6)

AREA RIO DE JANEIRO

THE RIO DE JANEIRO HOUSE

External: Long hours of development strategizing begin to reap results as GAB member writes introductory letter to 20 companies, and very promising call with R.J. Reynolds offers hope for private sector participation in IERD travel. Rio Bonito municipal team meets and devises plan for the economic undergirding of the rural help program.

Internal: House celebrates Mark Welch's birthday with luscious chocolate pie. His chief birthday present: an intensive course in Portuguese! Diann Porter is sent out to Caracas for Continental Council and GRA. Bill Slicker is here for development.

Contradiction: Prioritizing time in such a way that momentum is maintained on critical missional fronts. (Weeks 3,4)

GLOBAL NEXUS

THE BRUSSELS NEXUS

External: The IERD non resident nation strategy results in strong interest from Turkey, Denmark, Sweden, Botswana, Uganda, Ghana. Nine thousand dollars in hand from Germany, from UK highlight development trek's tour to areas. First IERD delegate fee of \$2000 is banked.

Internal: The whole House is together for two full days with the Panchayat including reception by the E.G. Marianne Baasch announces her decision to become a fellow of the Order.

Contradiction: Feeding the corporate imagination long enough and creatively to enable time task scenarios. (Week 7)*

THE BOMBAY HOUSE

External: National Steering Committee a great success as we are reminded that these are educational, not just planning events. Tata Tea Rs50,000 check is issued and Rotary proposal in the works for over a year finally gets approval supplying 11 lakhs (US\$110,000) to the Subcontinent! Thirty-two people are present at the opening feast of the New Skills Training School in Pune, including guardians, landlords, Panchayat. PDL facilitators arrive back having completed 39 PDL's across Subcontinent.

Contradiction: Unintegrated troop models for implementing the next round of decisive tactics in key arenas like IERD, development, self-support and ongoing programmes. (Week 6)*

HONG KONG NEXUS HOUSE

External: Citibank has opened a new all-glass 50 story building opposite the Nexus building's front door and offers ICA the use of their training rooms, when they get them set up after January. GLOBAL DEVELOPMENT CENTRUM

Global Development Centrum reports that the Centrum is painted in one day in IERD colors. Three major IERD funding visits; Blue Star Foundation gift of US\$1,500 is received. Troops are sent out on four circuits. The key contradiction lies in the arena of there is no 3-day planning model. (Week 4)*

GLOBAL RESEARCH CENTRUM
