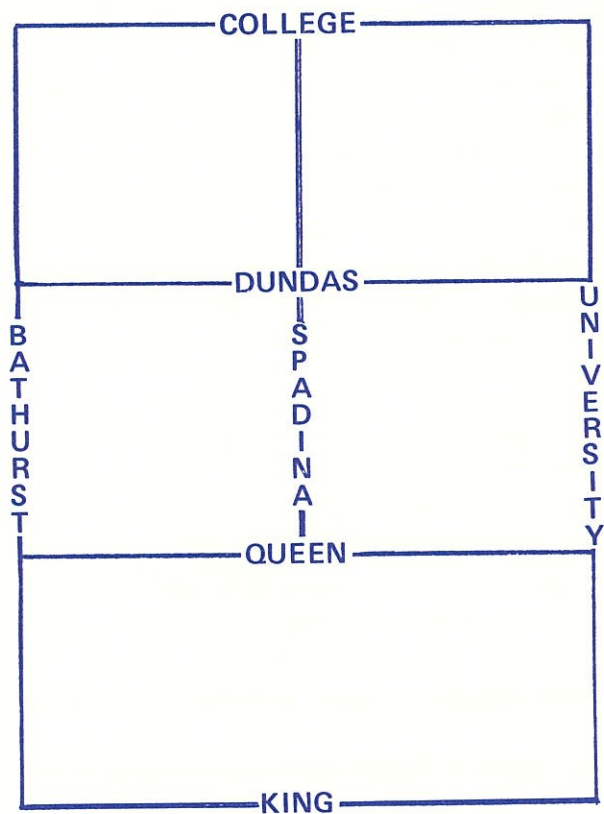

THE PLACE OF BEGINNINGS

The area that is now Spadina began as a trend-setting suburb of colonial Toronto. In the 1830's Spadina Avenue became a thriving centre as the main street of the new town, and a brick mansion, the Grange, became a focal point for government gatherings.

As Toronto became more nationally and internationally important, the core built up and expanded. In the 1890's Spadina attracted many of Canada's first immigrants from Germany, Austro-Hungary and Russia. Around 1905 the Jewish community moved west of the Grange area and began Kensington Market.

The proximity of Toronto Harbour soon added an industrial base to this commercial hub as Spadina Avenue became a node for the Toronto garment industry.

The Twentieth Century has seen Spadina grow even more cosmopolitan with the arrival of Southern Europeans and Asian peoples to give it an amazing ethnic diversity. Spadina is a place of new beginnings.

THE CENTRE OF DIVERSITY

Spadina is the kind of place where you can stand on a street corner and talk with people from every point on the globe. Each of the six cultures of man (Red, White, Yellow, Black, Brown and Tan peoples) brings its own unique gifts to this local community and make it an exciting place to live.

In addition, Spadina has many active social agencies of every kind and a growing reputation for urban planning, lively entertainment, cultivation of the arts and the civic responsibility of its residents groups.

The widely varied lifestyles, the many different social groups, the variety of architectural designs make Spadina a symbol of diversity, not melting away differences but celebrating the rich treasury of the whole globe in one spot.

THE FORERUNNER OF GLOBAL COMMUNITY

Because of its ethnic diversity, Spadina is already a global village and has the possibility of being a sign in the future of a new human community. Here ethnic groups have struggled to maintain identity in the midst of a multi-cultural community. Without this struggle would be lost the authentic possibility of sharing their unique cultural gifts at a time when the future of the planet demands ever closer working together between nations and races.

The world's tallest self-supporting structure, the CN Tower, stands in the south of Spadina 5 as a symbol of the future community and the intercommunication that will make it possible. Spadina was, is and will continue to be, a great place to be alive.
