1. Introduction

The people of the Republic of Korea are at the threshold of another great moment in their history of over 5000 years. After two decades of miraculous economic development on the national level, the nation has turned its attention to nation-wide social advancement through the socio-economic, spiritual development of local communities. As a vehicle for this ambitious effort the Republic of Korea has developed the New Community Movement or the Sae Maul (Maum) Undong. Any nation in the world would do well to emulate the initiative and dedication which have resulted in remarkable achievement in local economic development during the six years the Sae Maul Movement has been working throughout the land.

The Institute of Cultural Affairs has been engaged in comprehensive socio-economic development projects for over thirteen years with the following history:

1. 1963 - The Fifth City Human Development Project located in the West Side Negro ghetto, Chicago, Illinois, USA
2. 1970 - The Majuro Human Development Project located in Majuro, Marshall Islands, Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands. Consult held September, 1974.
3. 1970 - The Oombulgurri Human Development Project of the Aboriginal people located in North West, Australia. Consult held August, 1975.
4. 1975 - The Jeju-do Human Development Project located in Kwangyung Il Ri, Aeweol Myeon, Buk Gun, Jeju-do, Republic of Korea. Consult held October, 1975.
5. 1975 - November. The Kawangware Human Development Project located on the outskirts of Nairobi, Kenya.
6. 1975 - December. The Maliwada Human Development Project located east of Bombay in the State of Maharashtra, India. This project is replicating in 7 other villages within Maharashtra.
7. 1976 - January. The Isle of Dogs Human Development Project located in the dock workers community on the river Thames in London, England.
8. 1976 - April. The Sudtonggan Human Development Project located on the island of Mactan near Cebu, Republic of the Philippines.
9. 1976 - August. The Kelapa Dua Human Development Project located south of Jakarta of West Java, Indonesia.
10. 1976 - October. The Kreuzberg Ost Human Development Project located in a community on the Eastern edge of West Berlin, Germany, bonded on two sides by the Berlin Wall.
11. 1976 - November. The El Bayad Human Development Project located one hundred forty kilometers south of Cairo, Egypt.
12. 1976 - November. The Ivy City Human Development Project located in Northeast Washington D.C., USA



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13. 1976 - December. The Inyan Wakagapi Human Development Project located in Cannonball, Standing Rock Indian Reservation between North and South Dakota, USA.
14. 1976 - December. The Shantumbu Human Development Project located near Lusaka, Zambia.
15. 1977 - January. The Caño Negro Human Development Project located near Caracas, Venezuela.
16. 1977 - January. The Ijede Human Development Project located near Lagos, Nigeria.
17. 1977 - February. The Delta Pace Human Development Project, located near the Mississippi Delta area in Mississippi, USA.
18. 1977 - March. The Nam Wai Human Development Project, located in the New Territories of Hong Kong.
19. 1977 - The Sungei Lui Human Development Project located in a Malay village east of Kuala Lumpur, Selangor, West Malaysia. Consult to be held in April, 1977.
20. 1977 - The Lorne Del'Acadie Human Development Project located in New Brunswick, Canada. Consult to be held in April, 1977.
21. 1977 - The Nan Ping Human Development Project located in a fishing village south of Kaohsiung, Republic of China. Consult to be held in May, 1977.
22. 1977 - The Yellow Knife Human Development Project located near the Great Slave Lake, District of Mackenzie, Northwest Territories, Canada.
23. 1977 - The Botayama Human Development Project located in the coal mining town of Miyata in Kyushu, Japan. Consult to be held June, 1977.
24. 1977 - The Castelgrande Human Development Project located south of Rome, Italy. Consult to be held in June, 1977.

Summary: 24 Projects

These socio-economic community development projects are located in sixteen different nations outside the Republic of Korea: USA (five projects), Canada (two projects), England, Australia, Kenya, India (eight villages), Republic of the Philippines, Indonesia, Republic of Germany, Egypt, Zambia, Venezuela, Nigeria, Hong Kong, Malaysia and the Republic of China. By the end of June, 1977, two additional countries will have projects: Japan and Italy. Five of the projects are in urban centers and nineteen are in rural villages. Eleven of the projects are in "developed" countries and thirteen are located in "developing" nations.

2. The Institute of Cultural Affairs
